### MEGA-RRIFIC

Turning for home in yesterday's GII Santa Barbara H. at Santa Anita, even **Megahertz (GB)** (Pivotal {GB})'s staunchest fans must have thought the mighty-might had left herself too much to do, but the chestnut mare closed relentlessly and overtook **Nadeszhda (GB)** (Naswhan) in the final strides to win going away. Coming off a late-running win in the Mar. 20 GII Santa Ana H. and looking for her third straight Santa Barbara win, Megahertz was content to trail the field, falling back by as much as 20 lengths, as **Midwife** (Family Calling) opened up a big early lead. The pacesetter was swallowed up by rivals turning for home, with Nadeszhda going best of all. That mare sailed clear and looked home free, but Megahertz made up ground with a vengeance and collared Nadeszhda to win by 3/4 lengths. "She's so special," gushed winning rider Alex Solis. "I never have ridden a horse that has that kind of kick. It's incredible. You really have to understand her, leave her alone and let her do her thing. She gets me worried, too, but I trust what she's doing the whole race. She just says, 'I'll let them go and I'll catch them later.'"

## Triple Threats

### Blue Grass 1-2 Headed to Kentucky Derby...

The first six finishers from Saturday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. will all start in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby, it was confirmed yesterday. Trainer Todd Pletcher was pleased with how Blue Grass winner **Bandini** (Fusaichi Pegasus) came out of the race. "He's bright and alert and all systems are go for Churchill Downs," Pletcher said. It was six lengths back to runner-up **High Limit** (Maria's Mon), but trainer Bobby Frankel was not discouraged. "He'd only been out once this year [winning the GII Louisiana Derby]," Frankel remarked. "He needed a

hard race and he got one. I needed to put a little fitness in him for the Derby and this race accomplished that." He added, "I don't know whether he's going to move forward or backward, but I know one thing--you can tell this morning that he ran a tough race [Saturday]." There could be an equipment change in order for the colt, who jumped the tracks left by the starting gate during the stretch run of the Blue Grass. It is a habit he has displayed before. "I'm thinking of putting a little pair of blinkers on him, because obviously he's not paying attention if he's jumping tracks every time," Frankel said. "That's three times he's done it. I'm just wondering if [blinkers] would get him too rank, but it might not." *Triple Threats cont. p4.*

Megahertz's late-running tactics in yesterday's GII Santa Barbara H. did put a scare in Humberto Ascanio, assistant to winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "I was worried she was too far back," Ascanio admitted. "When a horse loses contact, it gets lazy. They need to follow something up close. But this guy [Solis] knows her. What can I say?" Julio Garcia, aboard runner-up Nadeszhda, knew he would have competition. "At the five-furlong pole, I tried to open up a little bit because I know [Megahertz] is going to be very strong," Garcia explained. "It was a good idea and I think she ran great." Megahertz is the first horse in the race's 57-year history to win the Santa Barbara three times. **INTERCONTINENTAL WINS SECOND WILEY**

Jerry Bailey wanted **Intercontinental (GB)** (Danehill) to settle off a slow early pace in yesterday's GIII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland, but the bay mare disagreed. Rank in the early going, she pulled Bailey to the lead while racing four wide down the backstretch. "Usually after she throws her head back in my face the second time, she settles down, but she would have none of it today," Bailey said. Intercontinental easily opened a clear lead on the field and was never threatened as **Delta Princess** (A.P. Indy) made a strong late run to get up for second. "She's very hard to ride," admitted winning trainer Bobby Frankel after watching Intercontinental win her second straight Jenny Wiley. "She really pulls. We tightened the girth an extra notch because we didn't want anything to happen. She's a very good filly, very talented. In the morning, she's perfect, but in the afternoon she likes to go." Intercontinental, who also captured last year's GII Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont in June, had not started since winning the GI Matriarch S. last November. In a race of changing fortunes, Hazariya snatched the spoils in the dying strides to continue the fine run of form of John Oxx representatives on the flat this season. Successful in a mile maiden at this track on her last start Apr. 3, she showed early dash to lie close to the pace under Mick Kinane, but appeared booked for place money as Airwave hit the front approaching the quarter pole. Taken to the stands' rail soon after, she rallied to grab the advantage in the final strides as Sky High Flyer overcame Airwave on the far side. "She won her maiden staying on at the end, so I think she's a 10-furlong filly," Oxx commented. "With the ground so testing, we thought she should take her chance and she won by courage and stamina, as the conditions are unbelievably tough. She is in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas here [May 22], but I doubt she'll go there as a mile on fast ground will be too short. Idealist, alongside Manduro (Ger) and Konigstiger (Ger), is one of three strings to Peter Schiergen's bow this term, and the colt added further depth to his conditioner's Classic aspirations with an emphatic success here. Few two-year-olds can win Listed races by three lengths on their racecourse debuts, but Idealist proved the exception when taking the Junioren-Preis at Dusseldorf in September. He found only Konigstiger a head too strong when second in the G1 Gran Criterium at the San Siro the following month, but emerged from his stable companion's shadow to re-affirm his reputation in this trial for the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 3. **Derby Still an Option for Blue Grass Also Rans...**

Both **Sun King** (Charismatic) and **Consolidator** (Storm Cat) finished off the board in the Blue Grass, but their connections are still pointing for the first leg of the Triple Crown. Sun King was beaten a neck by **Closing Argument** (Successful Appeal) for third. "For some reason, he just didn't fire," trainer Nick Zito said. "We'll try and regroup. The Derby might be a different story." Consolidator, the 3-1 co-second choice, was another four lengths back in fifth. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas felt a change in tactics compromised the colt's chances. "We just took him completely out of his game," Lukas said. "[Jockey Rafael Bejarano], I think, was a little bit concerned about the speed and when a couple of horses broke kind of sharp, he elected to take back. We've never had a good race out of him taking back." The Hall of Fame horseman added, "[The Blue Grass] has never been a conclusive race...anyhow. I've won it a couple of times and you couldn't find them in the Derby, and then I've [been beaten] in it and won the Derby. So I think we'll just go on to the next one and see what happens."

**Ongoing Argument...**

Trainer Kieran McLaughlin has not yet decided on future plans for Closing Argument. "I'm just happy he ran well," he said. "I'm real proud of him. I'll have to talk with [owners Philip and Marcia Cohen] about the Derby."

**Greater Good Enough...**

**Greater Good** (Intidab), fifth in Saturday's GII Arkansas Derby, was shipped to Churchill Downs Sunday and is still on the Kentucky Derby trail, according to trainer Bob Holthus. "Greater Good has done a lot in his career so far," Holthus said of the GIII Rebel S. winner. "So we plan to give him another chance."

### CHANGING WITH THE TIMES

The horse racing game has undergone many changes over the course of the last century, and never has that been more in evidence than in the sales arena. One of the most notable changes observed in the sale's industry has been the advent of the repository system. With hundreds of thousands and often millions of dollars exchanging hands for a single animal, the need for a system of full disclosure became of increasing importance.

Keeneland incorporated the repository library into its sales in 1996, and has continued to work on getting the system down to one of fluid efficiency. Cathy Shank, acting Keeneland librarian since 1978, was enlisted to head the project. It didn't take long to recognize the fact that major changes were needed in the filing and retrieval system.

"The take-out process we have has changed," said Shank. "It used to be all documented on paper, but now it is all computerized. Everyone who checks out X-rays is scanned into the computer--that way, if for some reason we need to go back and check and see when somebody looked at a set of X-rays, we can just generate a report that will give us all the information. Consignors were the biggest reason for the transition from paper to computer. They would come in and ask if their horses' X-rays were checked out, and we had no way of knowing because we were trying to do this with a paper trail. It just became unmanageable."

Another major change adopted by Keeneland since the repositories' inception was the standardization of material submitted into the libraries' informational archive.

"Probably the biggest change we made to the system was standardizing the number of X-rays included for each horse," explained Shank. "In the first year, we didn't have a specific number of views required. The problem with that was that people would sometimes come up to us and say that certain X-rays were missing, and since we didn't count them when they were submitted, we had no way of knowing if they had ever been there to begin with."

The solution, according to Shank, was simple.

"Keeneland sat down with our veterinary committee and decided that a minimum of 32 selected views were required," she said. "Also, the X-rays must have been taken within the allotted time prior to the sale [15 days for the two-year-old sale], before they can be accepted and submitted into the repository. Once there, they cannot be removed or changed."

However, not all of the practices implemented to protect perspective buyers enjoyed the same success as the X-ray repository. Scoping, a procedure used to detect irregular structure in a horse's respiratory tract, failed to take off because of the inconsistencies in imaging, as well as the subjective nature of the results. But, overall, the repository project has enjoyed tremendous growth and increasing participation through the years.

"In 1996, when the program was initiated, we had about 50 percent participation," said Shank. "People weren't really sure if this was going to work or not, but as the demand by perspective buyers increased, more and more of the consigners got on board."

According to Shank, participation in the program, specifically in the two-year-old sales, rose to about 90 percent in 2003. By 2004, 100 percent of horses led through the ring had the required documentation on file in the repository. It appears that results will be the same for the 2005 edition of the April sale.

"I think that it really makes a difference, especially with the larger sales, because people's time is limited and if X-rays aren't available, we discovered early on that horses without X-rays were generally not viewed as often," said Shank. "If someone has 20 horses to look at and there are a couple that haven't been X-rayed, then people will often mark those horses off their list. So as a result, we had more and more people start X-raying their horses."

Bob Lewis, prominent owner and frequent buyer at the April sale, emphasized the importance of the system not only to the individual owner, but also to the sport as a whole.

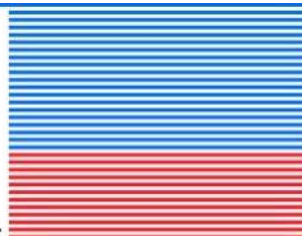
"We diligently vet a horse when we intend to make a purchase, and X-rays in the repository help us in that decision-making process tremendously," he said, adding, "It is a compliment to the industry and it improves the sport's credibility. It takes us further down the road to enhance the sport and hopefully, bring new investors into the game."

**CAJUN BEAT RETIRED** *Cajun Beat* (Grand Slam--Beckys Shirt, by Cure the Blues), winner of the 2003 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, suffered a career-ending injury during Saturday's GI Commonwealth Breeders' Cup H. The five-year-old gelding faded badly in the stretch to finish sixth and last, then had to be vanned off the track. According to *Thoroughbred Times*, he suffered a pulled suspensory in his left hind leg. Trainer Bobby Frankel indicated yesterday that the injury had been stabilized and Cajun Beat was being monitored by the stable's veterinarians. In addition to his Breeders' Cup score, the dark bay won the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint at three. He added wins in the GIII Mr. Prospector H. and GIII Hollywood Turf Express H. last year and retires with a record to 19-7-3-0 and earnings of \$1,159,100.

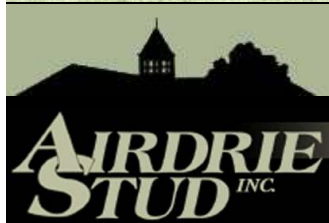
