### FULL FIELD OF 20 TO PLAY HOMERUN DERBY

As expected, a full field of 20 will be in the starting gate for Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby. Trainer Todd Pletcher got things started at yesterday's draw, selecting post 15 for GI Blue Grass S. winner **Bandini** (Fusaichi Pegasus). He will hope history repeats itself, as last year's winner Smarty Jones broke from that post position as well. "You have the extra space between the 14 and the 15, and five of

the last 10 Derby winners have come out of the auxiliary gate," Pletcher told *ESPN*. Trainer Nick Zito remained busy yesterday selecting post positions for his five Derby charges. George Steinbrenner's **Bellamy Road** (Concerto), the morning-line favorite at 5-2 off his decisive victory in the GI Wood Memorial, will break from the 16 post, while GI Florida Derby hero **High Fly** (Atticus) breaks from the 11. "It took five minutes--a minute a horse, that's it," Zito quipped. "No, there is some thought to the selection process. We wanted Bellamy Road outside. He is a great big horse and he needs room. That's the post we wanted--he'll have no excuse. I'm happy, I really am." **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet), a sharp eight-length winner in the GI Arkansas Derby, will break from the 12 post. He was made the 9-2 second choice.

### HIGH LIMIT SHARP IN HIS FINAL BREEZE

**High Limit** (Maria's Mon), winner of the GI Louisiana Derby, worked four furlongs in :48.20 at Churchill Downs after the renovation break yesterday. The work was the fifth fastest of 25 moves at the distance. "It was fine," trainer Bobby Frankel said of the colt's final breeze for the Derby. "I wanted between :48 and :49. The horse is doing super." The Gary and Mary West colorbearer was last seen finishing second behind **Bandini** in the GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 16. Frankel threatened to change riders on High Limit after jockey Ramon Dominguez was quoted in the *Louisville Courier-Journal* saying that "he probably doesn't have enough experience to compete at the highest level yet," but named Dominguez on the colt yesterday at the draw.

### Greeley's Galaxy Works Five Furlongs...

Making his last major move prior to this Saturday's Kentucky Derby, **Greeley's Galaxy** (Mr. Greeley) breezed five furlongs in 1:01.60 at Churchill Downs Wednesday. "He went too slow early because he was under too much hold," trainer Warren Stute said of the GI Illinois Derby winner. "I expected faster, but the last half-mile was fine. He finished OK. He looks good and healthy. I hope he can sit behind the pace early."

### Wilko Sitting On A Big Effort...

After battling foot problems for most of the winter, GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero **Wilko** (Awesome Again) is coming up to the Derby in good shape, according to trainer Craig Dollase. "He popped a quarter crack before the San Felipe, but he's been going good ever since and maybe the problems are behind him," Dollase said of Wilko, who was last seen finishing a creditable third in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 9. "I'm happy with where he's at today. He's bred to get the distance and he's a very durable, well-seasoned horse, which can help in a race like the Derby."

**ROSES IN MAY TO STAND IN JAPAN** G1 Dubai World Cup winner **Roses in May** (Devil His Due--Tell a Secret, by Speak John) will retire at the end of the season and head to Japan to stand at stud, it was

reported yesterday. Owners Ken and Sarah Ramsey have sold a majority interest in the breeding rights to the five-year-old to unnamed Japanese investors. Roses in May will continue to race in the Ramsey's colors until the end of the year. "It was an offer we couldn't re-

fuse, and we get to keep a piece of the horse," Ramsey told *The Blood-Horse*. "After the Dubai race when we were over there, a representative for Sheikh Mohamed made overtures of buying the whole horse. They wanted 100 percent of him for racing as well as breeding. With the offer from the Japanese, we'll be able to send our mares to him. And if things don't work out, we can bring him back to Kentucky to live out his final days." Ramsey had originally planned to stand Roses in May, along with champion Kitten's Joy, MGSW Badge of Silver and sophomore sire Catienus, at Ramsey Farm, near Nicholasville, Kentucky, in 2006. The dark bay has eight wins and four seconds from 13 career starts. His earnings stand at \$5,490,187. In addition to his World Cup score, he took the G1 Whitney H., GII Kentucky Cup Classic and GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker Breeders' Cup H., and was runner-up in last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Classic. He could make the final start of his career in the G1 Japan Cup Dirt in November. "I told the man if he wins, he can lead him in the winner's circle," Ramsey told *The Blood-Horse*.

Gygistar cruised to a 4 1/4-length score over Saarland in this race last year, but was off the board in his next three starts. The chestnut gelding then reeled off a trio of third-place finishes in the Sept. 4 G1 Forego H., Oct. 8 GII Meadowlands Breeders' Cup H. and Oct. 31 GIII Sport Page H., but finished fifth as the odds-on favorite in his 2004 finale, the Charles H. Hadry S. at Pimlico Nov. 20. The Edward Evans homebred returned to the winner's circle after his seasonal bow, taking an optional claimer at Gulfstream Park by 5 1/2 lengths Mar. 11, but had to settle for second behind Value Plus in the Apr. 2 Artax H. last time out. Looking to turn the tables as the second choice here, Gygistar settled in sixth as Value Plus dashed through a half in :44.61, then edged closer as they zipped through six furlongs in 1:08.93. He drove to the front at the top of the lane and held off Swingforthefences for a handy victory. The winner is now four-for-six at Belmont Park. "He loves this track," trainer Mark Hennig said. "This makes us think about holding off and waiting for the Brooklyn H. [Grade II, \$250,000, nine furlongs, June 11]. We would love to have a shot at the Met Mile [May 30], but in his best interest at this point, I would like to get as much confidence as we can into him. The more wins you get into him, the happier he is."

Aidan O'Brien continues his inaugural raid on the "Roodeye" at Chester with **Almighty**, who will need to step up on his seasonal return in the G3 Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 10. Sent off the even-money favorite on that occasion, he failed to fire in the testing ground and could manage only fourth of five, but there is undoubtedly better to come. Clive Brittain, who has won this twice since 1995, saddles **Hattan**, who ran with credit after meeting interference at a crucial point when third in the G3 Classic Trial at Sandown last time Apr. 22. "Hattan ran a cracking good race at Sandown --he missed the break and then got into a little bit of trouble on the inside," his trainer explained. "He certainly would have been second without any doubt and he would have put the winner under pressure if the race had gone a bit differently. He's entered in the Derby--we'll see how he gets on at Chester, which will tell us if he is good enough." Another who will relish this step up in distance is the maiden **Kalamkar**, whose connections won this in 1981 with no less than Shergar (GB).
