**SHOCK 'JOCK' TAKES THE ROSES**

You have to go all the way back to 1913 to find longer odds on the Kentucky Derby winner. Scoring the biggest upset since Donerail shocked the crowd at 91-1, 50-1 **Giacomo** (Holy Bull) came from out of the clouds to catch 70-1 **Closing Argument** (Successful Appeal) for a half-length victory in the 131st "Run for the Roses" at Churchill Downs yesterday. It was only the second win of the colt's career, but owner Jerome Moss said, "I knew that Giacomo was a pretty steady performer and I didn't think he has peaked yet. **Madcap Escapade** (Hennessy) was the 2-5 favorite, but fast fractions took their toll and it was **My Trusty Cat** (Tale of the Cat) who swooped late to record a 3/4-length score over **Molto Vita** (Carson City) in the GI Humana Distaff H. "I knew this wasn't going to be Madcap Escapade's kind of track," trainer David Vance said. "It's playing just too fast. I told the boss [owner Carl Pollard] that if we were within a length at the eighth pole, we'd win." Madcap Escapade faded down the lane to be fifth in the first off-the-board effort of her career. "She doesn't run even on this track," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "Usually she'll open up, but she just struggles over this track more than any other." **Humana Distaff H. cont. p3**

**Anatomy of an Upset...**

What road did **Giacomo** travel on his way to Kentucky Derby glory? Bred by owners Mr. and Mrs. Jerome Moss, the grey opened his career with a fifth-place finish in a 5 1/2-furlong maiden race at Hollywood last July. He was on the bench for three months after his debut, but came back to win his two-turn bow by 10 lengths at Santa Anita Oct. 22. Third in an entry-level allowance Nov. 14, he ended his juvenile season with a bang-up second at 15-1 in the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 18. Giacomo was the 7-5 chalk in the Feb. 5 Sham S., but had to settle for third behind **Going Wild** (Golden Missile), then was a distant second to Consolidator in the Mar. 19 Gil San Felipe S. He lost the faith of the bettors when he could manage only fourth in what was thought to be a weak renewal of the Apr. 9 GI Santa Anita Derby, but trainer John Shirreffs still believed. "I knew he had improved in each race and that's what kept us going," he told *NBC*. Rated in 18th as **Spanish Chestnut** (Horse Chestnut {SAf}) clicked off six furlongs in 1:09 2/5, the co-fastest split in the history of the race, Giacomo was four wide as they raced down the backstretch. He found himself behind a wall of horses at the quarter pole, but jockey Mike Smith wheeled him out and he hit the gas, catching a resolute **Closing Argument** as **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) stayed on for third. Smith was also aboard Giacomo's sire Holy Bull when he finished 12th as the 2-1 choice in 1994. "I've been telling this colt, since the first time I got on him...he was going to redeem his father's name in the Kentucky Derby," Smith said. "Just to have made it here is amazing, and to have won it? I can't even describe it. I've been fortunate to win some great races, but never have I had a win like this. This is unreal." **Five and Out...**

Trainer Nick Zito saddled a quintet of horses for the Kentucky Derby, but all five finished off the board. The best among them was **Bellamy Road** (Concerto), who was in front when they turned for home, but tired to be seventh as the 5-2 favorite. He was followed by **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus), 8th; **High Fly** (Atticus), 10th; **Noble Causeway** (Giant's Causeway), 14th; and **Sun King** (Charismatic), 15th. High Fly was perhaps the most impressive of the Zito runners. Unraced since taking the GI Florida Derby five weeks ago, he tracked the pace and put a head in front inside the final quarter, but came up empty late. "I was waiting for one of my closers to close, but they never came," a dejected Zito told *NBC* right after the race. But the Brooklyn native showed a touch of class when he added, "It's a little bit of a setback, but when you start thinking about what happens in life, it ain't that bad." Second choice Afleet Alex acquitted himself well, but GI Toyota Blue Grass hero **Bandini** (Fusaichi Pegasus) fretted his way through the post parade and had nothing to give in the race, finishing 19th.

America Alive had shown an affinity for the Churchill turf once before, running second by a nose in the Nov. 14 Commonwealth Turf S. The bay was on the winning end of photo finishes in his next two starts, taking an optional claimer at Fair Grounds on New Year's Eve and adding a victory in the Col. E.R. Bradley H. Jan. 15. An even fourth in the Feb. 26 Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H., he missed by a head in his most recent performance, finishing third by that margin in the GII Mervin Muniz Memorial H. Mar. 19. The Mill House homebred trailed the field through six panels, but found room to run up the rail as they raced around the far turn. Just two lengths separated the first seven horses when they hit the eighth pole, but it was America Alive who came out of the crowd to win going away. "I thought he was a little far back, but he never fails to close," trainer Neil Drysdale said. "He's a very genuine horse. We thought he deserved the chance." My Trusty Cat was beaten 4 3/4 lengths by Madcap Escapade when second in the Apr. 13 GIII Vinery Madison S. at Keeneland last time out, but she got the better of that rival with 1,234 1/2 feet of stretch to work with here. Winner of the GIII Chicago Breeders' Cup H. at Arlington and the GII Honorable Miss H. at Saratoga and second by a head in the GI Ballerina H. at the Spa last year, My Trusty Cat ended the season with a lackluster seventh-place showing in the Nov. 7 GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. going a mile. The bay opened 2005 with a victory over optional claimers in Oaklawn Park before finishing runner-up in Lexington last time out. As is her custom, Madcap Escapade jumped out to the early lead and was well clear as she dashed off fractions of :21.98 and :44.37. She was still in front at the top of the lane, but it was a long way to the wire and the cavalry was coming. Racing in tandem, My Trusty Cat and Molto Vita drove past the odds-on choice inside the eighth pole, with My Trusty Cat proving narrowly better. Battle Won captured an optional claimer at Churchill last May and was third in the GIII Aristides H. over the track in June. The dark bay picked up checks in a pair of starts at Saratoga, then returned to the Bluegrass State to win the Sept. 25 Kentucky Cup Cup Turf Dash at Kentucky Downs and Oct. 22 Woodford County S. at Keeneland. Shipped to Sha Tin for his final start of 2004, he raced evenly to be eighth behind Silent Witness (Aus) in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint. Battle Won had been out just once since, finishing fourth in the Apr. 16 GIII Shakertown S. at Keeneland. Back on the dirt for his second start of '05, he tracked Tricky Trevor (Demaloot Demashoot) through a half in :44.12. The longshot took command at the quarter pole and opened it up late, equalling the track record as he stopped the timer in 1:20.56. "It felt like we were going pretty comfortable," jockey Ramon Dominguez told *ESPN*. "I was surprised to see such fast fractions. They sure are getting over the track quick." It took Seeking the Ante six starts to break her maiden, but she has made up for lost time since. The dark bay filly was tried on the turf in her sophomore bow at Gulfstream Feb. 2, but returned to the dirt after finishing fourth in that contest. She shipped north to win going two turns over the Aqueduct inner track Feb. 27 and made it two in a row in a one-turn mile allowance on the main strip Mar. 25. Trying graded-stakes company for the first time in her latest, the Apr. 16 GII Comely S., she had the lead in the lane, but couldn't hold off Acey Deucey (Abaginone) and was second by a half length. Seeking the Ante was rated off a solid pace in her second graded appearance and saved her late run until the final furlong, catching Slew Motion in the final strides. "She started every race with a stumbled start, the first five races," trainer John Kimmel explained. "She's definitely gotten better." A seven-time Group 1 winner in Argentina, Miss Terrible made her U.S. debut for trainer Bobby Frankel back in 2003 and faded to fourth after setting the pace in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood that May. The bay mare made her second stateside start for

trainer Wesley Ward and was on the lead once again, but faltered badly to be sixth in a Saratoga allowance test in August. She disappeared after that start, and owners Carol and Charles Hammersmith opted to send her to Brad Ross, a semi-retired blacksmith based in Illinois. Miss Terrible was sidelined for nearly 19 months, but apparently thrived as the lone horse in the Ross stable.

Off at 11-1 in her comeback race, the Feb. 27 GIII Las Flores H. on the main track at Santa Anita, she rallied from just off the pace to win by a half length. The six-year-old went right to the front this time and dragged jockey Alex Solis through fractions of :24.45, :48.62 and 1:12.69. Sand Springs tracked her throughout, but Miss Terrible had gas left in the tank, opening up at the end to make it two-for-two for Ross. "She's my only horse in training, and she's like one of my kids," the conditioner said. "I always say I've got a son and a daughter, and my daughter has four legs."

He gives you 120 percent every time. When he came out of the paddock pumped up like Arnold Schwarzenegger, I knew Don Six would have to run his best to beat us." **What's in a Name...**

Where did the Derby winner's name come from? **Giacomo** (Holy Bull) was christened in honor of the son of top A & M Record artist Sting. Jerome Moss, who bred and owns the colt with wife Ann, founded A & M. "The mare was named Set Them Free, which was a Sting song," Moss, who sold the company in 1990, explained. "Sting has been with A & M just about all his career and we got to know the family. They have a brilliant and talented son, named Giacomo."

**Humble Beginnings...**

**Giacomo** is the first stakes winner from Set Them Free, who also raced for Mr. and Mrs. Moss. "Set Them Free cost \$45,000," Moss said, "She won a few stakes, she made about \$175,000. We decided to breed her, but the first three foals didn't work out at all. They never got to the racetrack, and yet we kept on believing in her. Next thing she has a beautiful daughter of Holy Bull and that's when we decided to breed to Holy Bull again--that's how we got Giacomo." His full sister, six-year-old Styler, won two races in 2003 and earned \$69,360. Five-year-old half-sister Sea Jewel (Sea Hero) was second in the GIII Santa Ysabel and third in the GII Oak Leaf S., earning \$196,825. The mare also has the two-year-old colt **Falcon Scott** (Swain {Ire}) and a yearling colt by Pleasant Tap.
