A day after turning the racing world on its head with a 50-1 upset in the GI Kentucky Derby, Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Moss' **Giacomo** (Holy Bull) was in fine order and

will take aim at the second leg of the Triple Crown, the May 21 GI Preakness S. at Pimlico. The gray colt, trained by John Shirreffs, received a visit from winning jockey Mike Smith Sunday morning, who posed for photographs with Giacomo before admitting that he'd turned down offers to ride other mounts in the Derby. Smith said he declined those offers, retaining faith in the horse who had just a maiden win to his credit, and added, "I'm sure John was approached a few times

about taking me off, too. But he didn't. He stuck by me. There's no way I could have taken off him. I was talking to my agent about two weeks ago and I said, 'You know what, if I could ride Bellamy Road, I don't think I would.' I said I wouldn't change, I would stick with this horse. I said that I believe." *Cont. p2*

THREE INCHES OF SEPARATION

Arizona shipper **Virden** (Tactical Cat) took little respect as a 26-1 outsider, but showed the local crowd a little something about determination when she held on by a desperate nose over fast-closing **Three Degrees (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}). The dark bay, a \$15,000 KEESEP yearling purchase, broke her maiden at Turf Paradise Dec. 5 before winning the Sun Devil S. two starts later for trainer Kurt Calton. Moved to Dan McFarlane's barn, she completed the exacta in her next two, the Feb. 12 Arizona Oaks and Mar. 13 Cactus Cup H., before taking her turf bow--the Scottsdale H.--in wire-to-wire fashion Apr. 2. Straying from her home environs for the first time, she jumped out to the early lead and clicked off sensible :23.95, :47.81 and 1:11.75 fractions. Kicking away down the lane, she responded to the drive of Omar Figueroa and got her nose down on the wire as Three Degrees came flying. "This might be my biggest win ever, actually," said McFarlane. "At first I thought maybe I got it, and I thought 'Naw, I didn't.' I was down there on my knees looking over the rail, just hoping." **Click for the brisnet.com chart.**

McLaughlin Will Wait to Decide on Closing Argument...

Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin will wait to make a decision on whether **Closing Argument** (Successful Appeal), a valiant second to Giacomo in the Derby, will join that foe in Baltimore for the Preakness. "He will ship to New York on Monday and I'll make a decision later," said McLaughlin, who was saddling his first horse in the Run for the Roses. "Normally, I do not like to run back in two weeks, but this is not a normal situation. He came out of the race great and looks super."

'Proud' Ritchey Keeps on Rollin'...

Trainer Tim Ritchey said he was proud of **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet), who fought hard in deep stretch to fend off Giacomo and Closing Argument before falling a bit short in the final sixteenth. "On that particular day, those two horses were just better than him, but it wasn't from his lack of trying or heart or courage," said the conditioner. "He ran a game race. We are very proud of him." Ritchey confirmed that 'Alex' is Preakness-bound. "He will walk a few days and then we will ship to Baltimore probably Wednesday. He is walking around the barn bucking and squealing this morning, so obviously, he came out of the race well." *Coverage cont. p4*

In a race which raised more Classic questions than it answered, it was Fracas who had his nose in front when it mattered to maintain his unbeaten record. He has made great strides in a short space of time, beating Merger and the subsequent G3 Chester Vase hero Hattan (Ire) in the G3 Sandown Classic Trial just 12 days after making a successful debut in a course-and-distance maiden Apr. 10. Keeping Alayan in his sights throughout in a stalking third, Fracas challenged in the straight as Kieren Fallon looked for room on Grand Central on the rail. While that rival ran into a blind alley, Fracas was in the clear and edged ahead after a frantic last-furlong tussle with Alayan. "That was a good effort as he's still green and the race wasn't run to suit," commented trainer David Wachman. "He will run in a Derby and maybe two." Kieren Fallon is enjoying a purple patch in the early stages of his new partnership with Aidan O'Brien and produced more magic to bring Belle Artiste through to win this contest. Tough and consistent as a juvenile for Joe Crowley, she was campaigned mainly over sprint trips, but performed with credit when upped to seven furlongs to finish fifth in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh in September. Off the track since finishing third in a conditions race at Galway in late October, she traveled with ease settled towards the rear before making smooth progress under hands and heels urging turning into the straight. Zito Crew A OK...

Despite all five of his Derby runners missing the board, trainer Nick Zito said yesterday that each horse came out of the race fine and would, for the time being, remain at Churchill. "These horses look tremendous," said Zito. "They look better now than they went in the race. We will keep them here and let them rest. I don't want to ship them anywhere right now. We will definitely go to Baltimore [for the Preakness] with somebody." Zito's best hope for a Derby win, the 5-2 post-time favorite **Bellamy Road** (Concerto), tired a furlong out after attending a hot pace and came home seventh, the best finish of Zito's runners and three spots ahead of **High Fly** (Atticus), the 7-1 fourth chance. "At the top of the stretch, we were getting excited," admitted Zito, "because those two horses [Bellamy Road and High Fly] were making a winning run. But when that big burst of horses came around the turn, I couldn't believe that none of them were our other horses. What could you do? That's sports." Zito's **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus) ran eighth, with **Noble Causeway** (Giant's Causeway) and Sun King (Charismatic) in 14th and 15th, respectively.

DERBY RATINGS INCREASE NBC Sports' broadcast of Giacomo's upset Kentucky Derby win Saturday posted an impressive 8.2 overnight rating and a 19 share, the fourth highest overnight rating for the Derby broadcast since 1992. Released by Nielsen Media Relations Research yesterday, the figures were only 0.1 shy of NBC's 2001, 2003 and 2004 ratings. The ratings, which grew throughout Saturday's 1 1/2-hour program, peaked at 11.5/26 from 6-6:30 p.m. The highest rated individual market for the telecast was Louisville, which claimed a 30.6/62 rating.

DERBY SHATTERS WAGERING RECORD The Kentucky Derby, which established records for on-track and off-track wagering, became the first individual race in United States racing to attract total betting of more than \$100 million when \$103,325,518 was wagered Saturday. An on-track crowd of 156,435--the second largest in Kentucky Derby history--invested \$10,055,508 on the Derby, while \$22,117,166 was bet on the entire 12-race program. Total off-track expenditures for the race rose to \$93,270,002 and a combined total of \$133,016,465 was wagered on the complete Churchill Downs program. Betting from all sources for the track's 12-race Derby program set a North American record for a single racing program with \$155,133,631. Friday's Kentucky Oaks also drew a sizable crowd, which translated into healthy dividends for Churchill. A crowd of 111,243, which topped the previous record of 106,156 in 2000, wagered \$12,065,134, while total betting increased by 9.4 percent over last year's total of \$11,015,102. Wagering from all sources on Oaks Day was \$31,159,328, a slight decline of 1.3 percent from 2004's total of \$31,570,827.

Sweet Sweet, who debuted with a length victory when thrown in against New York-breds over this track last June, returned from a 10-month respite to wire state-bred maidens going six panels at Aqueduct Apr. 13. Sent off the third choice here, the dark bay broke awkwardly, but managed to place herself in a close-up fourth early. Swung wide by Edgar Prado for the drive, the filly drew off late to record a facile victory. "She didn't break at all," said Prado. "She was out of it the first part of the race. It may have been the best thing because everybody went, and I was able to rate her and bide my time. She was much the best."
