It has been a balancing act just doing the right thing by **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) this term, but the unbeaten colt looked like a work in progress when winning yesterday's G2 Dante S. in comfortable style at York. Since capturing the G1 Racing Post Trophy at

Doncaster in October, he has been the subject of intense speculation which was heightened by the decision to forego the 2000 Guineas in favor of a gentler build-up to the Epsom Derby. This trial was strictly text book for the even-money favorite, who sat close to the steady early tempo in fourth before cruising to the forefront

at the quarter pole. Asked to quicken by Johnny Murtagh soon after, he edged right, but was clear in a matter of strides before holding the game rally of **The Geezer (GB)** (Halling) by 1 1/2 lengths. *Cont. p2*

### GIACOMO GALLOPS AT CHURCHILL

Kentucky Derby winner **Giacomo (Holy Bull)** returned to the track Wednesday at Churchill Downs for the first time since his upset victory in Saturday's Run for the Roses. The colt galloped one mile in the company of a pony ridden by trainer John Shirreffs. "I thought he did very well for his first day on the track," commented Shirreffs. "He's eaten up and it doesn't look like he dropped too much weight from the Derby, so I think we're in good shape." Giacomo is expected to ship to Pimlico for the May 21 G1 Preakness S. next Wednesday and Shirreffs has yet to decide if the colt will work before that race. "I would prefer not to breeze--that would be my first preference," Shirreffs said. "But he may get a two-minute clip or something. It's hard to say. It's only his first day back on the track and we'll see how things go."

### Galloping Grocer Joins the Preakness Fray

**Galloping Grocer (A.P Jet)** joined the list of possible Preakness starters yesterday. The colt, winless in four starts this term, was beaten 26 1/4 lengths when fourth in the G1 Wood Memorial and is coming off a third-place effort against New York-breds in the Apr. 24 Times Square S. at Belmont Park. His addition leaves **Golden Man (Suave Prospect)** and **A.P. Arrow (A.P. Indy)** on the outside of the 14-horse limit.

"It was a funny race as there wasn't much pace early and he was a little bit keen and fresh," Johnny Murtagh said of his winning ride aboard Motivator in yesterday's G2 Dante S. "In the straight I got him balanced, and when I asked him to quicken, he did it very well. There's still improvement in him as he was only having his third run. Good horses adapt to win the Derby and he has what it takes." Trainer Michael Bell added, "It has been an agonizing six months since the Racing Post Trophy and the decision to come to the Dante is looking a sound one as Epsom has always been his target. He's quite highly strung, but he was very calm in the preliminaries as we kept everything very low key before the race. He behaved immaculately before, during and after the race and his day has been very smooth. He was pretty fit today after only five bits of work, so there's a little bit of improvement there and it will take a good one to beat him at Epsom." Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Laverock (Ire)** (Octagonal {NZ}) and Michael Nolan's **Indesatchel (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) were supplemented yesterday to Sunday's G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp at a cost of €24,000. The former earned his place in the line-up in beating fellow entry **Melanosporum** (Royal Anthem) by two lengths in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over course and distance Apr. 24, while connections were satisfied that the G3 Greenham S. and G3 Tetrarch S. hero Indesatchel will get ground no faster than good in the mile Classic. Of the scratchings at yesterday's stage, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G1 2000 Guineas fourth **Oratorio (Ire)** (Danehill) was the most notable, while trainer Cyriaque Diard has decided to run last year's G1 Criterium International hero **Helios Quercos (Fr)** (Diableneyev) rather than step the colt up in trip in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Saint-Cloud May 16.

All Too Beautiful had no chance with Ouija Board (GB) in the G1 Epsom Oaks last June, but still beat the remainder comfortably before finding the ground on the quick side when fourth behind that rival in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh the following month. She took time to come back to herself after that experience, but showed promise when third behind Monturani (Ire) in the G2 Blandsford S. back at that venue in September. Settled in fourth throughout the early stages here, she made her maneuver wide in the straight as La Persiana quickened from the front. Hooking up with that rival at the quarter pole, she gained the edge soon after before asserting under Kieren Fallon's urging. "I got to the front too soon and she thought she'd done enough and was just toying with the grey filly [La Persiana]," Fallon commented. "She'd been working well at home and was giving me a great feel--she'll see out a mile and a half all right." **YORKSHIRE CUP-G2 preview cont.**

Last year's G1 Ascot Gold Cup hero **Papineau** makes his eagerly awaited return from the injury which brought a premature halt to his campaign after his career high last June. His defeat of subsequent dual Group 1 scorer **Westerner** (GB) at the Royal meeting sets him aside from his rivals, but is also responsible for the penalty he has to shoulder. He bids to extend his stable's enviable strike rate of five winners since 1995. "He will be a bit rusty and he is a big horse who takes quite a lot of getting ready," Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford told *PA Sport*. "All being well, he will run a very good race, but he'll improve for it." Last year's winner **Millenary** went on to share the spoils with **Kasthari** (Ire) in the G2 Doncaster Cup in September before following up in the G3 Jockey Club Cup at Newmarket on his final start in October. His regular jockey Richard Quinn is hoping that the veteran can hold his own in this competitive renewal. "I think we've got a lot of nice races to look forward to with him, so I think it's nice to have a fresh horse to go in with," he said yesterday. "It's a strong race tomorrow with the Ascot Gold Cup winner in there and **Franklins Gardens**." **Millenary** holds **Alcazar** on the form of this race 12 months ago, but that evergreen campaigner looked better than ever when outpointing **Franklins Gardens** in the G3 **Sagaro S.** at Lingfield last time Apr. 27.

**DOGWOOD DOMINION NOMINATIONS DUE**

## OLIVER UNLIKELY FOR SPRING CARNIVAL

Leading Australian jockey Damien Oliver has cast doubt that he will be able to return to the track in time for the Melbourne Spring Carnival in October, as he recovers from two fractured vertebrae sustained in a fall at Monee Valley on Mar. 24. Oliver, who has ridden 62 Group 1 winners and won seven premierships, has had a titanium rod screwed into the vertebrae to fuse them. "If injury allows me to get back to riding, I want to get back to riding," Oliver said. "The X-ray will tell how well it is healing, but the surgeon thinks I will be out for a minimum of six months. That would see me back right in the middle of October and that will be during the spring carnival, so it would be hard to come back at that time of year. At this stage, I am very doubtful to be back by the spring carnival." The rod must remain in his back for 12 months, and Oliver, 32, said he might face the choice of riding with it in place or waiting until next March when it is removed.
