LOCKED AND LOADED

With clear skies over Berkshire, Gary Tanaka's **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent) has everything in place to expand his resume in today's G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury. Since chasing home Nayef at 50-1 in the

G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot in June 2003, the ex-Italian has proven himself one of Britain's top performers, winning the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket and returning to Ascot to take the Prince of Wales's 12 months ago. He showed he could mix it with the best

milers when taking the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot in September, but must rebound from a pair of disappointing runs in the G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto in November and G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin in December. The six-year-old makes his first start of the year here, and jockey Philip Robinson is looking forward to getting back aboard. "I always look forward to riding Rakti and, on his day, he is probably the best I've sat on," he said. "It just comes down to how he feels on the day and it's a case of keeping him relaxed during the build-up. We just want decent ground for him." **Lockinge S. cont. p2**

SHAMARDAL SEEKING REDEMPTION

Godolphin's **Shamardal** (Giant's Causeway) heads a cast of 15 for tomorrow's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp. His connections are hoping that he can bounce back from his disappointing effort on dirt last time. Last year's G1 Dewhurst S. hero trailed in the G2 UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba Mar. 26, but racing manager Simon Crisford believes there were excuses. "We tried to put him through a Kentucky Derby preparation--we thought he was a suitable candidate for that race," he said yesterday. "The problem with him [in the UAE Derby] was that he was taken on by too many horses early on in the race and they went far too quick, so it wasn't surprising that he didn't finish. He's got loads of speed, but he's much more relaxed and we are hopeful he can run really well in France." Shamardal, who will be bidding to provide Godolphin with their third renewal after the exploits of Vettori (Ire) in 1995 and Bachir (Ire) in 2000, has been drawn in the one hole. **French 2000 Guineas field, p2-3**

Divine Proportions (Kingmambo) faces a depleted field of seven rivals as she puts her perfect record on the line in tomorrow's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp. Last year's G1 Prix Morny and G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine is widely expected to confirm the form of the G3 Prix de la Grotte over course and distance Apr. 24, where she beat **Ysoldina (Fr)** (Kendor {Fr}) (second), **Antique (Ire)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}) (fourth) and **Silk and Scarlet (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) (sixth). Rakti faces Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's enormously talented but enigmatic **Antonius Pius** (Danzig),

whose late antics cost him certain success in both the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains last May and G1 Breeders' Cup Mile in October. He bids to restore his reputation and provide Aidan O'Brien with his second memorable exploits two years

ago. "He's in good form and has been working well," his trainer told *PA Sport*. "He's a horse with a lot of speed, so we could keep him over a mile or he could drop back in trip." Another who started out in Italy is Scuderia Archi Romani's G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua winner **Le Vie Dei Colori (GB)** (Efisio {GB}), who finished third in both the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood in July and G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp in October for Luca Cumani. He warmed up with a cosy success in the Listed Leicestershire S. at Leicester last time Apr. 24 and his conditioner is optimistic that he can be competitive here. "He won better than the bare result suggests last time, as he idled,"

he explained. "I think he's a better horse this year than last, but if the right Rakti turns up he's the winner for sure." Further spice is added by the presence of the G1 Dubai Duty Free winner **Elvstroem (Aus)** (Danehill), who seeks to bury a disappointing

latest effort when down the field in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 24. Trainer Tony Vasil is ready to overlook that race. "In Australia, on a couple of occasions, the horse has run on days that were particularly hot and he has been very affected by it," he explained. "We got away with it in Dubai, where it wasn't too hot, but in Hong Kong it got progressively warmer to the point where on raceday it was stifling. It's different here and he felt terrific the other day."

The Luck of the Draw...

Michael Nolan's G3 Greenham S. and G3 Tetrarch S. winner **Indesatchel (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) will exit from stall 14 on the outside in the French 2000 Guineas. "The ground is 3.1 on the penetrometer at the moment and there's rain due there on Friday and Saturday," trainer David Wachman told *PA Sport*. "He goes on good ground anyway and hopefully he'll give a good account of himself." Michael Pescod's Listed European Free H. winner **Kamakiri (Ire)** (Trans Island {GB}) has also drawn poorly in stall 12. "He is probably a decent horse and as long as the ground is decent," conditioner Richard Hannon told *PA Sport*. "I don't think much of his draw, though. It could have been a bit better, but, on what he's done so far, he deserves his chance." Peter Chapple-Hyam was yesterday optimistic that last year's G2 Richmond S. victor **Montgomery's Arch** (Arch) can follow up on the success of Victory Note in 1998. "I'm very happy with him and I think he will give a good account of himself," he commented. "Whether he's quite good enough to win I'm not 100 percent sure, but he won't be far away. I actually think a mile and a quarter may end up being his best trip." **French 2000 Guineas field cont. p3**

In a race loaded with speed, it could set up perfectly for **Forty Moves**. The four-year-old filly came from just off the pace to take an optional claimer at Gulfstream Park in her first start of the season Jan. 28, an effort that earned her a 106 Beyer. Last time out, she was bumped at the break in the Mar. 20 GIII Hurricane Bertie H. and had to settle for second behind **Lilah**. The Edward Evans homebred has been first or second in five of his seven starts at Belmont Park, and trainer Mark Hennig is off to an impressive start at the meet, with three wins from his three starters. Lilah was posting her third straight victory in the Hurricane Bertie, but she will have a crowd with her on the front end here. The speedy **Smokey Glacken**, who has never been off the board in nine career starts, makes her first appearance since running second in the GII First Flight H. last October, but has been working sharply for her return. **Forest Music** led gate to wire to win the Apr. 16 Primonetta H. at Laurel in her latest, and **Forestier** bids for her third in a row after leading nearly every step in the Apr. 8 Classy Mirage S. at Aqueduct.

The five-year-old gelding went to the sidelines after running fifth in the GII Californian S. last June and was also fifth while trying the turf in his first two starts this year. Switched back to the dirt for Mar. 13 Santana Mile H., he held the lead at midstretch, but couldn't quite hold on, finishing third. The bay set the pace in his latest, but weakened late to fill the show spot once again behind Supah Blitz and **Outta Here** in the Apr. 2 GIII Tokyo City H. at nine furlongs. **Anziyan Royalty** is a horse for the course, with four wins from five Hollywood appearances. The Cal-bred closed out 2005 with a win in the Nov. 13 On Trust H. going 7 1/2 furlongs in Inglewood. He made his seasonal bow in the Apr. 24 Tiznow S. and raced evenly to be fourth.

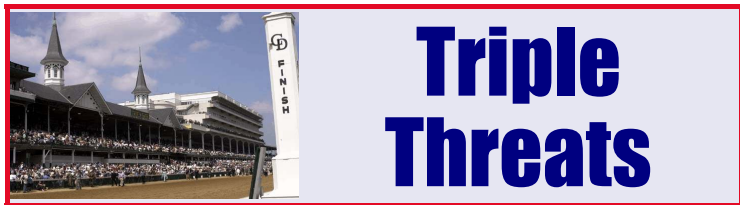

Heavy Penalties for Kentucky Drug Positives?

The *Harness Tracks of America Executive Newsletter* reports that the Kentucky Equine Drug Council yesterday gave its stamp of approval to a tough schedule of penalties for medication violations in the state. The recommended penalties will be put before the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority Monday and, if adopted, would make the Bluegrass State the toughest on drugs in the country. Under the new guidelines, horses as well as trainers could be suspended for drug positives, and stewards would have the authority to force a trainer to send a horse that tests positive to a new barn, rather than having an assistant or a relative take over its care. There is also a provision for revoking a trainer's license. "I hope other states adopt these kinds of rules," said trainer John Ward, a member of the KEDC and the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium.
