place finish of stable companion Dubawi (Ire) in the G1 2000 Guineas, the 3-1 second choice lifted the gloom with a game performance under an enterprising ride from Frankie Dettori. Allowed his own way up front, he had to battle as **Indesatchel (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) unleashed a late flourish, but answered the call to cling grimly to his advantage. **French 2000 Guineas cont. p2**

Classics are supposed to be the ultimate test, but the Niarchos Family's **Divine Proportions** (Kingmambo)

made the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) look easy pickings at Longchamp yesterday. The three-year-old filly now boasts a perfect record of seven-for-seven. Her odds of 3-10 said it all beforehand and it was text book material from the homebred, who raced keenly in second before taking total command with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining. Geared down by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire in the final yards, she had five lengths to spare over **Toupie (GB)** (Intikhab) at the line, but the margin does not do justice to her superiority. "She is just awesome and a fantastic filly," commented conditioner Pascal Bary. "It is a great pleasure to train her and I have not trained a better filly."

High Limit Breezes

High Limit (Maria's Mon) breezed five furlongs in 1:00.20, the fastest of 27 works at the distance, at Churchill Downs Sunday and appears in fine form heading into GI Preakness S. at Pimlico. "He's going to make the lead," confirmed trainer Bobby Frankel. He also indicated that the colt, who gains the services of jockey Edgar Prado Saturday, will also be equipped with blinkers for the first time. "He seems like he needs something to make him focus," said Frankel. The colt was found to have sustained superficial lacerations to both front legs during a last-place finish in the May 7 Kentucky Derby. "Somebody grabbed him early in the race, but it's not a problem," Frankel said. "I thought it might be, but a couple of days after the race it looked good." Explaining his decision to run the colt in the 9.5-furlong Classic, the trainer added, "He didn't run very hard in the [Derby]. If he had run hard, I wouldn't do it. I discounted the race and used it as a workout."

Looking for Redemption...**

"Everything went wrong in Dubai and we really hoped Shamardal would redeem himself," Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. That is exactly what the colt did as he made all to give his sophomore sire his second Classic winner. "It was not Plan A to lead but he jumped so well from the gates that I let him do his own thing," Frankie Dettori told *PA Sport*. "He got a little bit tired in the last 110 yards, but he had just enough to hold on." Added Crisford, "He was very game and tenacious in front. It was a great effort, and he is likely to improve further. I am absolutely delighted that he has fulfilled all the expectations and hopes that we have held for him throughout the winter." Shamardal appears to have that gritty determination that runs through Mark Johnston's performers. He was nurtured through an unbeaten juvenile campaign by that conditioner, earning successes in the G2 Vintage S. at Goodwood in July and G1 G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in October. His light went out quickly after chasing suicidal fractions on his debut for his new team in Dubai Mar. 26, but turf is clearly his game and he could bid for further Classic glory now. "We haven't decided on his next target as he could either stay at a mile for the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot at York June 14] or step up in trip for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [French Derby at Chantilly June 5]," Crisford said. "But he shows a lot of speed and it is quite likely we will stick with a mile for the present and think about a mile and a quarter later." **Click for the racingpost.co.uk chart or the [free brisnet.com](http://free.brisnet.com) catalogue-style pedigree.**

Down the Field...

Last year's G1 Critérium International winner **Helios Quercus (Fr)** (Diableneyev) was sent off the marginal favorite, but never looked likely to land a blow, staying on at the end to finish sixth. Highly touted **Coeur Courageux (Fr)** (Xaar {GB}) was at the back of the pack throughout, but was bumped badly at the beginning of the race and came back with a severe gash in his leg.

Divine Proportions has taken every step in her stride so far, moving up the ladder via the G3 Prix du Bois at Chantilly in June, G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte in July and G1 Prix Morny at Deauville the following month. After such dynamic wins over sprint trips, she had stamina to prove, but her performance in winning over course and distance in the G1 Prix Marcel Bussac in October and G3 Prix de la Grotte on her return Apr. 24 quashed any doubts. "We'll take our time to decide her next target, but she has won so easily it is difficult to know her stamina limits," Bary said. "She could stay at a mile and go for the G1 Coronation S. Altieri won this in his third attempt last year and followed up in a tougher renewal this time, running down the game long-time leader Vol de Nuit late under a forceful ride from Mario Esposito. After his three-length defeat of Vespone (Ire) here 12 months ago, he looked a doubtful stayer when fourth stepped up to a mile and a half in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano in June. Off the track until the G1 Premio Roma in November, he gave an uncharacteristically poor display and beat only one rival, but had enjoyed his customary preps in Milan when taking a conditions event Mar. 19 and Listed Premio Ambrosiano on his last start Apr. 23. Settled in mid-division off the early tempo set by Vol de Nuit and Mario Pasquale, he delivered a withering challenge down the outside to head that rival with 200 yards remaining before asserting.

Mummify scored for Australia in a race marred by a fatal injury sustained by Star Over the Bay (Cozzene). A four-time Group 1 winner in his native country, Mummify won the G1 Yalumba S. last October, but had not visited the winner's circle in eight subsequent starts. His recent results suggested a return to better form as the five-year-old was a good third to Grand Armee (Aus) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. at Randwick Apr. 2 and a close fifth in a Caulfield handicap event Apr. 23. Defending race champion Epalo (Ger) (Lando {Ger}) sped to the front from post three, but was quickly joined by Star Over the Bay and the duo flew through the opening stages. The American challenger fractured a sesamoid in his left fore at the midway mark, leaving Epalo on a loose lead, but he had little left for the drive as Phoenix Reach, the filly Alexander Goldrun and Mummify came with their challenges. Phoenix Reach opened a clear lead past the eighth pole and looked the winner, but the Australian dug deep over the testing ground and was along in the waning strides.

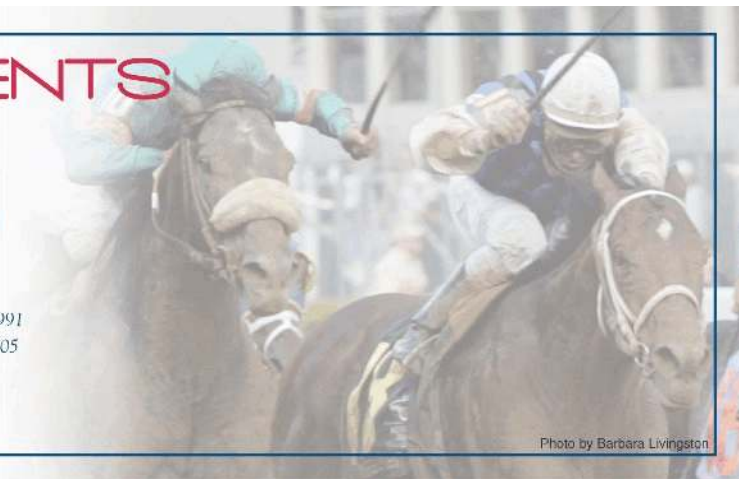

A full sister to the ill-fated Queen's Plate hero Archers Bay, the lightly raced Nashinda earned her first graded stakes victory here. The Ontario-bred captured each of her two starts at two by daylight, including the My Dear S. by five lengths. She returned at three to run second in the Star Shoot S. last April and won a local allowance the following month, but faltered to finish fifth on the turf in the Ontario Damsel H. in July. Sidelined following that excursion, Nashinda didn't make it back until Apr. 17, when she posted a front-running tally in the Whimsical H. over this surface. The crowd's choice assumed her customary position on the front end and never looked back, opening up under a hand ride. The Augustin homebred has been favored in each of her career starts. "If we can keep her sound, Lord only knows what kind of filly she is," said winning trainer Macdonald Benson. Nashinda was limited to just three starts in 2004 due to injury.

Telegnosis, who won this race in 2003 and was second last year, accelerated in the final furlong, but ran out of real estate and had to settle for third.

Chinese Dragon pressed the pace from second as Leo Getz cut out leisurely fractions. He was joined by Mighty Empire on the far turn, but shook loose of that foe in the stretch and powered past Leo Getz to win handily.

Retired trainer Kay Eric Jensen, who is believed to be the only rider to win a steeplechase and flat race on a single card, died Friday at his home in Warrenton, Virginia. A leading flat rider in Denmark and Sweden in the '40s, the Danish native arrived in the United States in 1948 and became a contract rider for W.G. 'Billy' Jones. Forced to give up his riding license in favor of pursuing a career as a trainer, Jensen trained for numerous owners over the course of the next four decades, including Harry Heiman, Major Herman Scholtz and George L. Ohstrom Jr. The trainer of stakes winners High Hat, Warhead, Heron Cove and He's Vivacious, Jensen also saddled multiple graded stakes winner Golden Don in 1974. The 86-year-old is survived by his wife of 41 years, Bland Greene Jensen, and his niece and nephew, Karen and Hans Egede. Funeral arrangements will be made by Moser Funeral Home in Warrenton, Virginia.

ROCK OF GIBRALTAR FILLY TOPS AT INGLIS

A weanling filly by **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill), who went to stud at Coolmore in 2003, brought a final bid of A\$220,000 to top the Inglis Select Weanling Sale at Newmarket Sunday. Consigned by Coolmore Stud, agent, she was purchased by Richard Johnston of Bylong Park. The bay is out of Enlightenment (Capote), herself a daughter of three-time Grade I winner and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up Tappiano. It is also the family of A. P Jet, Known Fact, Tentam and Gone West. The day's second-highest seller was a filly by Giant's Causeway out of Leopard Lady (Aus) (Marscay {Aus}). Consigned by Coolmore, as agent, she was also purchased by Bylong Park, bringing A\$180,000. "I intend to race both fillies and, all going to plan, win some black-type races and breed with them," Johnston said. The top-selling colt was by Encosta de Lago (Aus) out of stakes winner Egyptian Ibis (NZ) (Straight Strike). Offered by Arrowfield Stud, agent, he was bought by KP Thoroughbreds for A\$165,000. The weanling is a half-brother to Desert Eagle (Aus) (Hurricane Sky {Aus}), a Group 1 winner in Australia who went on to be named Hong Kong's Horse of the Year in 2002-03 while racing under the name Grand Delight. Of the 237 lots catalogued, there were 178 sold, 42 withdrawn and 17 that failed to reach their reserves. The sale realized gross receipts of A\$2,753,850, an average of A\$15,471 and a median of A\$6,000. "Once again we are very pleased to see buyers from throughout Australia and, in particular, from New Zealand supporting this sale," Managing Director Reg Inglis said. "There was very good interest in the top end of the market today, emphasising the demand for quality weanlings, and the fact that 90 percent of the weanlings sold reflects the interest across the board."
