ADROIT ALEX

Afleet Alex (Northern Afleet) overcame a dramatic stumbling incident at the quarter pole and re-rallied beneath jockey Jeremy Rose to post an emphatic 4 3/4-length victory in yesterday's GI Preakness S. at Pimlico. After an explosive move into contention on the far turn, Afleet Alex swept three wide into the stretch, but **Scrappy T** (Fit to Fight) ducked out badly under a left-handed whip, clipping heels with and nearly causing Afleet Alex to go down. So, how did Jeremy Rose stay in the saddle? "He was just that athletic and I was just that scared. I held on to his mane and he picked himself up and went on and won it," the winning rider

A DREAM REDEEMED

He went from hero to zero in less than two minutes in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas, but Godolphin's **Dubawi (Ire)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}) staged a dramatic reversal of fortune at The Curragh yesterday when besting Susan Magnier's **Oratorio (Ire)** (Danehill) by an easy two lengths in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas. For Sheikh Mohammed, his Newmarket disappointment was buried yesterday and a dream fulfilled. "This is a great day," he said. "Remembering Dubai Millennium

gave us inspiration, and this was the real Dubawi today. Horses are only flesh and blood and sometimes they just have an off-day, but today he was back to himself. I am so happy, this is history." The bay colt is now under consideration for the G1 Epsom Derby June 4. "I think he will get a mile and a quarter, and sometimes mile and a quarter horses win the Derby," Sheikh Mohammed added. "I will talk with Sheikh Maktoum, the trainer and the jockey and we will decide whether we go to Epsom for the Derby or not, but there is no hurry to make a decision."

TESTING THE WATERS

It was Attraction (GB) broke the hoodoo of English Guineas winners in this race 12 months ago, and Susan Magnier's **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo) will attempt to emulate that filly in completing a Classic double in today's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh. With smart but unspectacular juvenile form, she neared the Newmarket Classic an unlikely heroine in the shadow of her owner's **Damson (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}). If things looked different after a smooth success in the G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial S. Apr. 10 and Damson's late scratch, the picture became very clear with her easy defeat of Martin Schwartz's **Maid's Causeway (Ire)** (Giant's Causeway) at Newmarket May 1.

A Super Soph...

Put away following his runner-up finish to **Wilko** (Awesome Again) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile last October, **Afleet Alex** resurfaced in the Mountain Valley S. at Oaklawn, winning that six-furlong event by 2 3/4 lengths, but flopped home sixth in the GIII Rebel S. two weeks later. He was subsequently diagnosed with a lung infection and proved the Rebel was an anomaly, taking the GII Arkansas Derby by a record eight lengths. Sent off the 9-2 second choice in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby, the Florida-bred rallied gamely in the stretch, but could not withstand the closing kick of **Giacomo** (Holy Bull), ultimately finishing third.

An Amazing Performance...

Following a clean dispatch, **Afleet Alex** was guided towards the inside through the stretch for the first time and was allowed to race towards the back of the pack. Riding the rails up the backside, the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic May graduate began to pick off horses leaving the half-mile pole and loomed a threat inside on the far turn. Moving as if shot out of a cannon at the 5/16 marker, he set his sights on **Scrappy T**, who took command from **High Limit** (Maria's Mon) approaching the stretch. Then, near-disaster struck as the unfocused Triple Crown newcomer drifted out and clipped heels with the eventual winner. A less agile horse might have been unable to recover, but Afleet Alex, seemingly oblivious to the situation and content to go about his business, finished with a flourish, recording the fastest winning time since 1998. "He did something champions do today," commented winning trainer Tim Ritchey. "I've seen horses take bad steps and win. I never see horses stumble that badly and lose his momentum that much and come back on and win in a Grade I race like this, that's the first I've ever seen it." And now, assuming he comes back well it's on to New York for the Belmont. "I think he'll go a mile and a half no problem," Ritchey said. "So long as he comes out of the race, we've got three weeks to prepare him." **Cont. p13**

Dubawi took an unbeaten record back to his winter quarters at Al Quoz, thanks to a hard-fought win in the G3 Superlative S. at Newmarket in July and an impressive romp over this course in the G1 National S. in September, and was all the rage ahead of his return to Newmarket this spring. Firm ground was blamed for his eclipse in that Classic, where he finished under three lengths adrift of Footstepsinthesand (GB) in fifth, but the rain arrived in time here in Ireland. Always traveling easily in third under a confident Frankie Dettori, the 7-4 joint favorite was left in front passing the quarter pole and, despite veering right when asked to quicken, was in total command as Oratorio closed late. "This is what Dubawi is all about," Dettori said. "We were disappointed at Newmarket, but he did not enjoy the ground at all there and today he traveled like a great horse. He doesn't want a bog; he just does not want it firm." Runner-up Oratorio will now be stepped up in trip. "He'll probably stay further and is in the Epsom Derby and G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [French Derby at Chantilly June 12]," said trainer Aidan O'Brien.

Society Selection completed a rare Grade I double last season, winning the seven-furlong Test S. and 1 1/4-mile Alabama S., but did not fare quite as well against older females. Second to Sightseek in the GI Beldame S. Oct. 9, she was a well-beaten ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and had just one start to her credit this year, a seventh to Madcap Escapade after stumbling badly at the start of the GI Shirley Jones H. at Gulfstream Feb. 19. The Cowan homebred bided her time at the back of the pack and still trailed as the field hit the quarter pole. Switched out widest of all for the drive, the bay closed well to win going away. Explaining the three-month absence, trainer Allen Jerkens said, "She had a cut that got infected. We sent her to [Rood and Riddle] in Kentucky. I wasn't planning on running in this race until she worked too fast one day. We figured she must have been pretty fit." The winner is likely for the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont June 18. The winner of last year's GIII Hawthorne Derby Oct. 16, Cool Conductor faltered in his seasonal finale, finishing ninth in the Commonwealth Turf S. at Churchill Nov. 14. Rested off that effort, he returned to be sixth behind Artie Schiller in Keeneland's GII Maker's Mark Mile Apr. 15 and most recently crossed the line 3 3/4 lengths best in a Derby Day allowance at Churchill, only to be demoted to third for a bumping incident in upper stretch. Transferred to trainer Ralph Nicks off that effort, the second longest shot stalked a lethargic pace from a three-wide third, pulled on even terms outside Artie Schiller at the eighth pole and outfought that one to the wire. "My horse is a nice horse," said winning rider Cornelio Velasquez. "The other horse tried to come back, but my horse was not going to lose today. I had a lot of horse." Aidan O'Brien's hunch that Airwave would stay further than sprint distances received the ultimate endorsement as the former "flying filly" carried her brilliant speed over this stiff mile. Her esteemed record, which included success in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at two and placings in the G1 Golden Jubilee S., G1 July Cup and G1 Haydock Sprint Cup during her sophomore campaign, meant she had nothing to prove when re-entering training at Ballydoyle following her sale at Tattersalls December. Buoyed by the bay's performance in the mud when third over seven furlongs of this track in the G3 Athasi S. on her return Apr. 17, O'Brien sought a firm answer to his question, and Airwave duly provided it under a waiting ride from Kieren Fallon. Held up in rear early off the steadily increasing tempo, she quickened down the outside to lead with 200 yards remaining and was comfortably on top of Miss Trish in the run to the line. "She has all the fillies' races open to her now," O'Brien commented. "Kieren said she saw the trip out well, but just pulled herself up in front. She settled really well today and probably prefers it faster."

Storm Wolf was fourth behind Going Wild in his career opener at Santa Anita Dec. 26, but while that rival has had his head handed to him in four starts this spring, Storm Wolf has been unbeatable. The dark bay colt was given a short break after his debut, returning to break his maiden by seven lengths at Santa Anita Mar. 16. He made it two in a row with a 7 1/2-length success in an optional claimer at that track Apr. 9 and was the heavy favorite to continue the streak in his first try versus stakes foes. Sent right to the front from his inside post, he had company early, but opened daylight with a preemptive strike on the far turn and had it all his own way down the lane, winning as much the best. Willy o'the Valley showed potential last spring, winning two straight at Belmont Park and finishing fourth at this distance behind Mass Media in the Fly So Free S. Put on the shelf after falling on the far turn in a \$75,000 claimer at the Big A Nov. 13, he returned with a fourth-place finish over the Gulfstream turf Feb. 12. Back on the dirt in his next start, he prevailed by a nose in a \$75,000 optional claimer at the Hallandale race-track Feb. 28. Haltered for \$100,000 out of a sharp Keeneland victory last out Apr. 13, the dark bay was backed as the third-choice here. A Talented Supporting Cast... The ease in ground should suit **Maids Causeway**, according to rider Kieren Fallon. "I always thought that this ground was what she wanted," he said. "She is drawn in the middle, and hopefully with some luck in running we can win this one." **Damson (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}) looked to have the world at her feet last term when winning the G2 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot and G1 Phoenix S. at this track in August, but the wheels came off when she was only third in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket in October. A dirty scope ruled Damson out of the English version, but trainer David Wachman is hoping the filly can get back on track. "She's coming on all the time after her setback," he told *PA Sport*. "We've got to start her off somewhere and she will improve for it. Obviously the ground would be of some concern. We wouldn't want much more rain. Her best form is on fast ground. Virginia Waters won very well on the day at Newmarket and is the one to beat."

Maids Causeway (Ire) (Giant's Causeway) was carrying on where she had left off at Newmarket last time, having carved a reputation as one of the last season's toughest top-class juveniles. Successful in the G3 Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket in August, she finished third and second, respectively, behind Playful Act (Ire) in the G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster and G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot in September. After signing off with a battling score in the G2 Rockfel S. back at headquarters in October, she was 2 1/2 lengths adrift of Virginia Waters on her return, and needs to step up a notch if she is to provide trainer Barry Hills with his third win in this contest. "She's done very well since, the boys at home tell me she has improved," jockey Michael Hills told *PA Sport*. "It is hard to say if she can beat Virginia Waters as she may have improved too, but we have every chance." Joseph Joyce's G1 1000 Guineas sixth **Saoire (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) and Tom Curran's impressive G3 C L Weld Park S. winner **Jazz Princess (Ire)** (Bahhare) further boost the home defence, while Lady Bamford and the Sangster Family's **Titian Time** (Red Ransom) is an intriguing runner, having been away since finishing runner-up to Divine Proportions in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp in October. "She's taken some time to come to her herself but she's working very well," trainer John Gosden said of the latter. "There aren't many opportunities for three-year-old fillies at this time of year, so we might as well have a go at a big one. She's up to running a nice race." **Field p10**

He's a very brave horse with a great turn of foot and runs to the line very well--he's a horse who gets stronger and stronger as he gets nearer the finish. However, Bago is race fit and will be very hard to beat." Last year's G1 Irish Derby hero **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}), who was fourth in the Irish Champion and unplaced in the Arc on his last start, is another without the benefit of a previous outing this season. His trainer Dermot Weld expects the grey to improve for the run. "He's in good form and I expect him to run a good race," he told *PA Sport*. "Obviously with the ground and the wet spring, he's not quite as forward as I would like him, but he's as good as I can get him. It will be a smashing race, but I do expect him to come on for the run."

The colt looked special when winning the Listed Premio Daumier over a mile here Apr. 10 and confirmed that impression with a smooth two-length defeat of **Le Giare** in the Classic two weeks later. **De Sica** caught the eye when a fast-finishing fifth in the Parioli and looked more at home over 10 furlongs when taking a conditions event in impressive fashion on his only subsequent start May 8. Bruno Grizzetti, who took this three years ago with **Rakti (GB)**, saddles potential improvers in **Kerlis** and **Tedo**. The former took a conditions event at the San Siro on his latest start Apr. 30, while **Tedo** needs to recapture the form of his second in the G3 Premio Guido Berardelli here last October.
