SAOIRE SURPRISE

Joseph Joyce's **Saoire (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) was sixth in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, but turned the tables yesterday as she denied **Penkenna Princess (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) by a short head in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh. Frances Crowley, who became the first female trainer to win a Classic in Ireland as her charge led home a one-two for sire Pivotal, was not surprised by the outcome. "Things didn't go that well at Newmarket and she just lacked a bit of pace on that very fast ground," Crowley said. "She didn't have a great flight over there either, so we knew she would improve and, being based five minutes away from this more staying track, we knew it was going to suit her a lot better." AFLEET ALEX AOK AFTER PREAKNESS SCARE

It was an eventful trip to the winner's circle, but G1 Preakness hero **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) exited Saturday's Classic victory in good order, trainer Tim Ritchey reported yesterday. "We'll have to monitor him for at least three or four days," Ritchey explained. "What concerns me is muscle injuries, because he was contorted in a way that horses aren't meant to be, but he walked perfect today." Afleet Alex narrowly dodged disaster after clipping heels with Scrapy T at the top of the stretch in the Preakness. "The Steelers had the 'Immaculate Reception,'" Ritchey said. "What do you call this--the 'Immaculate Recovery'?" He also praised jockey Jeremy Rose. "You've got a great athlete in the rider and a very superior athlete in the horse," he said. "The horse has to maintain his balance, but the rider has to maintain his balance on top of the horse. It was a combination of things--and a lot of luck, too." Afleet Alex will remain at Pimlico until Friday, then ship to Belmont Park to prepare for the June 11 G1 Belmont S.

GOLD CUP IS ALL GREY

Yesterday's G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh race read like the equine cast of Oceans Eleven and it was **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}) who outgamed **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan) and company in the driving rain to soar his earnings past the million-euro mark. It wasn't the first time the gallant gray upset the odds at The Curragh. He swept past North Light (Ire) to win the G1 Irish Derby last June. Traveling best of all in third under cover throughout the early stages yesterday, he was eased out of his pocket by Pat Smullen approaching the quarter pole. Quickening to the lead soon after, he was pressed by Bago and Thierry Gillet all the way to the line, but was always holding that rival at bay under a determined drive. "He traveled supremely well throughout and probably got me there sooner than I wanted, but he had won a Derby, so I wanted to take the bull by the horns," said Smullen. "He just rolled towards the rail at the end, but that was just him getting tired."

Say It Is So...

Third in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. and runner-up in the G3 C. L. Weld Park S. at this track last fall, **Saoire** had run with credit on her return when finishing just over four lengths behind **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo) in the Newmarket Classic May 1. Off at 10-1 yesterday, she was settled in second in the group on the far side early by Mick Kinane. She toiled to get to the front at the eighth pole and refused to relent her slim advantage to Penkenna Princess in the drive to the line to post the upset. "We were really keen to get a clear run with no traffic problems and, at first, we thought we didn't have a great draw, but as the rain came we were happy and Mick [Kinane] did the right thing," Frances Crowley said. Saoire will return to this track for a tilt at the G1 Irish Oaks July 17. "We felt she was looking for a trip and today was going to be the last time over a mile," Crowley added. "She will definitely go for the Irish Oaks and we'll see what's in between."

Beginner's Luck...

For rookie trainer Ralph Beckett, Penkenna Princess's narrow defeat was bittersweet. "She ran her legs off and I'm thrilled with her run," he said. "It all panned out beautifully, but that's life. She didn't act at Newmarket at all, but with the ground soft we had to come and, if it's soft at York, we'll go for the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot at York June 17]. She took her traveling really well, so we can go anywhere." Virginia Waters was sent off the 11-10 punters' choice to complete the English-Irish Guineas double, but failed to show the same acceleration in these testing conditions and merely stayed on into eighth late on.

Given a mid-summer break after his G1 Irish Derby win, Grey Swallow returned to finish fourth behind Azamour (Ire) (Night Shift) in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown in September and suffered a troubled preparation when subsequently unplaced in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp on his last start in October. "He's a very big horse who is going to take more work to get to peak fitness, but his ability was enough today," said winning rider Pat Smullen. Dermot Weld confirmed the winner on course for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Newbury July 23, where he will face a rematch with Bago. The Niarchos Family's Racing Manager Alan Cooper said of last year's Arc winner, "He lost his place coming down the hill before the final turn and did well to make up the ground. Thierry said the ground was very sticky, but he ran a good race and could go straight for the King George and miss Royal Ascot at York." Vadawina treated the assembled crowds at Longchamp to a display of sheer class as she picked off her rivals in facile fashion to take her record to a perfect three-for-three. Not extended to win on debut at Saint-Cloud Apr. 13 or in the G3 Prix Cleopatre back at that track last time May 1, she coped with this rise in class with aplomb to secure her place in the line-up for the G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 12. Settled in rear off the respectable early fractions by a confident Christophe Soumillon, she was sent to the inner as the field fanned out at the top of the straight. Her rider's bravado was rewarded as Vadawina quickened between rivals to lead with 300 yards remaining and from there it was clear sailing before she was geared down in the final 50 yards. "She had already shown plenty of quality, but today was a demonstration of class," commented Georges Rimaud, French Stud and racing manager to His Highness the Aga Khan. "I've just talked to His Highness and, at this stage, it's more likely that she will head for the Prix de Diane." Not for the first time, Christophe Soumillon took ownership of this venue with another display of daring on Valixir to provide the new partnership of His Highness the Aga Khan and Andre Fabre with a Group 1 double. As he had with Vadawina (Ire) half an hour beforehand, the talented Belgian found a golden rail up the straight and his mount made easy work of the game Elvstroem. Third in the G1 Prix Lupin and G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) last year, Valixir won the G2 Prix Eugene Adam in July and added the G2 Prix Niel over Prospect Park (GB) and Bago (Fr) at this track in September. A flat 10th in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October, he looked in need of the outing when third in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. at Newmarket on his return Apr. 13. Settled in fifth on the inner as Elvstroem was allowed to lead, Valixir clung to the fence, slipped through a furlong out and was firmly in control from there. "The trip to Newmarket did him a lot of good, especially mentally," commented Fabre, winning this for the sixth time. "He's in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. [at Royal Ascot at York June 15], so he'll probably go there next." De Sica produced a late rattle to deny Ramonti the G2 Premio Parioli-Derby Italiano double and provided Emilio Borromeo with a memorable success as breeder, owner and trainer. Having broken his maiden at the San Siro in October, he returned to finish runner-up in a conditions event Mar. 20 before a fourth spot in the Listed Premio Gardone Apr. 4. He looked in need of more ground when fifth in the one-mile G2 Premio Parioli Apr. 24 and confirmed that when taking a 10-furlong conditions event here May 8. Keen off the slow early gallop in the hands of Marco Monteriso, he eventually settled in fifth as Ramonti took to the front under Edmondo Botti and was hemmed in on the rail as the sprint began inside the final half mile. Switched wide for his challenge, he started to lengthen when in the clear and reeled in the long-time leader in the final strides. Sauvage got up in the final stride as a 37-1 outsider for her only previous U.S. win in a Mar. 12 Gulfstream allowance, but was 4 3/4 lengths behind Finery (Lear Fan) when steadied in deep stretch to be sixth in the 1 1/16-miles GIII Beaugay H. last time out Apr. 30. Lightly regarded here despite the added ground, the bay filly stalked the pacesetters while running a ground-saving trip. She forged through an opening on the hedge and narrowly held off the late rush of traffic-plagued Angara. Of his winning trip, jockey Javier Castellano said, "A hole opened up and I guess I got a little bit lucky. I saw the other horse [Angara] coming and remembered that she was stuck in traffic at the sixteenth pole. I was really lucky to get through." Winning trainer Tom Albertrani added, "We always thought she would want to run longer. Her last race, the turf might have been a little softer than she likes it. We were hoping the rain would hold off today. We had confidence in her. Everything worked out today." Sauvage will now be pointed at the July 2 GII New York H. After pressing the early pace through fractions of :24.82, :50.77, 1:15.17 and 1:39.56, favored Honey Ryder (Lasting Approval) tired in the final furlong to finish fifth. "She likes to be covered up," explained John Velazquez on the beaten favorite. "If she's not covered up, she just pulls and pulls and pulls. Westerner turned in another predictably spectacular display to erase the memory of his shock defeat in this race 12 months ago. If that reversal raised doubts as to his status on this scene, he dispelled them during the remainder of the term, finishing a 1 1/2-length second to Papineau (GB) in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup in June and scoring repeat victories in the G1 Prix du Cadran and G1 Prix Royal-Oak at this track in October. The six-year-old inflicted an easy defeat on Allez Olive in the G3 Prix de Barbeville over course and distance on his comeback Apr. 30 and repeated the dose here under a supremely confident Olivier Peslier. Settled while traveling easily in fourth early, he quickened to hit the front with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining and settled the result in a matter of strides before easing into cruise control yet again. "He was brilliant again there and showed that he is top-class, which we have known for a long time," trainer Elie Lellouche commented. "We will stick to the original plan and head to Royal Ascot at York for the G1 Ascot Gold Cup [June 16]." Preakness Day Sets Records...

Preakness Day 2005 shattered both attendance and handle records at Pimlico Saturday. A record-breaking crowd of 115,318 packed into the historic track to watch Afleet Alex win the second leg of the Triple Crown. The previous mark of 112,668 was set last year. Preakness day wagering reached \$88,083,366, eclipsing the record of \$87,858,878 set in 2004. Handle on the Preakness was \$60,861,090, another record. "It was absolutely the best Preakness ever," said Joe De Francis, Maryland Jockey Club president and chief executive officer. "I never thought we'd break last year's record with all the attention Smarty Jones captured. It was a record in every category and the first time ever that over \$11 million was wagered in a single day within the state of Maryland."

On to the Belmont...

While the majority of the also-rans will be on break after the Preakness experience, the connections of a couple of runners are still considering a tilt at the final leg of the Triple Crown. Trainer Robert Bailes said that runner-up **Scrappy T** (Fit to Fight) came out of the race "super," but that future plans have not yet been finalized. "We haven't thought about his next race," Bailes said. "We'll talk about it for the next couple of days. We have options, but the main deal is to see how he is. We want to make sure he doesn't come up body sore." Kentucky Derby winner **Giacomo** (Holy Bull), third at Pimlico, shipped back to California Sunday, but owner Jerry Moss is leaning toward a return to the East Coast for the mile-and-a-half Belmont. "The longer races in the series better suit his running style," Moss told the *L.A. Times*. "I'd love to run in the Belmont, assuming [trainer John Shirreffs] wants to go. I'd like to give him another chance."

DUBAWI DERBY-BOUND Godolphin's impressive G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner **Dubawi (Ire)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}) will run in the G1 Epsom Derby June 4, it was confirmed yesterday. Following his two-length defeat of Oratorio (Ire) in the mile Classic, connections refused to commit the sophomore to the mile-and-a-half Classic, but Racing Manager Simon Crisford yesterday revealed the news on the Godolphin website. "Dubawi came out of yesterday's race well and the decision has been made to run him in the Derby," he said. He also stated that last Sunday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 1000 Guineas) winner **Shamardal** (Giant's Causeway) remains a possible runner in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 12. In an interview with *PA Sport* later, he expanded on the decision to send Dubawi to Epsom. "He has come out of his race extremely well, is arriving back from Ireland later on this morning and we have now got a green light to go to Epsom," he commented. "We are hopeful that he would have every chance of staying, but won't know until he tries it. We certainly won't be trying to find out before hand and we will only know on Derby day whether that trip is within his compass. We would be confident that a mile and a quarter is well within his range, but the extra two furlongs are an altogether different ball game, but over the years plenty of top mile-and-a-quarter horses have won the Derby."

Quarantined Horses Return to the Track:

The horses in one of the three barns at Churchill Downs that were quarantined due to an outbreak of the equine herpes virus have been cleared to return to limited training. The Kentucky Department of Agriculture protocol requires that, in order to be allowed to go to the track, all of the horses in a quarantined barn must be symptom-free for a period of seven days, and then test negative for the disease. The horses stabled in barn 39, including Kentucky Derby fourth Don't Get Mad, have met that requirement. They have not yet been cleared to join the general horse population, but were able to train separately during a two-hour period Saturday evening. The Churchill main track will be open to quarantined horses for an hour after regular training has concluded Monday and Tuesday mornings, and for two hours after racing Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday, until the quarantine has been lifted for all horses.

Pat Day Returns to the Winner's Circle:

Jockey Pat Day, sidelined since undergoing hip surgery in March, was back in the winner's circle at Churchill Downs Friday. The 51-year-old Hall of Famer guided 5-1 shot Web to a half-length victory in the 10th race, a six-furlong test for maiden claimers. "It was very sweet," Day said of the win. "It was reminiscent of the first race I won in my life. It was nice. I've never come back from a surgery quite like that. Everything considered, I was happy to get the job done." Now that he is back in the saddle, the veteran has no immediate thoughts of retirement. "I'm still enjoying the game immensely--the participation and, of course, the winning," he said. "That's what it's all about. I haven't got the nod from God as yet and I trust that, when I do, I will say 'adios' to this chapter of my life and move on to the next. But today, this right here is where I want to be."
