**ALEX BACK ON TRACK**

Cash Is King's **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) returned to the track yesterday morning for the first time since covering himself in glory during last Saturday's epic GI Preakness S. The three-year-old jogged two miles at Pimlico under the watchful eye of trainer Tim Ritchey. "He was a touch stiff the first mile, which was to be expected," said Ritchey, who will celebrate his 54th birthday Friday. "But by the time he was jogging the second mile, his ears were up and he was jogging forward and striding right out. I was ecstatic that he came out of the race as well as he has. He'll probably go out twice tomorrow and once Friday. He'll probably jog Saturday morning, get on the van and ship to Belmont." Winning the Preakness was a huge thrill for the Maryland-based Ritchey. "Most people only dream about winning a Kentucky Derby, Preakness, Belmont or the Breeders' Cup," he explained. "We got to live our dream. To do it in Maryland is even more special with Joe and Karin De Francis owning the racetrack. I was very good friends with their mother Mae, who was a tremendous woman and took interest in me as a show horse rider when I was 18, 19, 20 years old. She was a great lady, and it means even more to me to have her family associated with the Preakness and Pimlico."

**SURGERY FOR WILKO**

The GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero **Wilko** (Awesome Again) has emerged from his 12th-place finish in the Preakness with a chip in his right front ankle and will undergo arthroscopic surgery, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "The prognosis is good," trainer Craig Dollase told *DRF*. "The chip is in a good spot." The chestnut is expected to be out of training for 90 days. "He has the tools to be a good older horse," Dollase added. "We'll regroup, and hopefully have a star for next year."

**HOLLAND GETS MOTIVATED**

Darryll Holland has received the call-up for the Royal Ascot Racing Club's G1 Epsom Derby favorite **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}), should Johnny Murtagh fail to overturn his three-day suspension. Murtagh has until 5 p.m. today to appeal the ban he picked up for careless riding at Lingfield Tuesday. The hearing could take place as late as next Thursday morning, minutes before the deadline for declarations for the Epsom Classic. "Darryll will ride should Johnny's appeal against his suspension be unsuccessful," Racing Manager Harry Herbert told *PA Sport*. "Frankie Dettori and Kieren Fallon are great exponents at Epsom, but Darryll is up there as well. Darryll will sit on the horse next Wednesday to get acquainted with him. Motivator won't be doing any serious work at that stage, but Darryll will ride him at exercise to get a feel of him." Holland's agent Terry Norman added, "It's nice to get the ride, and if you take out Kieren and Frankie, Darryll's probably got the best record round Epsom. He's got the opportunity to ride one of the best three-year-olds in the country."

**VIRGINIA WADES INTO OAKS WATERS**

Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo) looks likely to run in next Friday's G1 Epsom Oaks. Trainer Aidan O'Brien indicated that blaze-faced bay would be supplemented for £20,000, despite her disappointing effort when only eighth in Sunday's Irish equivalent at The Curragh. "The plan is that if everything is well then, hopefully, she'll run," he told *PA Sport*. "She's in good form since her last run. It was very soft ground when she ran first time this season, but we obviously saw an improvement when we got fast ground at Newmarket. If the ground is good or better, we'll be supplementing her."

**Arcadio**, a brother to last year's G3 Dr Busch Memorial winner and G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen third Assiun (Ger), was impressive when breaking his maiden at Cologne last time May 1. **Orange Blue**, **Imola** and **Early Wings** finished third, fourth and fifth, respectively, behind Arcadio's stable companion Konigstiger (Ger) in the G3 Stadtrat Albert von Metzler-Rennen at Frankfurt Apr. 24, and bid to take another step towards the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 3.

**PARK ENJOYS EPSOM SPIN** Michael Tabor's **Walk in the Park (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was the sole attraction at Epsom's "Breakfast With the Stars" pre-Derby workout yesterday, but pleased connections with his agility over the unique undulations. Trainer John Hammond was on hand to supervise the colt, who finished a neck second to Kong (Ire) in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial May 7, in the 10-furlong exercise under jockey Alan Munro and was pleased with what he saw. "It went very smoothly and I'm very happy with him," he said. "What he really needs is plenty of pace in his races and he seems to settle okay when there is, and that's usually the case in the Derby. The ground was a bit firm at Lingfield and he handled that okay, but the ground here is in great condition and they are intending to have it good for the race. He's going to have to improve from Lingfield, but I always felt that he would come on for that and he's a lively outsider." Alan Munro, who won the Classic on Generous (Ire) in 1991, added, "He's a big type, but he's athletic," he commented. "We came round there at a pretty good pace today and he coped well--we were off the rail through markers, which makes it more awkward, but he's getting used to it."

**FRACAS GETS GREEN LIGHT** Conditioner David Wachman yesterday gave the go-ahead to Joseph Joyce's **Fracas (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}) to contest next Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby. After walking the course with the G3 Sandown Classic Trial and G2 Leopardstown Derby Trial's owner, he told *PA Sport*, "The place is in great nick and it's lovely ground. Having seen it, we will give it a go for the Derby if the horse stays OK over the next 10 days. He is in good form and has done nothing wrong, but like every other horse coming here, it depends if he handles the track, and you don't know until you try."

**HATTAN ON TRACK** Saeed Manana's G3 Chester Vase hero **Hattan (Ire)** (Halling) received an upbeat bulletin from conditioner Clive Brittain ahead of his tilt at next Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby. Following his half-length defeat of Almighty in that contest May 5, he was committed to the mile-and-a-half Classic and has pleased connections in the interim. "He did his final piece of serious work under Seb Sanders yesterday and we were delighted with the way he moved," he said yesterday. "He's in great heart and Chester really taught him his job. We think we have a chance of beating the favorite."

**SUROOR BULLISH OVER DUBAWI** Saeed bin Suroor was in confident mood yesterday as he looked forward to **Dubawi (Ire)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}) running in next Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby. Godolphin's colt put himself in the picture when beating Oratorio (Ire) by two lengths in Saturday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh and he has pleased connections subsequently. "He came out of the race very well and is sound, healthy and happy," the trainer said yesterday. "It is a new distance for him, but the dam [G1 Oaks d'Italia winner Zomaradah {GB}] was effective over a mile and a half and, if he relaxes here, he has the speed to finish strongly in the final two furlongs. He has the class to run a big race and I hope he has learnt a lot from The Curragh."

**PICO INTEREST TO THREE CHIMNEYS, PADUA**

Three Chimneys Farm and Padua Stables have purchased a 50-percent interest in the breeding rights of

Gary Tanaka's multiple Grade I winner **Pico Central (Brz)** (Spend a Buck--Sheila Purple {Brz}, by Purple Mountain). The six-year-old will take up stallion duties at Padua's base in Summerfield, Florida next season. "This horse is a Grade I winner on both the turf and dirt and won Grade I races at five furlongs, six furlongs, seven furlongs and twice at a mile," explained Robert Clay of Three Chimneys. "I cannot think of a more versatile stallion candidate to come along in recent years. We think his speed will make him a natural for the Florida market breeders, and we're very pleased that Padua Stables agrees and will join us in making this horse the successful stallion we believe he will become." Brazil's champion sprinter of 2003, Pico Central won the G1 Grande Premio Major Suckow over a mile on the turf and the G1 Grande Premio Estado do Rio de Janeiro over five furlongs on the turf. Transferred to North America last year, the bay was on the board in all seven starts, winning five times and earning \$1,239,000. He captured last year's G1 Metropolitan H., G1 Vosburgh S., G1 Carter H. and G1 San Carlos H. In his only start this term, Pico Central was a troubled fourth in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen. "Pico Central will race the remainder of the year for Gary Tanaka, with trainer Paulo Lobo, and his main target for 2005 is the G1 Breeders' Cup Sprint," said Tanaka's Racing Manager Lincoln Collins. The purchase price was not disclosed and a decision to sell shares in the stallion has not been made.

**GULFSTREAM FILES SUIT FOR SLOTS**

Gulfstream Park has filed a joint lawsuit with Pompano Park, Hollywood Greyhound Track and Dania Jai-Alai against State Attorney Michael J. Satz in order to allow the installation of slot machines, according to published reports. State law currently prohibits the possession and transportation of slot machines. In March, Broward County voters approved a state constitutional amendment for slots at their pari-mutuel facilities, and lawmakers had been directed to write rules for the implementation of slot machines by July 1. However, the Florida State Legislature adjourned May 6 without acting, leading the Broward-based pari-mutuel facilities to suggest that the amendment is "self-executing." According to *The Miami-Herald*, the lawsuit reads, "The Plaintiffs believe that they are legally entitled to transport, install, possess and operate slot machines at their Broward County parimutuel facilities...but Plaintiffs do not want to subject themselves to criminal prosecution or civil penalties by the Defendant because of the uncertainty caused by the Legislature's failure to specifically act." A competing lawsuit has been filed by anti-gambling interests, led by State Representative Randy Johnson, in Tallahassee, Florida. "...Unless and until the Legislature takes action, the current law in Florida, which specifically makes it illegal to possess and operate slot machines, is in full force and effect...No governmental agency, including the Department or Broward County, can promulgate rules relating to slots," according to the *Miami-Herald* report. A statement from Governor Jeb Bush indicated that the matter of Broward County slots could be determined by a special session of the legislature in the fall.

**Pletcher, Bailey Due for Lone Star 'Cap:**

Texas natives Jerry Bailey and Todd Pletcher will make an appearance during Monday's Lone Star Million program, as the two will team with Michael Tabor's **Lion Tamer (Will's Way)** in the GIII Lone Star Park H. Winner of the GI Cigar Mile H. last November, the chestnut five-year-old returned to be second in the GII Richter Scale Breeders' Cup H. at Gulfstream Mar. 12 and was last seen at Keeneland, finishing a disappointing fifth in the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup H. Apr. 16. "The timing of it is good for him and we just felt like it was an opportunity to get him stretched out around two turns, at a mile and a sixteenth, and see how he handles it," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "It might give him some more options for the rest of the year." Other horses expected for the \$300,000 event include **High Strike Zone (Smart Strike)** and **Supah Blitz (Mecke)**, first and second, respectively, in the GIII Texas Mile Apr. 30 as well as defending champion **Yessirgeneralsir (Patton)**.

**Crafty Shaw to Defend Hanshin Title:**

Charles Cella's **Crafty Shaw (Crafty Prospector)** will carry the top impost of 119 pounds in his title defense in Saturday's GIII Hanshin Cup H. at Arlington Park. Trained by Pete Vestal, the seven-year-old entered last year's race off a pair of runner-up finishes in Grade III events at Oaklawn Park, but will be making his first start in nearly eight months when he enters the gate on Saturday. The chestnut was a last-out second in the GIII Turfway Park Fall Championship S. Oct. 2, but has fired off similar layoffs in the past.

The 22-1 upsetter in last year's GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H., La Reason had been held winless in eight subsequent starts, but employed a change in tactics to right the ship. Eleventh in this track's GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. last November, the bay made two starts at Oaklawn this winter, finishing fourth in the Feb. 20 Pippin S. and sixth to Injustice in the GIII Azeri BC H. Mar. 12. She was the runner-up in Keeneland's Doubledogdare S. Apr. 20, but was most recently a well-beaten sixth in the GII Louisville BC H. May. 6. Dropping into an allowance for the first time since last February, La Reason, usually a stalker/closer, pressed the pace outside favored Injustice, took over from that one entering the stretch and edged away.

### CHRB Release Says Guild Not at Fault:

Statements made last month that the Jockeys' Guild had allowed medical claims from injured jockeys to go unpaid or be sent to collection agencies were premature, according to a release issued by Ingrid Fermin, executive director of the California Horse Racing Board. California Horse Racing Board Commissioner Richard Shapiro had requested in mid-April that the Jockeys' Guild address the status of 12 claims that Shapiro said had not been handled properly, resulting in unpaid or delinquent claims. After reviewing information provided by Jockeys' Guild attorney Barry Broad, Fermin said in a statement released Tuesday that it appeared that nine of those claims were "properly and timely handled by the Jockeys' Guild." Fermin went on to say that, "Three claims were not addressed due to the failure of the claimants to return medical release forms that would allow the Guild to divulge information about those claims. It does not appear that the Jockeys' Guild failed in its responsibility to address any of these claims."
