MEGAHERTZ OUT OF GAMELY

Megahertz (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) was assigned highweight of 124 pounds for Monday's GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park, but trainer Bobby

Frankel has decided not to accept the assignment. The six-year-old mare carried 123 pounds to victory in the Apr. 17 GII Santa Barbara H., but she has never been asked to shoulder more than that. "I don't think she should have been put up any more,"

Frankel told *Daily Racing Form*. "You don't come out of Grade II races beating garbage and pick weight up. I don't think it's fair. That's why I think Grade I races should be equal weights." An 11-time stakes winner, Megahertz ended 2004 with a second-place finish in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup and opened 2005 with a win in the Mar. 20 GII Santa Ana H. The chestnut has won 12 of her 30 career starts, earning \$1,691,572. It has not yet been determined where she will run next.

KITTEN'S JOY RETURNS TO WORK TAB

Recording only his second published work since his second-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last October, and his first since March, champion Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) breezed a half mile in an easy :51 around the 'dogs' on the turf at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. Exercise rider Faustino Orantes was aboard for the move. "It was good to see him back breezing on the turf," trainer Dale Romans said. "He went real good. He did it well, hit the ground good and came back good." The four-year-old, who underwent surgery to have chips removed from his left knee at the conclusion of his Eclipse Award-winning campaign, is being pointed for the July 4 GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup S. at Churchill. "He is very sound right now and Faustino said he felt every bit as good as he did last year," Romans said.

Murtagh Appeals...

Johnny Murtagh yesterday lodged an appeal over the three-day suspension that will keep him out of the June 4 G1 Epsom Derby. Darryll Holland has been named as the jockey on stand-by for the ride on the Royal Ascot Racing Club's likely favorite **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}), should Murtagh's appeal be unsuccessful. The Jockey Club confirmed that the hearing, which will consider the ban handed out by the Lingfield stewards for careless riding this past Tuesday, will take place either Wednesday or Thursday. Holland spoke yesterday of his delight at the opportunity to partner the G2 Dante S. winner in the Classic. "Subject to Johnny Murtagh being unsuccessful in his appeal, it's a great thrill to get the chance to ride a horse like that going into the race as the Derby favourite," he said. "He's won one of the best trials this season. The idea is for me to sit on Motivator probably next Wednesday. [Trainer] Michael Bell says he's virtually done all the serious bits of work he's going to do now. He'll probably just have a little blow out, have a canter, basically for me to get a feel of the horse."

Moore Gets Unfurled Ride...

John Dunlop has booked Ryan Moore to partner Listed Predominate S. winner **Unfurled (Ire)** (Unfuwain) in the G1 Epsom Derby. Last year's champion apprentice will be riding in the Classic for the first time on the colt, who followed a 10-length maiden score at Goodwood Apr. 30 with a head defeat of Indigo Cat at the same track last Wednesday. "Unfurled is an improving horse," Dunlop said. "His maiden has worked out quite well and [he] won the Predominate by determination, courage and stamina, but it was an unconvincing trial."

Eswarah Giving Right Signals...

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's unbeaten **Eswarah (GB)** (Unfuwain) has pleased connections in her work and was reported on course for the June 3 G1 Epsom Oaks. A debut winner at Newbury Apr. 15, she followed up in the Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. back there last time May 13 and trainer Michael Jarvis has been delighted with her progress. "Richard [Hills] sat on her over a mile of the Limekilns gallop on Tuesday and we were very pleased with her," he said. "She quickened up nicely and is in very good order. She's only had two races in her life, so inexperience is one thing against her, but she has adapted well and it's not going to be a huge field, so Richard can have her in the position he wants."

NBC'S PREAKNESS RATINGS DROP

NBC Sports' television broadcast of the 130th running of the GI Preakness S. averaged a 5.1/13 national rating/share, down sharply from last year when Smarty Jones captured the middle leg of the Triple Crown, but up slightly from the same figures for 2003. The 5.1 rating dropped 16 percent from the 2004 broadcast, which earned the company a 6.1/15 rating/market share. The rating is up 2 percent from 2003 when the network had a 5.0/13 posting. NBC also reported that the "pre-race" rating averaged 3.5, while the race segment itself rated a significantly higher 6.3. NBC Spokesperson Alana Russo said that 1.096 million households make up one rating point. Calling the 2004 Smarty Jones telecast ratings an "anomaly," Russo said the more accurate comparison would be the immediate years preceding that year's Preakness.

Egg Head Interest Sold:

A 45-percent interest in the speedy **Egg Head** (Honor Grades) has been sold to a partnership that includes trainer Kieran McLaughlin, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Breeder Rabbit's Foot Stable has retained a majority interest in the three-year-old, who had previously been trained at Philadelphia Park by Lynda Knee. The colt has joined McLaughlin in New York. "His form is very good," McLaughlin told *DRF*. "We were trying to get something done earlier, but we were busy with the Derby." A son of multiple stakes winner Redding Ridge (Screen King), the dark bay overwhelmed his competition by a combined 25 lengths in his last three starts. Egg Head is coming off a 9 1/2-length victory in the Francis "Jock" LaBelle Memorial S. at Delaware Park May 7, a race in which he earned a 112 Beyer Speed Figure. McLaughlin indicated that the colt would likely start next in the GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S. on the Belmont S. undercard, where he could face unbeaten Lost in the Fog.

Alex's Lemonade Stand Raises Another \$18K:

Aided by a record Preakness crowd, a total of \$18,000 in donations was raised by Alex's Lemonade Stand at its two locations at Pimlico Race Course last week. The charity, based in Pennsylvania, collected \$11,000 at the Kentucky Derby. "It really is amazing!" said Liz Scott, the mother of Alexandra "Alex" Scott, who succumbed to cancer last August. "This is incredible and we owe a tremendous amount of credit to the great people at Pimlico who helped put this together for us." The stand also benefitted from the performance of Afleet Alex, as his connections have pledged a percentage of his winnings to the organization. During the past week, Huckleberry Farm, another client of trainer Tim Ritchey, donated \$10,000. "Fasig-Tipton had a stand at the Timonium sale on Monday and I know they raised a significant amount of money as well," Ritchey added. "I hope we can get what we want accomplished on Belmont day [June 11] and that is to have a lemonade stand at every racetrack that runs that day. It would be a great story."

Case of Strangles at Delaware Park:

Veterinarians with the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission have been advised that there is a confirmed case of the upper respiratory disease strangles on the Delaware Park backstretch. The horse, whose identity was not revealed, has been placed in an isolation barn and the barn where he was originally stabled has been placed under quarantine. The horses in that barn are undergoing testing for strangles. "Quick action on the part of the commission veterinarians and Delaware Park management working in unison has this matter under control," said Commission Chairman Bernard Daney. There were suspected cases of strangles at Gulfstream Park, Palm Meadows and Tampa Bay Downs this spring, prompting a host of tracks to institute shipping policies to protect against the disease. Two suspected cases forced Indiana Downs to cancel its live card May 19.

Woodard Breaks Churchill Record:

Trainer Joe Woodard tied the record of eight consecutive winners at Churchill Downs when he sent out **Native Bull** (Holy Bull) to win the sixth event for \$8,000 claimers at the Louisville oval yesterday, then broke it in the very next race when 8-5 **Quick Blend** (Wised Up) rolled to an 11 3/4-length score against \$10,000 claimers in the seventh. Both horses were claimed out of their respective starts. "Winning any race is a special thing for us," said Woodard. "It's good for the owners and good for the people that work every day with the horses. Anytime you've got a shot to make history at Churchill Downs, [it's special]. I don't think I'll ever win four Derbys or anything, so this is my little shot to make history here at Churchill." He added, "To get these claiming horses to come over and perform every time, it's tough to do. We've been on a really lucky streak." Woodard's streak started on Friday, May 13. The record was set by trainer Pat Byrne in 1997.
