LOOKING TO CASH WINNER'S CHEK

After removing the saddle from **Chekhov** (Pulpit) following his 8 1/4-length victory in an 8 1/2-furlong maiden May 8, jockey Gary Stevens paid the colt a high compliment. "He's the best three-year-old I've sat on this year," the veteran reinsman said. The \$3.3-million

Keeneland April graduate gets the chance to build on his reputation as the likely favorite in today's GII Peter Pan S. After hitting the board in his first two career starts, Chekhov was fifth in the Feb. 5 Sham S. at Santa Anita, a race in which Giacomo was third. But the bay emerged with a pair of quarter cracks, effectively

ruling him out of Derby consideration. He was given plenty of time to heal, culminating in his maiden win 20 days ago. "He's a very good horse and we've been very high on him since the beginning," said Patrick Biancone, who trains Chekhov for Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith. "He is putting everything together now. His maiden win was really good and I was quite impressed with him. Now it's time to test him." **Golden Man** (Suave Prospect) failed to draw into last week's Preakness S., but could race his way into the June 11 GI Belmont S. with a good effort here. Claimed for \$60,000 at Gulfstream in January, the dark bay gelding has made one start for his new connections, a three-length allowance score in Hallandale Apr. 2. Among the vanquished that day was Coin Silver, who returned to win the GII Coolmore Lexington S.

SCRAPPY T PROBABLE FOR BELMONT

Scrappy T (Fit to Fight), the winner of Aqueduct's GIII Withers S. earlier this year, is likely return to New York to make his next start in the GI Belmont S. June 11. Following his controversial runner-up finish in last

Saturday's GI Preakness S., owner Marshall Dowell indicated that the gelding would switch to the turf and make an appearance in the inaugural running of the Colonial Turf Cup at Colonial Downs June 25. Dowell is a resident of Mechanicsville, Virginia, just 20 minutes from the track. "If it weren't for Colonial Downs, this would be an easy decision to make," he told *The Blood-Horse*. But, he added, "All indications are that Scrappy T is heading to the Belmont." Scrappy T has finished in the top three in each of his six starts in the Big Apple, but has yet to race at Belmont Park.

MEDALLIST INJURED

Medallist (Touch Gold), runner-up to Forest Danger in the GI Carter H. in his most recent start, has been diagnosed with a cracked sesamoid in his left foreleg, casting doubt upon his racing future. The injury is said

to be nondisplaced and will not require surgery, but will cost the four-year-old at least the rest of the year. "I've had a lot of horse come back," trainer Allen Jerkens told *Daily Racing Form*. "It just depends how everybody feels about it." Campaigned by by Three Chimeys' owner Robert Clay, Medallist was being aimed at Monday's GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park. No decision has been made on his future, according to Three Chimneys' President Dan Rosenberg. "We're still gathering information and looking at options," he told *DRF*. "We'll look at the X-rays and talk to Allen and discuss the options, the pros and the cons." A dual graded stakes winner, Medallist has five victories from his 12 career starts and earnings of \$421,375.

Alex's Big Apple Arrival Postponed...

Preakness winner **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) will not arrive in New York today as previously scheduled. A suspected, but as yet unconfirmed, case of strangles forced the quarantine of barn 60 at Belmont Park yesterday and the isolation of the filly Lady Libby. "[NYRA Racing Secretary] Mike Lakow called me right away about the suspected strangles case, which I am very appreciative [for]," trainer Tim Ritchey said yesterday. "I can't take a shot shipping into New York right now with this horse and expose him to something. I talked to the people at Pimlico and we'll stay here until at least Tuesday. By that time, NYRA will hopefully know what they are dealing with and have control of the situation." Afleet Alex was tentatively scheduled to work this coming Tuesday morning at Belmont Park, but that move is now likely to take place at Pimlico, where the colt has been stabled since his victory last Saturday. NYRA Reacts to Recent Outbreaks:

Recent cases of equine strangles and the neurological form of equine herpes have led the New York Racing Association to take measures to protect its horse population. Representatives of NYRA were forced yesterday to place Barn 60 at Belmont Park under quarantine after the five-year-old mare Lady Libby, trained by Steve Kappes, began exhibiting symptoms consistent with strangles. Lady Libby has been placed in an isolation stall. "This is a suspected case of strangles, not a confirmed case," NYRA's chief examining veterinarian Celeste Kunz explained. "But we are taking this very seriously and are taking every precaution and bio-security measure. We are testing every horse in the barn and horses that have been through the barn." In response to the confirmed case of strangles at Delaware Park, Dr. Kunz announced Thursday that, effective immediately, horses stabled at Delaware are temporarily restricted from shipping into NYRA premises. Assuming no additional cases outside of the quarantined barn at Delaware, horses will be permitted on the grounds as long as there is proof of a negative culture from a nasopharyngeal wash or swab taken on or after June 6. There has also been a restriction placed on horses shipping in from Churchill Downs, where several barns were quarantined due to an outbreak of equine herpes. Provided there are no additional cases of the virus, horses arriving from Louisville are temporarily restricted from NYRA premises until June 1. Horses from barns which were placed under quarantine are prohibited at NYRA tracks until further notice. Trainers wishing to ship horses that have recently relocated from Churchill or Delaware must first contact Dr. Kunz.

Salic Law had a rough start to his career, finishing fifth, beaten 28 1/4 lengths at Belmont last July and eighth, beaten 33 1/4 lengths at the Spa in August, but has turned things around since. He earned his diploma at the Big A last November and added allowance scores over the inner strip Jan. 16 and Feb. 9. Most recently fourth in his turf debut at Aqueduct Apr. 20, he was let go as the longest shot on the board here. The dark bay went right to the front, set easy fractions of :24.65, :49.21 and 1:13.43 and reported home an easy winner.

A Dynamite Runner in the Boiling Springs:

TNT Stud's **Melhor Ainda** (Pulpit) looms a very heavy favorite in tomorrow's GIII Boiling Springs H. at Monmouth Park. Trainer Bobby Frankel has tabbed John Velazquez to pilot the bay filly, who is perfect in her three career trips to the post. A 3 1/2-length maiden winner Sept. 17, she rolled to an eight-length victory in the Miss Grillo S. Oct. 24 before getting a breather. The sophomore returned from a six-month absence to defeat **Paddy's Daisy** (King of Kings {Ire}) in the Apr. 24 Appalachian S. at Keeneland and rematches with that rival in tomorrow's 8 1/2-furlong grass test.

Shipping Restrictions in Place at Monmouth:

Due to a confirmed case of equine strangles at Delaware Park, horses currently stabled at that track will not be permitted to ship into Monmouth Park, and any horse shipped to Delaware from Monmouth will not be allowed to return. "It's a necessary precaution that is essential for the protection of horses stabled here at Monmouth," commented Dennis Dowd, senior vice president of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exhibition Authority. "It's a difficult decision when you're forced to place restrictions on anyone, but paramount to racing is the health of our equine athletes and we'll take all the necessary precautions to protect those interests." The policy will be reviewed no later than June 2.

Still under quarantine at Churchill Downs, GIII Derby Trial winner **Don't Get Mad** (Stephen Got Even) worked a half mile on the main track during special training hours after the races Thursday. The three-year-old was clocked in :49.60 under jockey Gary Stevens. He was breezing for the first time since finishing fourth in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby.

Ellis Offers Bonus to Trainers:
