**ORATORY MAKES 'EM SAY THEIR PRAYERS**

While all the focus was on another son of Pulpit heading into the starting gate in yesterday's GII Peter Pan S., it was **Oratory** (Pulpit) who stole the show at Belmont, drawing away in the stretch to post a decisive 4 3/4-length victory over **Reverberate** (Thunder Gulch). Ridden by Jerry Bailey for the first time, he was allowed to set the opening quarter mile in an easy :24. Reverberate began to press the pace for the next half mile, but Oratory had plenty left in the tank for the stretch drive, drawing away to post an impressive tally. "He finished very, very well," Bailey said. "I didn't intend to be on the lead, they just gave it to me. He was impressive today." *cont, p2*

**Not Today for Chekhov...**

Favored at odds of 3-2 off a Belmont maiden victory May 8, **Chekhov** (Pulpit) could only manage a well-beaten fourth-place finish after a mild rally on the far turn. "He got bumped at the start," trainer Patrick Biancone said of the \$3.3 million two-year-old purchase. "He's a big baby and he got a little scared. Lack of maturity might have hurt today. I'm going to keep my confidence in him. We'll see how he comes back and we'll talk with my people about the Belmont." Jockey Gary Stevens believed the slow pace was to blame. "The pace was very slow," Stevens commented. "That wasn't what I was looking for."

A year ago, American Freedom returned from a seven-month vacation to finish third in the GIII Red Bank H. at 47-1. The veteran was off at 11-1 yesterday, but exited his holiday just a few lengths fitter and charged home a narrow winner. Trainer Jamie Woodington, who has trained the gelding since he came to the track at the age of two, explained, "Getting to give him the winter off keeps him happy and healthy." American Freedom captured the Jersey Bred Turf H. at Monmouth last August, then was third in a pair of starts before ending the season with a sixth-place finish in the GIII Cliff Hanger H. at the Meadowlands in October. He spent his down time in Camden, South Carolina, getting fit on the local turf course. Ready to run in his return, he settled just off the pace as Spruce Run loafed through a half in :52.72 and six furlongs in 1:18.12. Lord of the Game does not have the pedigree of a typical runner who starts out at the \$10,000 maiden claiming level. His dam is a full sister to the multiple graded-stakes winning four-year-old Daydreaming, and his second dam is a full sister to champion Rhythm and to the star Maryland stallion Not for Love. However, he was haltered for \$10,000 out of a 22 3/4-length winning debut at Hawthorne Dec. 31 and went on to add four more sharp scores for his new connections, including a pair of optional claimers over that track Apr. 2 and Apr. 12. Making his stakes debut in the GIII National Jockey Club H. Apr. 23, he turned in a third-place finish behind Pollard's Vision and Badge of Silver after contesting a hot pace. Backed as the second choice here, he tried new tactics settling in fifth after a quick half mile in :45.89. Swung out four wide for the stretch run, he turned in a determined rally to post his first stakes success.

Consistency is Lucky Strike's forte since he emerged on the international scene with his success in the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot at Longchamp in June 2003. Subsequently transferred to the Andreas Trybuhl barn, he acclimatized with success in this contest 12 months ago before adding the G3 Holsten-Trophy to his tally at Hamburg in July. He was not disgraced when sixth in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville the following month and ran creditably when third in the G2 Goldene Peitsche here in September. Putting in a rare tame effort when off the board in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in October, he returned to the winner's enclosure in the Listed Sprintpreis at Cologne last time May 1. Dropping the customary tactics of front-running here, Adrie de Vries settled Lucky Strike in mid-division before pointing him through a gap on the inner to challenge inside the final quarter. Hooking up with Felicity soon after, he dug deep to prevail in a driving finish.

**Simonas** was a late starter in life, but he made up for lost time when winning the G2 Premio Carlo d'Alessio at the Capannelle last May and when fourth in the G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne in August and G1 Grosser Preis von Baden the following month. He ran the race of his career when getting to within 1 1/2 lengths of Sulamani (Ire) when runner-up in the G1 Candian International at Woodbine in October, but was a disappointing 10th of 13 in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. He had **Rotteck** back in fifth when finishing 3/4-of-a-length second to Collier Hill (GB) in the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne on his return May 1 and sets the standard. Rotteck was second to Touch of Land (Fr) in this last year before winning the G2 Hansa-Preis at Hamburg in June and filling the third spot in the G1 Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf the following month.

He has to bounce back from two subsequent disappointing efforts in the Rheinland-Pokal and Gerling-Preis. **Gentle Tiger** beat **Sweet Wake** by a length in the Listed Grosser Preis der Dr Duve Inkasso GMBH at Hannover last time Apr. 17 and is a potential improver.

**TWO ADDED TO OAKS** Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G1 1000 Guineas winner **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo) and Godolphin's **Fen Shui (UAE)** (Timber Country) were yesterday added to Friday's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom. Their addition at a cost of £20,000 each swells the purse of this year's Classic, for which 13 fillies stood their ground at the five-day stage, to £383,600. While the addition of Virginia Waters was fully expected, Godolphin's supplementing of Fen Shui came as a surprise after the filly had disappointed when only 10th in the Newmarket Classic last time May 1. "Fen Shui has been working nicely since the Guineas and we think she deserves to take her chance in the Vodafone Oaks," Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. "The trip is an unknown. She shows plenty of speed and there are some stamina doubts." Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial winner **Eswarah (GB)** (Unfuwain) and Hesmond Stud's Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial scorer **Cassydora (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}) headed the remaining entries and Epsom's Director of Racing Andrew Cooper was yesterday looking ahead to Friday's renewal. "Virginia Waters and Fen Shui join a strong field for the Vodafone Oaks and I would expect virtually all of them to line up on Friday," he said. "The going is good at the moment. It is a bit cooler than yesterday but very breezy. I will walk the course again tomorrow and if necessary we will resume watering on Monday. The forecast is for mainly dry weather during the week - there could be some rain but it is not guaranteed."

**TANAKA, BUSINESS PARTNER, JAILED** Alberto William Vilar, a wealthy philanthropist whose net worth is reported to be near \$1 billion, and prominent Thoroughbred owner Gary Tanaka have been jailed and are being held without bail on fraud charges, the *Associated Press* reports. Vilar, the co-owner of the San Francisco-based Amerindo Investments, was charged Friday in U.S. District Court for engaging in business practices that were "fraudulent, deceptive and manipulative." He was arrested Thursday night at Newark Liberty International Airport after returning from an investment conference in Las Vegas. The complaint charges that Vilar defrauded a client of \$5 million while using some of those funds to satisfy his charitable promises. Authorities accuse Vilar of putting the money into a "personal piggy bank" and spending \$700,000 of it on gifts and various donations. "The charges are very serious and very well-founded," Assistant U.S. Attorney David Esseks said in court Thursday, Bloomberg news reported. "We feel they are just the tip of the iceberg." Vilar's lawyer, Susan Necheles, told the *New York Times* that Vilar denies any wrongdoing. "It's just not true," she said. "We think that it will be cleared up." In a separate complaint, Tanaka, one of the co-founders of Amerindo and its co-chief executive, was charged separately with inventing a scheme to convert investor funds for his personal use in order to purchase race horses. The complaint stated that Tanaka bought his first horse in 1992 and by 2002 was ranked eighth nationally with earnings of \$4.1 million. Tanaka is to return to court June 3.

**BELMONT FIELD SHAPING UP** The field for the 137th running of the GI Belmont S. is beginning to take shape, with GI Kentucky Derby winner **Giacomo** (Holy Bull) and GI Preakness S. winner **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) leading the way. According to NYRA Stakes Coordinator Andrew Byrnes, other horses under consideration are; **Scrappy T** (Fit to Fight), **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus), **Southern Africa** (Cape Town), **Pinpoint** (Peaks and Valleys), **Buzzards Bay** (Marco Bay), **Sort It Out** (Out of Place), **A. P. Arrow** (A.P. Indy) and **Watchmon** (Maria's Mon). Byrnes added that all of the GI Peter Pan S. participants are also possible starters.

**Yesterday's Results:**

**4th-BEL, \$43,000, Msw, 3yo/up, 6f, 1:09 3/5, ft. + INGOT (c, 3, Seeking the Gold--Catinca {GISW, \$864,775}, by Storm Cat)** had been training smartly for his formidable connections and went postward as 3-5 chalk for his debut. The dark bay broke a bit slowly and settled into third as 6-1 Saffir (Unbridled), a \$1.8-million purchase, opened up a six-length lead through a :21.81 opening quarter. As that colt began to tire at the top of the stretch, the favorite came rolling on the outside and forged clear to win by 3 1/2 lengths over Crunch the Numbers (Vicar), with Saffir staying on for third. The winner, \$300,000 KEESEP yearling, is the second foal from Catinca, who was purchased by Brushwood for \$2.8 million at FTKNOV in 1999.

**Snake Mountain Retired:**

Three-time graded winner **Snake Mountain** (A.P. Indy --Coup de Genie, by Mr. Prospector) has been retired and will start a new career as a show horse, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The seven-year-old gelding captured the GIII Stuyvesant H. and GIII Queens County H. in 2002 and added a victory in the GIII Aqueduct H. in 2003. A winner in 10 of his 15 starts at four and five, the chestnut had managed just one victory since and was off the board in two starts this year. He underwent throat surgery twice, but trainer Jimmy Jerkens told *DRF*, "It looked like wasn't going to come back to his best form and nobody wanted to run him cheap." Owned by Jack Shelley and Paul Buzas, Snake Mountain retires with a record of 27-11-0-6 and earnings of \$530,694.

**Strangles Update:**

Lady Libby, the five-year-old mare who showed signs of the respiratory disease strangles, has been sent to Cornell University for testing and treatment, while horses in quarantined Barn 60 at Belmont Park have all been tested for the disease. "This is how you stop disease from spreading, by doing what we are doing," NYRA's chief examining veterinarian Celeste Kunz said. "We had already been on a high surveillance because of the outbreak of strangles in Florida this winter and the recent outbreak of equine herpes at other racetracks." Kunz added that Lady Libby is still only suspected of having the disease and that the horses in Barn 60 would not be allowed to train or race until the test results are returned. Even if the results are negative, after-hours training would be arranged as a precaution.

**Monmouth to Isolate New York Shippers:**

All shippers headed to Monmouth Park from Aqueduct and Belmont will be isolated in a separate receiving area due to a possible case of strangles in New York. "All areas that those horses may come in contact with will be disinfected; starting gate, paddock, lead ponies, stalls, etc," said Dennis Dowd, senior vice president of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "It's similar to the procedures taken at Gulfstream earlier this year and it's consistent with our policy of doing what is necessary to protect the horses stabled here."

**Fogelsonger to Miss Remainder of Pimlico Meet:**

Jockey Ryan Fogelsonger, currently second in the standings at Pimlico with 28 wins, will take the rest of the meet off to recover from the back injury he suffered in a spill Apr. 21. The meeting ends June 12. "I have been to four different doctors and they have all told me the same thing--that it isn't going to get any better unless I rest," said the 24-year-old reinsman. "The two fractures they found in my lower back are stable, but my muscles are knotted up and getting stressed every day I ride. I have tried four or five different medications, but now I am going to massage therapy, electric therapy and acupuncture and hopefully will return when racing shifts to Colonial Downs June 17." Fogelsonger will be featured in an episode of MTV's "True Life: I Want The Perfect Body II," which will air Thursday, July 7 at 10 p.m.

**Maryland Jockey Club Institutes Strangles Policy:**

Responding to the news that there is a confirmed case of strangles at Delaware Park and a suspected case at Belmont Park, the Maryland Jockey Club yesterday announced that horses from those two tracks, as well as Aqueduct, will be restricted from shipping into Pimlico, Laurel or Bowie Training Center until further notice. Horses shipping from the three Maryland facilities to one of those tracks will not be allowed to return.
