PASSING THE TEST OF CHAMPIONS

Cash is King's **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) earned numerous accolades for his brave performance in the GI Preakness S. three weeks ago, but surpassed even that with a thoroughly rousing display in the GI Belmont S. yesterday on a hot summer evening. Making his trademark quick move on the far turn, the bay left his rivals toiling in his wake as he powered home seven lengths in front. It was the fastest Belmont final quarter-mile, :24

SPRINGING THE UPSET

Jockey John Velazquez made the acquaintance of **Sand Springs** (Dynaformer) for the first time in yesterday's GI Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park, and the two hit it off right away, leading every step to best odds-on **Intercontinental (GB)** (Danehill) by a decisive 2 1/2 lengths. "I wanted her to be wherever she was comfortable,"

Velazquez said. "If you try to fight her, she tries to run off and drifts out. Once she got into a comfortable rhythm, she was fine. When I asked her to run, she was there for me." Winning trainer Bill Mott was also at ease. "She's tough to handle...but I know that Johnny is used to handling tough horses," he said. "I felt comfortable with him being on this mare." Cont. p4

'LOST' KEEPS FINDING MORE

Unbeaten **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier) led every step of the GI Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S. at Belmont yesterday, digging in deep to deny **Egg Head** (Honor Grades) in a battle of Danzig grandsons. "I think this was his toughest race," admitted winning trainer Greg Gilchrist. The dark bay with the distinctive blaze has a big summer goal. "The King's Bishop [GI, 7f, Aug. 27, SAR], that's the one we really want to win," Gilchrist added. Cont. p5

ALEX THE GREAT Breaking from post nine, Afleet Alex came away well and was tucked in heading into the first turn as **Pinpoint** (Peaks and Valleys) led a host of runners. "All I kept saying was, 'Be patient, be patient, be patient; wait, wait, wait,'" explained winning trainer Tim Ritchey. "That was the plan. With these big, wide turns you have to save all the ground you can." Jeremy Rose followed those instructions to a T, settling the neatly made bay well off a fair pace. He nudged the colt to take closer order heading into the far turn as Kentucky Derby winner **Giacomo** (Holy Bull) loomed up on the outside. Rose and Afleet Alex split horses on the turn and angled to Giacomo's outside at the top of the stretch. For a moment, it seemed as though the well-publicized rubber match between Classic winners would be one for the ages. But it turned out to be a thriller of an entirely different sort. Afleet Alex quickened away, reaching out with relish down the stretch, and became the 17th sophomore since 1979 to win two Classics. Afleet Accomplishments...

Afleet Alex's past performances read like those of a runner from 25 years ago. Following double-digit wins at Delaware Park to start his career, he captured the GI Sanford S. and the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga. He finished up the year with seconds in the GI Champagne S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and opted to take the Smarty Jones path to Louisville via Arkansas. After a sharp win in the six-furlong Mountain Valley S. to start the season, he exited a sixth in the GIII Rebel S. with a lung infection, but rebounded with a scintillating win in the GI Arkansas Derby. The bay came up a length short when third in the GI Kentucky Derby May 7 before winning one for the ages in the Preakness S. His Belmont victory puts him in rarefied company: only a pair of colts previously had won the Hopeful and Sanford at two and the Belmont at three: Triple Crown heroes Secretariat (1972-73) and Affirmed (1977-78).

'Nolan' Pitches a Fast One...

With no career wins to date, **Nolan's Cat** (Catienus) was the second-longest price on the board at 20-1, and ran the opening three-quarters living up to those odds. But the blaze-faced chestnut rallied impressively from way, way back and wound up completing the trifecta. "He ran huge," said trainer Dale Romans. "He'll get better and better. If this horse didn't have some unfortunate events along the way, I think he would have been a contender throughout the entire Triple Crown."

Giacomo Displaced...

Derby winner Giacomo wound up seventh after looking prominent on the turn for home. According to jockey Mike Smith, the grey colt displaced his palate. "Down the backstretch, I could hear him make a loud, roaring noise," Smith said. "So I got him to the outside and dropped his head--a lot of times that will help get it back. But he never did." Trainer John Shirreffs indicated that the colt was acting up in the security barn, but said later, "He looks good now."

Good Reward got a perfect turf-saving trip beneath Jerry Bailey and rallied along the inside to take a blanket finish in the Manhattan. Third to Artie Schiller and Mustanfar (Unbridled) in the GII Hall of Fame H. at Saratoga last Aug. 9, the bay was an even fourth to Prince Arch in the GIII Saranac H. at the Spa Sept. 6 before earning his first black-type victory in the stakes named for his sire going a mile over the Keeneland turf course Oct. 10. Ambitiously spotted to end his three-year-old season, Good Reward was able to overcome a bumping incident in the stretch en route to a half-length victory in the 10-furlong GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 28.

Trainer Shug McGaughey opted to send the homebred back to California for his 2005 debut, where he switched to the main track and finished a respectable fourth to Rock Hard Ten in the GII Strub S. at Santa Anita Feb. 5. The bay resurfaced at Keeneland, running third in the GII Maker's Mark Mile Apr. 15 and was coming into this off a third-place finish in the GII Dixie S. on the Preakness undercard May 21, a race in which he was compromised by a total lack of pace. Good Reward broke well

and secured a perfect spot in fourth, just behind the leaders, as the field raced up the backstretch. Turning for home, pacesetter Quest Star (Broad Brush) left the rail open and Bailey pounced on that opportunity, driving Good Reward to the front at the eighth pole. The colt stayed on dourly to hold a very game effort from Relaxed Gesture, while favored Artie Schiller, with the pace throughout, could not match strides with the winner late. "When Jon [Court, aboard Quest Star] stayed off the rail, I said this is almost like a Christmas present," the victorious rider explained. "I got to stay slow-paced and I was able to save ground." Added winning trainer Shug McGaughey, "I think this is a true mile-and-a-quarter horse. I was glad to see him be versatile enough to be wherever he wants to be. If we can continue to improve, with the Breeders' Cup being here, it would be nice to have a chance." Sweet Return became the second former GI Hollywood Derby winner to capture a Grade I on the afternoon, following Good Reward's success earlier in the Manhattan. The blaze-faced chestnut won the GII Frank E. Kilroe Mile at the beginning of his four-year-old season, but hadn't had his picture taken in eight subsequent trips to post. In three starts this year, Sweet Return ran third in the Kilroe--now a Grade I--second to Singletary in the GII Arcadia H. Apr. 9 and most recently finished fourth in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic May 7 at Churchill Downs. Breaking alertly here, the third choice bounced along on the lead under a heady ride by Alex Solis, putting in trotting horse fractions of :50 3/5 and 1:14 1/5. But though favored Red Fort looked to set to go by him in the stretch, Sweet Return dug in tenaciously on the rail to get the job done.

Trainer Bill Mott is on a roll. The Hall of Fame horseman saddled Beacon Shine to victory in Friday's GIII Flash S., and picked up a second graded-stakes score here. Mott picked up Sand Springs after she won the Kentucky Cup Ladies Turf S. at Kentucky Downs last September, when she sold at Keeneland November. The dark bay mare returned to be sixth in a Gulfstream allowance test Feb. 11 in her first start under new management, then scored by a nose in the GIII Honey Fox H. Mar. 13. Given a short break after that effort, she came back to be second in the May 7 GIII Distaff Turf Mile S. at Churchill Downs, but was let go at 7-1 facing a tough bunch here. The five-year-old went right to the front under jockey John Velazquez, set a swift pace and opened it up late to best odds-on Intercontinental handily. Lost in the Fog has faced the starter at five different racetracks in seven career outings, never earning less than a 102 Beyer Speed Figure. After beginning his career with victories at Golden Gate and Turf Paradise, the powerfully built three-year-old travelled to his birth state, winning the Sunshine Millions Dash and the GII Swale S. at Gulfstream Park. Following a facile win in Aqueduct's GIII Bay Shore S., Lost in the Fog returned home to the Bay Area and annexed the Golden Bear Breeders' Cup S. May 14, winning by 10 lengths at 1-10 and earning a 110 Beyer. Odds-on for the sixth time in his career, he had the lead a few strides out of the gate and showed the way through a half in :44.45 while shadowed by Middle Earth. Egg Head took a run at him late, but the favorite held him at bay in the final furlong. "They softened him up a little bit," trainer Greg Gilchrist said, "but believe me, their tongues were hanging out trying to catch him." Regular rider Russell Baze was forced to miss the mount when he suffered a broken collarbone in a spill Wednesday, but Edgar Prado proved a capable substitute. Egg Head, purchased privately since his last start, gave a good account of himself. "Obviously, we were second best," admitted trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. Now a graded stakes winner at two, three and four, Limehouse became a millionaire here. The chestnut landed the GIII Bashford Manor S. as a juvenile and added victories in the GII Hutcheson S. and the GIII Tampa Bay Derby in 2004. He took his time coming around this year, with runner-up efforts in the GIII Mr. Prospector H. and the GII New Orleans H. sandwiching a fourth in the Sunshine Millions Classic. After a troubled fifth in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 9, the Dogwood colorbearer had his picture taken in the Alysheba S. on the Kentucky Oaks undercard and was the second choice here. Jockey John Velazquez placed Limehouse in second as longshot **Rogue Agent** (Anjiz) set the pace. They moved to the lead on the turn and were never seriously threatened by favored **Gygistar** in the stretch. "I didn't seem to think there was a lot of speed in here, and I thought being close would be good," winning trainer Todd Pletcher said. "I wasn't concerned when Johnny moved a little early." CLASH OF THE TITANS The Niarchos Family's **Divine Proportions** stretches out into beyond a mile for the first time as she bids to extend her winning streak to eight. She looked to be all speed at two when beating the colts in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August, but proved her effectiveness going a bit further when stamping her authority on the one-mile G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp on Arc day. Following a pair of facile scores this term in the G3 Prix de la Grotte Apr. 24 and G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) May 15, both in Paris, she bids to emulate her owners' East of the Moon, the last filly to complete the Pouliches--Diane double, in 1994. While the Niarchos filly's stamina is unproven, His Highness the Aga Khan's **Vadawina** has it in abundance. She demonstrated her readiness for this test with easy successes in the G3 Prix Cleopatre at Saint-Cloud May 1 and the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 22.

Her performance in besting the Listed Prix Rose de Mai winner **Argentina (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) by four lengths--with G3 Prix Penelope heroine **Perfect Hedge (GB)** (Unfuwain) languishing back in third in that 10-furlong contest--was sensational. Vadawina holds strong claims of providing trainer Andre Fabre with his fourth renewal as well as becoming the first to complete the Saint-Alary--Diane double since the Aga Khan's Zainta (Ire) pulled it off seven years ago. Jean de Roualle, who saddled Caerlina (Ire) to win this in 1991, relies on Steven Lamprell's **Satwa Queen (Fr)** (Muhtathir {GB}), who disposed with her rivals in impressive fashion in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp last time May 11.
