KEEPING IT IN PROPORTION

The Niarchos Family gained compensation for Miesque's eclipse in the 1987 Prix de Diane when her daughter East of the Moon garnered the Pouliches-Diane double in 1994, but that accomplishment was put firmly in the shade at Chantilly yesterday. The odds-on favorite in this year's running of the French Oaks, **Divine Proportions**, by Miesque's son Kingmambo, confirmed her status as Europe's darling with yet another scintillating performance, defeating **Argentina (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) by an easy three lengths. Connections had considered a possible tilt at this week's G1 Coronation S., but the decision to go the Classic route was vindicated in emphatic style as she claimed a fourth Group 1 and extended her winning streak to eight. **French Oaks cont. p2**

'ALEX' FINE AFTER BELMONT WIN

A day after capturing the GI Belmont S. in sensational style, Cash is King's **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) was doing fine. "No problems," said trainer Tim Ritchey.

"We washed the poultice off his legs, which is a normal thing I do with every horse. His legs were ice cold, tight as could be, he walked very well, grazed for awhile and everything's good." Afleet Alex, who beat **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus) by seven lengths in the third leg of the Triple Crown, is set to get a brief vacation before returning to the races. Ritchey said 'Alex' would remain at

Belmont Park for the next few days while he contemplates summer plans for the colt. "He'll either stay here, go to Monmouth, or Saratoga," Ritchey explained. "I want to have 10 or 15 horses going to the same place he is. Probably the most likely is Monmouth Park, because the GI Haskell [Invitational H., at Monmouth Aug. 7] is the next target we're going to shoot at." Ritchey also mentioned the Aug. 27 GI Travers S. at Saratoga as a possibility for 'Alex,' but added, "He doesn't need to run in both. He could run in one and not the other. We'll see how it plays out."

'Alex' at Four?

Not surprisingly, plenty of stallion operations have shown interest in Afleet Alex, who also won the GI Preakness S. by open lengths. But Ritchey said the bay's stud career likely won't begin until 2007. "As long as he's healthy and sound, he will run as a four-year-old, end of story," said Ritchey. "The owners are in 100 percent agreement with that. We've had about 15 farms call. The one condition we'll have in anything that we do with any breeding farms is that we will sell the breeding interests, not racing interests. I think the owners are having the time of their lives, and I know I am. If we can get one more year, it makes him an even better breeding prospect."

No Doubt...

"[Divine Proportions] is exceptional and erased all doubts about her stamina in great style," enthused Niarchos Racing Manager Alan Cooper. "Our pacemaker did a perfect job to provide her with cover and, now that she has proven her stamina, we will have to see what's next after discussing options with the owner." Mapping out a potential campaign, Cooper continued, "We've made a speculative entry in the [G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, but we are not planning that far ahead. The plan beforehand was to bring her back in the [G1] Prix Jacques Le Marois Haras de Fresnay-Le-Buffard [Deauville Aug. 14], where she will meet the colts for the first time this year unless scaring them away, and we might stick to that." Divine Proportions first tasted Classic glory in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches May 15, and the champagne flowed once more, mainly over jockey Christophe Lemaire, after she took her earnings beyond the €1-million mark with victory here. Racing a shade keenly early, she got the perfect tow behind **Sapas** (Kingmambo) as His Highness The Aga Khan's pacemaker **Alharmina** (GB) (Linamix {Fr}) set the tempo to the stretch. The leading pair drifted off the rail as they turned for home, allowing the contest to begin in earnest. Divine Proportions eased to the fore approaching the final quarter mile and settled the issue in an instant, bursting clear at the eighth pole. "She is a true phenomenon," exclaimed trainer Pascal Bary. "It is unbelievable to think she had her first run over five furlongs and has accomplished all this in just over a year. She doesn't pull, but has a high cruising speed which allows her to relax so well, like all great horses." Trainer Elie Lellouche was not downcast in defeat. "[Argentina] ran a great race," Lellouche remarked. "When she was second in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary she had not raced for seven weeks, which was probably too much of a break. She was a much fitter horse today, but there was nothing she could do against the winner who is in a class of her own." Sensibly Chic, who finished second to Bank Audit in the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. and GII Genuine Risk H., turned the tables on that foe for her initial graded tally. The late-developing New York-bred won a pair of minor stakes last year and kicked off her 2005 season with an impressive score in the Jan. 29 What a Summer S. at Laurel. A string of runner-up finishes began in the GII Barbara Fritchie H. at Laurel Feb. 19, as she failed to hold off Bank Audit in the Mar. 26 Distaff and, after a breather, the May 14 Genuine Risk. Here, the chestnut recovered from a bobbled start to attend the pace three wide, opened by daylight in upper stretch and strolled home well clear of her running-on rival. Acquired privately by Michael House after an impressive maiden win at Calder last November, Brooke's Halo paid dividends when she became a graded stakes winner yesterday. The bay romped by six lengths in Florida last fall for trainer Pablo Adrade, then joined Jeff Mullins' barn on the West Coast. A well-beaten 10th as the favorite over a wet-fast track in Santa Anita's Jan. 29 Sunshine Millions Oaks, she returned to her maiden form with a smart front-running tally against allowance foes at that track Mar. 9. Up the track when tossed to the wolves in the Apr. 14 GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland, the Florida-bred rebounded once again and nearly took her turf debut when a nose second in the Manhattan Beach S. over Hollywood's sod May 29. Hustled out to set the pace returning to the main track, Brooke's Halo set very honest pace as Cee's Irish loomed a threat. Konigstiger was a head in front when successful in the G1 Gran Criterium at Milan last October and again when winning the G3 Albert von Metzler-Rennen on seasonal debut at Frankfurt Apr. 24. Judging this with the accuracy of a brain surgeon, he cut it fine once more, enjoying the luxury of a nose supremacy over errant stable companion Silent Wind to just retain his unbeaten boast at the end of this G1 BMW Deutsches Derby trial. The Schlenderhan homebred was settled two lengths off Silent Wind's even pace, but looked tapped for toe when the tempo increased in the straight. Getting to the leader under a forceful drive inside the final furlong, he was driven out to deny the long-time leader on the nod as that rival veered off a straight line in the closing stages. The win provided jockey Andreas Suborics with his biggest tally since returning from serious injuries. Penalized for winning the G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein at Longchamp Oct. 2, Cacique justified connections' decision to supplement for this by wiring the field to record a cozy third group-race success. The Juddmonte Farms homebred was let go as the 2-1 second choice following a seasonal-debut fifth in the G2 Prix du Muguet at Saint-Cloud May 1 and a last-out third in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 22. Asserting for the outright lead soon after start, he was pushed along when pressed by Special Kaldoun inside the final quarter and maintained a comfortable advantage throughout the final furlong to easily dispose of that rival, who just held on for second. "He ran the first three furlongs of the Poulains as fast as he ran the last three furlongs today, and did too much too soon last time," explained conditioner Francois Rohaut. "He was able to settle today and showed his best form. We may come back here for the [one-mile G1] Prix Jean Prat [July 3]."

Turtle Bowl broke his stakes duck when landing the Listed Prix Montonica at Maisons-Laffitte Mar. 15 and returned to finish fourth in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau at Longchamp Apr. 24. He was thrust in the deep end, but not disgraced, when eighth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains back at Longchamp May 15 and benefitted from an astute Olivier Peslier ride to secure a first group win in his first start since then. Settled three lengths of the pace in third as Early March set the fractions, he moved smoothly onto the heels of the leaders approaching the final quarter-mile. Peslier exerted minimum effort as Turtle Bowl went to the front at the eighth pole and the former champion ensured his elbows were in working order late to score in comfortable fashion. "That was a nice performance considering he was giving weight all round," said Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe. "He seems to be at his peak now, so we'll bring him back in a Group 1 race, but we have yet to decide which one." "Today was just the beginning of a great New York run that will include our summer season at Saratoga Race Course and then the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships here at Belmont Park in the fall."
