**ON THE CAUSEWAY**

There is an open feel to today's renewal of the G1 Coronation S., but Martin Schwartz's **Maids Causeway (Ire)** (Giant's Causeway) will be looking to complete a memorable Royal Ascot double at York for her sire today. Shamardal got the "Iron Horse" off the mark in Tuesday's G1 St James's Palace S., and this filly looks to be hewn from the same material. One of last season's top juveniles, she took the G3 Sweet Solera S. in August and G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket in October either side of tussles with Playful Act (Ire) in the G2 May Hill S. at

Doncaster and G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot in September. The chestnut bested all bar **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo) in the G1 1000 Guineas S. on her return at Newmarket May 1, but was drawn away from the main action when fifth in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later. "We think that draw made all the difference in Ireland, as the ground on the stand side was a lot slower," trainer Barry Hills' son Charlie told *PA Sport*. "It felt it to walk on, and the filly had nothing to race against." Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's Virginia Waters has been busy since her impressive Newmarket victory, running eighth in The Curragh Classic before failing to land a blow when fourth in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 3. "She's in good form and hasn't done much since the Oaks," Aidan O'Brien said. "She won't mind fast ground, as it was very fast at Newmarket, so we're hopeful that she runs well." She is deserted by Kieren Fallon in favor of **Damson (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}), who showed blistering speed to win the G2 Queen Mary S. at this meeting 12 months ago before beating the colts in the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh in August. Softer ground may have been to blame for her subsequent eclipses when third in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket in October and ninth on her return in the Irish 1000 Guineas. Both the Newmarket and Curragh Classics appear to hold the key to this race, as **Karen's Caper** (War Chant) and **Cape Columbine (GB)** (Diktat {GB}) were fourth and fifth in the former and **Utterly Heaven (Ire)** (Danehill) filled fourth in the latter. **WILD WILD WEST**

With the sand flying on York's home turn, yesterday's G1 Ascot Gold Cup resembled a scene from High Noon, and it was Ecurie Wildenstein's **Westerner (GB)**

(Danehill) who proved to be the quick draw in downing **Distinction (Ire)** (Danehill) by a cosy neck. The 7-4 pick barely needed a gear shift to readily reel in the 33-1 outsider approaching the final eighth. From there it was a procession as Olivier Peslier allowed him to coast to the line, leading an unlikely one-two for his sire. For his owner/breeder Alec Wildenstein, it was an emotional moment. "For my father, and the family, it is wonderful," he said. "He is a friend--I was very worried when the pace was so slow, but the horse is so maneuverable. He's achieved everything you can ask." **INTO THE WEST** Westerner was beaten by **Papineau (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) in this race 12 months ago, but had confirmed himself time and again Europe's leading stayer with stellar performances at his beloved Longchamp. These have included successes in the last two renewals of the G1 Prix du Cadran and G1 Prix Royal-Oak, the last two runnings of the G3 Prix de Barbeville, last year's G3 Prix Gladiateur and the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier, which he used as a warm-up for this on his latest start May 22. For jockey Olivier Peslier, it was plain sailing. "We were in a good place on the inside so I stayed there and waited," he explained. "He wanted to go earlier, but I knew he had a good turn of foot and when I asked him he kept going." Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's Managing Director Harry Herbert was delighted with the performance of the runner-up, known as "Big D" in the stable. "I thought when he went clear he had done enough and he fought back when Westerner came," he said. "He's an amazing horse and has improved every year--he was very unlucky in the G1 Melbourne Cup last year and is going back there again." Seamus Sheridan's four-time G1 Irish St Leger winner **Vinnie Roe (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}) could not match the late burst of the front two, but ran his usual game race to fill third spot. "It was an exceptional race and they went a good pace throughout," jockey Pat Smullen commented. "The first three quickened at the end and he just ran out of stamina towards the latter part of the race. This is his last year and I would have loved to win this and bow out a Gold Cup winner, but he ran a very good race." Sheikh Hamdan, who had already won the G1 Epsom Oaks with a daughter of his beloved Unfuwain, watched as Thakafaat provided the late Shadwell stallion another success. After taking a handicap at Pontefract on her seasonal bow Apr. 27, she found **Something Exciting (GB)** (Halling) 1 1/2 lengths too strong in the Listed **Lupe S.** at Goodwood May 18 and sat out the Epsom Oaks, in which that rival finished second. Supplemented for this contest last week, she justified their boldness to win this war of attrition. Keen to exploit her stamina, Willie Supple sent the filly to the front after the first quarter mile and she led the field into the straight before crossing over to the stands' rail. She was still at the head of affairs as Twyla Tharp emerged widest of all with the greatest threat and, after being briefly headed with 100 yards remaining, dug deep to reclaim the advantage in the final dip of her head. "She's very tough and stays and hasn't had too hard a season so far," her trainer commented. "She deserved it and the obvious target is the G2 Park Hill S. [at Doncaster Sept. 7]. Easier ground will probably be more suitable." Trainer David Elsworth was disappointed with the performance of the **Something Exciting**. "Maybe the winner has improved, but [jockey] Richard [Quinn] said there was loose sand on the bend and she seemed to resent the kickback," he said. "I felt very confident after she showed her well-being after the Oaks, so I'm not going to use that as an excuse. We're obviously disappointed." Howard Johnson's revival on the racing scene has been funded by the Northern software tycoon Graham Wylie, but it has been orchestrated by his own talent. After saddling Pacific Pride (GB) to finish runner-up in Tuesday's G2 Coventry S. at 66-1, he went one better with Masta Plasta, who had shown the requisite speed when wiring a Newcastle maiden last time June 1. Quickest away again here, he enjoyed a narrow edge to halfway where Classic Encounter produced his challenge. He shrugged that aside and was firmly in command as Strike up the Band closed late, having given away valuable ground at the break. "Masta Plasta and Pacific Pride are two nice two-year-olds and I'm learning quick at this game," his trainer said. "We've always loved them and they've worked together since they came."

Sir Michael Stoute has saddled four winners of this race since Shareef Dancer opened his account in 1983. In this select renewal, Stoute will rely on the regally bred **Mountain High**--a half brother to champion Islington (Ire)--who was taken to Chester for his education and recorded a comfortable score in a 10½-furlong maiden May 5. Due to its proximity to the G1 Epsom Derby, this race has an uninspiring record for blue riband runners making a quick return, but Storming Home (GB) managed to win four years ago. **The Geezer** attempts the feat this year and bids to better his eighth placing in that Classic June 4. He had previously run Motivator (GB) to a length and a half when runner-up in the G2 Dante S. at this venue May 12, and trainer David Elsworth is hopeful he can return to that form. "He got taken back at the top of the hill at Epsom and then was stopped again," he explained. "He finished all right and didn't really have a hard race." **Front Row** did not even make that Classic after being withdrawn at the start, but has claims on his previous third in the G3 Chester Vase May 5. John Gosden has yet to win this prize. He saddles on **Plea Bargain**, who finished runner-up in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Saint-Cloud last time May 16.

**Rumplestiltskin** was distinctly green on her first two starts in a Naas maiden May 14 and Listed Swordlestown Stud Sprint S. back there last time June 6, but clearly possesses much ability. She faces a deep field of promising fillies, including the impressive Haydock maiden winner **Spinning Queen**, who comes from the Barry Hills stable successful in Tuesday's G2 Coventry S. "She looks a very nice filly with abundant natural speed and the Listed race over six furlongs should be ideal," his son Charlie told *PA Sport*. "She must have a very good chance." Jamie Osborne has tasted success at this meeting before and saddles **Marriage Value**, who took a warm maiden at Goodwood on debut May 20. "She has improved from her run and has had a nice preparation for York with no pressure on her," her conditioner told *PA Sport*. "She got six furlongs very well in soft ground at Goodwood. I must confess I was worried about the going, but she didn't mind it a bit. I think she's a very talented filly and if the Albany hadn't been there I would certainly have considered letting her run in the Queen Mary over five."

## OUIJA BOARD ON SHELF

Lord Derby's champion **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) exited her disappointing seventh-place finish in Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot at York with a quarter crack. Trainer Ed Dunlop revealed that the four-year-old will face a spell on the sidelines before a possible return in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood July 30. "I think realistically we will have to forget about Wednesday," he said. "She's sound at the walk, but we're going to have to do a bit of work on her foot. Her possible next target is the Nassau S., but we'll treat the quarter crack and take it from there. We haven't got the pressure of trying to get her to a race in a short amount of time. Hopefully, we can take our time and sort it out. Goodwood is not for a long time."

## Ladies' Day Smashes Record...

Wednesday saw a near-40,000 record crowd on the Knavesmire, but Ladies' Day of the Royal Ascot meeting easily surpassed that figure when 50,510 people crammed in to York racecourse yesterday. "The Yorkshire Course Enclosure was sold out today for the first time, along with the Grandstand, so the 50,000 barrier was broken and crowds for the remainder of the week will be in excess of 50,000," explained Ascot's Head of Public Relations Nick Smith. "This if by far the biggest crowd York racecourse have ever seen and we think the traffic plan coped very well, given that the crowd took such a leap since Wednesday." Yesterday's Tote on-course cash turnover was up 20 percent on Wednesday to £1,252,000, beating the previous York record set on Ebor day in 2003.

## Sand Bags at Dawn...

York's Clerk of the Course William Derby left the ground as good to firm yesterday after the rain that fell on Tuesday and Wednesday merely made the top slippery.
