Cloning is illegal in Thoroughbred racing, but getting hold of Giant's Causeway's genes may be the next best thing. His daughter, Martin Schwartz's **Maids Causeway (Ire)**, provided more proof with a victory beyond the call of duty in yesterday's G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot at York. She had to work far harder than Shamardal did in Tuesday's G1 St James's Palace S., but fight has never been in short supply where the "Iron Horse" was concerned, and the 9-2 second choice went through the pain barrier to best **Karen's Caper** (War Chant) by a short head. "She's unreal," her jockey Michael Hills explained. "She went lame coming up to the line, but thank God she's just pulled a shoe off. She's a man--just like her father. I was trying to get over on her, but I had to come back in the saddle and steady to go for one more surge and she came up for me." **Cont. p2**

FUTURE ADENA STALLION GIACOMO INJURED

GI Kentucky Derby winner **Giacomo** (Holy Bull), who will stand at Adena Springs Kentucky at the conclusion of his racing career, will undergo surgery next week for a bone chip in his left front ankle. Trainer John Shirreffs decided to put the three-year-old through a thorough examination after his seventh-place finish in the June 11 GI Belmont S. X-rays taken Wednesday revealed the chip. Veterinarian Rick Arthur will perform the surgery at Hollywood Park. Looking ahead, Shirreffs told *Daily Racing Form*, "The prognosis is excellent. Most of the time for these types of injuries, [the time off required] is between three or four months. He should be at the short end of the time. With time, he should go on to be a better horse." **Cont. p8**

FRANKEL DOUBLE-FISTED IN FOSTER

Trainer Bobby Frankel will send out the two morning-line favorites, **Badge of Silver** (Silver Deputy) and **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado) in today's \$750,000 GI Stephen

Foster H. at Churchill Downs. Saint Liam gave Horse of the Year Ghostzapper all he could handle when second by a neck in the GI Woodward in September. He rebounded with wins in the GII Clark H. Nov. 26--over track and trip--and the GI Donn H. Feb. 5, but hasn't been out since finishing sixth at even-money in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar.

5. The bay has been transferred to Frankel while trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. serves a 60-day suspension. Badge of Silver, a game winner of the GII New Orleans H. IRON MAIDEN Always prominent, **Maids Causeway** led the field into the straight before battling grimly when headed by **Karen's Capar** in the final 100 yards to win the bobber. Lame after the line, the heroine was walked back to her proud connections minus one shoe to add further merit to her display of bravado. Maids Causeway gave first notice that she had inherited the toughness that characterised her sire early on, but success came easy in the G3 Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket in August. Though things got tougher afterwards, she refused to duck the issue behind Playful Act (Ire) when third in the G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster and runner-up in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot in September. Her stoicism earned her a hard-fought score in the G2 Rockfel S. in testing ground at Newmarket in October, but was not enough as **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo) rushed past in the G1 1000 Guineas on her return May 1. Soft ground and an unfavorable draw were to blame when fifth in a blanket finish to the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later, and she was able to turn the tables on her rivals this time. "She's very very tough and tries very hard and will stay further eventually," said conditioner Barry Hills. "Last time she got left out when the field split, but she had a good run through the race and stuck her neck out all the way up the straight." Plea Bargain survived the first stewards' inquiry of the Royal meeting, justifying his connections' decision to let him take his chance on the quickening ground. They had avoided that prospect by taking the Sandown conditions winner to Saint-Cloud for the G2 Prix Greffulhe May 16, when he was the runner-up to Vatori (Fr). Settled in rear throughout the early stages here, he quickened down the outside to head Brahminy Kite with 300 yards remaining as The Geezer entered the fray. He may have been feeling the conditions as he wandered across the latter soon after, but he was on top of Brahminy Kite in the drive to the line, and the stewards judged him a worthy winner. "We came together when the race was over, but it's obvious that the best horse won," trainer John Gosden said. "He's out of a lovely staying family and ran a great race last time, but he's feeling the ground today. He's a lovely improving horse, who I'd love to put away until the autumn and he'll make a nice late-developing type for Godolphin next year. I will put him in the G1 St Leger [at Doncaster Sept. 10], because there's a lot of stamina there and he's getting the trip well, but Sheikh Mohammed will make the decision." Trainer Jeremy Noseda watched Salut d'Amour (Ire) finish second in Wednesday's G2 Queen Mary S., but the exciting La Chunga made amends when spreadeagling her rivals here. Third when strongly fancied for a Sandown maiden on debut May 30, she looked a different proposition in this competitive affair. Cutting through the pack to lead passing the quarter pole, her response to the whip was deadly and she was geared down near the line. "She's a very talented filly," her trainer said. "When I took her to Sandown I thought she was five lengths better than Salut d'Amour and that filly won the Listed National S. while she got beat in a maiden, which was astonishing. She must have needed that run and we had to stay faithful and bring her here. She showed today what she had at home and has everything--a high cruising speed, a good turn of foot and a great attitude to it. It's been a bit of a rush getting here, but her preparation for the February Calder Sale helped her to handle this sort of situation."

Overmatched when fifth in the G2 Futurity S. at The Curragh last August, he benefitted from a drop in class on his return when winning a Catterick conditions event Apr. 20 before finishing third in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial on his latest start May 7. Positioned in third throughout the early stages, he was stoked up for his run entering the straight and edged ahead at the three-furlong marker. Tackled by Helvetio soon after, he responded to driving to deny that rival before holding the re-rallying Mr Vegas in the closing stages. "We'll think about where to go next, but he's got a new career ahead of him and hopefully he'll be a Cup horse now," his trainer commented.

Eclipse Award winner **Ashado**, five-for-eight last season, has yet to reach the winner's circle this season. Given a break after her 1 1/4-length score in the Oct. 30 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, the dark bay filly was sent off the 1-2 favorite when she returned in the Apr. 9 GI Apple Blossom H., but faltered to be fifth. She was the 3-10 chalk in the May 20 GIII Pimlico Breeders' Cup Distaff H., her first-ever Grade III start, before getting caught by Silmaril at the wire and finishing second by 3/4 of a length. But, according to connections, the four-year-old is still the one to beat. "I think she'll silence her doubters on Saturday," said trainer Todd Pletcher's Belmont assistant, Tristan Barry. "She's as good as she was last year." The winner of the GI Test S. and GI Alabama S. at three, **Society Selection** didn't get the best of trips when ninth in the BC Distaff. The bay stumbled badly at the break in her 2005 bow, the Feb. 19 GII Shirley Jones H., and ran a distant sixth, but rebounded to take the May 21 GII Shuvee H. by 2 3/4 lengths over **Daydreaming**. She has been first or second in four of her five tries at Belmont. "Hopefully, she can run like she did in the Shuvee again," said trainer Allen Jerkens, who won his first Phipps [ex Hempstead H.] in 1974 with Poker Night and second in 1992 with Missy's Mirage. "She's been doing everything right since the Shuvee." He added, "She's a good girl. She's right up there with the best fillies I've had." Society Selection blew out three furlongs in :37 yesterday morning.

Fair Nashwan, unbeaten in three starts so far, warmed up for this when besting **Relais d'Aumale** in the Listed Premio Alberto Zanoletti di Rozzano here last time May 8 and bids to provide Bruno Grizzetti with an overdue first success in this Classic. Relais d'Aumale is one of two fillies representing Germany, successful in three of the last six renewals. Hans Blume was responsible for two of those heroines in Nagoya (Ger) and Meridiana (Ger), but his representative **Gyreka** needs to improve on her eighth behind the subsequent G1 Preis der Diana winner Iota (Ger) in the G3 Schwarzgold-Rennen at Cologne last time May 16. Clive Brittain won this 12 months ago with Menhoubah and saddles **Hallowed Dream**, who followed a second to the smart Fashionable (GB) in the Listed Pretty Polly S. at Newmarket May 1 with a sixth placing in the Listed Lupe S. at Goodwood 17 days later. **Troppo Oca** beat **Sunsemperchi** in the G3 Premio Mario Incisa here last time May 28 and is a useful second string for the Grizzetti stable.

Lady Legard's MG1SW **Somnus** started the year with a fine fourth under a seven-pound penalty behind **The Kiddykid** in the G2 Duke of York S. over course and distance last time May 11 and meets that rival on level terms here. **Etlaala** reverted to five furlongs for the G2 Temple S. at Sandown May 31 and was not disgraced when seventh. Trainer Barry Hills is hoping the extra panel will bring him back to his best. "I have always loved this horse and he was so impressive when he won the Champagne S. at Doncaster last year," he said. "He showed in the Temple that he has speed to burn, so if the ground dries up he must have a big chance." **Cape of Good Hope**, currently running away with the Global Sprint Challenge, is proof that consistency is its own reward. He has never been able to match Silent Witness (Aus) on home shores, but has a string of placings in the major Hong Kong sprints to his record and had his moment in the sun when taking the G1 Australia S. at Moonee Valley Feb. 19. The world and his wife thought **Doyen** was the second coming last year after he smashed Ascot's track record in this race before following up with an emphatic success in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at that venue the following month. When they had the opportunity with Giacomo, they pursued it and were able to come to terms with the Mosses."

One solution is to turn graded handicaps into races with uniform allowance conditions--whether a top horse runs at Belmont, Arlington or Churchill, he would carry and spot the same weight.

It resulted in a bounce last time, but even another at the level of his last would probably get him a check here, and he has a chance to upset if the big one didn't kill him.

SNITZEL TO ARROWFIELD Arrowfield Stud confirmed **Snitzel (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}--Snippet's Lass {Aus}, by Snippets {Aus}) will stand at the stud in 2006 after Arrowfield purchased 25 percent of the colt. Arrowfield will race Snitzel, the winner of two Listed races and the G3 Skyline S. in partnership with owner Damion Flower next season. "We've bought a leg in him and we are very happy," said Arrowfield's John Messara. "I think he had one of the better pedigrees of this year's two-year-olds. He's a lovely looking individual, very precocious and was probably the best of the two-year-olds, but ultimately he didn't prove that," he said of the horse who was well-beaten favourite in the Golden Slipper. Snitzel has won four from six appearances and will target races including the G1 Manikato S. over 1200 meters at Moonee Valley in spring. Snitzel is the fifth son of boom sire Redoute's Choice to have stud plans finalized with Widden securing Slipper winner Stratum (Aus) earlier this week.

HALO HOMEWRECKER TO COLLINGROVE

Collingrove Stud has purchased Gill Bay Shore S. winner **Halo Homewrecker** (Southern Halo--Marital Spook, by Silver Ghost), a seven-furlong specialist who won three times in 15 appearances. The leading Victorian Stud hopes Halo Homewrecker can replicate the success of Southern Halo sire More Than Ready, who is poised to win champion freshman honours in Australia as the season comes to a close. Halo Homewrecker, currently in quarantine, will stand at A\$6,600. Collingrove director Adam Sangster said the horse was ideally suited to the stud's Victorian operation and would appeal to breeders who participated in that state's lucrative bonus scheme. "We are continually searching for Super VOBIS type sires, ideal for our Victorian operation and our client base," he said. Collingrove co-owner David Hayes added, "He is pitched at a real value for money service fee. He had real speed and acceleration and on the back of More Than Ready's performance, he is a great option for breeders."

GENERAL NEYDIM BREEDER DIES

Prominent Queensland owner-breeder Ron Ashdown died suddenly while on a family holiday in Rome on the weekend. He was 63. Ashdown, who ran Glengarry Stud near Ipswich and bred champion sprinter and successful sire General Nediym (Aus) (Nediym {Ire}), is survived by wife Helen and daughters Cate, Alex and Georgia. Funeral arrangements are yet to be announced. Owned by the Ashdown family, General Nediym is standing at Widden this season at a fee of \$30,800. His dual Group 1 winning daughter Regimental Gal, a A\$16,500 yearling purchase, fetched \$800,000 at the final session of the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale Friday.
