## HIGH VOLTAGE

**Electrocutionist** (Red Ransom) had to do it the hard way to earn his stripes in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano at San Siro yesterday, but he answered every call to bag the big win his resume demanded. Successful in the Listed Gran Premio d'Italian at this meeting 12 months ago, he was beaten in a bobber by Shirocco (Ger) in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club back here in October. He looked a different class when scoring by six lengths in the G2 Premio Carlo d'Alessio at the Capannelle last time May 22 and, despite having to work harder here, confirmed his lofty status among his country's middle-distance performers. The bay was taken to the front in the early stages by Edmondo Botti, but was tracked throughout by **Vol de**

The minimum amount of Lasix now allowed at New York Racing Association tracks has been lowered from 5cc to 3cc. The new minimum went into effect Friday, June 17. The maximum dosage remains at 10cc. All horses that qualify for Lasix will receive 5cc unless a Lasix Administration Request Card is submitted before 7 a.m. race day or, for shippers, upon their arrival at the security barn.
