SUMMERLY DAY FOR MOTHER GOOSE

With temperatures expected to soar into the mid and upper 90s this afternoon in greater New York, it is only fitting that GI Kentucky Oaks heroine **Summerly** (Summer Squall) is one of the chief protagonists in the GI

Mother Goose S. The chestnut dominated the scene over the winter in the Big Easy, winning the GIII Silverbulletday S. and the GII Fair Grounds Oaks, but was a dull fourth in the GI Ashland S. at

Keeneland. She bounced back in style, taking the

Derby eve feature by two lengths and makes her first start since that effort. "I think she's an awesome filly," said trainer Steve Asmussen, who won the 1999 Mother Goose with Dreams Gallore. "We paid a lot of money for her. She was supposed to be the filly she is. She's got a lot of talent." Inside Information won 14 of her 17 career starts, but was third in this event in 1994. Her daughter **Smuggler** (Unbridled) will look to better that performance this afternoon. Stakes-placed at two, the bay has made a pair of starts this term, winning a Belmont allowance May 11 before finishing a good second to Round Pond in the GI Acorn S. June 4. Her off-the-pace style should fit well in a race full of early speed types. **Spun Sugar** (Awesome Again) is the latest rising star for her sire. The Adena homebred is three-for-four in her career and comes in off a 3 3/4-length victory in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May 20.

NINE FOR CURRAGH CLASH

Michael Tabor's **Hurricane Run (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Walk in the Park (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will face a select field of seven rivals in tomorrow's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. While the former has been leased back to his owner-breeder Gestut Ammerland for the Classic, Tabor's swoop for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club second gives him a strong hand in the 140th renewal. Hurricane Run's trainer Andre Fabre compares

him favorably with one of his past stars. "It is difficult to rate a horse who has just run a few times and the Irish Derby will give us more answers," he commented. "For me, I would put him in the same league as Peintre Celebre." Tabor's chances are reinforced by the John

Hammond-trained Walk in the Park, who bids to atone for his five-length defeat at the hands of Motivator (GB) in the G1 Epsom Derby June 4. His conditioner is hopeful that he can build on that effort. "He took the race at Epsom well," he commented. "He lost surprisingly little weight considering he got a bit sweaty beforehand. He has always been highly strung and always will be and got a little bit upset coming out of the paddock at Epsom, where there's not a lot of room. He was pretty good in the parade and then got fairly sweaty behind the stalls which is something I suspect he probably always will do, but it doesn't seem to affect him in the race." Aidan O'Brien will saddle a duo headed by Susan Magnier's Epsom Derby fifth **Gypsy King (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), while Joseph Joyce's **Fracas (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}) represents the David Wachman stable and also represents that form, having finished fourth at Epsom. Clive Brittain yesterday issued an upbeat bulletin on Sandown maiden scorer **Bahar Shumaal (Ire)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}), who was supplemented at a cost of €100,000. "We sent him over on Tuesday and Brett Doyle went along to put the finishing touches to the horse," the trainer told *PA Sport* yesterday. "He has improved steadily and I have every confidence in him." Irish Derby field p5

Noel and Miriam O'Callaghan's **Alexander Goldrun** found the greater strength of older rival Chorist (GB) too much when runner-up in the inaugural running of the Pretty Polly S. as a Group 1 last year, but returns to The Curragh to lay it down to the sophomores this time. Making her name on other shores in the interim, she bested Grey Lilas (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp on Arc day and Bullish Luck in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin in December. She was sixth in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba on her seasonal bow Mar. 26 before finishing third in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji last time May 15. "Alexander Goldrun is very well and has been working well," commented trainer Jim Bolger, successful three times in the 1980s. "This race has always been the plan for her." Of the three-year-olds, Joseph Joyce's **Saoire** offers Classic form, having edged out Penkenna Princess (Ire) to win the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at this track May 22. That was an improvement on her return when sixth in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket three weeks previously and her jockey Fran Berry expects her to put it up to her elders. "It was a great win last time and she showed she was tough and battled really well," he said. "All she could do was win and they've been saying all year that there's more improvement to come when she steps up in trip. For her to win a Group 1 over a mile is very encouraging and hopefully when she steps up she can improve again."

The mighty mite **Megahertz** looms a worthy heavyweight in this small field, but she'll be giving away at least nine pounds to her rivals. She has begun her six-year-old campaign in fine style, rallying to take the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 20 before three-peating in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 17. Her patented late charge has carried her to victory in 12 of 30 career starts for earnings of over \$1.6 million. Recent South American import **Halo Ola** might be able to give the favorite some trouble. The bay capped a three-race winning streak in her native Argentina in the G1 Copa de Plata Dec. 8 before concluding her tenure there with a third versus males in the G1 Gran Premio Miguel A. Martinez de Hoz Feb. 12. Both of those contests were at today's distance of 10 furlongs. In her U.S. bow, Halo Ola finished sixth in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. May 30.

Winendyneme, privately purchased by J. Paul Reddam following her win in the restricted Tranquility Lake H. May 29, will be making her first start beyond a mile here. The \$140,000 Keeneland April graduate boasts a pedigree--by Dynaformer out of a Caerleon mare--which suggests that the distance should be within her scope.

JOCK CHANGES FOR TOP RUNNERS A pair of prominent horses will have new jockeys in the irons for the rest of the year. **Kitten's Joy** (El Prado {Ire}), the reigning Eclipse Award-winning turf male, will be guided during his four-year-old season by jockey Edgar Prado, trainer Dale Romans told *Daily Racing Form*. The blaze-faced chestnut was ridden by Jerry Bailey to four victories last season, but John Velazquez took over for his final two races after Bailey went down with an injury. Prado was aboard Kitten's Joy during a 2 3/4-length victory in last year's GIII Virginia Derby. "Why not Edgar?" Romans told the *Form*. "Talking about Jerry or Johnny would be too political. I liked the way Edgar rode the horse in Virginia last year, and it's pretty obvious he's a great rider. Plus, he's going to stay with the horse all year. We're happy to have him." Bailey has been named to replace Jose Santos on **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor). "It's always great to have an opportunity to ride a good horse," Bailey told the *Form*. "I do know him about as well as you can know a horse without riding him," he added, referring to the 2003 Triple Crown, when he was the regular rider of Empire Maker. Funny Cide was most recently placed fourth in the GII Brooklyn H. June 11 after being interfered with entering the far turn. Trainer Barclay Tagg would not say whether the incident contributed to his decision. "I just think now and then a change of hands is good on a horse," the conditioner told *DRF*. "I love Jose, I just thought he needed a change of hands."
