### LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON?

With **Hurricane Run (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), **Scorpion (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Walk in the Park (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) to represent him, Coolmore's stallion sensation looks to be in a win-win situation in today's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. It was six years ago that the John Hammond-trained Montjeu took apart his rivals in this Classic. With an Epsom Derby winner already in his first crop thanks to Motivator (GB), a famous double could be on the cards. Scorpion has the most to prove of his trio, but, according to *Racing Post*, was "all the rage" after breaking his maiden at Leopardstown May 8. Trainer Aidan O'Brien said following that effort, "We've always thought highly of him. He's one of our top horses." The bay showed with promise when second by a short head in the May 22 G3 Gallinule S. over this course. He was unsuited by the lack of pace in the June 5 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club, finishing last but one, but deserves another chance here. **Irish Derby cont. p3**

**Classic Lines...**

With her regal pedigree and a series of solid workouts, **Smuggler** was no secret in her career opener. The bay was the even-money chalk at Belmont in October and, after lagging early, came flying late to win by a length. She made it two in a row in an allowance test at Aqueduct in November, but was unable to get past Leona's Knight in the Dec. 4 Three Ring S. at Calder and finished second. Freshened after that effort, she came back to win an allowance race at Belmont Park May 11. The Phipps homebred made her graded-stakes bow in the June 4 GI Acorn S. and, for the first time in her career, was not the favorite. Sent off at 6-1, she vied for the lead through rapid fractions, dropped back when they hit the stretch, but came on again to be second, beaten 1 1/2 lengths by Round Pond. "She is still learning," Shug McGaughey said. "I thought the hard race in the Acorn set her up for [the Mother Goose]." That it did. With jockey Edgar Prado in the saddle for the first time, the three-year-old was rated off the pace after **Spun Sugar** (Awesome Again) ducked in toward her as the field raced out of the chute. Spun Sugar, **Winning Season** (Lemon Drop Kid) and 6-5 **Summerly** (Summer Squall) fought it out on the front end through a half in :46.47, then Smuggler joined the fray after six furlongs in 1:10.63.

**Easier Than It Looked...**

Charging down the outside as they raced out of the turn, Smuggler took over and edged clear, but appeared to hit the brakes once she had the lead, allowing Spun Sugar to get back within a neck at the wire. "She was just galloping along when she got to the leaders," Prado said. "I think she forgot to keep going. She kind of pulled herself up. She could have won by a lot more." McGaughey agreed with that assessment, but added, "If she wasn't going to be tough to beat today, she just wasn't going to be that kind. I am tickled to death for her." As for what's next, the Kentucky horseman said, "We'll probably run her in the [GI Coaching Club American Oaks, July 23]." Spun Sugar will also be back for the final leg in the Triple Tiara.

**Taking The Curragh by Storm?**

Andre Fabre, who sent Winged Love (Ire) over to land these spoils 10 years ago, has made no secret of his regard for **Hurricane Run**, who smashed up the G2 Prix Hocquart at Longchamp May 9 before tackling the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly last time June 5. The reduced distance and enterprisingly ridden Shamardal proved his undoing there, but his late rally to finish a neck second had shades of father about it. "He has been lightly trained since the Prix du Jockey-Club, but he is doing well and I am pleased with him," his trainer said. "I think The Curragh will suit him better than Chantilly and the extra distance will be a help to him."

**Take a Hike...**

**Walk in the Park** produced his own flourish to fill second spot in the Epsom Classic, five lengths adrift of Motivator. He bids to emulate El Gran Senor, Law Society and St. Jovite in going one better here. "I think all the traveling has helped him," trainer John Hammond said. "He is a horse with a lot of energy and I think the more outings he gets like that the more it suits him and gives him something to get between his teeth. I think the track will be fine for him, as The Curragh doesn't really pose a problem for too many horses." Aidan O'Brien has won this three times since 1996 and, while he saddles the third of the Montjeu trio in **Scorpion**, his strongest chance appears to be **Gypsy King (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who followed success in the G3 Dee S. at Chester May 6 with a fifth placing at Epsom.

Second in this race last year, Alexander Goldrun was successful in G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp Oct. 3 and in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 12. She failed to land a telling blow in her first two starts this term, running sixth in the G1 Dubai Duty Free at Nad al Sheba Mar. 26 and a lackluster third in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji May 15, but was the 9-4 favorite to get back to winning ways here. Despite finding himself in the rear after her tardy start, jockey Kevin Manning exuded confidence as New Morning (Sadler's Wells) led the way. He angled the crowd's choice outside for her run once into the stretch and the move reaped maximum reward as she swept past every rival for an impressive score. Connections and punters endured a nervous wait before the stewards forgave her late inward drift, deeming it accidental interference. "She is a very tough filly and I think that was the best performance of her career," Jim Bolger said. "We'll see how she comes out of the race, but the [G1] Falmouth at Newmarket [July 5] is a race we'll be looking at, as well as the [G1] Matron S. [Leopardstown Sept. 10] and then the [G1] Prix de l'Opera [Longchamp Oct. 2]." The race was tempered by a serious tendon injury to third placegetter Elopa, who will be retired to the breeding shed if she overcomes her injuries. Trainer Bobby Frankel hesitated to let Megahertz shoulder the 124-pound impost against five over-matched distaffers here, but the six-year-old mare made light work of the weight, sprinting past the field en route to yet another decisive score. The chestnut crossed the finish line in front in her first three starts last season, although she was disqualified and placed

seventh for swerving at the eighth pole in the GII Santa Ana H. in March. She came back to take the Apr. 17 GII Santa Barbara H., but had to settle for second in the May 31 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H., then went to the shelf. Sent off at 10-1 for her return in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf at Lone Star Oct. 30,

she failed to handle the yielding course and ran 11th, but rebounded in her final start of the year, running second by a head in the Dec. 4 GI Hollywood Turf Cup. As good as she looked ending the year, Megahertz may prove to be even better this season. She closed from last to first to win the Mar. 20 GII Santa Ana H. and the Apr. 17 GII Santa Barbara H. Mindful of the extra lead being carried this time, jockey Alex Solis kept the mare just a little closer to the pack as she trailed early, then threaded her through an opening at the top of the lane. Kelly's Landing began his career with a pair of 9 1/4-length victories at Turfway and Keeneland last season

and started off his four-year-old campaign with a decent second in a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 17. The dark bay followed that defeat with a third-place finish behind Silver Wagon and Value Plus over that track Feb. 6, then got his picture taken versus allowance foes Feb. 26. He went on to disappoint with sixth-place finishes in his next two at

Keeneland Apr. 8 and Churchill Apr. 30, but rebounded with an \$80,000 optional claiming tally at the Louisville oval last time May 29. Sent off as the longest shot on the board for his stakes debut, he sat cozy as Jet Prospector blazed the way through :21.01, :43.83 and :55.22 fractions. Asked for run by Gary Stevens in the stretch, he took over and held the favorite at bay while setting a new track record. "He's the kind of horse that might step up and improve again," said Stevens, who was riding Kelly's Landing for the first time. "He broke real relaxed and was able to stay in striking distance without me using him. He just took me around the turn at his will." Added trainer Eddie Kenneally, "We were looking for an allowance race for him to run in, but there wasn't any so we opted for the stakes. We wanted to run at Churchill his home racetrack, so that was the option. There was no pressure--we just gave it a shot." Looking ahead, Kenneally remarked, "It's too bad there's not many races left at Churchill--the meet's coming to a close. He likes this track and he's on the improve right now. The latter represents the Pascal Bary stable, successful in 1990 and 1995. Grand Opening was receiving five pounds from **Montare** when besting that rival by 1 1/2 lengths in the Listed Prix Melisande at Fontainebleau last time June 8 and may struggle to confirm that form on these terms.

Germany's Horse of the Year in 2004 **Soldier Hollow** returns to his native country for this competitive renewal. Having run up a sequence last summer in the G3 Lotto Hessen-Pokal at Frankfurt, G3 Preis der Sparkassen-Finanzgruppe at Baden-Baden and G2 Euro-Cup back at Frankfurt, he beat Imperial Dancer (GB) in the G1 Premio Roma in November. Subsequently down the field in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin the following month, he returned to finish a disappointing fifth in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica at the Capannelle last time May 1. **Simonas** was a revelation last season, winning the G2 Premio Carlo d'Alessio in Rome before finishing fourth in both the G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne and G1 Grosser Preis von Baden. He was beaten only 1 1/2 lengths by Sulamani (Ire) when runner-up in the G1 Candian International at Woodbine in October before trailing in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. He finished runner-up to Collier Hill (GB) in the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne last time May 1 and rates a threat, as does **Sweet Wake**, who ran away with the G2 Grosser Mercedes-Benz-Preis at Baden-Baden last time May 29.

**Dance with Ravens**, the son of champion and Queen's Plate winner Dance Smartly, is a half-brother to Scatter the Gold, who took the Canadian Classic in 2000; and Dancethruthedawn, who won it on her way to a Sovereign Award as top three-year-old filly in 2001. It would be no surprise if his name ended alongside those of his illustrious relations. The bay has reached the wire first in each of his three dirt starts, taking the GII Grey Breeders' Cup S. while still a maiden last October and adding a Woodbine allowance tally May 7 in his second start this term. He was in front once again at the finish of the June 5 Plate Trial, but was disqualified and placed sixth for causing interference at the start. "He's coming up to the race in great shape," trainer Mark Frostad said. "If it was a beauty contest, I'd be a lot more confident. Unlike his half-brother Scatter The Gold, who probably never did understand what it was all about, this guy's starting to tune in. He'll certainly get the mile and a quarter. He's very talented, he'll relax, so we'll see."

**Three in the Bag** was awarded the win in the Plate Trial after finishing a neck back in second. A \$200,000 KEESOP yearling, the bay took five starts to break his maiden, finally beating **King of Jazz** going a mile at Gulfstream in March. He came back to be second to subsequent GII Peter Pan S. runner-up Reverberate in an allowance test at Belmont May 8 before making his stakes debut in the Trial. "We were having a little trouble breaking this horse's maiden, getting him to rate," explained Neil Winnick, the racing manager for owner Castletop Stable. "We weren't sure we were able to get the mile and a quarter--and we're still not. But when we came here...and we took hold of him and he finished on the outside the way he did [in the Trial], we knew we made the right decision." King of Jazz is two-for-two since losing by a length and a quarter in that maiden test. The bay gelding earned his first trip to the winner's circle with a 3 1/4-length score at Keeneland Apr. 22 and came back to beat allowance foes at Churchill Downs May 25. But the nine boys in the Queen's Plate field may face their toughest competitor in the filly **Gold Strike**. The Manitoba-bred miss has been unbeatable when going around two turns, taking a one-mile stakes race at Assiniboia Downs by 15 3/4 lengths last September in her juvenile finale. The dark bay was second in the Apr. 24 Star Shoot S. going six panels in the slop at Woodbine, but rebounded to take the May 22 GIII Selene S. by 5 3/4 and the June 12 Woodbine Oaks by 3 1/2. "I'm not concerned about the distance," trainer Reade Baker said. "I'm concerned about the time between races--I'd rather have more time...but she's galloped great ever since [the Oaks]."

If he does pair up he has a chance for a minor award.

This marks the 146th edition of the Queen's Plate, the longest continuously run stakes race in North America. It is the first jewel in Canada's Triple Crown of Thoroughbred Racing. The other gems are the July 17 Prince of Wales S. at Fort Erie and the Aug. 7 Breeders' S. at Woodbine.

The blaze-faced colt faced his toughest challenge in his latest start, winning the GII Riva Ridge S. by 1 1/4 lengths on the Belmont S. undercard.

"We knew that kind of race would come sometime," trainer Greg Gilchrist told the publication. "We knew he wouldn't win them all by eight or 10 lengths." Lost in the Fog returned to his Northern California base after running his record to a perfect seven-for-seven, and is yet to post a workout since. "He bounced out of that race quicker than I expected and as well as he has out of any of his previous races," Gilchrist added. "I will probably work him just once prior to the Carry Back. He's been running about once a month, so he's pretty fit at this point, and he'll be turning back from seven furlongs to six for this next start." Russell Baze, who was forced to miss the Riva Ridge due to a fractured collarbone, is "50-50" to ride him in the Carry Back, according to Gilchrist. Edgar Prado picked up the mount last time and will have first call if Baze is unable.
