### ROCK YOU LIKE A HURRICANE

Fresh from the exacta in the Epsom Classic, Coolmore sire Montjeu (Ire) yesterday took The Curragh by storm when French raider **Hurricane Run (Ire)** denied Team Ballydoyle's **Scorpion (Ire)** in a thrilling climax to the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby. Recently purchased by

the Coolmore operation, but racing in Dietrich von Boetticher's red and green colors, Hurricane Run emulated his sire's 1999 win with a powerful finishing display in Ireland's premier race. "For me, it means a lot. It is one of the nicest racecourses in Europe and one of the most important races," winning trainer Andre Fabre told *PA Sport*. "I think the

horse still has a little improvement to come, so this was a really good effort." The occasion was marred when **Gypsy King (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) broke his shoulder after the first bend, unshipping jockey Seamus Heffernan. He had to be euthanized. *Cont. p2*

### ALKAASED SHINES IN SAINT-CLOUD

**Alkaased** (Kingmambo) has achieved much since progressing through the handicap ranks, but his finest hour arrived in the Saint-Cloud sun yesterday when he romped to victory under an inspired Frankie Dettori in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud to secure a first win at the highest level. The victory owed much to the Italian jockey's patience, and he possessed too much artillery in the closing stages, besting **Policy Maker (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) by two easy lengths. The bay tasted his first stakes success in the Listed Glorious S. at Goodwood last July and found only one better when upped one notch in the G3 September S. Sept. 4. He came out fighting this term and landed the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 1, but was undone by Kieren Fallon's guile when second to **Yeats (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) last time in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 3. "The Coronation Cup was a strange tactical race where he was caught for speed, but he was very impressive here and traveled well throughout the race," explained winning trainer Luca Cumani. "He was on the bridle and when Frankie asked him to go he just went." *Cont. p2*

**Hurricane Storms to Irish Derby Win (cont from p1)**

**Hurricane Run (Ire)** was reserved off the pace in last for most of the way in yesterday's G1 Irish Derby, as **Brahminy Kite** (Silver Hawk) assumed the lead, closely followed by **Scorpion (Ire)**. The latter seized the initiative with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining and kicked for home as the industrious Kieren Fallon made serious inroads into the new leader's advantage on the outside. Hurricane Run joined issue at the eighth pole and looked to be holding the call, but he drifted inward to allow Scorpion a second bite of the cherry. However, Fallon was not to be denied, correcting his mount and forcing him to the wire to earn his first Irish Derby win. Trainer Andre Fabre was winning his second Irish Derby after the triumph of Winged Love (Ire) in 1995. Fallon told *PA Sport*, "When I got hold of him, he did everything I wanted. I thought I was on the best horse and I wanted the clearest route, even if it wasn't necessarily the best route. Maybe I could have rode a better race. I feel like I covered the whole of The Curragh, but I wanted to be sure of winning and not risk getting trapped on the inside. For years I have dreamed about winning this race, ever since I was an apprentice with Kevin Prendergast, it means everything." Of the runner-up, Colm O'Donoghue added, "He went 100 percent for me. He is improving all the time and he will be a serious horse in the autumn."

**Leger Bound?**

Trainers and jockeys of the vanquished seemed to be of the same mind, citing the G1 St Leger at Doncaster Sept. 10 as a target. John Oxx, trainer of third place-getter **Shalapour (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), was first out of the blocks, telling *PA Sport*, "He is an improving colt and we will look at the St Leger for him." Brahminy Kite's trainer Mark Johnston added, "I am delighted with him and you can see by the look of him that he has still got plenty of growing to do. I said I would be pleased with second, but actually I am thrilled to be fourth considering his lack of experience. The St Leger is still very much the plan."

**Alkaased Wins at Saint-Cloud (cont. from p1)**

Settled under cover in a mid-pack seventh, Alkaased was at ease with conditions as **Imago Mundi** (Spinning World) towed the field to the quarter-mile marker. The eventual winner made effortless progress into contention at the top of the stretch and was nudged to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. The result was never in doubt from there, as he lengthened in impressive fashion to comfortably hold Policy Maker at bay. Of future plan's for Alkaased, Cumani said, "I would like to have him in good shape for the [G1 Prix de l'] Arc de Triomphe [Longchamp Oct. 2], so he'll probably pass on the [G1] King George [VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. Newbury July 23] and come back in the [G2] Prix Foy [Longchamp Sept. 11] as a prep for the Arc." **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan) was far from disgraced, running on well from rear to snatch third from **Elvstroem (Aus)** (Danehill) nearing the line. Elvstroem, the Australian globetrotter, employed different tactics in this and, having looked a danger at the quarter pole, kept on well to earn more prizemoney for his round-the-world kitty. Elie Lellouche was not downcast in defeat and praised the runner-up, saying, "[Policy Maker] has run a gallant race. I would love to win a Group 1 race with him, maybe later in the season and possibly abroad." Niarchos Family Racing Manager Alan Cooper was not disappointed either, adding, "[Bago] hasn't run a bad race. He finished well, but I would have liked if he was positioned a little closer during the race. At this stage [the defeat] doesn't change our plans for Newbury and the King George."

Taking on a deep field that included 14 graded winners, Sweep Tosho became the first filly to capture the Takarazuka Kinen in 39 years. The four-year-old was coming off a successful sophomore campaign that saw her finish second in the Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) and win the G1 Shuko Sho against her own sex last October. In her most recent, she outran her 17-1 odds--as well as third-place finisher Silent Witness (Aus)--when a neck runner-up facing males in the June 5 G1 Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo. Let go as a 38-1 bomb here despite that valiant effort, the daughter of End Sweep was rated well off the pace before launching her bid turning for home. Setting her sights on last year's winner Tap Dance City (Pleasant Tap), who had forged to the lead, she overtook that foe and the running-on Lincoln (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) and outfinished Heart's Cry for the historical tally. Tap Dance City tired to finish seventh, while last year's Horse of the Year Zenno Rob Roy came on to be third. The latter is scheduled to be transported to the U.K. to participate in the G1 International S. in August.

Aidan O'Brien boasts an incredible record in this contest, having trained five of the last six winners. George Washington proved he had the teeth for a battle, providing the Co. Tipperary maestro with yet another winner, following Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire), King Of Kings (Ire), Hold That Tiger, Bernstein and Antonius Pius. "He's entered in all the good races, but we have yet to decide where to go next," O'Brien told *irish-racing.com*. The budding talent was raw material when finishing an eye-catching third on debut at Newmarket May 1 and shook off the maiden tag when easing through the rain over course and distance last time May 22. The lack of pace was evident early, as the winner raced keenly before settling behind the leaders in third on the run to halfway. Royal Highness hinted at better things when breaking her maiden at Longchamp May 9 and she didn't betray that impression when finishing an excellent third to the G1 Irish Oaks-bound Shawanda (Ire) in the G3 Prix de Royaumont at Chantilly June 4. Exhibiting further improvement here, she battled her way to a game success to deny odds-on punters' choice Fraloga in an exciting climax. "She's a very progressive filly who has done really well in a short space of time," commented trainer Pascal Bary. "We will now give her a well-deserved break, as she has had all her races in such a short period, and she'll come back for the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 11]." Breaking smartly to claim the rail slot, the sophomore filly was restrained in fourth until moving into third at the top of the straight. Nudged along at the quarter-mile marker, the winner looked held at the eighth pole, but found an extra gear from there to drive between Grand Opening and Fraloga inside the last 50 meters to deny the latter in the final stride. Simonas was awarded this race after an incident-packed closing quarter saw Germany's 2004 Horse of the Year Soldier Hollow pass the post in front, before being disqualified for hampering his nearest rival in the drive to the line. However, the stewards' deliberations were not over, as Bailamos was also promoted upon the disqualification of Expensive Dream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) from third to fourth, as the latter also took the scenic route late. Simonas, winner of last season's G2 Premio Carlo d'Alessio in Rome, finished fourth in both the G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne and the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden. Second to Sulamani (Ire) in the G1 Canadian International at Woodbine in October, he trailed home in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. Coming off a second-place finish in the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne May 1, the grey settled near the back as Sweet Wake (Ger) (Waky Nao {GB}) set a sedate gallop. Guided along the inside to take the lead into the straight, the gelding relinquished the advantage as Soldier Hollow's powerful wide run took him to the front with 150 yards to go. But Eduardo Pedroza did not raise the white flag and his mount's rallying call was instrumental in Soldier Hollow hanging in under pressure, leading to his disqualification. Willow O Wisp lulled the competition to sleep, setting soft early fractions in the early going of the Cinema and holding enough in reserve to gain his first win at the graded-stakes level. A winner in one of seven starts last year for trainer Michael Lightner, the gelding has proved much more productive this term. Moved to the barn of Vladimir Cerin, he posted a neck victory in a mile allowance over this track Apr. 23, and found Osidy only a head too tough in his latest, running second in the GIII Will Rogers H. at a mile May 28. Looking to stretch his speed an extra eighth this time, the dark bay dawdled through a half in :48.96 and six panels in 1:12.97. The three-year-old shaded :24 for his next quarter to open a daylight lead at midstretch and dashed through a final furlong in :11.72 to win handily over his Will Rogers conqueror. Soaring Free earned Sovereign Awards as the champion turf horse and the Horse of the Year in Canada after winning six of his eight starts last year. The dark bay gelding won three straight sprint stakes on the Woodbine turf, including the 2004 edition of this test, then stretched out to a mile and made it four in a row in the Sept. 19 GI Atto Mile. Sent to Texas for the Oct. 30 GI Breeders' Cup Mile, he cut out the pace over the yielding course, but weakened to be fourth. The Sam-Son colorbearer enjoyed his customary winter vacation and came back on top of his game, fighting his way to a neck decision in the Apr. 16 GIII Shakertown S. at Keeneland. Odds-on to go two-for-two on the season, Soaring Free broke on top, but allowed 43-1 Draw Fire (Elusive Quality) to set the pace through a half in :44.50. The champ drove past the pacesetter in the stretch and pulled away to a handy victory. "He's just a tremendous horse that runs hard every time he comes out," jockey Todd Kabel said. "He's maturing...he's not as speed crazy as he used to be. He's letting us settle him in a lot more. That's going to be a big change in this horse's career, I think, if we can get him to relax." Dan Borislow and a slew of partners took a chance and purchased a majority interest in Wild Desert this spring for an undisclosed price and that move was rewarded yesterday as the colt took the first leg of the Canadian Triple Crown. Wild Desert began his career with trainer Ken McPeck and enjoyed a solid eight-race juvenile campaign that included a third in the Nov. 27 GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill. Purchased by Borislow in February, he ran fifth in his 2005 bow, the Mar. 5 GII Fountain of Youth S. That was followed by a fast-closing second in the GII Lane's End S. at Turfway Mar. 26, but the colt took a step backward when eighth in the Apr. 16 GII Arkansas Derby--his final start for McPeck. Returning under Frankel's care here, Wild Desert lingered near the back of the back as the filly Gold Strike cut out the running. Wild Desert closed on the turn, caught the pacesetter in mid-stretch and, despite being squeezed between that foe and King of Jazz a furlong out, got to the wire first. "This is a race I've always wanted to win," said Borislow.

**Disappointing Finish for the Favorite...**

The regally bred **Dance With Ravens** (A.P. Indy) was backed as the crowd's 2-1 choice, but never really got going and finish seventh in the nine-horse field. It was the first time the Sam-Son homebred hadn't crossed the line first in a dirt race. He was coming off a controversial effort in the June 5 Plate Trial S., which he won before being disqualified to sixth for interference.

**SHARE IN VINERY AUSTRALIA SOLD** Prominent owner-breeders and Magic Millions Sale company part-owners Gerry Harvey and John Singleton have purchased a major share in Vinery Australia from Dr Tom Simon. "Tom Simon has vast operations in the U.S. and felt the solution to selling a major share in Vinery was to try and attract the likes of Singleton and myself, and we are presently negotiating with another two major businessmen to be included," Harvey told *The Sydney Morning Herald*. "Simon wants to reduce his active breeding involvement in Australia, but he is to continue his racing commitments, and both myself and Singo will be part of the set-up in Vinery's racehorses, which currently total between 40 and 50. It is a tremendous boost to Australian breeding knowing that Vinery will continue to stand some of the most popular stallions in Australia, including boom sire More Than Ready, along with Red Ransom and Mossman." Stud manager Peter Orton remarked, "The aim of the new conglomerate, including Harvey and Singleton, is to strengthen our stallion line-up, and with this funding we will be very competitive in purchasing the top colonial sires-to-be. Also, with Tom Simon's American contacts, we will be in a position to shuttle some of Kentucky's best stallion prospects, putting us up there alongside the Coolmore and Darley operations, which can only strengthen the local breeding scene." Orton added, "The farm will keep going exactly as it was, it's a good structure. Vinery will be home to some 150-200 clients' mares this season in addition to standing sires including More Than Ready. Gerry Harvey and John Singleton have bought into Vinery in a partnership where all percentages will work out equal, and there are still another couple of parties we are negotiating with." Vinery Australia sold 87 mares at the Inglis Easter broodmare sale for gross receipts of A\$19,059,000 and an average of A\$219,069. Prominent retailer Harvey owns 50 percent of Magic Millions and historic Baramul Stud in the Widden Valley, where he has some 300 broodmares. Singleton owns 25 percent of Magic Millions and the boutique property Strawberry Hills, where he has an elite broodmare band.

### WITNESS REPEATS AS HORSE OF THE YEAR

Archie and Betty da Silva's **Silent Witness (Aus)** (El Moxie) easily outdistanced five other candidates to repeat as Horse of the Year in Hong Kong. The five-year-old, conditioned by Tony Cruz, extended his record winning streak to 17 this season before finishing second to fellow Horse of the Year nominee and stable-mate **Bullish Luck** (Royal Academy) in the G1 Champions Mile in May and a bang-up third in the G1 Yasuda Kinen earlier this month. In addition to taking down the top prize, Silent Witness was also named Most Popular Horse of the Year as well as champion sprinter. Bullish Luck, who missed by a short head to Alexander Goldrun (Ire) in the 10-furlong G1 Hong Kong Cup in December, earned honors as champion miler, with a trio of domestic Group 1 successes at 1600 meters. **Vengeance of Rain (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}), whose rise to international recognition culminated with his victory in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in April, was voted the champion middle distance and staying horse. Trained by David Ferraris, the four-year-old also won this year's G1-HK Hong Kong Derby. The champion griffin, or newcomer, was three-year-old **Good Ba Ba** (Lear Fan), now three-for-four and winner of nearly \$250,000. **Capo of Good Hope (GB)** (Inchiner {GB}) could never quite solve Silent Witness, but excelled on the international stage, winning the G1 Australia S. and more recently the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at the Royal meeting at York. He was recognized by the Hong Kong Jockey Club with a Special Achievement Award.
