**EDDINGTON RETIRED**

**Eddington** (Unbridled--Fashion Star, by Chief's Crown), winner of his latest start in the GI Pimlico Special May 20, has been retired from racing due to a soft tissue tear in his right foreleg and will enter stud in 2006 at Claiborne Farm near Paris, Kentucky. The chestnut, who was scheduled to make his next start in Saturday's GI Suburban H. at Belmont Park, came out of a routine five-furlong work at Belmont last Friday with the injury. "He came out of the work-out last Friday with some inflammation--it looks like it's soft tissue," explained trainer Mark Hennig. "We spent the better part of the week evaluating it, and we think that it is in his best interest to retire

him now." Winner of the GIII Calder Derby at three, the \$450,000 Keeneland July sale purchase showed plenty of consistency with a slew of graded stakes placings last year, including the GI Preakness S., GI Travers S. and GI Wood Memorial. In the money in all five starts this term, the four-year-old triumphed by 8 3/4-lengths in a \$75,000 optional claimer at Gulfstream Jan. 16 before finishing behind Saint Liam and Roses in May in the Feb. 5 GI Donn H. A much-the-best winner in the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar 5, he again filled the show spot in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 9. "Obviously, we would have liked to see him run a few more times," said Bernie Sams of Claiborne. "However, we are thrilled he's coming to Claiborne. He is as much like his father as any son of Unbridled I've seen." Eddington retires with six wins, three seconds from 17 starts and earnings of \$1,216,760.

**PEACEFUL LOVE VICTORIOUS AT HAMBURG**

**Peaceful Love (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}) notched her first graded stakes victory when she came from off the pace to take the G3 Fahrhofer Stutenpreis at Hamburg Wednesday. The sophomore graduated in her first start of the year in the Listed Fruhjahren-Stuten-Preis at Cologne Apr. 9, but wasn't able to carry that form over to her next start when sixth in the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) at Dusseldorf May 8. Given a 5-1 chance for her second attempt at the graded stakes ranks, the filly was held up in mid-division off the generous early tempo before challenging wide in the straight. Full of run late, she cut down four-year-old **Nightdance Forest (Ire)** (Charnwood Forest {Ire}) with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before asserting for a comfortable score. **Shapira (Ger)** (Kornado {GB}), another four-year-old, rounded out the show spot.

**DUBAWI AND 'DIVINE' REST AHEAD OF MAROIS**

Godolphin's **Dubawi (Ire)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}), winner of the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, is on course for a clash with the Niarchos Family's **Divine Proportions** (Kingmambo) in the G1 Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 14. Away since finishing third in the G1 Epsom Derby June 4, Dubawi will get some time off ahead of his next start. "He's doing really nicely and we'll look at the Jacques le Marois, which looks like its going to be a cracking contest," said Racing Manager Simon Crisford. Alan Cooper, racing manager for the Niarchos family, also outlined plans for Divine Proportions, who added the G1 Prix de Diane to her success in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches. "She has come out of the race very well and is in good form," said Cooper. "She will have a little break before being prepared for August. Although Divine Proportions won over 10 furlongs the other day, we are going back to a mile and we will see after that what her program will be for the latter half of the year. Hopefully, the sky will be the limit for her, but our plans will become clearer after the middle of August."

He then trounced Eurosilver by seven lengths in Keeneland's Perryville S. Oct. 14, and added an optional claiming victory at Churchill Nov. 25. But he lost his perfect record in the GIII Hal's Hope H., finishing seventh in that Jan. 8 test at Gulfstream, and was sidelined thereafter with a fractured shin. With Roman Ruler scratched from this contest, the prohibitive chalk went straight to the front, rolled along through fractions of :44.77 and 1:08.16 and opened up under a mild hand ride by Channing Hill, coming within a tick of the track record..
