**SHOWDOWN AT SANDOWN**

The Royal Ascot Racing Club's unbeaten G1 Epsom Derby winner **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will face a stellar line-up of seven rivals in tomorrow's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown, which looks set to attract a record crowd. A dominating winner of the June 4 Classic, the Michael Bell-trained sophomore will take on Godolphin's dual Classic and G1 St. James's Palace S. hero **Shamardal** (Giant's Causeway) and a host of older rivals headed by the Australian Syndicate's **Starcraft (NZ)** (Soviet Star) in the 10-furlong contest. His trainer feels he is ready for the next step. "We've got to be confident--the horse is

unbeaten and he's still not seen a horse in the last quarter-mile of his races," Bell commented. "It's no forgone conclusion, but he's odds-on favorite, and let's hope he can justify the bookmakers' opinion of him." Frankie Dettori may hold the key to the contest on the bold Shamardal, and Godolphin's scratching of Grand Emporium (SAf) hints that the colt will be making the running again. However, his rider was non-committal earlier this week. "Shamardal has never been able to get a lead and he doesn't have to make the running," he explained. "It depends how the race is run. He is very versatile and you can do what you want with him and it seems that the more racing he has, the more relaxed and professional he is. I take nothing away from Motivator--he is a great horse and is unbeaten. I really do worry about him, but he has to be at his best to give my horse a race." Starcraft, who flies the flag for Australia, looked to have a bright European campaign ahead when a fast-finishing third in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot at York last time June 14. Owner Paul Makin was impressed. "He gave them a big start at the top of the straight and he made up ground on the leaders, so I suppose it has to be a good run," he said. Eclipse field p??

**INTERNATIONALS FLAVOR AMERICAN OAKS**

Six sophomore fillies, representing four different countries, meet seven U.S.-based horses in Sunday's G1 American Oaks at Hollywood Park. But despite some classy overseas representatives, they could all be running for second money if TNT Stud's **Melhor Ainda** (Pulpit) brings her 'A' game. The attractive bay has been unstoppable in her four career trips to the post, three of those in black-type events, including the GIII Sands Point S. at Belmont Park June 5. The lone question, one which most of this field must answer, is the 10-furlong distance, but

Melhor Ainda hails from a staying Argentinian family which has produced numerous champions. Leading the foreign charge is **Cesario (Jpn)** (Special Week {Jpn}). Four-for-five in her brief career, the dark bay suffered her lone defeat--a head second in the G1 Japanese 1000 Guineas two back--but rebounded with a neck success in the G1 Japanese Oaks May 22. She will look to better the effort of compatriot Dance in the Mood (Jpn), who was second as the favorite last year.

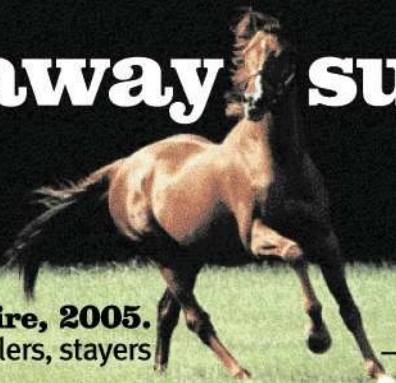

**FOG CITY PARTNERSHIP TO DISSOLVE** Fog City Stable partners David Shimmon and Bill Bianco, the owners of such horses as GI Santa Anita Derby winner **Buzzards Bay** (Marco Bay) and **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus), have decided to dissolve their partnership. All the horses, with the exception of the two aforementioned, will be split between the two partners. Roman Ruler, scratched from a Belmont allowance Wednesday afternoon, will make his second start of the year in Monday's GI Dwyer S., while Buzzards Bay will be sold as the last horse through the ring at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July Sale July 18. "Fog City will continue under my ownership," Shimmon told *Blood-Horse*. "I am effectively buying out Bill." Shimmon indicated that Bianco intends to turn his attention to California-breds and retirement programs. Those yearlings and two-year-olds currently owned by Fog City will continue in their racing careers. Bianco will reportedly join his son and daughter in their Sunset Stables. "This is a business decision between two different guys going in two different directions," said Darby Dan Bloodstock's Davant Latham, an advisor to Fog City. Shimmon and Bianco made a splash at major yearling sales in recent years, acquiring the Seattle Slew colt **Distinction**, which topped the 2000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale at \$4.2 million. The team also experienced some success in selling their bloodstock. **Spring Meadow** (Meadowlake), a graded stakes winner and three-times placed in Grade I company, sold for \$800,000 at the Keeneland January Sale in 2004. She was purchased as a two-year-old in training for \$200,000 and earned nearly a half million dollars at the races.

The dark bay gelding set an easy pace and drew clear when challenged for a confident score.

**Racing Has \$40B Impact on Economy:**

A study released Wednesday by the American Horse Council (AHC) estimates the total economic impact of the horse industry in the U.S. contributes nearly \$40 billion to the economy and supports 1.4 million jobs. When indirect and induced spending are included, the figure rises to approximately \$102 billion. The study estimates the total horse population in the U.S. to be 9.2 million and, of that number, about 1.3 million are Thoroughbreds. "This study paints a portrait of an industry that operates in every corner of the country and contributes mightily to the American economy and culture," commented Jay Hickey, president of the AHC. "Never before has the impact of our industry been so dramatically demonstrated." The study also showed that 45 of the 50 states have a horse population of at least 20,000, with Texas (1 million), California (700,000) and Florida (500,000) the leading horse states.

**Cassidy to Deliver Speech at Hall of Fame Ceremony:**

Entertainer David Cassidy will deliver the keynote speech during the National Museum of Racing's Hall of Fame induction ceremonies. The induction will take place Aug. 8 at 10:30 a.m. at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion in Saratoga. The 2005 inductees include Nick Zito, Sidney Watters Jr., rider Thomas Walsh and five-time champion Lonesome Glory. "It's one of the highlights of my entire adult life and career to be asked to speak at the induction ceremony and articulate my passion for racing. To say I'm flattered would be a gross understatement." Cassidy purchased his first Thoroughbred in 1973 and was involved in the breeding and sales side of the game before expanding into racing.

**FABULOUS FALMOUTH IN PROSPECT** The Elite Racing Club's **Soviet Song (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) headed yesterday's nine declarations for the £200,000 G1 UAE Equestrian & Racing Federation Falmouth S. Tuesday at Newmarket. Last year's heroine, who went on to add the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood and G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown to her tally, returned with a third in the G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot at York June 15. "It's all systems go for Newmarket--that's the plan," the syndicate's Racing Manager Matthew Budden told *PA Sport*. "It was nice to get a run under her belt before going for the Falmouth again. We feel that she has come on for the run. Last year she needed a couple of races before she hit top gear." The five-year-old may resume rivalry with the Duke of Roxburghe's multiple Group 1 winner **Attraction (GB)** (Efisio {GB}), who has been off the track since finishing down the field in the G1 Champions Mile at Sha Tin May 14. She was runner-up to Soviet Song in this race 12 months ago and in the Matron S. and connections are hoping that a minor setback will not keep her from attempting to reverse that form. "She will work at the weekend and we are keeping our fingers crossed that we get her there," trainer Mark Johnston's wife Deirdre told the *Racing Post*. Conditioner Jim Bolger has described Noel and Miriam O'Callaghan's globetrotting four-year-old **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}) as a likely contender after her success in Saturday's G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh. "We will only decide at the last minute, but at the moment she is more likely to go than not," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. "Obviously, we are keeping out options open because she has just run at the weekend and while she seems in good form and at the top of her game, there is no pressure to make an irrevocable decision. But I would say she was very likely to travel." Other notables include Cheveley Park Stud's **Peeress (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) and Godolphin's **Sundrop (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), first and second, respectively, in the Windsor Forest S.; and the G1 Coronation S. runner-up **Karen's Capar (War Chant)**. "There could be no better vindication for the races that were created or upgraded for fillies and mares last year by the European Pattern Committee than the field confirmed for next Tuesday," Newmarket's Clerk of the Course Michael Prosser said yesterday. "Soviet Song and Attraction were first and second in this race last year, but Alexander Goldrun was mightily impressive at The Curragh last weekend and must rate a huge danger, while the three three-year-olds together with Sir Michael Stoute's pair and the Godolphin filly all have the potential to take a hand at the business end."
