### SHAMARDAL RETIRED

On the eve of his much-anticipated showdown with Motivator (GB) in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown, **Shamardal** (Giant's Causeway--Helsinki {GB}, by Machiavellian) was retired yesterday after it was announced that he had sustained an ankle injury. Godolphin revealed that the sophomore had chipped a bone in his right-fore fetlock Thursday. "Everyone is very sad, especially Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid al Maktoum, as he was very fond of this colt and he was very much looking forward to the Eclipse on Saturday," Racing Manager Simon Crisford remarked.

"He worked on Wednesday morning and had a very easy blow out, after which we expressed great satisfaction at the way he moved. He was clinically absolutely fine afterwards and it was only at evening stables on Thursday night when he came out for a pick of grass that he took just one lame step. At that time it looked as though he had a possible foot condition, but X-rays revealed a fresh chip which would require surgery if he was to continue to race, so Sheikh Maktoum has taken the view that he should really retire to stud. He's had a very illustrious career and this is the right thing to do." Trainer Saeed bin Suroor also paid tribute. "It is very disappointing that this injury has occurred," he said. "We were looking forward so much to running in the Eclipse. He would have had a great chance in the race as he was in tremendous form. He is one of the best horses Godolphin has had." Bred in Kentucky by Brilliant Stable, the bay was produced by Helsinki, a daughter of G1 Irish Oaks heroine Helen Street (GB), making her a full sister to Godolphin's G1 Dubai World Cup hero Street Cry (Ire). Shamardal was led out unsold as a weanling for \$485,000, but was purchased the following year for 50,000gns at Tattersalls Houghton by trainer Mark Johnston. He began his career last year in the orange colors of Abdulla Buhaleeba, comfortably collecting an Ayr maiden by eight lengths July 12 before defeating Wilko, the subsequent winner of the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, in the G2 Vintage S. at Goodwood 16 days later. **Shamardal Retired, cont. p2**

### READY TO BUST OUT

Bobby Frankel and Frank Stronach were forced to retire reigning Horse of the Year Ghostzapper due to an injury last month, but can set off some early fireworks at Belmont today with the undefeated **Record Buster** (Alphabet Soup) in the G1 Suburban H. The chestnut didn't make his career debut until his four-year-old season, but was worth the wait, taking a maiden special weight on the Wood Memorial undercard. He returned to add a pair of Belmont allowance tallies, including a sharp 5 3/4-length tally at 1 1/16 miles June 15. The modest \$7,000 yearling purchase should find himself on the lead from his rail post. **Pollard's Vision** (Carson City) has been a real model of consistency throughout his career and posted a career best victory taking the GIII National Jockey Club H. over Badge of Silver and Limehouse at Hawthorne Apr. 23. The Todd Pletcher trainee was second in the G1 Pimlico Special H. to the recently retired Eddington last time. **Cont., p3**

### THE GENERATION GAME

Following the career-ending injury to Shamardal, today's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown has lost a major contributor, but the Royal Ascot Racing Club's **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) still faces the daunting prospect of taking on his elders and a change of direction for the first time. "One concern is that he's never been right-handed before, which is an element of doubt, but he should be able to cope with it," trainer Michael Bell said. The course may not pose a problem, but the older brigade could topple Motivator from his perch. **Starcraft (NZ)** (Soviet Star) is a Group 1 winner from seven furlongs to a mile and a half in Australia, but the intermediate trip of the Eclipse may prove to be his optimum. "You can always tell a good horse when you sit on one and he definitely gives me that feel," said jockey Philip Robinson. "He has got an engine there and he's a big, powerful, strong horse." Andre Fabre saddles His Highness the Aga Khan's **Diamond Green (Fr)** (Green Desert), who just missed in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, G1 Prix du Moulin and G1 St James's Palace S. last year. Changing Hands...**

Changing ownership after his win in the Vintage, Shamardal established himself at the top of the European Juvenile Rankings when taking the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in October. His championship 2004 season saw the value of his relations skyrocket: Helsinki sold for \$3.9 million, in foal to Cherokee Run (she has since produced a colt ), at Keeneland November, while his weanling half sister by Unbridled's Song went to John Sikura for \$1.15 million at the same sale.

**The Grass Is Greener...**

After flopping on the dirt in the G2 UAE Derby on his return in March, Shamardal resumed his winning ways on grass, taking the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) May 15 and, with subsequent Irish Derby winner Hurricane Run (Ire) in second, the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) June 5. His last start was an easy victory in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot at York, just nine days after his second Classic success. Jockey Frankie Dettori, who partnered him to both his French successes, said, "He was a great horse to be around--very uncomplicated--and a real champion. We have already seen how good he was but it is a shame that he could not fulfill his full potential in the great career he was going to have." A winner in five of his six career starts, Shamardal accumulated £1,099,290. Stud plans for the three-year-old have not yet been announced.

**Coral-Eclipse Preview, cont.  
It's His Race to Lose...**

It won't be a walkover, but after his resounding five-length triumph in the G1 Epsom Derby June 4, **Motivator** is the odds-on choice to win the Coral-Eclipse. "Motivator is giving out all the right signs at home," said Michael Bell, who will be keeping an eye on the energetic colt during the preliminaries. "The lead-out on the track is a bit daunting, so don't expect to see the horse walking out down the walkway with his head between his front legs fast asleep--he's just not that type," he explained, but added, "I thought he handled the parade at Epsom really well and there didn't look to be any chinks in his armor in that department." There will be long faces among the 230-strong syndicate if he loses his unbeaten tag, but Managing Director Harry Herbert is in no doubt that the colt has what it takes to join Nashwan and Mill Reef in completing the Epsom Derby-Eclipse double. "If he wins, then he will join some of the greats," Herbert said.

Last time out, **Better Talk Now** was caught behind a slow pace, then hit traffic on the far turn and ended up fourth in the May 21 GII Dixie H. at Pimlico. Trainer Graham Motion can't control the traffic flow, but he does have a plan to ensure quick fractions in the U.N. Motion has entered both **Better Talk Now** and his speedier stablemate **Shake the Bank**. "Better Talk Now needs an honest pace," Motion explained. "Looking at his past performances you might think he is inconsistent, but unless he gets a good pace to run at, it's hard for him to run his best race." The gelding closed to win last year's GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga over 2004 U.N. winner **Request for Parole**, and shocked the crowd at Lone Star Park when he rallied to win the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at 27-1. He opened this season with a victory in the GIII Fort Marcy H. at Aqueduct in April, but, in three starts sandwiched between those efforts, **Better Talk Now** suffered through halves in :50 or slower, and failed to hit the board every time. Enter Shake the Bank. "We bought him for the specific purpose of providing an honest pace for Better Talk Now," the conditioner said. "It could be just a one-race deal--we'll see how it goes and decide whether to do it again. But [Better Talk Now] is only going to run four more times this year, and we can't afford to waste a race with him." Second in the Sword Dancer, Request for Parole was off the board in his last three starts of 2005, including a sixth in the BC Turf. He returned in a Belmont allowance test June 10 and finished fourth. "He got really sick after the Breeders' Cup and it's taken us a long time to get him back," explained trainer Stan Hough. "Hopefully, that one race will be enough to get him ready."

The regally bred **Lord of the Game** began his career with five straight wins, rising from \$10,000 maiden claimers to add four allowance/optional claiming victories. He stepped up in class for the GIII National Jockey Club H. Apr. 23 at Hawthorne and gave a good account of himself, finishing third to Pollard's Vision and Badge of Silver. The Illinois-based dark bay rebounded to take the GIII Hanshin H. at Arlington May 26 and looms as the class of this field. **Cryptograph** ran second in the GIII Lone Star Derby and third in the GIII Oklahoma Derby in his final two outings as a three-year-old. Off for six months, the bay was an outstanding second in his return, missing by a nose in the blanket finish of the GIII Lone Star Park H. on Memorial Day.

**Playful Act**, pitched straight in against her elders, makes her eagerly awaited return in this contest. After besting Queen Of Poland (GB) and Maids Causeway (Ire) in the G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster in early September, she confirmed that form when recording a length success over Maids Causeway in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot later that month. She failed to blossom in time for a Classic campaign this spring, but joins the G2 Ribblesdale S. runner-up **Twyla Tharp** and **Shastye** in a three-pronged challenge from the John Gosden barn, which has been successful here twice since 1997.

**Punctilious** developed into a high-class middle-distance performer last summer when third in the G1 Epsom Oaks in June and runner-up in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh in July. After flopping in testing ground when fourth in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks in August, she signed off with a half-length second to **Commercante** (Fr) in the GI E. P. Taylor S. at Woodbine in October. She failed to land a blow on her return, however, finishing last of five in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 31. "I'm looking forward to riding her and it should be a good match-up with **Playful Act**," jockey Kerrin McEvoy said. "She's in good shape and is progressing all the way through."
