TOO HOT TO HANDLE

He once raced in claiming company, but **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew) handled the step up to Grade I company in impressive fashion, galloping away to an 8 3/4-length victory in the Hollywood Gold Cup yesterday afternoon. Stretching out to a mile and a quarter for the first time, the dark bay gelding pressed **Congrats** (A.P. Indy) through solid splits, swept past that rival at the quarter pole and opened up down the lane to give resurgent jockey Patrick Valenzuela his first win in the 66-year old event. For winning trainer Doug O'Neill, it was his second Gold Cup victory in the last four years. He saddled Sky Jack to victory in the 2002 running of the \$750,000 event.

SUMMIT OF SPEED POSTPONED

Hurricane Dennis did not make a direct hit on the state of Florida yesterday, but related heavy storms in Miami-Dade County forced the postponement of the Summit of Speed program to this afternoon. Although Calder Race Course did not sustain any physical damage during the storms, there were widespread telephone and power outages. Officials at Calder made the decision to postpone early yesterday morning, though power was restored during the 9 a.m. hour. The track remained open for full-card simulcasting. "It is too good a card to try to run it under these conditions," commented Calder President Ken Dunn. The program features four graded-stakes events, highlighted by the appearance of **Madcap Escapade** (Hennessy) in the GII Princess Rooney H. and undefeated **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier) in the GII Carry Back S.

ONE-TWO PUNCH IN PRIORESS

Score one for the blue-collar horses. Dismissed at odds of 13-1 in a field chock full of three-year-old fillies bred in the purple, New York-bred **Acey Deucey** (Abaginone) landed the decisive one-two punch to nail **Maddalena** (Good and Tough) in yesterday's GI Prioress S. at Belmont Park. It was the first victory at the top level for trainer John Morrison and jockey Diane Nelson. "This means a lot to me," said Nelson, a 19-year veteran of the saddle. "I'm sure a lot of people feel that my career is over. But I haven't gotten a lot of good horses to ride. I would love to ride, but I don't want to run last every day. I know I can still ride at any level-- I just need the horse." Acey Deucey is under consideration for a Grade I repeat in the Test S. at Saratoga Aug. 6. [Video, sponsored by Taylor Made.](#)

Up the Ladder...

Lava Man was haltered for \$50,000 after running second at Del Mar last August, and the claim paid instant dividends. The Cal-bred came back to take the Pomona Derby Trial by 6 1/4 lengths, then picked up checks in four more stakes events. Proving he could compete at the top level, he was beaten only a half length by Rock Hard Ten in the GI Malibu S. in December, but went off form at the beginning of this campaign, finishing off the board in three straight. The gelding rebounded to take an optional claimer at Hollywood May 14, made it two in a row as an 8-1 shot in the June 18 GII Californian S. and scored again at 6-1 yesterday.

Sour Lime...

Limehouse (Grand Slam), sent off the 13-10 chalk off his win in the June 11 GII Brooklyn H., bobbled at the start, then was settled in the middle of the pack. Jockey John Velazquez angled the colt wide for the stretch drive, but there was no response and the two came under the wire a well-beaten fifth.

Also the sire of GI Ashland S. winner Sis City, the son of Seattle Slew also counts Isaac Murphy H. winner Jaguar City and My Sweet Sug among his black-type winners this season. The sire of over 70 stakes horses to date, Slew City Slew stood the 2005 breeding season at a fee of \$5,000.

Acey Deucey won two of her first four career starts, each in state-bred company, before upsetting Aqueeduct's Dearly Precious S. Feb. 21 at nearly 25-1 odds. A good second after a wide journey in the GIII Cicada S. going seven-eighths at the Big A Mar. 19, the bay charged late to win the one-mile GII Comely S. Apr. 16, but was most recently fourth as the favorite in the GII Nassau County Breeders' Cup S. May 7. Patiently handled as Maddalena and Slew Motion (Slew Gin Fizz) alternated on the front end, Acey Deucey angled out for room at the eighth pole and finished with good energy for the victory. "I was hoping the pace would be a little quicker, but she got the job done," commented winning trainer John Morrison. "She's a very special filly and will always have a special place in my heart." Favored Talented (Fusaichi Pegasus) travelled three wide most of the way and had every chance turning for home, but could not sustain her bid. Second, beaten a neck in his career debut racing six furlongs at Santa Anita Jan. 29, Surf Cat suffered another narrow defeat, going down by a nose in a 6 1/2-furlong event at that oval Mar. 5. The dark bay graduated by 3 1/2-lengths in Arcadia, with Indian Ocean third, Apr. 9, but really turned heads in his first allowance test, clocking 1:14 2/5 for the 6 1/2-furlong distance, an effort which earned him a 114 Beyer, the co-second highest figure for a three-year-old in 2005. Stretched to two turns for his latest, the June 18 Gill Affirmed H., the Bruce Headley runner locked up with Indian Ocean in a tooth-and-nail stretch battle, failing in the end by just a neck. Sent up to stalk the pace of Dover Dere, Surf Cat eased to the front on the turn, edged away into the stretch and leveled off nicely to win handily.

They'll have to name a race after her one day. Flaunting her love affair with Monmouth Park, Capeside Lady sprinted out of the gate, led every step and cruised home an easy winner yesterday afternoon. The bay has now won four stakes in just six Monmouth starts. She completed the mile and a sixteenth on the muddy track in 1:41.49, just a fifth of a second off the stakes record set by Ambassador of Luck in 1983 and tied by Horse of the Year Lady's Secret in 1986. Capeside Lady opened her Monmouth account with an inauspicious last-place finish in the 2003 Sorority S., her only loss that year, but came back to take the Little Silver S. and the GII Monmouth Breeders' Cup Oaks last season, catching wet tracks both times. The filly was also second in the GIII Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks, but finished off the board in her next three outings, including two lackluster efforts on the turf. Switched back to the dirt for the June 18 Monmouth Beach S., she was back in the winner's circle and earned herself a chance in the Molly Pitcher. Why is she such a star at the Jersey Shore? "For one thing, she is a superior mud horse," said jockey Chris DeCarlo, who has guided the daughter of Cape Town to every one of her Monmouth wins. "I also think that the tight turns help her. She runs the turns very well here. She can't open up on the turn at other tracks, but here she can put some daylight between her and the rest of the horses, and there is a short stretch. It makes it tough to catch her." The crowd's choice to make add to her Monmouth mystique, she was alone in front through honest fractions and sailed solo down the lane to win handily. "I knew when we turned for home that she was running as fast as a horse can run," DeCarlo said. "They would have had to be flying to get to her." Capeside Lady became the first horse since Honky Star in 1974 and 1975 to win both the Monmouth Oaks and the Molly Pitcher.

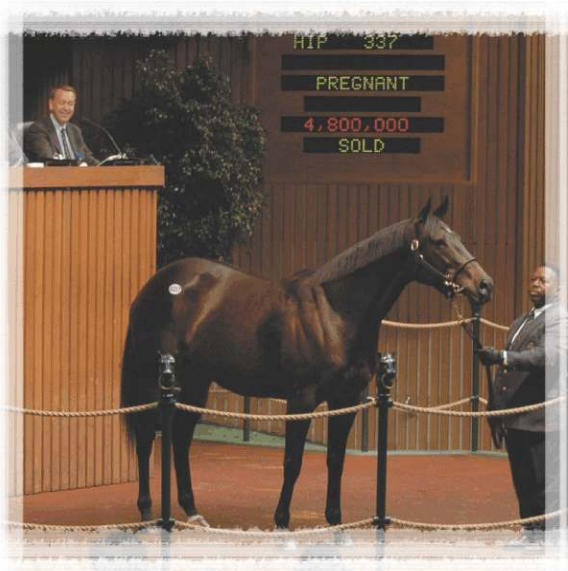

Back to her favorite distance for this, Alphabet Kisses broke a bit inward, but recovered quickly to lead the field while racing off the rail. Stevens let out a notch as they rounded the turn and his filly responded, opening up under minimal encouragement. 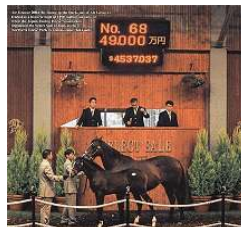

TIME CHARTER DEAD

Robert Barnett's outstanding **Time Charter (GB)** (Saritamere--Centrocon {GB}, by High Line {GB}) died at Fair Winter Farm Thursday night, the *Racing Post* revealed yesterday. In retirement at the Buckinghamshire stud since 2001, the 26-year-old mare was widely accepted as one of the best of her sex during the early '80s, capturing the G1 Epsom Oaks and G1 Champion S. in 1982, the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. the following year and the G1 Coronation Cup as a five-year-old. She was also runner-up in the G1 1000 Guineas and to Sadler's Wells in the 1984 G1 Eclipse S. Her trainer Henry Candy paid tribute on Friday. "Time Charter was always the most tremendous character," he told the *Post*. "She adored dropping everybody in her youth, very exuberant, and she was immensely tough." The dam of G2 Jockey Club S. winners Time Allowed (GB) and Zinaad (GB), himself sire of Godolphin's 2002 G1 1000 Guineas and G1 Epsom Oaks heroine Kazzia (Ger), she also produced Not Before Time (Ire), the dam of Classic-placed Time Away (Ire) and Time Ahead (GB). She is also the dam of By Charter (GB), who has produced the G2 Lonsdale Cup winner First Charter (GB) and the 2003 G1 Derby Italiano runner-up Private Charter (GB); and Time Saved (GB), the dam of last month's G2 King Edward VII S. winner Plea Bargain (GB).
