SMOOTHER THAN MEL TORME

Hurricanes were the talk of the track on Saturday, but on Sunday at Calder, it was all about The Fog. **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier) came to Calder looking for his eighth win without a defeat and it turned out the only thing that could slow him down was the weather, as the Summit of Speed was delayed one day due to Hurricane Dennis. Once on the track, Lost in the Fog treated fans to a supremely easy 7 1/4-length victory in the GII Carry Back S. On top from the start, he was never threatened, while setting fractions of :22.42, :45.46 and :57.11. He carried a five-length lead into the stretch and extended his advantage to the wire to stop the clock in a stakes-record 1:09.30. "That was just the way we planned it," said winning rider Russell Baze. "For the first time, today when that horse moved up on the backside to where he could see him, he was actually watching him and he leaned into the bit and wanted to go. Usually he lets them come right up to him and doesn't care. AN EASY ESCAPE

Madcap Escapade (Hennessy) toyed with the field in yesterday's GII Princess Rooney H., leading from start to finish for an easy 5 1/4-length victory. The precocious filly was sidelined by a hip injury after finishing third in last year's GI Kentucky Oaks. She came back running as a four-year-old, taking the GII Shirley Jones H. in February before a 4 3/4-length victory in the Apr. 13 GIII Madison S. at Keeneland. But she was upset in her most recent trip to the post, tiring to fifth after setting the pace in the May 7 GI Humana Distaff H. "That last race just wasn't her day," owner Bruce Lunsford said after watching Madcap Escapade romp in the Princess Rooney. As for what is next for his star filly, Lunsford said, "I love Saratoga and the [Aug. 5 GII] Honorable Miss [H.] might be her next start. The more she shows, the more options we'll consider. I love racing and want to give her every chance to be all she can be." *Chart p2*

Deputy G (Matty G) justified his 8-5 favoritism with a determined half-length victory in yesterday's GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill Downs. The dark bay juvenile had made just one previous start, winning his five-furlong debut over a sloppy Churchill strip May 14 by a facile 4 1/4 lengths. Deputy G stumbled at the break yesterday, but recovered to press the pace through fractions of :21.69, :45.97 and :58.40. He put away **Federer** (Grand Slam) and **Preside** (Pulpit) in upper stretch and then outlasted the late-closing **R Loyal Man** (More Than Ready) for a game win. *Chart p4*

Lost in the Fog's win in yesterday's GII Carry Back S. at Calder improved his record to a perfect eight-for-eight. The dark bay colt, whose victories this term include the GII Swale S. and the GIII Bay Shore S., was coming off an impressive 1 1/4-length triumph in the June 11 GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup H.

No Worries for Gilchrist...

"I was glad to see orange [of owner Harry Aleo's colors] fall out of there in front," admitted winning trainer Greg Gilchrist. "After they let him get away with a first quarter in :22 2/5, I felt pretty good." Gilchrist said Lost in the Fog will start next in the Aug. 27 GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga, with a possible tilt at the Breeders' Cup Sprint after that. "He's not Breeders' Cup eligible, but I don't think that will be a problem if that's what we decide to do."

With jockey Jerry Bailey in the irons, Madcap Escapade went right to the early lead. She was loose on the front end through fractions of :21.69, :44.64 and :56.88 and drew clear to the wire. "She broke better than her last two races and she settled better and she punched," Bailey said after the victory. "She's easy to ride and she's breaking well now--she didn't used to break at all or was flat-footed. Now she's breaking well and not trying to run off. She's rating well--a certain degree is all you want. You don't want to turn her off and make her come from last. She finished up today." Woke Up Dreamin, on the board in five of six 2005 outings, was third in the May 14 GIII Los Angeles Times H. at Hollywood Park before a front-running two-length tally in the June 11 GII True North Breeders' Cup H. last time out. Never far back, the bay angled out three wide for the drive and drew clear for an easy victory. "He's not like some of those horses that are really, really quick in the first quarter, but I was fortunate to almost out-break the gate--it's the best he's ever broke," said winning rider Mike Smith. "I always use him out of there for the first 50 or 100 yards and then let him do his thing and stay out of his way. They started to out-foot him down the backside, but it was a little too early to start putting him into a drive at the four and a half. I took a quick peek back and saw that I could get to the outside with no trouble, so I went for it. It worked out. He moved real easy on the leaders and I just stayed busy on him." Ostankino emerged from two scores at Clairefontaine and Craon to finish fourth behind Simplex (Fr) on his first try in stakes company in the Listed Prix Turenne at Chantilly in September. He was denied a short-head by the smart Fracassant (Fr) in the Listed Prix Vulcain at Deauville the following month before opening his account in the Listed Prix Max Sicard at Toulouse in December. He reportedly needed his first outing when runner-up in the Listed Grand Prix de Lyon at Lyon-Parilly last time June 25 and was sent straight to the front in the early stages here. Challenged by Short Pause in the final furlong, he was always holding that rival to record a career best. "He is lightly raced and improving, but he's starting to peak now," commented trainer Elie Lellouche. "The question now is whether to stretch him over further for the G2 Prix Kergorlay [at Deauville Aug. 21], or drop back and wait for the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville [Aug. 28]." Eagle Rise looked booked for Classic success after winning the G3 Preis des Winterfavoriten here as a juvenile, but his sophomore campaign proved a disappointment and it was not until last summer that he began to fulfil his potential. He reserves his best for this track, finishing runner-up in the G3 Globetrotter-Meile in August and winning the G2 Grosse Europa-Meile in September at this distance. After signing off with a defeat of Martillo (Ger) in the G2 Premio Ribot at the Capannelle in November, he had taken three starts this term to warm up, showing promise when third in the G3 Jaxx Pokal at Hamburg last time June 25. Settled just behind the leaders off this moderate early gallop, he relished the sprint at the top of the straight and quickened to lead with 1 ½ furlongs remaining. Woodlander has emerged as a pretty good grass horse since first trying the surface in March. Moved to the green after running fourth in a main-track maiden at Gulfstream Mar. 5, he finished runner-up in a one-mile event in Hallandale 15 days later. The Darley colorbearer earned his diploma over Belmont's sod May 22 and made it two straight taking on first-level allowance foes June 18. Ready to run in his stakes debut, Woodlander took over from Reel Legend after the opening quarter and wheeled off the far turn with a daylight advantage. The resurgent Reel Legend kept him honest late, but Woodlander dug in to give Edgar Prado his second of the day. "He's improving with every start," said winning conditioner Tom Albertrani. "The key is that he has been relaxing every race. He has learned to control his speed." Albertrani said the Aug. 8 GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. at Saratoga was a probable target. Leave Me Alone, second behind No Bull Baby in the Apr. 2 Santa Paula S., beat up on state-bred foes with a four-length victory in the Apr. 24 Melair S. when trying a route for the first time. She returned to run fourth after stalking the pace in the June 12 GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks. Turning back to six furlongs here, the chestnut filly was on or near the lead from the start, but lost her advantage when Hide and Chic snuck through along the rail on the turn. She clawed her way back and outbattled that foe to the wire for a narrow victory. "I was cruising down the racetrack, but then got shuffled out off the rail and that was the beginning of the fight," explained winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "They turned on the pressure at the half and she dragged me back to the front. Needless to say, I needed every ounce of blood she had the last three-sixteenths of a mile and she gave it to me."

AFLEET ALEX WORKS AGAIN Dual Classic winner **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet) turned in his first work since winning the June 11 GI Belmont S. with a five-furlong move at Belmont Park yesterday in 1:00 4/5.
