SYMBOLI KRIS S COLT TOP JRHA OPENER

Two-time Japanese Horse of the Year Symboli Kris S (Kris S.) got off to a flying start in the sale's ring yesterday when a colt from his first crop topped the opening session of the Japan Racing Horse Association's

Select Foal Sale at the Northern Horse Park on Hokkaido, with a final bid of \$1,875,000. The bay colt was consigned by Northern Farm and was purchased by Mizuki Noda's Danox Co. Ltd. He is out of Must Be Loved (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), the dam of leading sophomore filly Rhein Kraft (Jpn). The session-topping foal was one of three lots to break the million-dollar barrier. A

colt by Japanese Derby winner Admire Vega (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) brought the day's second highest price, fetching a final bid of \$1,517,857. The bay foal, from the Northern Farm consignment, is out of Fairy Doll and is a three-quarter brother to Japanese champion mare To the Victory (Jpn) and to Japanese group winners Be Positive (Jpn) and Silent Deal (Jpn). He was purchased by Nobutaka Tada. Also topping the seven-figure mark was a son of Japanese 2000 Guineas winner Agnes Tachyon (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), who was purchased by Takaya Shimakawa for \$1,071,429. Out of the Grade I placed Fanjica (Ire) (Law Society), the colt was consigned by Shadai Farm. During yesterday's session, 128 foals sold for \$39,428,571 and an average of \$308,036. The sale's final session begins today at 11 a.m.

SCORPION ADDED TO GRAND PRIX Susan Magnier's G1 Irish Derby runner-up **Scorpion (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was yesterday supplemented to Thursday's G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp. The Aidan O'Brien-trained colt, last seen finishing a half-length adrift of Hurricane Run (Ire) in the Curragh Classic June 26, joined **Orion Star (Fr)** (Sternkoenig {Ire}) in being added at a cost of €30,000 each. "He's come out of the Irish Derby very well and we're really pleased with him," the Ballydoyle conditioner told the *Racing Post*. Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum could be double-handed in the contest, run over a mile and a half for the first time this season, as the G2 King Edward VII S. winner **Plea Bargain (GB)** (Machiavellian) looks set to join the Andre Fabre-trained G3 Prix du Lys scorer **Desideratum (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}).

COLIC SCARE FOR PHOENIX REACH Winterbeck Manor Stud's **Phoenix Reach (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) may be forced to sidestep the July 23 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Newbury after suffering another setback, it was announced yesterday. The globe-trotting five-year-old had recovered from an eye infection picked up in Singapore after finishing second in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji May 15, but met with another scare over the weekend when reacting from an injection administered for a bout of colic. "He had colic for the last couple of days and had an injection on Friday," trainer Andrew Balding said of the G1 Canadian International, G1 Hong Kong Vase and G1 Dubai Sheema Classic hero. "He had a bad reaction to it and we've got to take every day as it comes. Missing two days' training is not ideal for any race, let alone a race of the calibre of the King George, but if any horse can overcome it, it's Phoenix Reach, as his powers of recovery are extraordinary. We'll just have to keep a close eye on him over the next couple of days."

Daiwa El Cielo captured last year's Japanese Oaks, but had been winless since taking the G3 Keihan Hai. The filly took the lead from the start and maintained her advantage throughout. Winning jockey Yuichi Fukunaga commented, "I didn't care about her position and let her set her own pace. She almost lost her spirit turning for home, but when the runner-up Meine Samantha came up to us, my horse started to fight again. This was her best performance this season." Daiwa El Cielo ended last season with a third-place finish in the G2 Hanshin Himba S. in December. She disappointed in four previous starts this term, running ninth in the Jan. 5 G3 Kyoto Kim Pai, sixth in the Jan. 26 G1 (NRA) Kawasaki Kinen and 16th in the Apr. 3 G3 Lord Derby Challenge Trophy before finishing 16th again in the June 5 G3 Aichi Hai last time out.

One of the saddest stories in Britain's breeding industry in recent years has been the decline in the fortunes of the country's National Stud at Newmarket. Little more than 20 years ago the stud was home to the Derby winners Mill Reef, Blakeney, Grundy and Royal Palace, as well as Moorestyle, a sprinter who earned Horse of the Year honors, and Star Appeal, a champion who numbered the Arc among his Group 1 successes.

Unfortunately, the stud was heavily dependent on the benevolence of owners such as Paul Mellon and Carlo Vittadini in the struggle to compete for the best stallion prospects. With the Levy Board controlling the purse strings, the National Stud has steadily lost clout in an industry dominated by a new breed of owners who naturally wish to stand their best colts at their own farms.

The struggle to find a successor to the magnificent Mill Reef has consequently proved an unequal one, despite the arrival of the French Derby winners Suave Dancer and Celtic Swing (neither of whom lasted long, for different reasons). Many now question the stud's role, but there has been one success story over the last few years--the steady rise to prominence of Bahamian Bounty.

Trained by David Loder, a man adept at handling quick-maturing juveniles, Bahamian Bounty soon established that he had been very well bought for 45,000 guineas as a yearling. Tackling Group 1 company in the Prix Morny on only his third outing, he wore down the odds-on Zamindar to win by a short neck. By the time he raced again in the G1 Middle Park S., Bahamian Bounty had changed hands for a reported £1 million, his buyer being Maktoum Al Maktoum, who had campaigned the colt's sire, champion sprinter Cadeaux Genereux.

Sheikh Maktoum's decision to buy the colt was justified by a head victory in the Middle Park and Bahamian Bounty then attempted to gain his third Group 1 success, this time over an extra furlong in the Dewhurst S. Perhaps the extra distance was beyond him, as he could finish only fourth behind the Middle Park third-place getter In Command.

The next chapter in Bahamian Bounty's story was a move to Dubai, into the care of Saeed bin Suroor, but he failed to add to his reputation. Finishing last of six in the French 2000 Guineas seemed to confirm his lack of stamina and his only subsequent appearance came over six furlongs, when he finished a respectable fourth in the 1997 Darley July Cup--a race which, last week, was to provide him with his finest moment as a stallion. That was when his four-year-old son Pastoral Pursuits sprang a 22-1 surprise for a partnership which includes the National Stud.

When Bahamian Bounty began his stallion career at the National Stud in 1998, his fee was £4,500--a modest amount for a dual Group 1 juvenile winner. Of course, he wasn't helped by his failure to shine at three.

Although he fared reasonably well in his first season, with a book of around 55 mares, books of 38, 29 and 37 followed as the novelty wore off. Then his first two-year-olds drew attention to him in 2001, with Berk The Jerk and Lady Links both becoming Listed winners. He again added to his reputation in 2003, when the two-year-old Pastoral Pursuits became his first Group winner in the G3 Sirenia S. and Babodana, Naahy and Dubaian Gift all underlined his ability to get smart performers at up to a mile. As a consequence, Bahamian Bounty's book rose to over 110 mares in 2004, and another good year, featuring Group successes over seven furlongs by Naahy and Pastoral Pursuits, led to his fee being increased to £6,000 this year. His successes also earned him respect in the sales ring last term, with weanlings selling for up to 54,000 guineas and yearlings for up to 130,000 guineas.

Pastoral Pursuits has now won over £260,000--roughly 10 times his price as a yearling. He is the third foal of Star, a lightly-raced juvenile five-furlong winner by Most Welcome.

It is always interesting to try to work out why a breeder chose a certain stallion for a particular mare, and I can't help thinking that Star might have been sent to Bahamian Bounty because her second dam, Evendo, was by Derring-Do. When this very successful stallion was mated to Bahamian Bounty's fourth dam, Djerella, the outcome was the remarkable Stilvi.

Stilvi's tremendous speed and courage helped her inflict two defeats on the top male sprinters in 1972 and she later made a truly spectacular start to her broodmare career. All of Stilvi's first five foals became stakes winners and among them were Tachypous (G1 Middle Park S. and second in the 2000 Guineas), Tromos (G1 Dewhurst S.), Tyrnavos (G1 Irish Derby) and Tolmi (G2 Coronation S. and second in the 1000 Guineas).

Pastoral Pursuits seems to be ideally suited to six and seven furlongs, but his connections considered it worth trying him over a mile in the G1 Queen Anne S., in which he lost his chance by slipping on the treacherous ground at York. He could possibly stay a mile, as his broodmare sire, the underrated Most Welcome, was versatile enough to finish second in the Derby and third in the Breeders' Cup Mile.

Pastoral Pursuits' younger brother Goodricke is also above average and a third good performer, by Bahamian Bounty out of a Most Welcome mare, is Group-placed Mary Read.

Pastoral Pursuits isn't the first good sprinter from this family, as Star is a half sister to Superstrike, winner of the Gill Riva Ridge S. and Gill Frank J. Defrancis Memorial Dash in 1992.

ducted into the Calder Hall of Fame during a ceremony held in the winner's circle following the second race at Calder Race Course Aug. 7. Boots 'n Jackie, bred in Florida and campaigned by John Bush's Bee Bee Stable, won the Susan's Girl and My Dear Girl divisions of the Florida Stallion S. before finishing third to Eliza and Educated Risk in the

1992 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Second in a host of graded stakes at three, including the GI Forward Gal S. and the GI Davona Dale S., the filly was retired following a fifth in the GI Kentucky Oaks. Boots 'n Jackie has also managed to leave her mark as a broodmare, producing MGSW and millionaire Supah Blitz. Trainer Bill White, well-known on the South Florida scene, has dominated the training ranks at Calder over the course of the last decade. He collected the last eight Calder meet titles, with nine overall, and received top honors at five Tropical-at-Calder meets. White is perhaps best known for his work with youngsters, beginning the careers of eventual champion sprinter Not Surprising; High Fly, winner of the GI Florida Derby; and last year's Delta Princess S. heroine Punch Appeal.

Effectual (Carson City), winner of Saturday's GIII Debutante S. at Churchill Downs, will journey to the Empire State for the upcoming Saratoga meeting, according to Scott Blasi, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen. A 3 1/4-length winner in her debut at Keeneland Apr. 15, the filly is expected to make her next start in the Aug. 26 GI Spinaway S. "In New York, they really don't allow for the Kentucky horses to run in the [GII Adirondack S. July 27]," explained Blasi. "If that race was the first week in August, that would give you an option to run there and in the Spinaway." With her Debutante victory, Effectual has improved her career earnings to \$101,082.

Yougottawanna captured the GIII Seabiscuit Breeders' Cup H. in front-running fashion at Bay Meadows in February, but those tactics failed to get him into the winner's circle in his next when he finished a tiring fifth in the grassy Stanford Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 19. Given a breather after a poor showing in the Tiznow S. for Cal-breds at Hollywood Apr. 24, he never threatened when third in the GIII Berkeley H. on the dirt at Golden Gate June 11. Reverting back to his free-wheeling ways, Yougottawanna sped to the front and carved out honest splits of :22.78, :46.07 and 1:09.70. Turning into the lane with a three-length lead, he responded to his jockey's urging and kept on well late.

JAPANESE VET BEGINS SERVING TIME FOR MISUSING FUNDS

Koichiro Hayata has begun serving a five-year sentence for misusing syndicate funds of stallions managed by C.B. Stud, reports *Blood-Horse* yesterday. In 2004, a syndicate member filed suit against Hayata, and criminal charges were filed, during proceedings for that case. Hayata was found guilty of using funds from various stallion syndicates to buy horses in his own name and pay off personal debt. C.B. Stud, formerly operated by Hayata and his wife Yukiko, stood as many as 10 stallions, including Brian's Time, imported to Japan following a U.S. campaign which included victories in the GI Florida Derby and GIII Jim Beam S., as well as his outstanding son Narita Time, Japanese Horse of the Year and Japanese Triple Crown winner in 1996. Brian's Time was moved to Arrow Stud prior to the 2005 breeding season. Hayata has been banned by the Japan Racing Association from owning and racing horses at JRA tracks.
