SCORPION IN A PARISIEN STINGER

On a balmy Parisian evening, a domestic victory in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris was the wish for France's Bastille Day, but it was not to be as G1 Irish Derby runner-up and 6-4 favorite **Scorpion (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) bounded to an imperious 2 1/2-length success at the expense of **Desideratum (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}). In registering his first win at the highest level, he eclipsed the 1997 record of Peintre Celebre's by 3/10 of a second. Kept under wraps until winning his debut at Leopardstown May 8, Scorpion was beaten a short-head when runner-up in the G3 Gallinule S. at The Curragh a fortnight later before finishing last-but-one in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly June 5. That previous Gallic experience was consigned to the archive after his latest effort at The Curragh June 26 and he also improved on Aidan O'Brien's previous best in the race which came courtesy of Bonnard (Ire)'s third-place effort in 2001. "We were quite confident going into the race as [Scorpion] had done well since the Irish Derby," the Ballydoyle conditioner explained. "This new [distance] Grand Prix de Paris is nicely positioned in the calendar and has proved a competitive race. We shall now give Scorpion a break and prepare him for the [G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe back here [Oct. 2]."

Jockey Kieren Fallon was keen to get an early position off an even break and niggled Scorpion into second as Airex (GB) (Unfuwain) assumed pacemaking duties after the opening stages. The order was maintained throughout until the eventual winner, who joined the leader along the false straight, was sent to the front in early stretch. Desideratum made ominous headway to press the new leader just inside the quarter pole, but it was the signal for Fallon to go for closure. The contest was settled in a matter of strides approaching the final furlong as Scorpion accelerated clear and kept on strongly from the eighth pole to claim the win as Desideratum confirmed G3 Prix du Lys form with Orion Star, whose surge from the rear carried him into third.

Kane Hekili won for the fifth time in his last six starts as the overwhelming favorite. The chestnut won a pair of races on the dirt in February by a combined 16 lengths, but was seventh in the Mar. 26 Mainichi Hai on the turf. He bounced back to take the Tango S. back on the main track at Kyoto by nine lengths Apr. 30 and made it two straight with a 1 3/4-length victory in the June 4 Unicorn S. at Tokyo. The winner's dam, carrying a foal by Wild Again, was purchased by Katsumi Yoshida for \$270,000 from the consignment of Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services at the 1999 Keeneland January sale.

Daily Racing Form. "You can make a good case for not changing [distances] and a good case for branching out," trainer Frank Brothers told the publication. "Being a filly, it puts her in an awkward position when looking down the road at the Breeders' Cup, because it means she'll either have to run against the boys or at a mile and one eighth against the girls." The four-year-old filly may start next at Saragota in the six-furlong GII Honorable Miss H. Aug. 5 or the seven-furlong GI Balle-rina H. Aug. 27. "The timing of the races is such that we could probably make both if we'd like, but nothing is etched in stone at the moment," Brothers added. "I also still have thoughts about trying her around two turns again and wouldn't rule out the [GI] Spinster S. at Keeneland [Oct. 9] this fall as a possibility."

NYRA PERSONNEL CHANGES MADE BY

HAYWARD The New York Racing Association will have a new racing secretary and chief examining veterinarian, according to a statement released by Charles Hayward, president and CEO of NYRA. P.J. Campo has been named racing secretary and handicapper, replacing Mike Lakow. Dr. Anthony Verderosa has been named acting chief examining veterinarian, taking over for Dr. Celeste Kunz. "Today we have made key personnel changes that will provide NYRA with a fresh approach as we continue our efforts to make this company more dynamic and responsive," Hayward said. "The ultimate goal is to build a better business model and racing experience that will benefit all of our important stakeholders." It was also announced that NYRA will soon name a new vice president of human resources and labor relations to replace Ralph Chetcuti. Hayward also announced that steward David Hicks would retire.

Bailey, Hayward & Zito Panel Members at Spa Preview:

Trainer Nick Zito, jockey Jerry Bailey and NYRA president and CEO Charles Hayward will be members of the panel for the Saratoga Preview program at the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame, Monday, July 25. Saratoga Preview, a roundtable discussion which involves a review of the previous season as well as a look ahead to the meeting at Saratoga, will begin at 7 p.m. in the Hall of Fame Gallery. It is free and open to the public.

Full to Elusive Quality Makes U.S. Debut:

A full brother to leading sire Elusive Quality makes his U.S. debut today in the fifth race at Belmont Park. Darley Stable's four-year-old **Great Exhibition** (Gone West), a \$1.8-million Keeneland July acquisition, has drawn the five hole in a one-mile maiden special weight over the main track. The colt, winless in seven starts, has raced primarily over the sod in Britain, last finishing runner-up in a Goodwood maiden in October. His lone dirt effort came earlier in 2004, when he was a well-beaten eighth in the G2 UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba. Kieran McLaughlin has taken over training duties from Saeed bin Suroor. The race also marks the return of **Papi Chullo** (Comeonmom), who, despite being a maiden, was on the Triple Crown trail after a runner-up effort in the Sham S. and a fourth in the GII Fountain of Youth S. He's been on the sidelines since finishing up the track in the Apr. 2 GI Florida Derby. Papi Chullo has been cross-entered in Sunday's GIII Leonard Richards S. at Delaware Park.

"Del Mar represents the best in American horseracing, from the quality of the races to the overall racetrack atmosphere," said Tony Allevalo, TVG senior vice president and executive producer. "We are delighted to once again be able to offer our viewers complete coverage of this great meet."

New Grass Surface for Del Mar:

The Del Mar turf course will have a new surface this season in the form of GN-1 Bermuda grass. Created by champion golfer and turf business entrepreneur Greg Norman, the new course will be put to the test from the beginning of the meet, with the usual opening day feature, the Oceanside S. "[It was selected] because of its ability to grow well in our coastal conditions, which a lot of Bermudas will not do, mainly because it doesn't get warm enough," Leif Dickinson, the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club's chief agronomist said. "We want it to hold up, but we want all horses to finish well, the times to be moderate and everyone to come back safe."

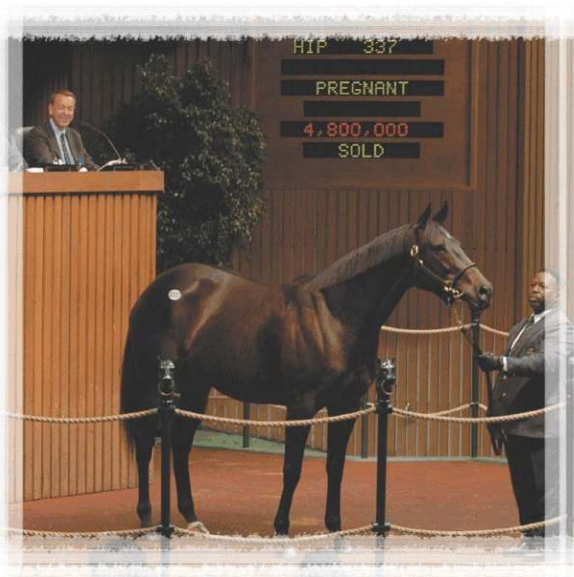
