GOING DEEP IN BOWLING GREEN

On the bit from the opening strides, 26-1 **Cacht Wells (Arg)** (Poliglote {GB}) battled past pacesetter **Salic Law** (Deputy Commander), then held off favored **Relaxed Gesture (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) to take the GII Bowling Green H. at Belmont Park by a head. It was a gallant finish for the five-year-old gelding, who pulled up lame after the race and had to be vanned back to the barn area. "He took a bad step pulling up," trainer Stan

Hough explained. "It doesn't appear to be that bad." A Group 1 winner in Argentina, Cacht Wells returned from a six-month winter vacation to be third in an allowance test at Gulfstream Mar. 24. He shipped north to win an optional claimer at Belmont in May and, stepping up for the June 11 Battlefield S. at Monmouth, closed well to be third. He was stretching out to a mile and three-eighths for the first time off that nine-panel test.

A DASH OF CLASS

It has been 19 years since Meon Valley Stud's epoch-shaping Colorspin (Fr) carried the famous black-and-white silks of Helena Springfield Ltd to success in the G1 Irish Oaks, but the wheel will turn full circle if **Dash to the Top (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) justifies favoritism in today's Darley-sponsored renewal of the Classic at The Curragh.

Described as "an Oaks filly through and through" by trainer Luca Cumani after finishing third in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot in September, she failed to come to hand in time for the Epsom equivalent June 3, but affirmed her reputation with a bloodless score in the Listed Hopping S. at Newcastle June 23. Jockey Johnny Murtagh takes the mount as he looks for a fourth renewal. "She's going well, but it's going to be very competitive," he said. "It's a good Oaks with all the good fillies from England and a very strong home defence, so I'm sure it's going to be one of the best fillies' races of the year. Getting in on the Act...

Another set of colors stepped in the history of The Curragh are those of the Sangster Family, who will be hoping that **Playful Act (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) can end a long Oaks drought that stretches back to 1979. She proved a formidable force at two, winning the G2 May Hill S. before besting Maids Causeway (Ire) and Dash to the Top in the Fillies' Mile. An intemperate spring meant she failed to make the line-up for the Epsom Classic, but she produced all the right moves when winning the G2 Lancashire Oaks on her belated return July 2. Trainer John Gosden told *PA Sport*, "She has come on since her last race. One would have liked to have spaced her races out a bit more, but that was not to be. She would have liked the odd thunderstorm, but it is a fair racetrack which should suit her."

Wild Irish Rose...

Another trainer looking to roll back the years is Con Collins, who saddled Princess Pati (Ire) to win this in 1984 and he has his best chance of a follow-up with Tony and Frances Donnelly's **Chelsea Rose (Ire)** (Desert King {Ire}) here. The winner of the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at this venue in September, she returned to beat the colts in the Listed Silver S. at Leopardstown June 8 before running down the field in the G1 Pretty Polly S. over 10 furlongs at this track June 24. "She's very well and the fast ground will be ideal for her," said the trainer's daughter, Tracey. "We're hoping for a good pace in the race and the step up in trip should suit her." Despite his enviable big-race haul over the years, John Dunlop looks for his first win in this race with Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Thakafaat (Ire)** (Unfuwain). She showed a vital battling spirit to take the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot at York on her latest start June 16.

Cacht Wells was settled in second as **Salic Law** dawdled along through fractions of :51.94, 1:17.19 and 1:40.93. Under stout restraint, the winner was just a half-length off the lead after the opening mile, forged to the front as they raced out of the turn and was resolute as favored **Relaxed Gesture** came at him in the final yards. "My plan was to be third or fourth, but they started going too slow," jockey Eibar Coa said. "I said, 'Let me get close,' and he got comfortable. In the end I was a little concerned whether he was going to get the distance, but he showed big-time heart." Coa added, "He pulled up lame. I don't know what the problem was. I felt it after the wire, so I didn't want to take a chance to bring him back [to the winner's circle]."

R Lady Joy followed a seven-length maiden score at Tampa Feb. 22 with a nine-length victory in the Mar. 19 Florida Oaks. She shipped to Oaklawn off that effort and was not disgraced when third behind Round Pond in the Apr. 15 GII Fantasy S. Last time out, the bay closed to be second in the May 20 GII Black Eyed Susan S. "After her last race, I mentioned to the owner that if we get two months with her, we will clean up in this race," said trainer Kirk Ziadie. "She had started to tail off from her last two races. I needed two months with her and I got her where I wanted her. We gave her the break and came back real good. She put on lot of weight and she looked great." As for what's next, Ziadie said, "There are no plans right now. We are just going to take it one step at a time." Favored Round Pond came with a bid on the far turn, but couldn't get past the winner. English Channel won his lone race at two, taking a maiden test on the turf at Saratoga in August. He showed his inexperience when fourth in a Mar. 13 allowance race at Gulfstream Park in his return, but came back to post a 5 3/4-length allowance victory at Keeneland a month later. The chestnut colt made it two in a row in the May 21 Woodlawn S. at Pimlico and added a tally in the first leg of Colonial's \$5-million Grand Slam of Grass, the June 25 Colonial Turf Cup. The even-money chalk to capture the second event in the four-race series, English Channel rated in second as Chattahoochee War led them along through six furlongs in 1:14.43 and a mile in 1:38.23. Jim Ryerson didn't even have to think about it. After watching Park Avenue Ball romp to an easy win, Ryerson announced that he will be sending the colt to the \$1-million GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park Aug. 7. "If he comes out of this race OK, we'll run him in the Haskell," he said. "We have to give him a shot." Park Avenue Ball won the Tyro S. and the GII Futurity last season and opened 2005 with a second-place finish in the GII Hutcheson S. He was off the board in his first two tries at two turns, however, running sixth in the Mar. 5 GII Fountain of Youth S. and fourth in the Apr. 3 GI Florida Derby. Park Avenue Ball was given one more chance to prove he could handle a route of ground in the one-mile GIII Withers S. at Aqueduct, and responded with a solid second-place finish. Freshened after that effort, the chestnut settled in second early, put a head in front after six furlongs and galloped away from the field down the lane for an impressive score. 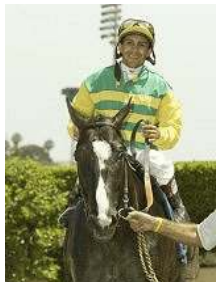

"She's in foal to High Chaparral and is an improving mare, but I think that's her last race," jockey Pat Smullen said. "That can transform them and it's happened with her--really, she's probably a mile-and-a-quarter mare."

"We had to take it easy on him for about three weeks to let it heal," trainer Rick Violette Jr. said, but added, "I think he's right where he needs to be now." **Smokume** has been first or second in six of his eight starts at Belmont Park. The chestnut gelding was off the board in two prior starts at the Tom Fool distance, but drove to a 2 3/4-length score over handicap foes going 6 1/2 panels June 29. He is two-for-three with jockey Chantal Sutherland in the saddle. "He runs his best when he can get a little breather in the middle of the race," Sutherland said. That might not happen here. BUZZARDS BAY SWOOPS INTO FASIG Without much fanfare, the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July Selected Yearling Sale kicked into another gear yesterday with the 1:30 p.m. arrival of GI Santa Anita Derby winner **Buzzards Bay** (Marco Bay). The blaze-faced chestnut made a striking appearance and looked a picture of health and fitness as he made his way to his temporary home in Barn 11 at the Newtown Paddocks. The colt, who has been under the care of California-based conditioner Jeff Mullins, is being sold as the final horse through the ring Monday afternoon to dissolve the Fog City partnership of David Shimmon and Bill Bianco. "He's a lovely horse," Fasig-Tipton's Director of Marketing Terence Collier commented as Buzzards Bay was being led in. "We're delighted that Mr. Mullins brought him to the sale looking so well." Despite a very humid afternoon and intermittent rain showers, prospective buyers were busy poring over the catalogue and carefully eyeballing the 679 youngsters on offer. Collier is pleased with the level of activity on the grounds at this early stage. "It started strong on Thursday and from 7:30 Friday morning, there were horses being inspected pretty much all over the barns. It's kept at a steady and consistent level ever since," he said. "There has been a lot of interest from some heavyweight buyers from the West coast and New York. All the pinhookers that we anticipated are here as well. I can't say that it's more than we anticipated, but it's certainly up to our expectations." Bloodstock agent Buzz Chace, who arrived Friday morning, completed his first go-round of the barns by mid-afternoon yesterday and is optimistic about the year's first major yearling auction. "There's an awful lot of nice horses here, nice physicals, some pedigree," the New Jersey-based agent commented, adding that his 'short' list contains about 90 horses. "There's a lot of people and a lot of money here and it looks like it's going to be a really good sale." Bidding begins Monday morning at 10 a.m.

ALEX HARTHILL DIES Dr. Alex Harthill, the noted and controversial veterinarian who, according to the *Daily Racing Form*, claimed to have treated as many as 26 Kentucky Derby winners, died early yesterday morning at Hospice and Palliative Care in Louisville due to complications from a stroke suffered several weeks ago. He was 80. Retired columnist Joe Hirsch told *DRF*, "Dr. Harthill was an outstanding individual and an outstanding veterinarian. He had an intuitive sense about what was bothering a horse. He went far beyond conventional means to determine what was ailing them. He was very, very talented. He also was extremely generous with his time, especially with horsemen who might not have been able to afford his services. He will be sorely missed." Born in Louisville in 1925, Harthill was a second-generation veterinarian, graduating from Ohio State University in 1948. He went right to the top in Thoroughbred racing, handling the care of Triple Crown winner Citation that year, and went on to treat such notable racehorses as Northern Dancer, Affirmed, Sunday Silence, A.P. Indy and Fusaichi Pegasus. He also was fined and suspended on a number of occasions, but his most infamous case was that of Dancer's Image, who was disqualified from his win in the 1968 Derby after testing positive for Bute. In addition to his vet work, Harthill served as director of racing at Fair Grounds in the early '80s and was president of the Kentucky HBPA for nearly two years, ending his term in July of 2002. He is survived by daughters Meha Harthill of California and Alexis Borden of Louisville. Heady-Cralle Funeral Home of Lexington is handling the memorial arrangements. Visiting hours will be held Wednesday from 5-8 p.m., with a service to follow.
