Blood-Horse

REMATCH IN CCA OAKS

There's a fifty-percent chance that today's Grade I Coaching Club American Oaks will be won by a filly beginning with the letter 'S.' **Smuggler** (Unbridled), who gave trainer Shug McGaughey an elusive first win in the GI Mother Goose S. June 25, rematches with the narrowly vanquished **Spun Sugar** (Awesome Again) and third-place finisher, GI Kentucky Oaks winner **Summerly** (Summer Squall) in a field of eight that will tackle 10 furlongs for the first time. "I was really looking forward to running her in the Mother Goose and it was great to win it for the first time," said

McGaughey of the daughter of champion Inside Information. The lightly raced bay is still learning the business. "She kind of pulled herself up once she made the lead in the Mother Goose," he explained. "It's important to time her run, but this is something she'll get over with more racing experience." Edgar Prado is at the controls again today. Spun Sugar, victorious in the May 20 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. prior to the Mother Goose, is also trying to overcome some inexperience. The Stronach runner, coupled today with Revidere S. victress **Bayou Breeze** (A.P. Indy), veered in leaving the chute three weeks ago and may have been best, given the half-length margin of defeat. "I wish she could have been ridden a little differently," commented trainer Todd Pletcher. When she tried to make the chute, her position was compromised and then she was at the mercy of everyone else." Undeclared **For All We Know** (Stephen Got Even) is in from Chicago for trainer John Ward. The chestnut, who defeated subsequent stakes winner Talented in her Mar. 21 maiden at Gulfstream, tried a mile in her latest and posted a five-length victory at Arlington June 9.

DIAMOND DESTINY

His Highness the Aga Khan's **Azamour (Ire)** (Night Shift) faces the age-old question of "will he stay" as he stretches out to a mile-and-a-half trip for the first time in today's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Newbury. While there is no doubting the four-year-old's resolve, he will be entering unknown territory as he passes the quarter pole in today's feature, transferred from its native Ascot for the first time. He proved adept over that track's stiff mile when capturing the G1 St James's Palace S. last June and beat the best around over 10 furlongs when following up in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown in September. He had excuses for his third in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket the following month and fourth in the May 22 G1

Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh on his return, but demonstrated his staying power when clawing back **Ace (Ire)** (Danehill) in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. on a testing surface at Royal Ascot at York June 15. "He won nicely last time and he's as tough as can be," commented trainer John Oxx, successful with Alamshar (Ire) two years ago. "It's worth a go, as not many horses can win Group 1s at all three distances, but he's always finished his races at a mile-and-a-quarter very strongly, giving the impression that he will go a bit further." Azamour had Rochelle Quinn's **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}) behind when placed in both last year's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, but that colt turned the tables over an extended 10-furlongs in the Tattersalls Gold Cup last time. He proved he stayed this trip when besting North Light (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby last June, but connections are more concerned about the prospect of fast ground at the Berkshire venue. "He has developed very well from three to four and is now a very powerful colt," conditioner Dermot Weld told the *Racing Post*. "I don't want the ground to be too fast for him. We want genuine good ground and we don't want it firm." **Cont. p2**

Last year's impressive winner **Doyen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) will bid to end his slide down the ratings and provide Godolphin with a sixth renewal since 1995. With three off-the-board efforts since his emphatic score 12 months ago, the five-year-old has much to prove and showed little when down the field in the June 18 G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot at York. "It was a disappointing run at York, as he traveled well throughout the race and didn't finish," jockey Kerrin McEvoy said. "He wanted to hang left under pressure and didn't feel at home over the rough surface, so I'm

going to Newbury hoping he can enjoy himself." Saeed Manana's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden and dual G1 Coronation Cup winner **Warrsan (Ire)** (Caerleon) is another currently in a dip, having finished well adrift of Azamour in the Prince of Wales's on his last start.

Trainer Clive Brittain is not giving up on the seven-year-old yet. "We took him to Lingfield a week ago to give him a gallop and all of the old spark was in him, so the horse certainly isn't dead and buried," he explained. "I'm not writing him off and I wouldn't run him if I didn't think he could go on and beat them."

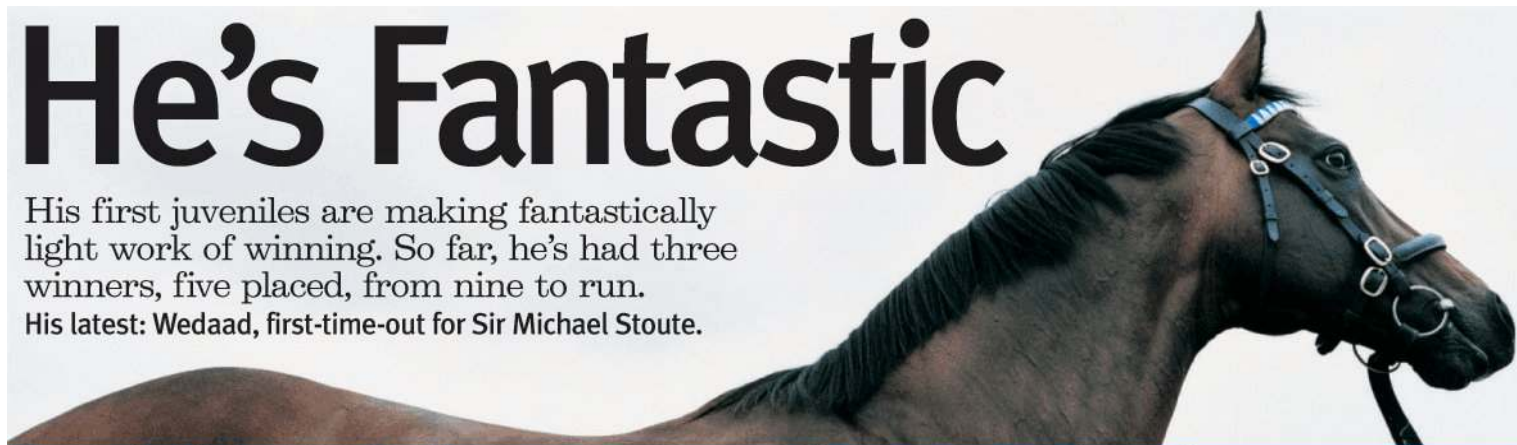

Winendynme returns to the scene of her maiden victory two years ago. The dark bay filly has not raced at Del Mar since that two-length tally, but has been a consistent competitor at the other two Southern California tracks. Third in the GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood to end her juvenile season, she started just four times last year, winning the Manhattan Beach S. at Hollywood and running third in the Providencia S. at Santa Anita. The four-year-old opened 2005 with a third in the Apr. 10 GIII Las Cienegas H., then reeled off victories in the May 6 Tuzla S. and May 28 Tranquility Lake S. Making her first start for trainer Doug O'Neill in her latest, Winendynme came within 3/4 of a length of the mighty Megahertz (GB), finishing second in the June 25 GII Beverly Hills H. She drops back a furlong off that 10-panel test. **Intercontinental**, four-for-six last year, took the Apr. 17 GIII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland in her first start this term. Second as the odds-on chalk in the June 11 GII Just a Game BC H. at Belmont, she rebounded to take the July 3 GIII Royal Heroine S. by 1 1/4 lengths over **Ticker Tape** going a mile at Hollywood. In her only other try at nine furlongs, the bay was fifth in the GI Diana H. last year. **Halo Ola**, a multiple Group 1 winner, ran a troubled sixth in her U.S. bow, the May 30 GI Gamely BC H., but improved to be third in the Beverly Hills last time out.

ROUND POND OUT OF TRAINING Fox Hill Farm's **Round Pond** (Awesome Again) has emerged from her second-place effort in last weekend's GII Delaware Oaks with a small knee chip, owner Rick Porter said in his journal on the Rockport Harbor website. Porter

reported that trainer John Servis noticed that the winner of the GI Acorn S. June 4 appeared "uncomfortable" during a routine visit to the track Thursday. A series of X-rays were ordered and performed at New Jersey Equine, where the chip, located in the top joint of her left knee, was diagnosed. Surgery will be performed in the coming weeks following which Round Pond will be turned out for two months. Porter indicated that there remains a slight chance that his

filly could start again before the end of the year. The winner of the GII Fantasy S. earlier this spring, Round Pond has four wins from six career starts and earnings of \$467,300.

CESARIO INJURED According to a statement from the Japan Racing Association, Carrot Farm's **Cesario (Jpn)** (Special Week {Jpn}), the winner of the Japanese Oaks and the GI American Oaks, has strained a ligament in her right front leg and will be sidelined for at least three months. BORISLOW RESPONDS TO PROBE Owner Daniel Borislow has responded to an investigation taking place by the New York and New Jersey Racing Commissions surrounding the whereabouts of **Wild Desert** (Wild Rush) prior to his victory in the Queen's Plate at Woodbine June 26. The colt reportedly had just two official workouts between his eighth-place effort in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 16 and his effort in Canada.

"From what I recently learned from my own inquiries is that a NYRA official informed [trainer] Rick

Dutrow that Wild Desert was not allowed to stable or train in New York," Borislow told the *Blood-Horse*. "I was then told the horse was sent to a farm before being shipped to Monmouth Park, where Dutrow has a string of horses, for a workout." Borislow continued, "I was also informed that when the horse was put under the official care of Dutrow's New York assistant Juan Rodriguez during Dutrow's 60-day suspension, he began working regularly at Aqueduct leading up to the Queen's Plate." The owner also addressed a reported \$100,000 profit he made on the race. "It never entered my mind that there might be an issue betting this horse," he told the publication. "I knew nothing more than anyone else. I just knew he was a talented horse, he had Pat Valenzuela up and my trainer told me he was doing great." Borislow also went out of his way to indicate that in no way was trainer Bobby Frankel involved in the situation. "He just put the saddle on him," he said.
