**WHO'S THE BOSS?**

Superlatives were flowing after His Highness the Aga Khan's **Azamour (Ire)** (Night Shift) bossed his rivals in yesterday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. and they were richly deserved. Silencing those who doubted he had the stamina for the mile-and-a-half test, the homebred swept from last to first to win handily, eclipsing the Newbury track record as he stopped the clock in 2:28.26. With a confident Michael Kinane at the reins, the 5-2 pick simply rolled by every rival, and he owned the much-debated final quarter-mile, idling to win by a comfortable 1 1/4 lengths over 50-1 shot **Norse Dancer (Ire)** (Halling). "He is certainly one of the best I've ever had," commented his proud owner/breeder, celebrating his third success in this prestigious contest. **Cont. p2**

**OUT IN THE OPEN**

The Phipps Stable's **Smuggler** (Unbridled) assumed the mantle as the nation's top three-year-old filly with a measured victory in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont yesterday afternoon. "She does it so easy, I'm kind of floored a little bit," said winning trainer Shug McGaughey. The bay will now head to the Spa to cement her claim. "We have four weeks to the [GI] Alabama now," added her Hall of Fame conditioner. "We have been looking for a really nice horse for a while. It is pretty exciting." **Cont. p2**

**Amorama (Fr)** (Sri Pekan)'s love affair with Del Mar continues. Yesterday, the dark bay added the GI John C. Mabee H. trophy to that earned in last year's GI Del Mar Oaks. "She has a big heart," winning trainer Julio Canani told *ESPN*. "We'll give her one more [race] before the Breeders' Cup." ***Staying Power...***

Azamour had already claimed three Group 1 prizes, but those victories came over a mile and 10 furlongs, and while there were those who questioned his ability to get the extra quarter mile, his success in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot at York June 15 suggested the distance was within reach. "I had a pretty good feeling that he'd get the trip," said the Aga Khan. "We wanted to do as little as possible in the first part of the race. We were aware that this was a very strong field and he came very easily." Azamour cracked over Ascot's stiff mile in the G1 St James's Palace S. at the 2004 Royal meeting, then staged an impressive winning return when flashing late in the G1 Irish Champion S. over Leopardstown's 10 furlongs in September. He may have been found out by the soft ground when only third in the Newmarket equivalent in October, and encountered those conditions again when an unlucky fourth in the May 22 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh first time up this term. He rebounded in the Prince of Wales's, and made it two straight at the highest level yesterday. "They were going very quick and I didn't want to mess him around, so I kept him where he was happy and let them at it and he actually swept into the race too quickly," Mick Kinane said. "He likes to get into a rhythm and I always felt he would be better when he steps up. He's ultra-consistent and a very high-class horse at any trip." The Aga Khan confirmed the plan was to run in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 2 if the ground is not too testing. Trainer John Oxx added, "I expect the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 10] will probably be his next race and then the Arc is a distinct possibility." ***Second Best...***

Owner-breeder Jeff Smith was not too downcast to finish second again with **Norse Dancer**. "Azamour is a champion and we've got to be thrilled, but I have mixed feelings as it is so desperately frustrating to have such a good horse and be second again," Smith said. "The horse deserves it, but it wasn't to be and he's run a wonderful race. The Irish Champion S. is where he's headed next." But trainer David Elsworth does not favor another crack at Azamour. "I rather fancy a Southern Hemisphere campaign, but we'll see what Jeff thinks," he said. The Niarchos Family's **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan) will be pointed for the Arc and Breeders' Cup.

After capturing her first two career starts in New York, Smuggler made an unlikely stakes debut in the Three Ring S. at Calder Dec. 4. Her rally came up 3/4 of a length short as the 1-2 chalk, and the bay didn't face the starter again until May 11. With a facile allowance win at Belmont that day, she stepped up in class next out and settled for second best to Round Pond in the GI Acorn S. June 4.

Smuggler earned her first stakes victory in the GI Mother Goose S. June 25, defeating Spun Sugar and Summerly, and was a slight favorite here. Jockey Edgar Prado kept the Phipps filly tucked into fourth as Summerly and Spun Sugar raced in tandem on the lead. Smuggler was guided to the outside approaching the stretch and moved past her rivals in a facile manner, with Prado twirling his stick at her to keep her attention in the final sixteenth. "It worked out the way we planned it," said Prado. "She is cruise control. But when she takes the lead she waits on horses a little bit; she thinks the race is over. I know if there is ever a horse coming she is going to have another gear." Summerly, heroine of the GI Kentucky Oaks, won the battle for second. "She left it all on the track today," said rider Jerry Bailey. "She probably doesn't want to go that far." [Video, sponsored by Taylor Made](#). Amorama began her career in France, where she had five juvenile outings for trainer Maurice Zilber, winning twice. Since arriving in the U.S., the dark bay has competed solely in stakes company. The late-running filly took seven tries to get her first victory on these shores, but picked a perfect time to do it last summer, rallying past Ticker Tape (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}) in the GI Del Mar Oaks Aug. 21. During a flirtation with the main track over the winter, Amorama gave a good account of herself, finishing fifth in the seven-furlong GI La Brea S. Dec. 27 and a close fourth in the GI La Canada S. Feb. 12. She was given a brief break and had shown improvement in her two starts since, rallying for third in both the GIII Wilshire H. Apr. 23 and the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. May 30. With Martin Pedroza in the irons for the first time, Amorama tucked into a ground-saving fifth as favored Intercontinental gave Alex Solis fits just behind the pacesetter. Pedroza took his mount to the outside in the stretch and found clear sailing while Intercontinental, forced to check when a hole closed, settled for third. Gun Salute's first foray into graded company came in his 2005 opener, when he ran sixth, beaten two

lengths, in the GIII Palm Beach S. at Gulfstream Mar. 26.

Treated with Lasix in his next outing, the bay collected Keeneland's Forerunner S. Apr. 21 before settling for third, a half-length from the winner, in the GIII Jefferson Cup at Churchill June 18. Jockey Cornelio Velasquez allowed Gun Salute to settle into stride in mid-pack while keeping tabs on the unbeaten Purim. The pair moved into striking position on the turn and wore down the favorite to win in the last jump. "This is my first homebred runner, ever," said owner/breeder Brant Laue. "To have him prevail at a great track like Arlington on a big day like this is special. There are a lot of opportunities for good three-year-old turf horses, and this was certainly a prime target for us." Cool Conductor lived up to his name with a front-running victory, his second at the graded level in 2005. Second in last year's GII American Derby, the bay earned his stripes in the GIII Hawthorne Derby in October for trainer Bill Mott. He began this campaign with a fifth to Artie Schiller in the GII Maker's Mark Mile Apr. 15, but turned the tables on that rival with a nose win in the GII Dixie H. on Preakness Day, his first start for Ralph Nicks. Cool Conductor then went to Monmouth for the GI United Nations S. July 2, winding up a close fourth in that strangely run contest. Cornelio Velasquez kept the four-year-old on a tight rein through the opening stages here, and they turned for home with a full head of steam before running on strongly down the lane. "When he makes the lead, Cornelio does a very good job with him," said Nicks. "If he comes out of this well, we'll see you in three weeks [for the GI Arlington Million]." Jockey Cornelio Velasquez completed his sweep of the three graded stakes carded at Arlington with this rallying win aboard Noisette. Heroine of the restricted Gaviola S. at Belmont in October, the dark bay had come up short in five previous trips to the post this year, most recently finishing a length back in third in the Lady Canterbury Breeders' Cup H. in Minnesota June 19. Noisette raced along in midpack, following odds-on Shaconage. She was angled to the outside by Velasquez and outfinished the favorite for her first graded stakes success. "I just followed the #3 filly [Shaconage] most of the way, and then the last eighth of a mile my horse swung around her and got clear," he explained. "Every jockey needs good horses to ride, and I got lucky today with three of them." Gary Stevens, aboard Shaconage, took the blame for the favorite's defeat. "I never should have hit her," he said. "As soon as I did, she pulled up."

Tactics come easy when you are champion jockey, as Kieren Fallon proved as he stole a march on Mixed Blessing to capture this competitive renewal. The filly was taken to the stands' rail, away from the main group, from her high draw. By halfway, it was clear that she had lost nothing for Fallon's manoeuvre, matching strides with the head of the far-side peloton. It was Nidhaal who mastered that group, but by that time, Mixed Blessing was gone, and she finished geared down in splendid isolation to set a new track record. "It's quicker [on the stands' side] than the middle, which is over-watered," her rider explained. "She traveled really well for me and quickened--she is a really nice filly." Mixed Blessing came off a Goodwood maiden score June 17 to finish third in the June 30 Listed Rose Bowl S. at this track on her latest start. Trainer Alan Jarvis, who saddled River Belle (GB) to victory in this event in 2003, was convinced there was an excuse for the loss last time out. "She has never stopped improving and doesn't like soft ground, so I should have pulled her out last time," he said.

**Thoro-Graph Race of the Week**  
by Jerry Brown

**Sunday, Eddie Read H.--GI, \$400,000, 3yo/jup, 1 1/8mT**  
*Because the ground is more forgiving and/or the pace less taxing, grass horse run figures in a much tighter range than those on dirt--once we make the adjustments for weight and ground loss, we find they run their tops or close to it very often, especially the stake horses. In turf races the fields bunch up and are closely matched, and weight, ground loss, pace (and therefore post position and riders) are far more important than on the dirt.*

**Singletary Sultry Song Flores 120**  
Improved quite a bit from three to four, ran almost exactly the same figure in all his starts last year, and won the B.C. Mile as a result of a good trip in a 14-horse field. This year he has drawn outside in all three starts, resulting in a lot of 3w turns, but now draws the rail, and with tactical speed should save ground in a race with little early speed. Every path on every turn is worth a length, or 1/2 Thoro-Graph point at this distance, so Singletary will be very strong if he simply runs the race he runs most of the time. The negative is that his last effort was uncharacteristically poor, which could be significant with a turf stake horse. Still, strong contender if he runs his race.

**Sweet Return (GB) Elmaamul (GB) Solis 120**  
Another that improved to run a very big figure at early four, but tailed off, and only started coming around again a year later. His Churchill try was much better than it looked, as he was caught 3w both turns, and a repeat of that effort combined with a 1w1w trip was good enough to win a GI last time. On his last two this horse is almost exactly at the level of Singletary's best, and he is the only other horse in the field with any real early speed. With an even better figure in his past to run back to, he's another strong contender.

**Fourty Niners Son Distorted Humor Nakatani 114**  
Improved a lot when Drysdale got hold of him, and his last three are the best of his life. But those efforts still leave him about 2 1/2 points (about five lengths at this distance) short of the inside pair, although the six pounds he gets makes up about half of that. He needs to improve, but Drysdale runners tend to do their improving early in campaigns, and just hold their form after that.

**Fast and Furious (Fr) Singspiel (Ire) Espinoza 117**  
A much better three-year-old than either Singletary or Sweet Return, earning a big figure for that age when running second in the Hollywood Derby with one of several wide trips. He returned to that figure in his seasonal debut, and looked all set to progress last time, but instead regressed--not a good sign. A good figure for a three-year-old won't cut it against top older turfsters, so this one needs to improve--and after his last, we're from Missouri.

**Qsar (Ger) Tiger Hill (Ire) T Baze 112**  
Decent in Germany, then improved in his second start for Frankel to run a figure that at the weights puts him within range of contending (eight pounds is worth about 1 1/2 Thoro-Graph points (three lengths here). If he had drawn inside, a repeat effort would put him about even with the top ones, but the outside draw combined with his running style almost certainly will mean ground loss relative to the main contenders, and Frankel is another whose runners tend to peak when fresh, and not improve that much through a campaign. Borderline contender.

**Castledale (Ire) Peintre Celebre Douglas 121**  
Ran the race of his young life to win the Santa Anita Derby, and it took a lot out of him--he went to the sidelines for a long time, and took five starts to return to that level this year. This is a very weak pattern, and the big effort last time is more likely to result in another bounce than a repeat effort--which is not a good situation, since even a repeat only makes him a moderate contender. This horse has been getting unbelievable trips, presumably because the barn gives the riders good instructions--he's been on the rail for at least one turn in his last five races, and never more than 2w. Inside draws have helped, but he doesn't get one here. Overall, a bet against as one of the favorites since he could run out of the money.
