A SWEET RETURN IN THE EDDIE READ

Third in this race last year, **Sweet Return (GB)** (Elmaamul) came back with a vengeance, bagging his second consecutive Grade I victory in Sunday's GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar. Allowed to set all the early fractions, the chestnut went gate-to-wire, holding off game closer **Fourty Niners Son** (Distorted Humor), who got up in the last jump to deny defending Breeders' Cup Mile champion **Singletary** (Sultry Song) third-place money. "He really broke sharp and the he relaxed," explained winning jockey Alex Solis. "I just let him roll along. he's got a half-mile run in him that is special. You can ask him for it and you'll get it for sure." According to trainer Ron McAnally, Sweet Return will be pointed toward the GI Arlington Million Aug. 13.

GONBARDA VICTORIOUS AT DUSSELDORF

While Eswarah (GB) tried and failed to best elder males in Saturday's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., **Gonbarda (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) bridged the generation gap to take the German equivalent, the G1 Deutschland Preis Sunday at Dusseldorf. Her climb to the top has been steady, narrowly missing the juvenile fillies' crown when second in the G3 Preis der Winterk-onigin at Baden-Baden in October before making a winning return in the Apr. 23 Listed Jean Harzheim- Rennen at Cologne. Fourth behind Iota (Ger) in both the May 16 G3 Schwarzgold-Rennen and the June 5 G1 Preis der Diana at Hamburg, she rebounded to win the G3 Alice-Cup back at that venue July 1. Breaking smartly this time, she settled in a stalking role in the downpour and arrived at the head of affairs with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Tackled by Collier Hill there, she took charge soon after and showed grit to pull clear in the closing stages. Fourth behind that foe in the G1 Pacific Classic Aug. 22, his final race of the season, the five-year-old resurfaced with another fourth in the seven-furlong GII San Carlos H. at Santa Anita Feb. 26. Shipped to Nad al Sheba for the Dubai World Cup Mar. 26, Choctaw Nation showed some fight and came on late to finish fourth before being sent to the sidelines for a rest. A flat fifth in his latest in the GII Californian H. June 18, the bay was none-the-less sent off the 8-5 choice here. Andre Fabre does not mistake geese for swans and it had to be significant that he put dual conditions scorer Archange d'Or up against stable star Hurricane Run (Ire) in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 5. "Cherokee's Boy has stolen the Salvator Mile," said track announcer Larry Collmus, and he had it right. Sent off the second choice, Cherokee's Boy went right to the front, then was taken in hand by jockey Aaron Gryder. The five-year-old idled through leisurely fractions of :24.82 and :48.57, hit the gas at the top of the stretch and held Aggadan at bay in the final furlong to win his graded debut. "That's exactly the way we hoped the race would be run, but we never thought he'd get away with a half-mile in :48 and change," said owner David Picarello, one-third on the ZWP Stables Inc. partnership that bred and races the Salvator winner. "We knew we were running against a classy field. But when I saw how easy he was going, I knew he would be tough to catch." Cherokee's Boy used the same tactics to take the June 11 Brandywine H. at Delaware Park by a neck. Shipped to Monmouth for his next start, the July 2 Skip Away S., he had to battle early, but pulled away late to win by 1 3/4 lengths. Impressed with that effort, his connections decided to give the bay a shot in graded stakes company, and he responded with his third straight victory. The son of Citidancer might get the chance to add to his streak in the Aug. 28 GIII Philip Iselin Breeders' Cup H. "We have to talk it over with [trainer Gary Capuano], but we'd like to come back for the Iselin," Picarello said. "We know he likes the track."

Winner of the GI Hollywood Derby during his sophomore year, the versatile English bred came back at four to take the one-mile GII Frank Kilroe Mile and the 10-furlong GII San Marcos H. before finishing second over a soggy turf course at Churchill Downs in the nine-panel GI Turf Classic last May. In the money in only one of his final four starts of 2004, and that was in Eddie Read, the five-year-old

showed marked improvement in his return to action this term. Third and second, respectively, going a mile at Santa Anita in the Mar. 5 Kilroe and the GII Arcadia H. Apr. 9., he had to settle for fourth in this year's edition of the Turf Classic May 7. Ready to fire his best last time, the chestnut took the lead and never looked back, winning by a head in the GI Charles Whittingham Memorial H. June 11.

AZAMOUR CLASH ON CARDS FOR MOTIVATOR

The Royal Ascot Racing Club's G1 Epsom Derby winner **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was reported on course for a clash with Azamour (Ire) in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 10. The syndicate's Racing Manager Harry Herbert reported the sophomore, who is currently enjoying a break after his second in the July 2 G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown, is "progressing in quite an impressive manner," before nominating the 10-furlong contest as his next start. "The plan is to go for the Champion S., as long as the ground isn't too firm," Herbert told *PA Sport* yesterday. "It is the race that we had always been thinking about, but we wanted to see how the horse would do for his holiday. So far, he has done particularly well, he has really filled out in the right places and is progressing in quite an impressive manner for such a short period of time of rest. I have never seen a horse look better as a physically specimen. He is nicely covered, his skin looks amazing and he looks magnificent standing up in his box. He is developing before our eyes, and by giving him this break, we are hopeful of a successful autumn campaign and getting him back to winning ways." Despite the tall task ahead, Herbert is relishing upcoming confrontation with Saturday's impressive G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. hero in the Leopardstown race. "Azamour will have everybody quaking in their boots, but that is what it is all about--there are no hiding places from these horses," he added. "Ireland and then on to the [G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 2] is the preferred option, but if Ireland didn't take place for us, for whatever reason, we would probably go to the G3 Arc trial at Newbury [Sept. 16] before the Arc."
