One day before Saratoga opens its storied gates, the five-day meeting dubbed Glorious Goodwood will be conducted at the historic Sussex racecourse. A total of 11 Group races are scheduled to be run, highlighted by Wednesday's G1 Sussex S., the one-mile contest in which champion Soviet Song (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) is set to defend her title. "So far Soviet's preparation has gone nicely and she seems well in herself," trainer James Fanshawe told

At the Races. "Around Goodwood, you just hope that you get some luck in running. I just hope that we get there in one piece and things go smoothly for her during the race." Three of the Group races are for two-year-olds, including the G2 Vintage S. Wednesday, which was won by champion Shamardal last year.

Back in the 1970s, a filly called Girl Friend became one of the stars of French racing. Asked to race frequently at a high level for four seasons, this highly popular mare recorded annual Timeform ratings of 117, 121, 126 and 124. In the process she showed enough stamina to go within a short head of winning the 1,000 Guineas and enough speed--and toughness--to win eight Group 3 sprints in the space of less than 20 months.

It was therefore a bold decision by R.C. Strauss of Kilfrush Stud to select the name New Girlfriend for another French-trained filly. However, lightning appears to have struck twice in pretty much the same place, as New Girlfriend has shown strong signs that she too is heading for the top of her division. After winning the Prix Yacowlef, a five-furlong Listed race for newcomers on July 7, the daughter of Diesis reappeared 17 days later to trounce the opposition in the G2 Prix Robert Papin over an extra sixteenth.

The assessment of her trainer Robert Collet is that New Girlfriend "is something out of the ordinary. She is a filly of enormous potential who will now run in the Prix Morny at Deauville and I feel she will stay even further." Cont. p2

Rider Christophe Soumillon raised the stakes higher when he suggested that New Girlfriend has just as much class as Divine Proportions, winner of last year's Papin. Divine Proportions has gone on to win four Group 1 races, including two Classics, and is now unbeaten in eight starts.

Robert Collet has every right to be thrilled with New Girlfriend, as he purchased her dam New Story for as little as \$25,000 at Keeneland's 1998 September Sale. The filly was sold before her elder sister Dyna's Club had begun to show the type of form that was to earn her victory in the Osunitas H. and over \$300,000.

New Story proved a very shrewd buy at her modest price, earning the equivalent of over \$200,000 in a career which featured several good efforts at Group 1 level. The filly underlined Dynaformer's ability to get the occasional smart juvenile when she finished second of 11 in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac. Although that proved to be her only placing at stakes level in France, New Story also emerged with credit from her sixth in a very strongly contested edition of the French Oaks and another sixth, beaten about seven lengths, against males in the Prix Jacques le Marois.

New Story also tackled the males after her transfer to the States, where she took third place behind Walkslikeaduck in the GII Del Mar Derby. She remained in the U.S. for her broodmare career, starting with a 2001 visit to Distant View, who had already sired a champion--Observatory--from a Roberto line mare.

The choice of Diesis as her second mate in 2002 was also based on plenty of encouraging data. Diesis' best performers during the previous year had included Grade II winner Diadella, who was out of a Dynaformer mare; the smart English miler Duck Row, who is out of a Roberto mare; and G3 Lancashire Oaks winner Sacred Song, who is out of a Red Ransom mare.

The 2001 season had also seen two of Dynaformer's progeny out of Diesis mares become stakes winners, with Dynamous taking the Providencia S. and Spanish John the Premio Giuseppe de Montel. Since then, he has added Dynamist to the list of stakes winners from his first six foals out of Diesis mares.

Of course, the names of Roberto and Diesis have been inextricably linked ever since Diesis sired the top-class Elmaamul from Roberto's daughter Modena early in his long and distinguished career. With the addition of Defacto and Duck Row, there are now three Group/Graded winners among the first 20 foals by Diesis out of Roberto mares.

There are also graded winners bred on the reverse pattern, with Diesis mares producing Bowman Mill and Gastronomical to Roberto's sons Kris S. and Sunshine Forever.

So why does this combination work so well? As the partnership produces no significant inbreeding in recent generations, I suspect that its success is based on the fact that the two male lines complement each other physically. Diesis is quite refined in appearance, a description which could rarely be applied to the big, masculine, rather plain types for which the Roberto line is renowned. Of course, they don't come much bigger or more masculine than the 17-hand Dynaformer. **Cont. p3**

Another factor in the success of the Diesis-Dynaformer partnership could be Dynaformer's broodmare sire His Majesty, a son of Ribot. Diesis and his illustrious brother Kris have both done well with Ribot blood. For example, Diesis sired the dual Oaks winner Diminuendo from a Tom Rolfe mare and Love Divine, another of his Oaks winners, is out of a Ribot-line mare. It was a mare by His Majesty's brother Graustark which produced the triple Classic winner Oh So Sharp (Kris). Remember too that His Majesty sired that fine turf performer Cetewayo, twice a Grade I winner, from a Diesis mare.

As a long-term admirer of Diesis, one aspect of his career which has always surprised me is that his reputation has been based more on top-notch middle-distance performers than on two-year-olds.

Diesis himself was a spectacular juvenile, with victories in both the G1 Middle Park S. and G1 Dewhurst S. Then there's the fact that his brother Kris and his sire Sharpen Up were jointly unbeaten in their nine starts at two and that Diesis' second dam, Soft Angels, was a champion two-year-old filly.

However, Diesis' first two dams were by Reliance and Crepello. Reliance was an outstanding winner of the Grand Prix de Paris and the Prix Royal-Oak over 1 15/16 miles, while Crepello was a Derby winner by Donatello, another major winner at around 15 furlongs. Add in the fact that breeders have often looked to Diesis to inject speed into their middle-distance mares and it is easy to understand why his mature British-raced progeny have an average winning distance of over nine furlongs.

Of course there have been some notable two-year-olds, such as the impressive Three Valleys, the Demoiselle S. winner Rootentootenwooten, the dual Group 2 winner Daggars Drawn and now New Girlfriend. Bearing in mind Diesis' record, there is no reason why New Girlfriend shouldn't continue to excel as the distances lengthen.

Autumn Glory was a poorly disguised stakes horse masquerading as a handicapper last term until blowing his cover with success in the G3 Prix Quincey at Deauville in August. That victory came on testing ground, which he encountered again when besting Sights on Gold (Ire) in the G3 Darley S. at Newmarket in October. He benefitted from kind underfoot conditions when handing Hurricane Alan (Ire) both five pounds and a 1½-length beating in the Mar. 31 Listed Doncaster Mile on his return, and found only the Saint-Cloud specialist Martillo (Ger) too strong in the G2 Prix du Muguet May 1. Stretching out to 10 furlongs for the G3 La Coupe at Longchamp June 16, he ran out of steam late to finish third, but rebounded to defy an unfavorable draw and his first start on the polytrack when taking the July 9 G3 Silver Trophy at Lingfield last time. **Arakan** finished runner-up in this race in 2003 and finds this trip his optimum, as he demonstrated when taking the G3 Criterion S. on Newmarket's July course last June. Sidelined for the rest of the season, he has taken time to regain his momentum, but looked on the way back when splitting the smart Caradak (Ire) and subsequent G3 Meld S. winner Tropical Lady (Ire) in last Sunday's G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh. **Vortex** holds a short-head verdict over **Court Masterpiece** from the June 25 G3 Criterion S. at Newmarket, but could manage only third behind Autumn Glory in the Silver Trophy and needs quicker conditions.

PASTORAL PURSUITS TO STUD The Pursuits and National Stud Partnership's G1 July Cup hero **Pastoral Pursuits (GB)** (Bahamian Bounty {GB}--Star {GB}, by Most Welcome {GB}) has been retired, it was announced yesterday. Trainer Hughie Morrison revealed the news that the four-year-old, who registered his career-best in the premier six-furlong sprint last time July 7, had sustained an injury. "He has had a minor injury to his leg and, sadly, has had to be retired," the conditioner told *PA Sport*. "Given the limited options for him, we were going to struggle to get him ready for the main targets, which were the Prix Maurice de Gheest and the Sprint Cup at Haydock. He needed some rest to recover from the injury and there isn't enough time to have him ready for the races we had in mind." Pastoral Pursuits collected the G3 Sirenia S. at Kempton as a juvenile before injury forced him to the sidelines. He made up for lost time at three with scores in the six-furlong Listed Hackwood S. at Newbury and the G2 Park S. over a panel further at Doncaster. Following unplaced efforts in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp in the fall and in the G1 Queen Anne S. on his return at Royal Ascot at York, he was let go at 22-1 for the Newmarket contest, but proved a length and a half too strong for Avonbridge (GB) on what proved to be his final start. "We are very disappointed, but we achieved our main objective and I would like to think that the July Cup is the most prestigious European sprint--it is certainly the most valuable," Morrison said. "To my mind he won the race pretty easily, and would have improved for the run as well. This won't affect his stud career at all and it could be beneficial in some ways, as he will be able to go there and let down and fill out properly before he starts covering mares in February." Pastoral Pursuits, who was purchased by the National Stud last year, retires to that Newmarket-based operation as the winner of six of his 10 starts with earnings of £264,496. A stud fee is yet to be announced.

No breeding plans have been announced for the four-year-old filly, who will be boarded at Taylor Made Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky. Bred and raced by Frank Manganaro and sons' FJFM Stable, the dark bay captured the GIII Miesque S. at two while defeating Ticker Tape (GB), a subsequent multiple Grade I winner. She added the GIII Sands Point S. to her credit

in 2004 and heads into retirement with a record of 15-4-2-0 and earnings of \$282,180. "She was the best of her crop as a two-year-old on grass," commented trainer Patrick Biancone. "She was very precocious and had a great turn of foot. A wonderful filly to be around." Mambo Slew is a half sister to graded stakes winner **Awesome Time** (Awesome Again), stakes winner **Born Twice** (Opening Verse) and the Grade I-placed **Jess M** (Strawberry Road {Aus}).

MAURICE ZILBER RETIRES One of European racing's leading figures, Maurice Zilber, has announced his retirement from training. The 84-year-old was represented for the last time at Maisons-Laffitte on Sunday when the Khalid Abdullah-owned Highliner (GB) finished sixth in a conditions race. Zilber, famed for his handling of the dual G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. heroine Dahlia, will transfer all 24 horses in his stable to David Smaga. Dahlia, owned by the legendary Nelson Bunker Hunt, won 15 races in five different countries. She took the Ascot showpiece as a three-year-old in 1973 before recording back-to-back successes the following year. The chestnut also won the 1973 G1 Irish Derby before adding two renewals of the G1 Benson and Hedges Gold Cup, now known as the International S., to her tally at York in the trainer's golden age of the mid-'70s. She was the centrepiece of a career that spanned nearly 60 years and also included success in the 1976 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) and G1 Canadian International with Youth and the G1 Epsom Derby in the same year with Empery. Zilber saddled more than 1,000 winners. Teddy Grimthorpe, racing manager for Prince Khalid Abdullah, told *Racing Post*, "He is the most wonderful man, not only a great trainer, but also a great friend of the Prince. His record stands up to the closest inspection." Smaga, who referred to the great horseman as his "second father," added, "He had some health problems two months ago, but is fine now. I am sure we will still be seeing Maurice at the racetrack from time to time."
