Blood-Horse

SOUTHERN IMAGE RETIRED

MGISW Southern Image (Halo's Image--Pleasant Dixie, by Dixieland Band), unraced since he was beaten a nose by Colonial Colony in the 2004 GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs 13 1/2 months ago, will not be making a comeback. The five-year-old had been working toward a possible return at the current Del Mar meet, but was sore behind after working six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 at Hollywood Park July 4. It was not the first setback for the dark bay, who was sidelined by chronic foot problems last summer and failed to make the work tab for 364 days. He breezed six times between June 5 and July 4, but trainer Mike Machowsky has finally decided to give up on the attempt to bring Southern Image back. "He's been great to me," Machowsky said. "He gave me the satisfaction--and sometimes frustration--that comes with training such a talented horse." A winner at Santa Anita for owners Tom and Jerry Kagele and Don Blahut in his only start at two, Southern Image captured the GI Malibu S. at three. He followed with consecutive victories in the Sunshine Millions Classic, GI Santa Anita H. and GI Pimlico Special before ending his career in the Stephen Foster. Southern Image heads to the breeding shed with six wins from eight starts and earnings of \$1,843,750. Stud plans have not yet been determined.

AGAIN AND AGAIN

Already a three-time winner over the Saratoga turf, **Wonder Again** (Silver Hawk) will try to add to that record in today's GI Diana H. The six-year-old mare cruised to a 5 3/4-length victory in the nine-panel Diana last year. Sixth in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. in October, she improved to be third in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, then headed to the sidelines. The bay returned to be third behind **Sand Springs** (Dynaformer) in the June 11 GII Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. and missed by a neck when second in the July 2 GII New York H. "It would be great to win the Diana again," trainer Jimmy Toner said. "This is Saratoga. This is where you always try to shine. This is her last year and this is the one we've been pointing to get the job done." Sand Springs was fourth in last year's Diana, but has two turf wins at the Spa. She returned after a 4 1/2-month layoff to be sixth in a Gulfstream allowance in February, but came back to take the GIII Honey Fox H. in March. Second in the May 7 GIII Distaff Turf Mile H., she led every step in the Just a Game to win by 2 1/2 lengths. Her trainer, Bill Mott, took the title at the Belmont spring meet. The runner-up in the Breeders' Cup F/M Turf to end 2004, **Film Maker** (Dynaformer) won the May 21 GIII Gallorette H. at Pimlico in her return before finishing a troubled third in the New York H.

GOLD DUST

Four-year-old **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}) has history against her in today's G1 Nassau S. at Glorious Goodwood--sophomores have been beaten by their elders only five times since the race was opened up to them in 1975. But that dynamic could be changing as a result of the European Pattern Committee's decision to entice the best distaffers to remain in training. Alexander Goldrun is confirmation that this incentive has worked and her pilot Kevin Manning thinks she can reverse the trends in the Nassau. Noel and Miriam O'Callaghan's **Alexander Goldrun** burst on to the international scene last season when doubling up in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp on Arc day and G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin in December. She added the June 25 G1 Pretty Polly S. to her resume at The Curragh before finding Soviet Song (Ire) too hot last time in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 5. "The main thing that I like about this filly is that she has got a great turn of foot," Kevin Manning told *PA Sport*. "She was just beaten by a very good horse at Newmarket and there were no complaints. When you enter Group 1 company every horse is a danger, but we are confident taking anyone on--she's got every chance tomorrow." Of the three-year-olds, Susan Magnier and Micahel Tabor's **Virginia Waters** bids to get her season back on track after a scintillating success in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1. Off the board in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later, she ran fourth in the June 3 G1 Epsom Oaks and has been rested since her lifeless sixth in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot at York June 17. Setsquare Recruitment's **Something Exciting (GB)** (Halling) was runner-up to Eswarah (GB) in the Epsom Classic before finishing a lackluster fourth in the June 16 G2 Ribblesdale S. at the Royal meeting at York. Conditioner David Eslworth is hoping she can turn that around. "That York race was not a true reflection of the filly's ability," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. "The ground was rough and it was a disaster. I would be very surprised and very disappointed if she did not run much better tomorrow." Sir Michael Stoute has saddled seven winners, including the last two heroines in Russian Rhythm and Favourable Terms (GB). Today he relies on Cheveley Park Stud's **Red Bloom (GB)** (Selkirk), who has 1 1/2 lengths to find on Alexander Goldrun (Ire) from the Pretty Polly.

Freshened after finishing ninth in the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby, **Flower Alley** was the favorite for his return in the July 4 GII Dwyer S., but came up a half length short behind Roman Ruler. "I think he was a race away from where he needed to be," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "The horse has trained really well since and I think he is sitting on a big race." Pletcher, bidding for a third straight Saratoga training title, already has six winners at the meet and has saddled the last two Jim Dandy victors. Trainer Nick Zito, little more than a week away from his induction into the Hall of Fame, sends out **Andromeda's Hero**, who was eighth in the Kentucky Derby and second in the June 11 GI Belmont S., and **Noble Causeway**, who was 14th on the first Saturday in May and sixth in the May 21 GI Preakness. Zito felt that colt had excuses for his less-than-stellar Triple Crown campaign. "He never had a chance to do anything in the Derby and Preakness with the trips he had," the Brooklyn native said. "I look forward to him starting off the second half of the year and hopefully come back and get those two races off his chart."

Perfect Drift, winner of this race in 2003, was second to **Freefourinternet** on his last trip to Illinois, losing by 1 3/4 lengths in the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup last October. Fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic and third in the GII Clark H. to end the year, the gelding opened 2005 with an allowance score on the turf at Keeneland in April. He could do no better than ninth after hitting serious traffic in the May 7 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic, then switched back to the dirt to be third in the June 18 GI Stephen Foster H. He faces Gary Tanaka's latest import, **Billy Allen**.

The Irish-bred captured four of the five races in the European All-Weather Championship Series, winning in France, Germany, Italy and Sweden, but finishing 11th in the Winter Derby at Lingfield Park in March. He was fifth in his latest try, the Grand Prix de Compiègne on the turf June 29. Freefourinternet has been off the board in eight of his nine starts since taking the Hawthorne Gold Cup, most recently running

fifth in a turf allowance at Churchill July 10. GII Super Derby hero **Fantasticat** was off the board in his last three starts of 2004, but just missed in his 2005 debut, rallying to get second in an optional claimer in Louisville July 4. "He needed a freshening," trainer Bobby Barnett explained. "He popped a quarter crack at the end of the year, so we gave him as much time as he needed. But he should benefit from that Churchill race and we expect him to give a good performance Saturday."

Twice placed in Listed races in France, **Louvain** opened her U.S. account with a two-length win over **Royal Copenhagen** in the GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood in November. The bay took a winter break, returning to be sixth in the June 5 GII Honeymoon Breeders' Cup H., but turned it around in her second start of the year, closing to take the July 4 Flawlessly S. by 1 1/2 lengths, with Royal Copenhagen second once again and **Island Escapade** another head back in third. **Salsa Brava** was the runner-up in Group 2 company in back-to-back races while competing in Britain as a juvenile, ending her British stint with a fourth-place finish against colts in the G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury in September. Ready's Gal opened her career with a 2 3/4-length victory on the Saratoga main track last August and came back at the end of the meet to win an allowance test by two. She started just once more last season, finishing second by a half length in the GI Frizette S. at Belmont in October, then disappeared for seven months. The chestnut filly returned to be fourth in an allowance test at Churchill Downs May 6, but tired badly to be a distant fifth in a seven-furlong affair at Belmont Park June 4.

Ready's Gal was switched to the turf after that effort and showed an immediate affinity for the surface, wiring the field in the Little Silver S. at Monmouth June 26. Looking to make it two in a row on the lawn, she settled just off the pace this time, then fought through an opening at the fence at the eighth pole and edged clear. Referring to the decision to try the filly on the grass, trainer Todd Pletcher said, "It was an educated guess. We knew some of the More Than Readys were handling the turf, and she had just sort of lost her way on the dirt. I worked her on the turf with English Channel, and he couldn't go by her--I thought that was all I needed to know." [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

John Fretwell's Always Hopeful was not the candidate in the eyes of punters, who let him go at 12-1, but he confounded those doubters with a power display. In doing so, he provided a career high for the owner, trainer and jockey combination of John Fretwell, Eoghan O'Neill and Graham Gibbons. Fifth in the furiously run July 16 Weatherbys Super Sprint over five furlongs at Newbury last time, he improved for the extra panel here, racing prominently from the outside box before edging into an outright lead at halfway. Soon clear, he was pushed out by Gibbons to easily turn down Upper Hand. "I always thought he was a bit special," his rider said. "His first three runs were over five, but I told John after we worked the horse last week that, when we step him up to six, he's going to be different class. How good he is we'll have to find out, but it's a long year." Always Hopeful caught a tartar when runner-up to the speedy Classic Encounter (Ire) on debut at Newmarket May 29 before taking a Nottingham maiden June 15 and running fifth at Newbury. This race was screaming out for her to have a go at, and I'm glad it's gone right. She scoped clean and we were hopeful. She's won two Group 3s and £400,000 and I wish I had a yard full of them."

He spotted significant weight and raced 4w in the Dwyer, earning a better figure than Roman Ruler despite losing to him. With four weeks rest and only 3 1/2 points of development from his first established level, a repeat of his top is likely and he is likely to win. Right now, Flower Alley is the early favorite for the Travers.

This is a tough pattern to read, and a forward move is not impossible, but he has some lengths to make up on Flower Alley.

Which won't win unless Flower Alley backs up, but should get a check.

Improved quite a bit this spring, paired up that effort, and then bounced last time. The pair of tops followed by an off-race pattern has been good to us over the years, and this horse should run well—for him. But that still leaves him a few lengths away from competitive with these.

Overview — Flower Alley spots about a point of weight, but that still leaves him a couple of points (about four at this distance) the fastest going in.

In response, NYRA officials reconfigured the barns, eliminating six stalls in each to give more space to the horses, and ordered rubber mats, which will be installed on the plywood floors so that the footing will be more secure. The barns have also been upgraded so that each horse can have a fan.
