**ARTIE SCHILLER BACK ON TOP IN BARUCH**

Denied a trip to the winner's circle in his two most recent outings this term, **Artie Schiller** (El Prado {Ire}) wore down a dead-game **Silver Tree** (Hennessy) in the final strides to take Monday's GI Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga Race course. Settled just behind a soft early pace set by Silver Tree, Artie Schiller forged past that foe in deep stretch and inched clear to record his second win in as many starts over the historic turf course. "At the top of the stretch, I thought Silver Tree [second] had us," said winning trainer Jimmy Jerkens. "I still can't believe he did it. This has to be one of his best races." Justifiably confident in his mount's chances, jockey Richard Migliore was worried that the colt was not getting hold of the ground, but that fear quickly dissipated. "When I turned for home, I clucked at him and let him swing out to get on better ground," he explained. "It seemed like he caught his beat." (cont. p2)

**OFFLEE WILD TO STAND AT DARLEY IN 2006**

GI Massachusetts H. and GI Suburban H. winner **Offlee Wild** (Wild Again) has been purchased Darley and will stand the 2006 season at Jonabell Farm. The five-year-old, who will continue to represent AZ Azalea

Stables for the remainder of the current racing season, is under consideration for Saturday's GI Whitney H., and is expected to cap off the season in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, which will be held at Belmont Park Oct. 29. "To have the services of a stallion prospect who broke his maiden at two, won graded races at three,

four and five, and having a perennial leading sire in the second dam opens up limitless possibilities for breeders," said Jimmy Bell, president of Darley U.S.A. A winner of the GIII Holy Bull S. and third in the GI Blue Grass S. during his sophomore season, the \$325,000 KEESep yearling purchase won the Mass 'Cap at four, but has enjoyed his best season at five. Second by a neck in the John B. Campbell Breeders' Cup H. at Laurel Feb. 19, the dark bay romped by 8 1/2 lengths in the GIII Excelsior H. Apr. 2, but failed to fire and had to settle for sixth in the GI Pimlico Special May 20. Back to his best form for his latest, he recorded his first Grade I stakes victory in Belmont's Suburban July 2. Offlee Wild's stud fee will be set at the conclusion of his racing career.

**Chekhov Confirmed; Surf Cat Out**

Trainer Patrick Biancone has confirmed that **Chekhov** (Pulpit) will contest Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational H.

at Monmouth and that Gary Stevens will have the mount aboard the three-year-old. The bay is slated to breeze tomorrow at Saratoga before shipping down to the Jersey Shore. "He continues to progress very well," Biancone said. "He was a late foal. He's still immature, but he's learning with every race

and, like I said, he's progressing nicely." Biancone saddled **Lion Heart** to win last year's Haskell. Among the other confirmed starters for the \$1-million contest are GII Dwyer S. hero **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus). "He's doing better than he ever has been in his life," trainer Bob Baffert enthused. "He's shipping Thursday and Jerry Bailey is riding." The California-based **Surf Cat** (Sir Cat) had been considered for the Haskell following the withdrawal of marquee runner **Afleet Alex**, but will now stay at Del Mar after shipping problems arose. "We appreciated the invitation and all the offers," trainer Bruce Headley said, "but the travel just didn't work out." The sophomore will take on his elders in the \$1-million GI Pacific Classic Aug. 21. "We're very happy to stay home," Headley added. "We love running in the Pacific Classic."

**Saint Liam Primed for Whitney**

**Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado) breezed five furlongs over Saratoga's Oklahoma training track yesterday morning in preparation for Saturday's GI Whitney H. The winner of this year's GI Donn H. and Stephen Foster H. covered the distance in 1:02 1/5, the fastest of six moves at the distance. "He's ready," said Rudy Rodriguez, who was aboard for the work. "I honestly think he's doing as good if not better than ever...If he runs his race and we get a little luck, he's going to be tough." Although confident in his horse's chances, trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. remains guardedly optimistic. "My only concern is him getting along with the track," he said. "He can do some goofy things sometimes which, we all know. But if he runs the way he's trained, he should be tough." Dutrow, who has also nominated stablemate **Offlee Wild** (Wild Again) to the Whitney, stated that it is unlikely that both horses will meet this weekend. "I don't want to run both against each other," he said. "I'm going to run Offlee Wild if it comes up wet. Otherwise, Saint Liam is going."

The winner of five starts in 2004, including the GII Hall of Fame H. over course and trip and the GII Jamaica H. at Belmont in September, the bay closed out his campaign with a lackluster 12th in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Lone Star Oct. 30. Back on top in the one-mile GII Maker's Mark H. at Keeneland Apr. 15, Artie Schiller found himself a nose short of Cool Conductor in the nine-furlong GII Dixie H. at Pimlico May 21. A game third, beaten only a half length, in the 10-furlong GI Manhattan H. at Belmont June 11, the four-year-old was installed the 2-5 choice for a return to his best distance.

"The long stretch can be pretty taxing on a front running horse," winning jockey Robert Landry explained. "My filly was in the game the whole way. [Tara's Touch] is a pretty uncomplicated filly. I was just a passenger. She's the kind you like to ride." Heather Stark, assistant trainer for Kentucky-based Niall O'Callaghan, said Tara's Touch was given all of 2004 off after her acquisition. "She shipped in from overseas, so we wanted to give her a chance to get used everything [in North America]," she said. "So we took our time with her. We knew she was a good filly."

When it comes to this year's top mile events in Europe, I guess you could say it has been the Year of the Mambo Kings. No, not the Castillo brothers of the celebrated novel and movie, but the descendants of Mr. Prospector's highest-priced stallion son.

Kingmambo has been directly responsible for the winners of the 1000 Guineas in England and France, in the shape of Virginia Waters and Divine Proportions, and he has also made a sizeable indirect impact. His broodmare daughter Vallee des Reves is the dam of Maids Causeway, the heroic winner of the G1 Coronation S., and now his Classic-winning son King's Best has supplied Proclamation, an impressive last-to-first winner of last week's G1 Cantor Spreadfair Sussex S.

That Sussex S. victory improved Proclamation's record to four wins from five starts, his only setback coming on his second start, when he boiled over in the Dante S. over an extended mile and a quarter. His trainer, Jeremy Nosedá, later said, "at York he just pulled and had no chance after a furlong. The only thing to do was to come back in trip and get some pace in front of him." That ploy has worked well, with the colt displaying tremendous acceleration in coming through from the rear to win three stakes, including a victory of the G3 Jersey S. over seven furlongs.

Proclamation is proving a first-rate advertisement for King's Best, who earned an increase in fee to €35,000 this year, after achieving an impressive total of over 20 juvenile winners from his first crop, which numbers 112 foals. Those 20-odd winners included the Group 3-winning filly Dubai Surprise, who finished a fine second when she took on the colts in the G1 Criterium International, and Elliotts World, winner of the Acomb S.

Proclamation has boosted the total of stakes winners to three and there could well be more to come from this first crop, as Earl's Court, Fading Light, Sailor King, Oiseau Rare and Runaway have all earned black type.

Some of these black-type performers were produced by the natural desire of breeders to reinforce the Nureyev blood of Kingmambo's exceptional dam Miesque. Sailor King is out of a Nureyev mare, and is therefore inbred 4x2, whereas Runaway and Earl's Court are out of Sadler's Wells mares, creating 5x3 inbreeding to Northern Dancer and 5x4 to Special. Of course, it was Sadler's Wells mares which produced Divine Proportions, El Condor Pasa and Virginia Waters to Kingmambo.

Much as this type of inbreeding appeals to pedigree pundits such as myself, I'm afraid to say that the mating which produced Proclamation doesn't involve a single duplication in the first five generations.

No doubt because he is grey and carries his head a little high, Proclamation reminds me of Zeddaan, the sire of his second dam, a useful miler called Shannfara.

The two-year-old Zeddaan showed the type of explosive speed associated with his grandsire, the tremendously temperamental Grey Sovereign. Undefeated in his first five starts, from 4½ to 5½ furlongs, Zeddaan ended his first season with two seconds to older horses in five-furlong sprints. A career as a sprint specialist seemed to beckon. Francois Mathet had other ideas, though, and Zeddaan began his second season with impressive victories in the French 2000 Guineas and the 9.2-furlong Prix d'Ispahan. In the process, he displayed the type of acceleration which has characterized Proclamation's triumphs.

Zeddaan was sent to Japan as a 13-year-old, but not before he had sired three top-class sons in Kalamoun, Nishapour and Nadjar. Kalamoun--another grey with quite a high head carriage and a brilliant turn of foot--had a phenomenal record as a stallion and it is interesting that his son Persepolis ranks as the broodmare sire of Fading Light, a King's Best filly who has twice finished third at Group-3 level.

It is no surprise that Proclamation is highly strung. King's Best took strong exception to being restrained when he finished last as second favourite for the Dewhurst S. at the end of his first season and he was prone to sweat up. However, he settled well in the 2000 Guineas before producing a spectacular effort, which took him 3 1/2 lengths clear of Giant's Causeway.

Also, Proclamation's dam, Shamarra, has four lines to the tempestuous Nasrullah (as well as two to the stayer Wild Risk).

As might be guessed from her pedigree, Shamarra was bred by the Aga Khan. However, she never made it to the races and she was by Zayyani, a Darshaan horse who won nothing more important than the G3 Greenham S. Consequently, she was soon considered surplus to requirements and was sold for Ir55,000gns at Goffs' February Sale in 1998, when carrying her first foal, by the comparatively inexpensive Kahyasi.. To the Aga Khan, Shamarra was probably just another filly, but to her buyer, Cathal Ryan of Swordlestown Stud, she offered a chance to revive the glory days of her illustrious female line. This line traces back to Teresina, one of the foundation mares of the late Aga Khan's tremendously successful stud.

Ryan immediately sent Shamarra to Danehill, whose fee in 1998 was Ir35,000gns, and the daughter of Zayyani subsequently visited the top-class racehorses Hernando, Desert Prince and King's Best. Proclamation, whose recent progress might have something to do with his May 1 birthdate, isn't her first stakes winner. That distinction went to No Refuge, Shamarra's son by Hernando. After becoming a Listed winner over 1 7/8 miles, No Refuge was sold for 180,000gns and has since become a Group-1 winner over hurdles.

Shamarra is the third non-winning daughter of Shanfara to become the dam of a group winner and she is also a half sister to Shantaroun, a Green Dancer colt who was well above average in Britain and Australia.

Proclamation's second dam, Shannfara, also had a distinguished half sister in Sherkala, a group-placed winner who ranks as the third dam of the outstanding miler Sendawar. Sendawar numbered the French 2000 Guineas, St James's Palace S. and Prix du Moulin among his wins in 1999 and it's far from impossible that Proclamation could end the year with a similarly impressive resumé.

While the former, who finally garnered his Group 1 win in the June 19 Gran Premio di Milano at the San Siro, is boarding with Luca Cumani, the G1 Japan Cup hero is at Geoff Wragg's barn. Connections of Electrocutionist are confident that the four-year-old will hold his own in the 10-furlong contest. "Electrocutionist has earned a shot at a big one and we are optimistic that he will perform well against some of the best in Europe at York," Racing Manager Aaron Coen told the *Racing Post*. "Twelve furlongs appears to be his best trip, but we think that York would be the perfect track for him to return to the lesser distance." Zenno Rob Roy, who also has the G1 Tenno Sho and G1 Arima Kinen to his resume, is due to be broadcast live to his home nation when he takes in the York test. Owner's representative Nobutaka Tada told the *Post*, "He is a class horse, he could win from one mile to two miles. Fast ground would be preferable, but he handled heavy ground in Japan. Yutaka Take rides; he has not ridden him before, but he is an easy horse to ride." Tada also revealed that the five-year-old could take in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 10.

**INTERNATIONAL DATE FOR DANCER** Jeff Smith's **Norse Dancer (GB)** (Halling) will be aimed at the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 16 following his second in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Newbury. The David Elsworth-trained five-year-old split Sulamani (Ire) and Bago (Fr) when second in York's 10-furlong contest 12 months ago and proved he retained his ability when again finishing in front of Bago in the Newbury showpiece last Saturday.
