ALL SAINT'S DAY?

Is **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado) the leader of the pack? He can prove it with a win in today's GI Whitney S. at

Saratoga. Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. believes that the presence of speedster **Commentator** (Distorted Humor) will provide an assist to his charge's chances. "I believe Saint Liam's best race is when he has a target," said Dutrow. "That's for damn sure--that's what he loves. So if he likes this track, you're liable to see him run the best race he's

ever run." The five-year-old will have to put on an outstanding display to eclipse his performance in last year's GI Woodward S., where he carried level weights with Horse of the Year Ghostzapper and was beaten just a neck. He came back to take the GII Clark H. in November, then opened 2005 with a 3 3/4-length victory over Roses in May in the Feb. 5 GI Donn H. Saint Liam faded to sixth in the Mar. 5 GI Santa Anita H., but rebounded with a 2 3/4-length score in the June 18 GI Stephen Foster H. "I think he's the fastest horse going two turns right now," said Dutrow. Commentator led gate to wire to win his first five starts by a combined 42 1/4 lengths. He took on graded foes and two turns for the first time in the Jan. 8 GIII Hal's Hope H., but tired to be seventh behind Badge of Silver. Sidelined after that race, he came back to take a seven-furlong optional claimer at Belmont by 16 1/2 lengths. "He's an amazing horse," trainer Nick Zito said. "We'll find out if he can go a distance. If not, we'll just regroup."

SARATOGA STYLE

Sense of Style (Thunder Gulch), two-for-two at Saratoga last year, looks to keep her Spa winning

streak alive in the GI Test S. at seven furlongs this afternoon. The bay cruised to a 6 3/4-length score over track and trip in the GII Spinaway S. and added a victory in the GI Matron S. at Belmont in September, but was off the board when trying a mile and a sixteenth in the Oct. 6 GII Darley Alcibiades S. and Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Out of action for more than seven months after finishing ninth at Lone Star Park, she made her return in the two-turn Revidere S. at Monmouth Park June 4 and ran second by a nose. Trainer Patrick Biancone dropped her back to six furlongs for the July 9 GI Prioress S. and the three-year-old finished well to be third behind **Acey Deucey** (Abaginone) and **Maddalena** (Good and Tough). "Her last race makes me believe she's heading in the right direction," Biancone said. "I think the seven furlongs really suits her well and I think she will pass the test--I believe she can win this race." **In the Gold** (Golden Missile) also boasts a graded-stakes score at seven panels, taking the GII Beaumont S. over **Aspen Tree** (Holy Bull) at Keeneland in April. Second in the May 6 GI Kentucky Oaks, she forged to the front at midstretch in the June 4 GI Acorn S. last time out, but was overtaken by Round Pond and Smuggler in the stretch and ended up third. **Test field, p2**

A distant third after setting the pace in the GI Test S. at Saratoga a year ago, Forest Music had twice won against non-graded stakes company in her seven starts since. The gray filly captured the Seton Hall University S. at the Meadowlands last fall and added an 8 1/2-length score in her third start this term, the Apr. 16 Primonetta S. at Laurel. She returned to the graded ranks for the May 14 GII Genuine Risk S. last time out and cut out the early fractions before fading to third. Sent right to the front here, the crowd's third choice dashed off a half in :44.43, opened up a six-length lead at midstretch and, despite shortening stride in the final furlong, held on. Thoro-Graph Race of the Week

Saturday, Saratoga

WHITNEY H.-GI, \$750,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/8m
This year's Whitney is a great handicapping exercise, involving sheet patterns, trainer patterns, weight differentials and trip handicapping.

Was one of several Zito runners in the last couple of years that has fired his best shot off a layoff. The first GP effort was the best of his life, and the one that followed almost as good. Since then he has tailed off some, with the last four just decent. At the weights and with the rail, his best would give him a shot to win this, but that's unlikely to happen until he is freshened again.

2 Saint Liam	Saint Ballado	Prado	122

Good at three and early four, but improved dramatically last fall, and with the retirement of Ghostzapper can now make a case for being the best horse in training. Dutrow has spaced his races and three of his last five have been enormous, with one of the sub-par efforts coming after less rest than usual and a cross-country ship. He has seven weeks into this one, and may well fire one of his big ones, but it's important to note that five pounds of weight carried is worth one TG point. One of Saint Liam's best efforts would give him a big shot, but wouldn't guarantee a win, and anything less would probably not be good enough at the weights.

3 Wiggins	Cartwright	Guidry	112

Was a good 3yo that has developed very little since. His first two this year were sub-par, but he went to Romans before his last and, as seems to happen more and more these days, he instantly improved. Another forward move would put him in the middle of things here at the weights. Your guess is as good as mine.

4a Commentator	Distorted Humor	Stevens	115

We were responsible for the purchase of Distorted Humor as a racehorse, and we've gotten a big kick out of his success as a sire. He gets horses that run fast and show up often. Commentator worked his way down to a very good 3yo figure over a one-turn mile, and then suffered an injury in his only try around two turns. He took the Zito/layoff thing to the extreme last time, returning with a Ghostzapperish figure and, at the weights, saving ground on the lead, a repeat effort would win off.

It's anybody's guess whether he can handle the distance and how much the big one took out of him, but he has had five weeks' rest, and even a two or three-point bounce would make him tough to beat.

5 Swingforthe fences	Boston Harbor	Coa	113

A solid 3yo and ran well, if not spectacularly, in his first two starts this year. His last came not only in the slop but over a dead rail, and he's primed for the race of his life. That is why he should be running someplace else, where he could have a shot.

6 Eurosilver	Unbridled's Song	Albarado	114

Ran a big race in his last start at two, slightly better at early three, but showed no development at all for the next 14 months--not a healthy sign. He finally broke through last time, but the necessary forward move is unlikely, given the overall pattern, though a repeat could get a check.

Something of an early developer, but he has improved some this year, running well over the winter and cycling back to win the Brooklyn before bouncing when shipped cross-country. Pletcher and Velazquez have been winning everything and this horse will get bet, but he is a major bet-against given the weights. He has never run fast enough to make an impact with these, and his pattern is suspect.

8 Pollard's Vision	Carson City	Bailey	117

Has a much more solid pattern than Limehouse, with his last five all good. But he's another that has never run fast enough to make a serious impact at the weights, especially considering prospective ground loss.

Overview--If either Saint Liam or Commentator runs their race, it's unlikely anyone else can win. The Pletcher trainees are underlays, so it might be worthwhile using longshots underneath.

MGISW Pico Central (Brz) (Spend a Buck), who finished ninth and last as the 5-2 favorite in the July 31 GI Bing Crosby H. at Del Mar, could be heading for retirement, according to the *Daily Racing Form*. The six-year-old, who bled in the Bing Crosby, is slated to undergo a series of tests. "We'll check his blood and ultrasound his lungs," trainer Paulo Lobo told *DRF*. "Aside from the bleeding, he's perfect." The Horse of the Year and champion sprinter in his native Brazil, Pico Central won five of seven starts last year, including the GI Carter H., GI Met Mile and GI Vosburgh S., where he had Eclipse winner Speightstown back in third. The bay skipped the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and ended the season with a third-place finish in the GI Cigar Mile H., a result that likely cost him year-end honors. He opened 2005 with a fourth-place finish in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Nad al Sheba in March, then was given a break before returning in the Bing Crosby. To date, the Gary Tanaka colorbearer has won nine of his 17 career starts and bankrolled \$1,283,145. As to his future, Lobo told *DRF*, "We'll make a decision next week." Pico Central is scheduled to go to stud at Padua Stables in Summerfield, Florida in 2006.

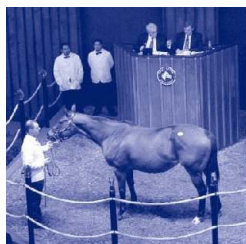

Ellis Reduces Overnight Purses:

Due to lower-than-expected business, officials at Ellis Park in Henderson, Kentucky, have announced a 15-percent decrease in overnight purses, effective with the program of Wed., Aug. 10. In addition, the purses for the Governor's H. and the Tri-State H. have been reduced from \$75,000 to \$50,000. "The decision to reduce purses for the remaining weeks of the Ellis Park meet is disappointing, but it was a move that had to be made in light of business levels," explained Paul Kuerzi, vice president and general manager of Ellis Park. "Our daily racing operation continues to face ever-growing pressure in the competition for horses with racetracks in other states that offer larger purses boosted by slot machine revenues," he added.

Mandatory Disclosure of Vet Practices Postponed:

The Monitoring Committee for the Sales Integrity Program announced yesterday that it is postponing the implementation of the mandatory disclosure of acceptable veterinary practices. The SIP Code of Ethics, which defines these practices as surgery that results in permanent change to a horse's conformation, originally called for mandatory disclosure beginning with the foal crop of 2005. Reynolds Bell, Jr., chairman of the Monitoring Committee, explained, "As we were implementing this particular provision of the code, certain issues and concerns were raised about the information management process for acceptable veterinary practices. After careful consideration by the Monitoring Committee and an open discussion with members of the Sales Integrity Task Force and consignors, we felt it was best to postpone implementation of this provision until these issues and concerns were fully addressed. However, until next year when a new implementation plan for mandatory disclosure is developed, we encourage sellers and consignors to voluntarily disclose this information." The subcommittees will look into the development of effective record-keeping procedures and a centralized database to store all of the information collected.
