COMMENTATOR THE TALK OF THE TOWN

All of the focus was on MGISW **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado) going into yesterday's GI Whitney H. at the Spa, but it was the gritty New-York bred **Commentator** (Distorted Humor) who stole the show. Gunned to the front by Gary Stevens, the chestnut set quick fractions of :23.56 and :46.41 with Saint Liam sitting a stalking second. Trailing by 5 1/2 lengths through six furlongs in 1:09.76, Saint Liam began to cut down on the lead soon thereafter, but just couldn't get by Commentator, who prevailed by a neck. "This is probably the most important victory of my life," said trainer Nick Zito, who will be inducted into the Racing Hall of Fame Monday. "I didn't know if he could go the distance...I think we'll wait for the Woodward [GI, Sept. 10]." **cont. p3**

"She will rate, but I thought we were very dominant with the speed that she has," trainer Eric Kruljac said. "She just keeps getting better and better...I kind of doubt we're going in the [GI] Ballerina [Aug. 28]. "

Roman Ruler was one of the more hyped two-year-olds last season after beginning his career with a sharp Hollywood maiden win and a seven-length tally in Del Mar's GII Best Pal S. Sent off at 1-10 in the GII Del Mar Futurity, he finished a neck short behind champion two-year-old Declan's Moon. The dark bay redeemed himself with a win in the GII Norfolk S., but could do no better than fifth as the chalk in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile S. The \$500,000 KEESEP yearling purchase began his sophomore campaign with a lackluster eighth in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 19, but got back on track in his latest, defeating subsequent GII Jim Dandy S. winner Flower Alley in the GII Dwyer S. July 4. "He's doing really well right now," Baffert added. "He looks like he's coming back to his brilliant juvenile form. The Dwyer was a really nice race and he's doing better than he was for that race." Many had Sun King pegged as the best of Nick Zito's

loaded three-year-old arsenal this season after a dominating allowance score at Gulfstream and a professional GIII Tampa Bay Derby victory, but the dark bay didn't move forward when placed on the biggest stage this spring. He followed his well-beaten fourth in the GI Blue Grass S. with a 15th-place finish in the GI Kentucky Derby and a fourth-place finish in the GI Preakness S. Freshened up after the second leg of the Triple Crown, Sun King got back on track in his latest, taking Delaware Park's GIII Leonard Richards S. by 5 3/4 lengths in wire-to-wire fashion.

Ready for Another Stroll in the Park...

It's no secret that **Park Avenue Ball** (Citdancer) loves Monmouth Park. The chesnut opened his account with two wins over this course as a two-year-old, including the Tyro S. before notching the GII Futurity S. at Belmont. He held his own in Florida this winter, finishing second in the GII Hutcheson S., sixth in the GII Fountain of Youth S. and fourth in the GI Florida Derby. He turned in one of his better efforts in the GIII Withers S., where he was second behind Scrappy T, then followed with a razor sharp victory in this track's GIII Long Branch Breeders' Cup July 16. "He obviously likes the track," trainer James Ryerson said. "And he doesn't have to ship for this race. I think the mile and a eighth races he ran in Florida, he had too much to do. He didn't get off great and got in trouble."

Commentator began his career in fine fashion, winning five starts by a combined 43 1/4 lengths, including a seven-length tally in Keeneland's Perryville S. He suffered his first career defeat when seventh in the nine-furlong Gill Hal's Hope S. at Gulfstream Jan. 8, then was placed on the sidelines for the next five months. Brought back in a \$75,000 optional claimer at Belmont facing only three rivals last time June 29, the gelding blazed seven furlongs in 1:20 1/5 and earned a 121 Beyer Speed Figure in the process.

The Graveyard of Favorites....

Leading older horse Saint Liam, who was favored at odds of 3-5, had to settle for second money. "He ran well," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. said. "I knew we could [get nine furlongs]. I didn't know Commentator could. I'm not going to complain about nothing. I'm proud of him. It's just a shame we couldn't win. Hopefully, we'll live to fight another day."

Leave Me Alone has come a long way since finishing 11th over the Hollywood turf last December. She kicked off her sophomore season with a maiden win at Santa Anita over state bred, then added a restricted first-level allowance. Stepped up to open company in her next start, she held her own, finishing second in the Santa Paula S. Apr. 2. Stretched out in distance to 1 1/16 miles for another tilt versus Cal bred in the Melair S., she crossed the line four lengths clear. Freshened up off that stakes score, she could only manage a fourth-place finish as the 3-2 chalk in the GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks June 12. Cut back in distance for Calder's Azalea Breeders' Cup S. July 10, she gamely defeated Hide and Chic by a nose. Backed as the third choice here, she broke well from the one hole beneath Kent Desormeaux and carved out :22.42 and :45.46 splits with Maddalena a close second. Asked to quicken in the stretch, the chestnut responded and cruised home to a dominating victory. Notable Guest started to meet his potential this term when taking a Newmarket handicap Apr. 30 and defying an unfavorable draw to win the June 18 Duke of Edinburgh S. at Royal Ascot at York. He returned to that venue for the valuable John Smiths Cup July 9, and there appeared more than another bad post position to blame for a lifeless effort, but connections maintained the faith. They were rewarded with an impressive first stakes score here. Not content with the pedestrian early fractions, Richard Hughes allowed the four-year-old to stride to the fore on the backstretch as Richard Hills waited with the 4-6 pick David Junior. Kicking clear inside the final three furlongs, Notable Guest was beyond recall as the favorite floundered in pursuit. "The plan was to get in behind and get him relaxed and he was quite settled when I jumped out," Hughes explained. "They were going so slow I let him slide along and he relaxed even going up to the lead. From four out I squeezed him along and when I picked him up the last two, he really flew and wasn't stopping. Nasheej carried a substantial reputation into a Newbury maiden on debut June 30 and emerged with it enhanced after a smooth score. She was unlucky not to finish closer to Confidential Lady when third after suffering a troubled trip in the July 21 Listed Star S. at Sandown on her latest start, but wreaked revenge in a pulsating finish to this competitive renewal. Reserved off the strong early fractions set by Deveron and kept honest passing halfway by Confidential Lady, Nasheej switched out for her challenge late and swept to the front in the final strides of the uphill climb to the line. "I thought that the second horse was the one we had to beat," trainer Richard Hannon said. "My filly got into a lot of trouble at Sandown--she couldn't get out and that was it really--so I was confident of reversing the placings. We'll give her a bit of time now and she'll stay a mile, so we'll probably bring her back for something like the G1 Fillies' Mile [at Newmarket Sept. 24]." **Click for the racingpost.co.uk chart.**

Bully Bones shocked the Hollywood faithful in her 4 1/2-furlong debut, winning at odds of 37-1 Apr. 23, but hadn't been heard from since. The chestnut put together a solid worktab in the interim though, posting a :59 1/5 five-furlong move at Del Mar July 27 and a four-furlong workout over that strip in :46 4/5 Aug. 2. Ridden by Rene Douglas here, she raced right with the leaders through :21.71 and :44.48 splits. She took over when ready at the top of the stretch, opened up a clear lead in the lane and had plenty left to hold off the second-place finisher. "She hadn't raced since April and I was concerned about going 6 1/2 furlongs," trainer David La Croix commented. "I wanted a race for her before the [GI] Debutante [Aug. 27], so we had to go."

If there was one thing that got America's first president going it was the Brits, and Ron Arculli's **Red Clubs** heads the invasion from across the Irish Sea. He followed a brace of visually impressive scores with a performance of substance when winning the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot at York June 14. Shouldered with a harsh penalty in the July 6 G2 July S. at Newmarket, he was only seventh behind Ivan Denisovich (Ire), yet was only beaten just over three lengths on that occasion. "I wasn't particularly disappointed by the Newmarket run--you cannot expect them to win everything and he did have his Group 2 penalty from the Coventry," trainer Barry Hills told *Racing Post*. "He seems to act on any ground, so we'll not be looking for any specific conditions at The Curragh."

Deauville's August festival kicks off in earnest with this specialist contest, which as usual has attracted a stellar array of Europe's sprinters. The field is headed by last year's one-two **Somnus** and **Whipper**. Helped by the soft ground prevalent throughout the 2004 meeting, the former racked up the second Group 1 win of his career 12 months ago, a tally he extended in Longchamp's Prix de la Foret in October. He performed with credit when fourth under a subsequent penalty in the May 11 G2 Duke of York S. at York before throwing in an uncharacteristic below-par effort when trailing in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 7. While Whipper went on to defeat Six Perfections (Fr) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois over this straight mile a week after his eclipse here, the feeling persists that he is best over short of that trip. He underlined that suggestion when only third in the May 1 G2 Prix du Muguet at Saint-Cloud and fourth in the June 12 G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord at Chantilly. "His seasonal comeback in the Prix du Muguet was very pleasing and I'd prefer to overlook his last race, where he was hampered by the lack of pace," Robert Collet told *PA Sport*. "He worked really well at Deauville this week and I'm running **Tycoon's Hill** as his pacemaker."

This is yet another prize that Andre Fabre has farmed in recent times, collecting six renewals since 1989. He relies on the closely matched **Diamond Tango** and **Russian Hill** to add to that haul. Russian Hill has the stronger overall profile. She was one place in front of her stablemate when chasing home the smart Elopa (Ger) in the G2 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud May 30 before outclassing her rivals in the June 2 Listed Grand Prix de Compiègne last time. **Guadalajara** earned her place in this line-up when beating the subsequent G2 Prix Maurice de Nieuil winner Ostantino (Fr) and Diamond Tango in the Listed Grand Prix de Lyon at Lyon Parilly June 25. Last year's G2 Prix de Royallieu heroine **Samando** returned to take the Mar. 10 G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud before filling third spot in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp Apr. 3. Ninth in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji May 15, she was subsequently freshened and returns here. Sir Mark Prescott's raiders are always to be respected and it may be significant that **Songerie** is turned out just eight days after a fine fourth in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood; last year's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner **Paita** showed signs of a return to her best last time when third behind Divine Proportions in the G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 12.

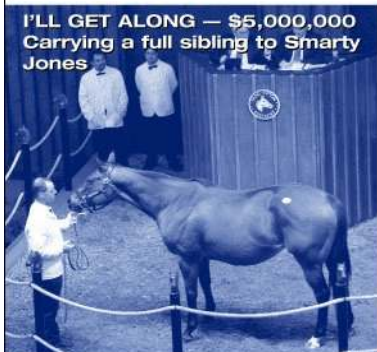

LOST IN THE FOG BREEZES Harry Aleo's **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier), who puts his undefeated record on the line in the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga Aug. 27, worked five furlongs between races yesterday at the Solano County Fair. With regular rider Russell Baze in the saddle, the handsome dark bay clicked off fractions of :34 2/5 for three-eighths and :46 3/5 for the half before completing his move in :57 4/5. "He's a very good work horse," trainer Greg Gilchrist commented. "The time was about what we wanted. I told Russell to go in about :58. He's the kind of horse who doesn't really look like he's going anywhere, but then you look down at the watch and he's really moving." The Florida-bred will be making his third trip to the Empire State, having won the GIII Bay Shore S. in April and the GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S. on the Belmont S. undercard June 11. To date, Lost in the Fog has amassed \$684,075 in his eight victories.

NOBLE CAUSEWAY PULLED UP Noble Causeway (Giant's Causeway), a controversial last-minute scratch from the GII Jim Dandy S. July 30, was pulled up by jockey Ramon Dominguez fewer than two furlongs into yesterday's third race at Saratoga. He was subsequently vanned off. "[Jockey] Ramon [Dominguez] said he warmed up good and broke sharp," trainer Nick Zito explained. "Then, after a quarter of a mile, the horse started to act funny and stopped. Usually, after a horse breaks sharp, the horse will continue to run well. Once he was pulled up, he was fine. That's how he has been in the last two races. Ramon said he'll probably jog fine back to the barn. I have to send him to the clinic to see what is wrong with the horse. It has to be something internal." Sixth in the GI Preakness S. May 21, Noble Causeway was set to make his return in the Jim Dandy, but was reported to be stiff by his jockey Jerry Bailey and was scratched by the examining veterinarian. He worked four furlongs under the watchful eye of NYRA veterinarians Tuesday in :49 3/5 and was green-lighted to run in yesterday's race.

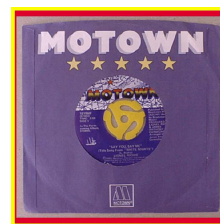

HOPPEGARTEN FACES CLOSURE

Berlin's racecourse Hoppegarten is dangerously close to being shut down after the Union Klub declared insolvency at the district court.
