TALK OF CHI-TOWN

Multiple Grade I winner **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man) has been entered for a title defense in Saturday's GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga, but will run instead in the GI Arlington Million the same afternoon.

Trainer Graham Motion had been leaning toward the Sword Dancer, but has had a change of mind after mulling such factors as pace scenarios and course conditions. "The weather was a huge factor," Motion said. "It's what started the wheels turning." Most of Better Talk Now's best efforts have come over courses with some give to them, which is not the case at the current Saratoga meet. Rain is expected in the Chicago area Friday and Saturday, while Motion termed the Saratoga turf course as "rock hard." Motion ac-

knowledged that the trip to Arlington would mean a rematch with Kitten's Joy and Powerscourt (Ire), who respectively ran second and third to his charge in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. "We realize we're running in the tougher race now," Motion continued. "But we'd rather go out there and run our race--win, lose or draw--than get compromised." John Velazquez will ride Better Talk Now in the Million, replacing Ramon Dominguez. Dominguez has ridden Better Talk Now in each of his last seven starts, but his agent told Motion that he didn't feel he could get out of his other riding commitments on Saturday's Saratoga card.

LAYING OVER THE FIELD

Layman (Sunday Silence) had missed the major gigs so far this term, but his return in yesterday's G3 Salisbury S. at Newbury was as promising as it gets. Guided by an inspired Kerrin McEvoy, the chestnut killed off solid rivals with his acceleration to set a new track record. Handled by Andre Fabre last year, he had looked a star in the ascendancy when dominating the G3 Prix de Cabourg at Deauville in early August, and was not disgraced when runner-up to Divine Proportions in the G1 Prix Morny over soft ground later that month. He faced contrasting conditions the last time he was seen when a short-neck third to Oratorio (Ire) in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp on Arc day. Reportedly idle at home, he woke up in the paddock here and settled kindly off the early fractions carved out by New Seeker. The handsome colt strode to the front passing the quarter pole and kicked clear for an authoritative score. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor is now advocating a continuation of the patient approach with Layman. "Maybe we will take him to Goodwood at the end of the month for the G2 Celebration Mile [Aug. 28], but we will go step by step with him," he said.

Susan Magnier's **Grand Central (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) has been sold to the Hong Kong Breeders' Club, it was announced yesterday. Coolmore issued a statement which read that the sophomore "will continue to be trained at Ballydoyle by Aidan O'Brien for the rest of the year before he embarks on a racing career in Hong Kong." Grand Central was third in the May 8 G2 Leopardstown Derby Trial before finishing unplaced in the G1 Epsom Derby June 4 and the Listed Celebration S. at The Curragh June 26. He returned to the winner's circle after a conditions event at Leopardstown last time July 13. "Saturday's field at Arlington Park is very competitive and it will give Grand Central good international experience before he ships to Hong Kong for more Group races later on in his career," the Hong Kong Breeders' Club's Racing Manager John McGrath said. Grand Central will be leased back to race in the Magnier colors Saturday at Arlington.

KITTEN'S PATH **Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire})**, the morning-line favorite in Saturday's G1 Arlington Million, is likely to take a pass on the Nov. 1 G1 Melbourne Cup, owner Ken Ramsey said.

Instead, Ramsey will point Kitten's Joy for the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf after his scheduled start in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in Paris. Ramsey's plans also include a start in the in the Nov. 27 G1 Japan Cup. "I was very impressed with the people from Australia," Ramsey said. "They flew their representative up here to watch him run in the Firecracker. I had him as my guest in the Turf Club and let him lead the horse in with me when I won. I had a very good experience with them and I

would really love to go to the Melbourne Cup. Having said that, I don't think this is the year I should go. It's about a 20-horse field, it's a long race and the field is usually made up of older geldings. I don't think it would help our horse that much from a stud standpoint to win it. And it could hurt us in our big goal for the end of the season, to win the Japan Cup." Ramsey said that following the Arc, Kitten's Joy will likely be shipped to New York and will stable at either Belmont or Saratoga while preparing for the Breeders' Cup Turf. The Japan Cup will likely be his last career start. "He'll probably be retired after that," Ramsey said. "If he manages to run the table and go undefeated this year, they couldn't deny him Horse of the Year. If we pull off what we have planned for this horse, I think he has to be Horse of the Year, no matter what else happens. If we get Horse of the Year, win the Arc, win in Japan, I think that would be a high note to go out on."

A \$1.2 million KEESEP yearling, Path of Thunder was first or second in six of seven starts last term, including a win in the off-the-turf Golden Pond S. at Calder in December. She made it two in a row with an allowance score on the Gulfstream turf Mar. 2 and added a third straight victory in a Keeneland allowance test on the grass Apr. 14. The bay tired to be sixth in the May 21 GIII Gallorette H. at Pimlico, then took a short break, returning to be seventh in the July 16 GIII All Along Breeders' Cup S. at Colonial Downs. Favored against restricted stakes foes here, she sped out of the gate before slowing it down once in front to set pedestrian fractions. With Patience was at her throat throughout, but Path of Thunder put her away late to prevail. A solid campaigner on the main track, Cloakof Vagueness had made just one previous start on the turf prior to this season. Newly inducted Hall of Famer Nick Zito, who won his first GI Travers S. last year with Birdstone, sent out **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus) for a five-furlong breeze yesterday on the Saratoga main track. The three-year-old covered the distance in 1:02. "We just wanted to stretch his legs," Zito said of the chestnut, who most recently ran third in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 30. "Everything went smooth and he looked [good] out there." Zito indicated that his charge **Sun King** (Charismatic) would also be nominated for the \$1-million Travers Aug. 27. The bay colt, runner-up to Travers hopeful **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus) in the GI Haskell Invitational H. Aug. 7, is considered an unlikely runner. "I think three weeks to come back running is too soon for this horse," Zito said. "Still, I'm going to keep my options open and see what happens."

Act of Duty to Bridlewood:

Act of Duty (Mr. Prospector--Nuryette, by Nureyev), a 3/4-brother to leading young stallion Northern Afleet, will enter stud next year to Bridlewood Farm, according to a press release from the Ocala, Florida nursery. Purchased for \$3.6 million at the 2001 Keeneland July Sale, the chestnut placed once in three starts for Godolphin. In addition to being closely related to Northern Afleet, Act of Duty is also a half brother to Grade I winner Tap to Music and to multiple stakes winner Boss Soss from the family of Cape Town, Fantastic Light and Swain (Ire).
