DEAUVILLE BELONGS TO DUBAWI

Six years ago Dubai Millennium (GB) ripped up the Deauville turf in the G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard-Jacques le Marois, and yesterday it was his finest son **Dubawi (Ire)** who bested **Whipper** (Miesque's

Son) in the same contest. Freshened after a stamina-sapping third in the June 4 G1 Epsom Derby, the 5-1 chance made it look straightforward and was untouched by Kerrin McEvoy's whip en route to a 1 1/2-length success. "Dubawi looks like Dubai Millennium and has a lot of heart, so he is very close to me," Sheikh Mohammed commented. "It is a great day for me and we plan to make him into the world's champion miler." BEST SONG

Unbeaten **What a Song** (Songandaprayer) gave trainer Bob Baffert his sixth win in Del Mar's GII Best Pal S. with a professional performance yesterday. A handy winner of his June 18 career debut, the Bob and Beverly Lewis colorbearer staved off **Bashert** (Tiger Ridge) in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S. July 16. He had been training smartly since and was odds-on to maintain his perfect record. The strapping colt broke alertly to show the way in the opening stages, but allowed **Corazondelcampeon** (Comic Strip) to put his head in front approaching the turn. That didn't last long, though, as the 4-5 chalk took control once again and shrugged off the persistent Bashert to remain unbeaten. The time of 1:15 3/5 was second only to that recorded by Officer in 2001. **A. P. Warrior** (A.P. Indy) was scratched after tossing his rider in the post parade. Horse for the Course..

Dubawi's powerful galloping style has proved well suited to cut in the ground, which he encountered when winning the G1 National S. as a juvenile in September and when beating subsequent G1 Eclipse S. winner Oratorio (Ire) in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 21. His only two defeats have been a fifth on fast ground in the Apr. 30 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket and when failing to see out the mile and a half at Epsom. This mile is his optimum, and he showed his customary early speed to sit in

the slipstream of barnmate **Council Member** (Seattle Slew) until that rabbit caved in at the quarter pole. Left in front there, he was always holding Whipper at safe distance, with McEvoy only needing to wave the stick to keep him straight. Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "He had worked great coming here and was very relaxed, which is a good sign for him, so we were very confident. Now he'll go for the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Newmarket Sept. 24] and the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile [at Belmont Oct. 29]."

Gallant in Defeat..

Trainer Robert Collet offered no excuses for Whipper, who was running back seven days after his success in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. "Once again, he has run a great race, but was beaten by a better horse," he said. "He has had two races in a short space of time, so we'll take our time and see where we go next."

Mortal After All...

Sent off the 7-10 favorite to stretch her record to a perfect 10, **Divine Proportions** (Kingmambo) traveled strongly off the early pace, but floundered under pressure and could make no impression in fourth. "I am very disappointed, as she had the perfect trip and cover, but wasn't able to quicken," a disconsolate trainer Pascal Bary commented. "She certainly hasn't run her race and I don't know why."

Czech-based Group 1 winners do not come along very often, but Darsalam finally broke through after a string of consistent efforts at the highest level. He was sent to Doncaster last September for an audacious bid in the G1 St Leger and was far from disgraced when sixth behind Rule of Law. Subsequently third behind Albanova (GB) in the G1 Preis von Europa just 15 days after those exertions, he closed his season with a win in the G2 Deutsches St Leger at Dortmund in October. After conquering the stamina fest of the May 21 G3 Betty Barclay-Rennen at Baden-Baden, he again ran with credit when ninth in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting at York June 16 before finishing second in the a conditions event on domestic shores at Karlsbad last time July 31. Shadowed by Bandari on the lead, that pair stayed one-two throughout, but the result was not in doubt once Terry Hellier had asked Darsalam to stretch inside the final quarter. A winner at first asking at Keeneland in October, Real Dandy proved best in an optional claimer at Fair Grounds Jan. 21, which sent him on the Triple Crown trail. The bay's five subsequent starts all came in graded stakes: he ran second in the GIII Risen Star S., fifth in the GII Louisiana Derby and fourth in the GII Arkansas Derby. He followed that up with thirds in both the GIII Lone Star Derby May 14 and the GIII Northern Dancer Breeders' Cup S. June 18 before finishing second to Devilment (Peaks and Valleys) in the Round Table S. at Arlington July 16. Allowed to settle into stride at the back of the pack, Real Dandy began to pick it heading into the far turn. He circled the field, collared Magna Graduate in the stretch and outfinished that colt for his first graded stakes success.

Caradak had dominated the G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh on his last start July 17, but had to work harder to prevail in this tight contest. The Minstrel was his fourth stakes score, having taken the Listed Platinum S. at Cork last August and June 26 Listed Celebration S. at The Curragh, and the homebred was a warm order to add this to his resume. Tracking the furious early exchanges in a distant third, he took command on the run to the eighth peg and answered every call as Mustameet lunged late on. "It was nice to see him win, but he didn't seem to run up to his best," conditioner John Oxx commented. "We had the G2 Celebration Mile [at Goodwood Aug. 27] or [Sept. 4] G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp in mind for him, but I think he needs a little break now. Seven furlongs suits him better than a full-blown mile run at the pace that this was today and we might look at the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 1] now."

York is preparing itself for a Japanese invasion tomorrow, when the country's flagship horse Zenno Rob Roy turns up for the G1 Juddmonte International S. Last year's G1 Japan Cup hero will be watched live on Japanese television and via the internet supplied by the Japan Racing Association. William Derby, Racecourse Chief Executive and Clerk of the Course, is savoring the prospect. "The Juddmonte International is our flagship race and we are thrilled that it has lived up to its name and attracted a field of global superstars," he said. "It's particularly exciting that Zenno Rob Roy is set to make his European debut in a contest that has long attracted the very best of our domestic talent. From the perspective of a racecourse manager, one of the keys to the future appeal of our sport lies in yet more international competition among the best in Thoroughbreds." The prestigious three-day Ebor meeting is due to get underway on good ground after rain fell at the track before the weekend. "It is currently good ground, but the forecast is set fair for a sunny, bright week," he said. "We won't be watering; the track is holding up very well."

EUROSILVER RETIRED Buckram Oak's multiple graded stakes winner **Eurosilver** (Unbridled's Song--Russian Tango, by Nijinsky II) has been retired after

sustaining a hairline fracture in his left hind leg, according to published reports. The injury was discovered at Hagyard Equine Medical Institute in Lexington, Kentucky, where the four-year-old was shipped following a sixth-place finish in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 6 at Saratoga. "It's

not a bad one," trainer Carl Nafzger told *Daily Racing Form*. "It's sort of like what happened to Afleet Alex." Stud plans have not yet been determined. Eurosilver began his career under the tutelage of Nick Zito, for whom he captured the 2003 GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity and was among the early favorites for the GI Kentucky Derby. Sidelined by a glandular infection in his neck, the dark bay returned to action in the fall of his sophomore season, finishing second to Commentator in Keeneland's Perryville S. in his first start for Nafzger. He rounded into form and took the GIII Skip Away H. at Gulfstream Apr. 2 before catching a sloppy track when fifth in the GI Pimlico Special. Prior to the Whitney, the grandson of champion Brave Raj was the runner-up to Saint Liam in the GI Stephen Foster H. June 18. Eurosilver retires with a record of 12-4-4-0 and earnings of \$622,310.

Trainer Barclay Tagg signed the ticket at \$100,000 for the bay from Southern Cross Farm's consignment for Elise Benedict Browne.
