**LAST CHANCE SALOON**

Jeff Smith's **Norse Dancer (Ire)** (Halling) is not alone in looking for salvation for a vital Group 1 win in today's Juddmonte International S. at York, a race which features an intriguing line-up. With Godolphin's **Doyen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) attempting to salvage a declining reputation, Susan Magnier's **Ace (Ire)** (Danehill) chasing an elusive first score at the highest level and raiders from Italy and Japan, this will represent a breakthrough for the lucky recipient. Norse Dancer may have the strongest claims if he can reproduce his second to Azamour (Ire) in the July 23 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., but he is zero from 18 at this level. "Hopefully he wins the Group 1 [today]," jockey John Egan said. "We'll just keep our eye on what they're doing on the day and play with the cards we get." Norse Dancer's aptitude for this company is unquestioned, with a third in the G1 2000 Guineas and fourth in the G1 Epsom Derby two years ago. He split Sulamani (Ire) and Bago (Fr) in this 12 months ago before being undone at Leopardstown by Azamour's late burst in the G1 Irish Champion S. last September. That race marked the first setback for Doyen, who had looked such a world beater in last year's King George. His no-show in the Irish Champion was followed by similar efforts in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket in October and on his return in the June 18 G2 Hardwicke S. at the Royal Ascot meet here. **Cont. p2**

**DIVINE ON TRACK FOR MILE**

The Niarchos Family's **Divine Proportions** (Kingmambo) remains on course for the Oct. 29 G1 Breeders' Cup Mile despite losing her unbeaten tag when fourth in Sunday's G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville. The five-time Group 1 winner will head straight to the Belmont contest. "She has traveled home to Chantilly safe and well and she has eaten up," Racing Manager Alan Cooper told *PA Sport* yesterday. "She will have a rest and then go for the Breeders' Cup. Pascal Bary is traveling back from Deauville today and he will have a look at her. It will be a day or two before we know if anything has come to light. She ran flat--it can happen." Divine Proportions was looking for her 10th straight success in the mile contest, having won the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, G1 Prix de Diane and G1 Prix d'Astarte this term.

**PROUD ACCOLADE RETIRED TO PADUA**

Grade I winner **Proud Accolade** (Yes It's True--Proud Ciel, by Septieme Ciel) has been retired from racing and will enter stud next year at Padua Stables in Summerfield, Florida. After beginning his racing career with back-to-back wins at Saratoga last summer, Proud Accolade defeated Afleet Alex by half-length to win the G1 Champagne S. As a three-year-old, the dark bay won the GII Hutcheson S. He ended his career with a third-place finish behind subsequent G1 Haskell Invitational H. winner Roman Ruler and GII Jim Dandy S. winner Flower Alley in the July 4 GII Dwyer S. On the board in five of 10 starts for trainer Todd Pletcher and owner Padua Stables, Proud Accolade retires with four wins and earnings of \$476,630. "Proud Accolade was one of the best of his generation and won one of the most important sire-making stakes in the Champagne," said Padua owner Satish Sanan. "He went on at three to win the GII Hutcheson, another race noted for producing sires. With the excellent success his sire had here and his pedigree being a complete outcross for Mr. Prospector and Northern Dancer, we are very excited to bring him to Florida." Proud Accolade will stand for \$5,000.

Doyen's sixth in last month's King George offered connections some hope that he can regain some face. "Doyen has been disappointing this year and at the end of last season," commented Saeed bin Suroor, in search of his fifth renewal since 1995. "But he came back from the King George in good form and he is training very well so I am happy with him. We are giving him another chance in a Group 1 race, this time over 10 furlongs." Aidan O'Brien, who saddled Giant's Causeway to victory five years ago, relies on Ace. That runner chased home Azamour over course and distance in the June 15 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at the Royal meet, but looked as though he ran out of steam in the 12-furlong King George last time.

**The International Challenge...**

Earle Mack's **Electrocutionist** (Red Ransom) has suffered defeat just once, when nosed out by Shirocco (Ger) in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club at the San Siro in October. He achieved his first score at the highest level back at that venue last time in the June 19 G1 Gran Premio di Milano and is partnered by Mick Kinane. "I've thought about this race for him since the end of last year," conditioner Valfredo Valiani told *PA Sport*. "I've been to York before when Super Tassa won the Yorkshire Oaks and the course will be perfect for him." Japan will be represented for the first time here by Kumiko Oosako's reigning Horse of the Year **Zenno Rob Roy (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence). He has a 10-furlong score to his name in the G1 Tenno Sho last October, alongside success over longer distances in the G1 Japan Cup and G1 Arima Kinen. He warmed up for this with a third in the G1 Takarazuka Kinen at Hanshin June 26 and has acclimatized in Newmarket. "York should suit him," representative Nobutaka Tada told *PA Sport*. "It's a fair, flat track like a lot of courses in Japan. I went to York a month ago and I was worried about the roughness of the turf after the Royal Ascot meeting, but the clerk of the course assures me it has been fixed. That would be the only thing that concerns me. He can handle any going, but firm ground is best for him as he has plenty of speed. He is mentally very strong and very adjustable. He can go off in front, come from behind or be in the pack."

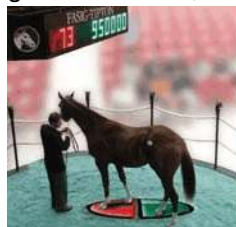

**The Geezer** bids to emulate Bandari (Ire) in completing the Gordon S.-Great Voltigeur double en route to the G1 St Leger at Doncaster Sept. 10. Runner-up to Motivator (GB) in the G1 Dante S. here May 12, he flopped in the June 4 G1 Epsom Derby before running third in the G2 King Edward VII S. at the Royal meet just 13 days later. Not one to rest on his laurels, he was back to win the July 2 Listed July Trophy at Haydock before trouncing Unfurled (Ire) and **Brahminy Kite** in the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood last time July 26. Owner-breeder Jeff Smith is confident there is more to come.

“At Goodwood he trotted up by five lengths and it was only the second time this year he has had his ground,” Smith said. “He had shown in the Dante what a high-class horse he was on ground with just a bit of cut. I don't think it needs to be soft, just a bit of give. At Epsom in the Derby he didn't act on the track and I think potentially he's right up there.” Sir Michael Stoute, a four-time winner of this contest, saddles **Hard Top**, who broke his maiden in fluent style at Lingfield on his latest start July 20. Aidan O'Brien has won two of the last four renewals and puts forward the July 16 Curragh maiden winner **Avalon**, while John Dunlop is looking to the Epsom Derby disappointment **Kong** to provide his first victory in this contest since 1983. That colt had previously beaten subsequent Derby runner-up Walk in the Park (Ire) and **Melrose Avenue** in the May 7 G3 Lingfield Derby Trial and warrants respect.

**Distinction** takes another step towards the Nov. 1 G1 Melbourne Cup as he makes a quick return after a battling score in the G2 Goodwood Cup July 28. That followed a career-best second to Europe's top stayer Westerner (GB) in the June 16 G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meet here and he sets the standard from the Stoute barn successful 12 months ago with First Charter (GB). **Kasthari**, a cast-off from Distinction's stable, surprised the crowds when deadheating with **Millenary** in the G2 Doncaster Cup last September. He comes off a 304-day lay-off after a disappointing last behind that rival in the G3 Jockey Club Cup at Newmarket in October, but has been jumping in the interim. Millenary, who looked to have the domestic stayers' division at his mercy based on last year's evidence, seems to have lost his way this term and could only trail in a distant third in the Goodwood Cup on his latest outing. Godolphin have yet to capture this prize and saddle **Songlark**, who is stepping up markedly in trip having won the Listed Pontefract Castle S. last time June 19.

The weekend's happenings, such as the GI Beverly D. S. success of Angara, the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois triumph of Dubai Millennium's son Dubawi and the GII Best Pal S. victory by What a Song, underlined the way that history has a compelling habit of repeating itself in the world of the Thoroughbred.

Angara's win made her the 12th daughter of Alzao to score at the highest level in Europe or North America, with this total being all the more remarkable in view of the fact that only two of Alzao's sons have gained similar status. While it is difficult to explain such a pronounced bias, female excellence is entrenched in Alzao's genetic history, with both his sire Lyphard and broodmare sire Sir Ivor ranking among the few stallions ever to have sired a female winner of the Arc.

As Lyphard was responsible for such outstanding sons as Dancing Brave and Manila, he couldn't be described as a "filly" sire. However, he did sire an impressive number of Classic-winning daughters, such as Jolypha, Three Troikas, Dancing Maid, Pearl Bracelet, Reine de Saba and Ensconse, plus other distaffers of the quality of Durtal, Ski Paradise, Riviere d'Or, Sabin, Sangué and Chain Bracelet.

I suspect that the main precedent for the sex bias in Alzao's stock was set by Sir Ivor, who was responsible for 30 Group/Graded-winning daughters, but for only 14 Group/Graded-winning sons. The bias was more pronounced among Sir Ivor's Grade/Group 1 winners, with Bates Motel and St. Hilarion being the only sons among a total of nine, completed by Ivanjica, Optimistic Gal, Godetia, Fascinating Girl, Ivor's Image, Lady Capulet and Equanimity.

History is also repeating itself with the unbeaten What a Song, whose efforts--along with those of the Tyro S. winner He's Got Grit--have helped catapult Songandaprayer to the head of the freshman sires' table.

Songandaprayer had ranked alongside Unbridled Elaine, Even the Score and Griffinite as one of the stars of Unbridled's Song's impressive first crop. Unbridled's Song in turn had played a major role in putting Unbridled on the map as a sire, becoming his first Grade I winner from his first crop. Consequently, the first four generations of What a Song's male line were born in the space of only 17 years.

History has also repeated itself in that Songandaprayer stands 16.3 hands and is therefore of a very similar size to the first three stallions in his male line--Unbridled's Song, Unbridled and Fappiano. Fappiano, of course, started his stallion career in Florida before becoming one of the main stallions in Kentucky, and it is possible that a similar fate awaits Songandaprayer. After spending his first three seasons at Marablue Farm and his fourth at Hartley/De Renzo, Walmac South, he has now left Florida for Walmac's head office in Kentucky.

Songandaprayer's fee in his first four seasons has been static at \$10,000, but it will surely be a good deal higher in 2006. It is well worth remembering that his two stakes winners come from a total of 47 named two-year-olds, and that 48 live foals have been reported from his second-season coverings. No doubt there will be much bigger crops to come, especially after his first yearlings sold for up to \$200,000. His first breeze-up horses impressed to the extent that Robert and Beverly Lewis paid \$350,000 for one of his daughters at Fasig-Tipton and \$1,900,000 for one of his sons at Barretts.

That son, of course, was What a Song, who had worked a quarter-mile in a record :20.60 at the first pre-sale breeze show. Once again, this is an instance of history coming close to repeating itself, as Songandaprayer had also achieved a seven-figure price at the two-year-old sales, when Bobby and Leslie Hurley paid \$1,000,000 for him at Fasig-Tipton's Florida February sale.

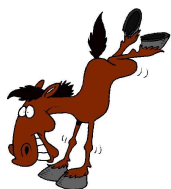

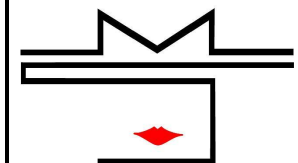

Songandaprayer made a winning debut in the June of his first season and it was only ankle chips which delayed his becoming a stakes winner until November. His finest moment came in the GI Fountain of Youth S., which he won by 2 1/2 lengths after quickly establishing a clear lead. That victory came over 1 1/16 miles, and Songandaprayer struggled as the distances lengthened, finishing fifth in the Florida Derby, a five-length second in the Blue Grass and 13th in the Kentucky Derby after setting fractions of :22.25, :44.86 and 1:09.25. Judging by his final start, a third in the GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S. over six furlongs, his connections finally accepted that he possessed more speed than stamina. In this respect he could be likened to another distinguished Florida stallion, the sprinter Montbrook, whose second dam Attache Case is the third dam of Songandaprayer.

If Songandaprayer is going to sire top performers over a mile and an eighth or more, he is likely to need a bit of help from his mares. So where does that leave What a Song?

The answer, I suspect, is that he is going to shine at shorter distances. His dam, What a Knight, spent most of her career in sprints, her only stakes victory coming in a six-furlong event restricted to the progeny of stallions standing in Washington. It was a similar story with the colt's broodmare sire Tough Knight, a winner of three stakes at around six furlongs at Longacres, and with some of What a Knight's close relatives. Her sister Tough Tara was a speedy juvenile and the same applied to Time For Sale and Foxy Island, two fillies sired by Tough Knight's grandsire Drum Fire from What a Knight's dam Run Tara Run. It is therefore no surprise that What a Song has shown enough speed to win a Grade III over six furlongs and a Grade II over an extra 110 yards.

**INDIA GOING HOME FOR \$2 MILLION** Peachtree Stable's **India** (Hennessy), a 12-length maiden winner at Saratoga July 28, has been sold back to her breeders, Frank and Jane Lyon's Summer Wind Farm for \$2,050,000, according to *Blood-Horse*. Peachtree Stable purchased the filly for \$400,000 at last year's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga August sale. "India is the finest thing I have ever owned," Peachtree owner John Fort told *Blood-Horse*. "I will forever cherish the memories of watching her train all spring, and watching her win by 12 lengths here at Saratoga." India missed by just a neck after a troubled trip in her June 16 debut at Belmont, but made up for it with an impressive maiden score, running 5 1/2 furlongs in 1:04.3. "We raced her mother and we loved her since she was a foal," the Lyons' daughter and Summer Wind manager Karen Bailey told *Blood-Horse*. "It looks like she could be a once-in-a-lifetime filly. We lost three top mares last year--all Grade I producers--so we've been looking for some to add back to the broodmare band." Todd Pletcher will continue to train India.

**CARSON CITY COLT TOPS FASIG OPENER** A colt by Carson City topped Sunday's opening session of the Fasig-Tipton New York-bred Yearlings Sale in Saratoga Springs with a final bid of \$165,000. The yearling, out of the unraced Careful Approach (Re-launch), was consigned by Summerfield, agent, and was purchased by Michael Marceda. He is a half brother to the stakes-placed Shaky Town (Peaks and Valleys). For the session, 55 yearlings sold for \$2,484,000. The average was \$45,164, down 2.8 percent from 2004, while the median rose 5.3 percent to \$40,000. A total of 35 horses were reported not sold. **MILLENNIUM RELATION MYSTERY** *AAP Racing* has reported that hair samples from a horse imported into Australia as **Dubai Excellence (GB)** (Highest Honor {Fr}--Colorado Dancer {GB}, by Shareef Dancer), a half brother to the deceased Dubai Millennium (GB), will be DNA tested in a bid to establish his true identity. A laboratory in Sydney will test 30 hair samples from the "unknown" horse imported six months ago, who had been scheduled to begin covering mares this breeding season. The horse was imported by Western Australia Turf Club chairman Ted van Heemst to his Evergreen Lodge near Bunbury in Western Australia, but it has now become apparent the wrong stallion was sent from England. "We are 99.9-percent sure that he is not Dubai Excellence," van Heemst told *AAP Racing*. Bred by Sheikh Mohammed, Dubai Excellence, a foal of 1999, won his only start at Chepstow as a two-year-old before being retired. Van Heemst said it has become apparent a horse similar in appearance to Dubai Excellence went into quarantine last December before being shipped to Australia. Perth bloodstock agent John Chalmers alerted van Heemst to his doubts about the identity of the new stallion shortly after his arrival. Chalmers, who had negotiated the deal to import Dubai Excellence, was concerned that when the stallion arrived he was a bigger individual than the "original" and also carried no signs of tendon damage evident when inspected in the UK. Further concerns arose when a scan could not detect the new arrival's microchip identification implant. The Australian Stud Book has advised van Heemst that blood tests confirmed that the horse residing at Evergreen Lodge, while probably by Highest Honor, could not be a son of the mare Colorado Dancer. Dubai Excellence had been booked to 80 mares at fee of A\$3,850 for this breeding season. Sheikh Mohammed's chief bloodstock adviser John Ferguson told *Racing Post*, "We sold Dubai Excellence to Australia in late December and are very concerned by the reports we are hearing, so there will be a full investigation to establish the facts."
