With no standout sprinter this year, today's renewal of the G1 Victor Chandler Nunthorpe S. at York needs a boost, which could come in the form of the Marquesa de Moratalla's **Chineur (Fr)** (Fasliyev). He already has

most of his rivals' measure, having bested Hippodrome Racing's **Boogie Street (GB)** (Compton Place {GB}) and John Grant and Cheveley Park Stud's **Moss Vale (Ire)** (Shinko Forest {Ire}) in the June 14 G2 King's Stand S. at the Royal Ascot meet here on his latest start. That was the pinnacle of a four-year-old campaign

which has seen him unbeaten through the various tests of the Apr. 5 Listed Prix Cor de Chasse at Maisons-Laffitte and G3 Prix de Saint-Georges at Longchamp May 15. "I am happy with him and he has trained with no problems since his last race," trainer Mikel Delzangles told *PA Sport*. "The horse is very well. I don't know what to think about the draw, as he will run from stall 14 and I would prefer to have been closer to Avonbridge, but I am about as confident in his chance as I was last time." **Cont. p2**

Punctilious Wins Yorkshire Oaks (cont. from p1)

After finishing third behind Ouija Board (GB) in the G1 Epsom Oaks last June, Punctilious captured the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot, then got to within a length of Ouija Board when runner-up in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh the following month. Her effort there may have taken the edge off subsequently, but she still ran second in the GI E. P. Taylor S. at Woodbine in October before returning this term with two off-the-board runs in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 31 and July 2 G2 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock. Dropped in class for the Listed Chalice S. at Newbury last time July 31, Punctilious reported home an easy two-length winner in that timely confidence booster. Reserved off the fast early fractions towards the rear in yesterday's contest, the bay filly was brought through the favored channel of ground up the middle to deny Dash to the Top, who appeared to be headed for victory at the quarter pole. "She was thoroughly honest and really deserved that," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "We were disappointed with her at Sandown and Haydock, but maybe she just took a long time to come to herself. It seemed to be a real stayers' race, and she stayed on really well--she is very stoutly bred and she will go a mile and six no problem. As long as she's happy and well, we'll look at the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 11] and why not try the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf [at Belmont Oct. 29]? We've got nothing to lose and we've got to be ambitious." Yesterday's close finish allowed Punctilious's sire Danehill to cut into the lead held by Montjeu (Ire) on the leading sires table. Her victory also made Punctilious the fourth Group 1 winner for her sire this year.

No Fun for the Favorite...

The Sangster Family's **Playful Act (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) was sent off the 3-1 favorite, but never looked likely to justify those odds, fading tamely in the straight to finish last. John Deer's **Avonbridge (GB)** (Averti {Ire}), who was beaten 1 ½ lengths by Pastoral Pursuits (GB) when runner-up in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 7, stakes his claim for Group 1 honors after a string of consistent efforts at this level. He had previously won the G3 Palace House S. at Newmarket Apr. 30 before filling third spot behind **The Trader (Ire)** (Selkirk) and **Benbaun (Ire)** (Stravinsky) in the June 5 G2 Prix du Gros-Chene at Chantilly, a race which could be key to this contest. Robert Strauss' **Nipping (Ire)** (Night Shift) was fifth on that occasion before finishing second in both the June 23 Listed Prix Hampton at Chantilly and G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis at Deauville July 9. She warmed up for this with success in the Listed Prix du Cercle back at that track last time Aug. 4. She hails from the stable who ran second with the filly Sainte Marine (Ire) in this contest in 1998 and 1999. Last year's one-two **Bahamian Pirate** (Housebuster) and **The Tatling (Ire)** (Perugino) have not recaptured that form, but the latter failed by only a neck to give five pounds to **Fire up the Band (GB)** (Prince Sabo {GB}) in the G3 King George S. at Goodwood last time July 28.

Mick Channon, who took this race in 1998 and 2001 with the brilliant juveniles Bint Allayl (GB) and Queen's Logic (Ire), respectively, has a contender that may be in their league in the form of **Flashy Wings**. Unbeaten in three starts, she reserved her best for the latter occasion when beating subsequent G2 Cherry Hinton S. second Salut d'Amour (Ire) by three lengths in the June 15 Queen Mary S. at the Royal Ascot meeting held here. Her conditioner is expecting big things. "When you think you've got a good horse, you're always glad when they go and do it in a group race," he said. "She's a high-class filly and on a par with Bint Allayl and Queen's Logic, so it's very exciting. She's got to go and do it again now and La Chunga's no slouch, so it will be a good race." **La Chunga**, impressive when winning the G3 Albany S. at the Royal Ascot meeting June 17, failed to defy a subsequent penalty when fourth in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Newbury last time July 23. She represents the connections responsible for the 2003 heroine Carry On Katie, and like Flashy Wings, will be bidding to become the fifth filly since 1998 to defy an extra burden. "We found a reason for her lacklustre effort at Newbury last time, but her preparations for the Lowther have gone extremely well and we are hopeful," trainer Jeremy Noseda explained. Aidan O'Brien saddles **Beauty Bright**, who started with a third in the July 13 Listed Silver Flash S. at Leopardstown before scoring in a Cork maiden 18 days later.

Third behind Red Clubs in the June 14 G2 Coventry S. at the Royal Ascot meet, Amadeus Wolf exacted his revenge thanks to a five-pound turnaround with that rival. He failed to handle the tight bends of Chester when finishing second in a conditions event last time July 8, but bounced back to provide the Kevin Ryan stable with a notable Ebor meet double after Tuesday's Listed Acomb S. exploits of Palace Episode. Showing the early dash that characterised his sire's Nunthorpe success here four years ago, he raced prominently before hooking up with Red Clubs passing the quarter pole. He gained the edge over that rival in the final 100 yards and was driven out for the win. "I felt he was a better horse coming here than at the Royal meeting, where he was just going a little bit weak on us," Ryan commented. "Everything he has done at home has been exceptional and today he stamped it." The Meadowlands has announced a stakes schedule worth \$2.6 million at its upcoming fall meet, which will run from Sept. 30 through Nov. 12. The East Rutherford, New Jersey oval will host four graded stakes, highlighted by the \$500,000 GII Meadowlands Cup Oct. 7. The other graded stakes are \$250,000 GIII Pegasus S. on opening night, the \$150,000 GIII Cliff Hanger H. Oct. 14 and the \$150,000 GIII Violet H. Oct. 21. "With the Meadowlands Cup three weeks before the Breeders' Cup, we should continue our trend as a major prep for racing's richest day," said Dennis Dowd, senior vice president of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "It was the first time she really did anything in about a month, so she figured to get a little tired. We will probably come back in another week or so and go another five-eighths with her." Stellar Jayne was purchased by Godolphin following a three-year-old campaign which included wins in the GI Gazelle H. and the GI Mother Goose S., both at Belmont. She will be based at that track this fall. "After the Ruffian, there is the Beldame [GI, Oct. 1] and then there is the Breeders' Cup four weeks after the Beldame," Mattee continued. "As of now, we are going to try that, but we'll worry about the Ruffian first and then see how she comes out of it."
