WHAT A SONG EUTHANIZED

What a Song (Songandaprayer--What a Knight, by Tough Knight), who stamped himself as one of the best of his generation with a pair of graded stakes victories this year, was euthanized yesterday morning after fracturing a right-front sesamoid during a routine gallop. The dark bay colt, trained by Bob Baffert for Bob and Beverly Lewis, was returning to the track for the first time since winning the GII Best Pal S. at Del Mar just this past Sunday. What a Song had jogged a mile in the company of a stablemate and was about to break off on an easy one-mile gallop when the injury occurred.

“When he got to the top of the stretch, he switched leads, and it just buckled and went boom,” Baffert told the *Blood-Horse*. “There was nothing [the veterinarians] could do with this type of injury. It’s the kind that won’t heal and they usually founder and suffer,” he added. A \$47,000 weanling purchase from the 2003 Keeneland November sale, What a Song was subsequently resold to pinhooker Murray Smith for \$95,000 at last year’s Fasig-Tipton Kentucky sale. The best, however, was yet to come. Consigned to this year’s Barretts March sale, the colt breezed a quarter mile in a world-record :20.60 and caught the respected eyes of Baffert and Lewis, who ultimately went to \$1.9 million. Sent off at 3-10 for his June 18 bow at Hollywood Park, What a Song won by 3 1/4 lengths in 1:03 and tacked on a neck success in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S. July 16. He made it three-for-three in the Best Pal, winning by 2 3/4 lengths in 1:15 for the 6 1/2 furlongs, the second-fastest time in the history of the race. Baffert told the *Blood-Horse* that the call to Lewis was one of the most difficult he’s ever made. “For some reason, this is the worst one I’ve ever felt,” Baffert admitted. “You lose horses. That’s the worst part about this business, but this one is devastating.” Added Bob Lewis, “I can only say this. ROSES IN MAY RETIRED

Ken and Sarah Ramsey’s **Roses in May** (Devil His Due--Tell a Secret, by Speak John), unraced since his victory in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 26, has been retired from racing due to a torn tendon in his left front leg. “He brought me and my family to a new level,” Ken Ramsey told the *Blood-Horse*. “He was special to us, a real home-run horse. All the big races he ran in...his Dubai World Cup was the highlight of my career. What a great joy that was leading that horse

into the winner’s circle of a prestigious race like that.” A two-time winner at three, Roses in May bested Perfect Drift in the GII Cornhusker BC H. and the GI Whitney H. prior to a score in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic. Second to Ghostzapper in the GI Breeders’ Cup Classic to end the season, the dark bay returned to complete the exacta behind Saint Liam in the GI Donn H. Feb. 5 prior to his Middle East success. Bred by Margaux Farm and trained by Dale Romans, Roses in May retires with a record of 13-8-4-0 and earnings of \$5,490,187.

ALABAMA DEEP DESPITE DEFECTIONS

This afternoon’s GI Alabama S. at Saratoga “suffers” from the withdrawals of GI Kentucky Oaks heroine Summerly and GI Mother Goose and CCA Oaks winner Smuggler, but the field is by no means short on talent. **Sis City** (Slew City Slew), the 2-1 favorite on the morning line, is winless since taking the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 9. Fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last October, **Sis City** rebounded to win the GII Demoiselle S. by 3 3/4 lengths the following month before getting

a rest. Returned to action in the GII Davona Dale S. Feb. 5, the bay crushed by 16 lengths before tacking on a 10-length score over a field including Summerly in the Ashland. She has reportedly overcome issues at the gate, which may have contributed to fourth-place finishes in the Apr. 30 Kentucky Oaks and

the GIII Delaware Oaks July 16. "Bob Duncan has been working with this filly for the last couple of weeks and he's got her in his pocket right now," trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. commented. "I'm hoping when we put her in the gate, she stands quiet as a mouse and if she does, I'm sure she'll run her race."

Spun Sugar Ready for Sweet Run...

Trainer Todd Pletcher has won nearly everything in sight within and beyond the borders of the Empire State, but saddles Stronach Stables' **Spun Sugar** in an attempt to win this three-year-old filly fixture for the first time. A tough-luck runner-up to Smuggler in the GI Mother Goose S. June 25, the bay comes into this off a third to that foe in the CCA Oaks July 23, but can rebound here with some improved luck. "Her best running style is to be in a stalking-type position," Pletcher explained. "Unfortunately, the way it's worked out the last couple of times, we weren't able to do that. If we adjust her trip, she's got a chance." Jockey John Velazquez has won this twice, with Yanks Music in 1996 and Island Fashion in 2003.

R Lady Joy a Capable Longshot...

Richard Averill's **R Lady Joy** has flown mostly under the radar this season while racking up some excellent stats. After doing her dam, Come On Joy (Cormorant)

A full field of 10 fillies, including six graded stakes winners, will go postward in the 49th renewal of this contest. Trainer Julio Canani, who saddled Amorama (Fr) to victory last year, will lead over **Shining Energy** this afternoon. Placed in Listed company while a maiden in France, the chestnut captured her first three U.S. starts before falling short in her next two outings. She rebounded with an impressive victory in the GII San Clemente H. going a mile over this course July 30. "She's doing very, very good," Canani said. "She worked well and I think she'll run good." Two other ex-European runners, **Singhalese** and **Three Degrees**, will be among the favorites. Singhalese ran a bang-up third in the GI American Oaks July 3 before trumping **Isla Cozzene** in a local allowance test Aug. 1. Three Degrees, a sharp winner of the GII Honeymoon Breeders' Cup H. June 5, hasn't been out since finishing fifth in the American Oaks. The well-travelled **Rich in Spirit** sports victories over four different turf courses, including the GIII Regret S. at Churchill June 18, and is coming off a second to My Typhoon (Ire) in the Virginia Oaks at Colonial Downs July 16. Coming in from Germany is **Peaceful Love**, winner of the G3 Fahrhofer Stutenpreis June 29. She followed that with a fourth, beaten just a half-length, in the G3 Prix de Psyche at Deauville Aug. 2.

Horatio Nelson, who takes the next step up after comfortable scores in a course-and-distance maiden June 24 and July 7 G3 Superlative S. at Newmarket, holds solid claims of providing Aidan O'Brien with his sixth renewal since 1997. While he has some way to go to match the level of past winners Giant's Causeway and Hawk Wing, the manner of his Newmarket success suggests there is more to come. British challengers have done well here when the Ballydoyle charges have misfired in recent times, and Eoghan O'Neill is looking for the upset with **Silent Times**. He may have found the soft ground against him when five-lengths second to Close to You (Ire) in a conditions event at Newbury last time July 24. "His last run was a bit inconclusive and he got very tired, but he'll have better ground here and has improved," he said. This race was a favorite of Jim Bolger's before the new Ballydoyle era, with St Jovite a notable winner for the yard in 1991. He relies on **Galantas**, who broke his maiden at Galway on his latest start July 30, but that colt needs to find major improvement to order to trouble the favorite.

Ruwi returns after a break following his troubled run in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly June 5. Sixth on that occasion, he was promoted to fifth, but may have finished closer had he not met interference at a crucial stage. He had previously looked smart when beating **Gold Sound** by three lengths in the Apr. 10 G2 Prix Noailles at Longchamp and may have found the ground too quick when only fourth behind Hurricane Run (Ire) in the G2 Prix Hocquart back at that venue May 9. **Kocab**, who took the May 31 Listed Prix Matchem at Maisons-Laffitte, followed up with a creditable third behind stable companion Archange d'Or (Ire) in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at the same course July 24. He holds the fourth-placed **Chrysander** on that form and represents the Andre Fabre stable, successful five times since 1989. Ruwi's barnmate **Pinson** had **Kendor Dine** back in third when recording a comfortable success in the G3 Prix Daphnis at Longchamp last time June 27 and warrants respect.

PROCLAMATION SPRINT PLAN

Princess Haya of Jordan's **Proclamation (Ire)** (King's Best) will cut back in distance for a tilt at the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup Sept. 3. "The William Hill Sprint at Haydock is the plan for Proclamation," Sheikh Mohammed's Bloodstock Advisor John Ferguson told *Racing Post*. "We will take it one step at a time, but he has come out of the Sussex S. very well, and both Johnny Murtagh who rode him at York when he won the Jersey S., and Mick Kinane, who rode him at Goodwood, said he has the speed for a top sprint."

JOCKEYS STRIKE ON

After weeks of speculation, Monday will witness the proposed strike by the majority of British jockeys in reaction to the introduction of Arena Leisure's own stalls' handlers at Wolverhampton racecourse. Following a meeting between John Blake of the Jockeys' Association and Arena Leisure's Ian Renton yesterday, a compromise was not met, and a large number of riders will boycott the scheduled meet. "I put the suggestion to Ian that should he not use his new team on Monday, I would recommend to my members to take rides," Blake told *PA Sport* yesterday. "He did not accept that invitation though and is keen to stick to his plans. We discussed the suitability of training the staff he has currently got and while our positions are apart on that issue, he certainly understood our concerns that a brand new team would not have the experience of the day-to-day teams." Arena's move to replace the industry's RaceTech handlers with their own set has been met with hostility, but the Jockey Club's trials were passed last week and accreditation and permission were granted.

DNA RESULTS CONFIRM IDENTITY CRISIS The Australian Stud Book confirmed Friday that the stallion at the center of the identification mystery at Evergreen Lodge in Western Australia is definitely not **Dubai Excellence (GB)** (Highest Honor {Fr}, a half brother to champion Dubai Millennium (GB). Keeper of the Stud Book Michael Ford said the situation was unprecedented. "This means the wrong stallion left England," he said. "I cannot recall a situation like this in my 21 years with the Stud Book. It would have been disastrous if he'd served a book of mares. We will be working closely with Weatherbys, the English Stud Book authority, to help the owners determine which stallion really was exported and where Dubai Excellence is now." DNA samples, taken from the mystery horse Monday, were tested this week at the Australian Equine Genetics Research Centre at the University of Queensland. Purchased from Darley for a reported A\$400,000 by WATC chairman and breeder Ted Van Heemst, the stallion once known as Dubai Excellence had been booked to 80 mares this season.
