ered past that rival in the final sixteenth and held fellow closer **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) at bay to give trainer Beau Greely his first victory in a \$1-million race.

ROCKING AT DEAUVILLE

Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) got off to a flyer Sunday evening when a colt from his first crop topped the opening session of the Agence Francaise Yearling Sale at Deauville. After an intense round of bidding between the Coolmore and Shadwell operations, it was Sheikh Hamdan who secured the prized hip 34, Haras d'Etream's half-brother to this year's G1 Prix Jean Prat winner Turtle Bowl (Ire) (Dyhim Diamond), for €500,000. As if the pedigree and looks were not enough, the colt came with the French-bred tag which sets him up for purse premiums of up to 75 percent during his racing career. "He is out of a mare who has produced top horses with moderate sires and you can imagine that she could do even better with a young, promising sire like Rock of Gibraltar," said Angus Gold, racing manager to Sheikh Hamdan. "He is still immature and might need time, but could be a real nice one and the premiums for French-breds are high." *cont. p7&8*

sition next time taking a Newbury maiden by three easy lengths July 22. "We'll have to take our time and think about where she goes now," Channon added. "There's the G1 Fillies' Mile [at Newmarket Sept. 24], the G1 Cheveley Park S. [at Newmarket Sept. 29] and the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac [at Longchamp Oct. 2]."

Not-so-happy Endings..

While Borrego's connection's were celebrating, those behind third-place finisher **Lava Man** and **Musique Toujours** (Musique d'Enfer), who trailed the field home in 11th, found little reason to rejoice. Neither gelding returned to be unsaddled and both were later vanned off the track. The former sustained an injury to his right front, but the injury did not appear to be life or career threatening. Meanwhile, the prognosis for the latter didn't appear to be as upbeat. The five-year-old, who is trained by John Sadler, suffered from a ruptured tendon in his left front and appears unlikely to return to competition.

The handsome grey had not had his picture taken in over a year, but found a good time to become reacquainted with the inside of the winner's circle when he wore down early pacesetter Beau Soleil and outgamed game closer Gotaghostofachance to secure the win. Thrust squarley into the Classics spotlight with victories in last year's GII San Vicente S. and GII San Rafael S., the grey finished third, but was promoted to second, in the GI Santa Anita Derby before employing his customary come-from-behind tactics to collect show money in the GI Kentucky Derby. Generally a model of consistency, the colt failed to hit the board in three subsequent graded stakes starts, but rounded out the season with a third on the grass in the 10-furlong GI Hollywood Derby. Returned to

the main track for his seasonal debut, he came home fourth in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup H. going 1 1/16 miles at Santa Anita Jan. 15 before finishing runner up to Rock Hard Ten, this time by a nose, in the nine-furlong GII Strub S. Feb. 5. Imperialism had been on the sidelines since finishing a well-beaten seventh in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 5.

Suave, sent to the front early and nursed along by jockey Johnny Velazquez, dispensed of early leader Tap Day in deep stretch and held closer Royal Assault safe en route to a professional victory. Up to pressure Tap Day through a modest opening quarter, the bay soon overtook that foe and narrowly led through a half in :48.25 and three quarters in 1:12.14. Pushed along approaching the stretch, he pulled out a little extra in the final sixteenth to record his second straight victory. Favored Offlee Wild faded to last after prompting the early pace. "He makes you work," said Velazquez. "He was a handful in the gate, and he stumbled a little bit coming out of there. I wanted him in good position going into the first turn. Going down the backside, he put his ears up and started pulling out. So, I let him drift to the outside and when Tap Day came back, I dropped him back inside. When both horses [Tap Day and Offlee Wild] came at him, he seriously started running." A three-length winner in the slop in the 1 1/16-mile GIII Northern Dancer S. at Churchill Downs last June, the bay came back the following month to finish second to Rock Hard Ten in the GII Swaps Breeders' Cup S. going nine furlongs at Hollywood. Sixth next time in the GI Travers S., Suave concluded the season with a second and fourth, respectively, in the GII Indiana Derby and the GII Clark H. Sent off the even-money choice for his 2005 debut, the four-year-old made short work of \$50,000 optional claiming company at Arlington July 23, winning by three lengths. Alcazar has been incredibly tough and consistent in stakes company over marathon trips since returning from a lengthy absence due to injury as an eight-year-old. Proving once again that time has not withered him this season, he took the G3 Sagaro S. at Lingfield Apr 27, finished fourth in the G2 Yorkshire Cup May 13 and was third in the G2 Henry II S at Sandown in his last appearance May 30.

Tracking the leaders in fourth after the first furlong of this contest, he was allowed to join the pace-setting Ostankino on the bridle with three furlongs remaining. Pushed into the lead at the quarter pole, he was ridden out from there for the career-best win as Reefscape swooped late to trump Ostankino for second.

Pride's season had not got into gear before this victory, with the joy of a second to Bago (Fr) in the Apr. 24 G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp turning to disappointment as she was demoted to sixth in the stewards' room. She was never in the hunt when sixth in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom last time June 3, but had been consistent in group company for most of last season. The winner of the G3 Prix Allez France at Chantilly in May and runner-up in this race last year, she balked at a crucial stage in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October, finishing 13th. She more than made up for that by taking the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris at the same venue two weeks later, her final start of the season. Racing in her customary position towards the rear of the field here, she made smooth progress to track the leaders at the top of the straight. Pushed into the lead 100 yards from home, the bay was hand-ridden from there for a comfortable victory. The proceedings got off to an auspicious start when the very first yearling, Haras de la Louvière's Peintre Celebre--Abime (Woodman) filly, was knocked down to Shadwell France for €140,000. However, the promise proved short-lived, with one withdrawal and eight buy-backs from the first 37 lots through the ring. Coolmore stallions were at the fore throughout, with Rock of Gibraltar's late sire Danehill securing the second highest price of the session when hip 11, a colt produced by a full sister to MGSW Crimson Tide (Ire), went to trainer David Smaga for €320,000. Consigned by Haras d'Etream, the colt was purchased for Malcolm Parrish. "The dam was unraced after a training accident, but I knew that she was very good at home and I know the family has produced top horses at each generation," the new owner commented. "Danehill is such a great sire that it was worth spending that money for this lovely colt." The "Rock" was back in the spotlight just eight lots later when his colt out of a half sister to G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) winner Bluemamba reached €290,000. From Lady O'Reilly's Haras de la Louviere, the French-bred from the family of Orpen and the outstanding Niarchos dynasty of Coup de Folie was purchased by Marc Antoine Berghgracht's MAB Agency. "I bought him because he is by a young sire who was an exceptional horse on the racecourse, he was raised on a top farm and has the looks to be precocious," Berghgracht said.

Leading Lady

Haras du Mezeray were responsible for the top-priced filly of the session when hip 79, a daughter of Linamix (Fr) from the family of Luth de Saron (Fr), was knocked down to Paul Webber on behalf of an undisclosed client for €260,000. Overall, the market was up and down, with the sought-after yearlings proving easy to sell and the remainder struggling. The average dropped 12 percent on 12 months ago, while the buy-back rate soared to nearly 32 percent. Full results can be found on www.deauville-sales.com. The sale continues today.
