### SHADOW IN THE GRAVEYARD OF FAVORITES

The Saratoga mystique claimed another favorite when the 1-2 chalk **Ashado** (Saint Ballado) was swept aside by the versatile **Shadow Cast** (Smart Strike) in the GI Personal Ensign H. yesterday afternoon. It was the first Grade I win for owner William S. Farish Jr. "Obviously, Ashado didn't run her race today," acknowledged winning trainer Neil Howard. "It is great to win a Grade I with

any horse. But this filly has been so honest and such a nice filly that she doesn't owe anybody anything."

### ADIEU IN SPINAWAY

**Adieu** (El Corredor) rebounded from a loss in the GII Adirondack S. on opening day to take the GII Spinaway S. at Saratoga yesterday in her latest match-up with

**Folklore** (Tiznow). After capturing her debut at Keeneland by 4 1/4 lengths in April, Adieu didn't run again until July 3, when she outbattled Folklore in Belmont's Astoria S. But she faltered as the favorite in the Adirondack, finishing fourth to Folklore, and both fillies were dismissed at 7-1 here in favor of **Effectual** (Carson City). Away alertly, Adieu settled into second as the favorite showed the way. The bay took charge on the

turn and kept finding more when the persistent Folklore challenged her in the lane. "She broke much better," explained winning rider John Velazquez. "She started waiting and pulling up, and I said, 'Oh boy, let someone else come early so she doesn't get surprised.' The closer the horses got, the more she gave me."

### SECOND SEASON

Today's \$1-million GI Travers S. at Saratoga brings together seven colts seeking to cement their credentials in the absence of sidelined Classic winners Afleet Alex and Giacomo. **Bellamy Road** (Concerto), so impressive in winning the GI Wood Memorial before sustaining a splint injury as the beaten favorite in the GI Kentucky Derby, will have his work cut out for him in his first start back since that loss. Facing him will be **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus), perfect in two starts since returning from a long layoff; and **Flower Alley** (Distorted Humor), a dominating winner of the GII Jim Dandy S. ### CHECK MATE

Unbeaten **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier)'s road show continues in the GI King's Bishop S. at the Spa. His perfect record in eight starts encompasses four graded stakes victories at four different tracks, including the GII Carry Back S. at Calder July 10 in his latest tour stop. He steamrolled his overmatched rivals that day, and although he's been training in a bar shoe to protect a quarter crack in his left hind, trainer Greg Gilchrist is brimming with confidence. "If any horse tries to go with him, he'll wear them into the ground," Gilchrist said. "His best attribute is his second quarter. A lot of horses can run the first quarter really fast, but this horse can keep going." King's Bishop cont. p4

Shadow Cast had a fun time at Fair Grounds over the winter, winning three straight races, including the Truly Bound H. Jan. 22 on dirt and the GIII Bayou Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 19 on grass. She missed by just 3/4 of a length when third in the GI Apple Blossom H. Apr. 9 at Oaklawn, with Ashado (Saint Ballado) behind her in fifth. After winning Churchill's GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. on the first Saturday in May, the chestnut ran fifth as the favorite to Two Trail Sioux in the GII Fleur de Lis H. June 18. She went back to the turf for her latest and wound up seventh in the GI Diana H. at Saratoga July 30. The homebred got an ideal trip in this contest, settling comfortably in fifth as Two Trail Sioux sailed along on the lead. While Ashado was spinning her wheels on the far turn, Shadow Cast came rolling on the outside, hit the front at the top of the stretch and finished up strongly. Trainer Todd Pletcher was at a loss about Ashado. "She left there flat and ran flat the whole way," he said. ## ☆ TRAVERS STAKES ☆

**RULING CLASS Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus), forced to skip the Triple Crown with foot problems, looms a tough foe. After edging **Flower Alley** (Distorted Humor) in the GII Dwyer S. July 4, the handsome bay proved a professional victor of the GI Haskell Invitational Aug. 7. "He really stepped up in his last race," said trainer Bob Baffert of the colt's Haskell performance. "He's really doing good this summer, because he's learned how to relax. We always knew he was a good horse, he just had little pestering injuries. He's showing his stuff now."

### Nothing But Flowers...

Flower Alley rebounded from his Dwyer defeat with a front-running score in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 30, when he earned a 112 Beyer Speed Figure while defeating **Reverberate** (Thunder Gulch) and **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus). "Maturity has really brought him to hand," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "I'm very happy with the timing and a race over the track."

### Go East Young Man...

The stretch-running **Don't Get Mad** (Stephen Got Even) makes his first start in New York after disappointing as the favorite in the GII Swaps Breeders' Cup S. July 9, finishing fifth. The bay's finest hours have come at Churchill, where he closed for fourth in the GI Kentucky Derby before posting a sharp win in the GIII Northern Dancer Breeders' Cup S. June 18. "It's possible he likes the East Coast tracks better than the ones in California," said trainer Ron Ellis. "We took him out of his style in the Swaps. We learned that you can't change this horse's style."

**Lost in the Fog** didn't have much competition in his Carry Back S. victory at Calder July 10, but there are some intriguing newcomers in this spot. **The Daddy** will try these deep waters after capturing his first two outings, a maiden win at Hollywood July 16 and a 12-length demolition of New York-breds in a local allowance Aug. 13. **Santana Springs** has improved since running fourth to Lost in the Fog back in March, most recently denying **Social Probation** and **Storm Surge** in the GII Amsterdam S. Aug. 7. **Fusaichi Rock Star**, sidelined after winning the GII San Vicente S. in February, ships in for trainer Bob Baffert after running sixth against his elders in a Del Mar optional claimer July 31.

**Henny Hughes** was unveiled at Monmouth June 17 with a six-length tally, then overwhelmed his rivals by 15 lengths in Belmont's Tremont S. on Independence Day. Those victories led to Darley purchasing him privately for seven figures, and the chestnut rewarded his new connections with a sparkling win in the GII Saratoga Special S. July 28. "He's certainly the best horse I've trained for a long time," said Patrick Biancone, who has remained the colt's conditioner following his purchase. "So far, everything's been perfect. All the karma looks good. When you run in a Grade I you're always going to be stepping up with the competition." Henny Hughes might be facing some heat from fellow unbeaten **First Samurai**, who has won by daylight in each of his two starts. After taking a Churchill maiden by 5 1/2 lengths July 9, the chestnut sailed

home by six lengths in a Saratoga allowance Aug. 7. He has recovered from a minor lung infection suffered following that victory, and a win today isn't imperative to his connections. "He's bred to be, and we bought him to be, a top three-year-old," said owner Bruce Lunsford, whose older star Madcap Escapade was recently retire. "He's turned out to be a pleasant surprise and it looks like he should get better as he goes longer. I like this horse a lot. We're running against a qualified, top-notch two-year-old who's probably going to be better shorter than we are. I hope things keep moving forward to get him to the Breeders' Cup [Belmont, Oct. 29]. As a two-year-old, a mile and a sixteenth should be right in his sweet spot, I would think."

No less than five of the 10 Del Mar Deb runners passed through the ring at the Barretts March Sale, and the best of the quintet to date was led out unsold.

**Indian Breeze**, a \$230,000 RNA, opened her career with a 3/4-length score over \$100,000 BESMAR purchase **Calamity June** in a Hollywood maiden test June 1. She came back to beat **Rivers Prayer**, a \$180,000 BESMAR RNA, by the same margin in the July 2 Landaluce S., but faltered as the 2-1 chalk in the Aug. 6 GIII Sorrento S. at Del Mar, finishing eighth behind undefeated **Bully Bones**. Jockey Tyler Baze said after that effort, "She just wasn't happy today. She was nervous in the post parade, then she just wasn't in the race. I was riding her at the half-mile pole--trying to stay up in there--but she just didn't want to run today." The bay adds blinkers as she tries to get back on track. **Calamity June** led from gate to wire to win by 4 1/2 lengths at Hollywood June 29. She hasn't been out since, but showed her affinity for the Del Mar strip with a bullet six-furlong work in 1:11 2/5 Aug. 13 and came back to breeze seven panels in 1:28 2/5 a week later. **Wild Fit**, a full sister to GSW Fusaichi Rock Star, was bought back for \$240,000 at Barretts, but had those that passed on her second-guessing themselves after a rallying four-length maiden victory at Del Mar Aug. 14. She should handle the added distance in today's event.

The 122-pound highweight was one of the most formidable turf horses in this country in 2004, with wins in the GIII Inglewood H. at Hollywood, the GIII Morvich H. down the hill at Santa Anita and the GI Citation H. to close a five-for-six campaign. In his lone start this season, the five-year-old set a fast pace and held on very gamely to win the GI F.E. Kilroe Mile at Santa Anita Mar. 5.
