She got off to a slow start when chasing Madcap Escapade home in the Princess Rooney, but was the 2-1 Ballerina favorite to finish on top yesterday. Never far back, Happy Ticket powered to the lead with a three-wide move on the turn and drew clear in the final furlong for an easy win.

"She broke perfectly and I was where I wanted to be on the backside," explained winning rider John Velazquez. "I called

Del Mar H. Yesterday at Del Mar, the conditioner did the same thing. Last year the horse was the ill-fated Star Over the Bay. Yesterday it was **Leprechaun Kid** (Alphabet Soup). Mitchell claimed Leprechaun Kid out of a course-and-trip third-place effort in a July 28 optional claimer last time out. The six-

year-old gelding jumped out to the early lead in yesterday's 1 3/8-mile marathon and set moderate fractions on an open lead. Happy Ticket Takes Ballerina (cont. from p1)

Happy Ticket (Anet) stormed through the Louisiana delta last season, with seven straight victories against fellow state-breds. After starting her 2005 campaign with a win against open stakes company at Louisiana Downs in May, Happy Ticket took her show on the road with a 3 1/2-length win in the June 18 GIII Chicago Breeders' Cup H. at Arlington. "She's just a runner," commented winning trainer Andrew Leggio Jr. "We targeted this race after the race in Chicago. I was looking for a seven-furlong race because that seems like it might be her trait. We'll stretch her out when the time comes." As for what is next for Happy Ticket, Leggio admitted, "We have no long-term plans for her. We'll just take it one race at a time."

No Excuses from Also-Rans

Pleasant Home (Seeking the Gold) was well back early, but came running late to be second. "I thought she ran fine; unfortunately, we ran into the Lost in the Fog of the fillies," said Pleasant Home's trainer Shug McGaughey. Rafael Bejarano, aboard third-place finisher **Molto Vita** (Carson City), added, "When I asked her to run at the three-eighths pole, she was coming strong, but Happy Ticket was too much for us."

Three of Sir Michael Stoute's five previous wins in this had come since 1997 and Chic boosted the tally when recording back-to-back successes after a thrilling finale. She used to accompany Russian Rhythm on the gallops at home, but it took until the G3 Hungerford S. at Newbury last August to emerge from that filly's shadow. She was on a roll when beating Nayyir (GB) in this 12 months ago and found only Attraction (GB) too strong in a pulsating renewal of the G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket in October. She was not disgraced when off the board on her comeback in the July 9 G3 Silver Trophy on Lingfield's polytrack, but got connections concerned when failing to beat a rival in the July 27 G1 Sussex S. over course and distance. Belying fears that she was passed her best, she arrived with a late rattle from rear under Ryan Moore to hook up with Majors Cast in the final eighth and had the call only in the final bob of their heads. "It's a relief after last time when she ran so disappointingly," owner-breeder Cheveley Park Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson said. "Sir Michael had said 'Let's take our time and hope that she is an autumn filly,' and she's so game and tough."

In a dramatic renewal of this contest, Lucky Strike was disqualified after looking like he'd gotten third-time lucky, and Striking Ambition was handed the "golden whip" by the stewards. A promising sophomore, Striking Ambition revived his career last October when winning the Listed Testimonial S. at The Curragh and finishing second in the G3 Prix de Seine-et-Oise at Maisons-Laffitte. He returned to that venue to win the Listed Prix Contessina the following month and got off the mark on his seasonal bow in the Listed Woodlands S. at The Curragh Apr. 17. Sixth in the G2 Duke of York S. at York May 11, he trailed in the G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot at York June 14 before rebounding to win the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis at Deauville July 9. He was down the field again in the Aug. 7 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest back at Deauville, but showed his customary dash here to hook up with Lucky Strike at the top of the straight. Carried across the track by that errant rival in the closing stages, he lost the stretch-long war, but won the favor of the judges afterwards. 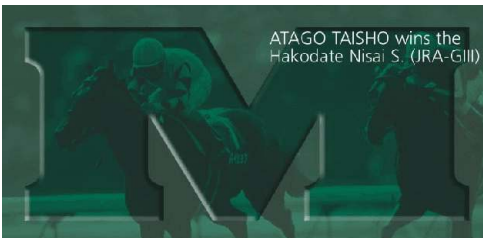

Pletcher's GI Spinaway winner **Adieu** (El Corredor) is expected to start next in the Oct. 8 GI Frizette S.

Zito Happy With Bellamy Road Nick Zito was happy with the Travers effort of **Bellamy Road** (Concerto), who returned from a four-month layoff to run a game second Saturday. "It was an amazing thing that horse did yesterday," Zito said. THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

August 29, 1987...Charlie Whittingham became the first trainer to surpass 500 stakes wins when he sent out Ferdinand to victory in the Cabrillo H. at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club.

August 29, 1993...Laffit Pincay, Jr. 46, became the second rider in North American racing history to ride 8,000 winners when he rode El Toreo to victory in the seventh race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club. Bill Shoemaker was the first to hit 8,000, a feat he accomplished in 1981 at age 49.

August 30, 1981...Arlington Park...Bill Shoemaker became the first jockey to win a \$1 million race when he rode **John Henry** to a nose victory over The Bart in the inaugural Arlington Million.

August 31, 1955...Washington Park...In an East vs. West showdown, East Coast's **Nashua**, ridden by Eddie Arcaro, went wire-to-wire to defeat the West Coast's **Swaps**, ridden by Bill Shoemaker, in a match race.

August 31, 1985...Angel Cordero Jr. became the third rider in history--behind Bill Shoemaker and Laffit Pincay Jr.--to have his mounts earn \$100 million.
