### ESWARAH RETIRED

Shadwell's **Eswarah (GB)** (Unfuwain--Midway Lady, by Alleged), winner of this year's G1 Vodafone Oaks, has been retired from racing after x-rays revealed a small chip in her knee. The three-year-old filly opened her racing career with three straight victories, culminating with her 1 1/2-length triumph in the June 3 Oaks. She also won the Listed Fillies Trial S. Her injury was discovered after a fourth-place finish in the Aug. 17 G1 Yorkshire Oaks. "Eswarah was a very high-class filly, winning three of her five starts, and she was blessed with a great turn of foot for a middle-distance filly," commented

Angus Gold, racing manager to Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum. "I would just like to pay tribute to [trainer] Michael Jarvis and his team who did such a wonderful job with the filly, and also to thank Ben Hanbury and his staff who looked after her so well as a two-year-old." Out of English 1000 Guineas and Oaks winner Midway Lady, Eswarah is a half sister to Group 1-placed Umniyatee (GB) (Green Desert) and to group winner Itnab (GB) (Green Desert).

### DAMAGE TO FAIR GROUNDS UNCLEAR

With much of city under water and the region still reeling from the effects of Hurricane Katrina, which rolled through earlier this week, the damage to New Orleans' Fair Grounds Race Course was still undetermined yesterday. "We will reserve detailed comment on this matter until such time as we are able to conduct on-site inspections and more accurately gauge the impact Hurricane Katrina had on our Louisiana operations," said Thomas H. Meeker, president and chief executive officer of Churchill Downs Incorporated, which owns Fair Grounds. "Given the difficulty of accessing areas affected by the storm, it could take several days or weeks before we have an accurate assessment." Video shot by local television showed extensive flooding and appeared to show damage to the grandstand roof. The oval was closed for live racing, so no horses or stable personnel were housed at the track.

### MULLINS BAY SCORES IN STRENSALL

Like his half-brother Stagecraft (GB), **Mullins Bay (GB)** (Machiavellian) has taken time to grow into his esteemed pedigree, but took another major step forward in this competitive renewal of the G3 Strensall S. at York yesterday. Runner-up to the subsequent G2 Scottish Derby winner Imperial Stride (GB) in the June 17 Listed Wolferton H. at the Royal Ascot meet, he returned to beat established handicappers in the prestigious John Smiths Cup H. last time July 9. He stalked Andean throughout the early stages before mastering that rival approaching the eighth pole. **ZOFFINGER OWNER DRAZIN APPEALS ISELIN FINISH**

Dennis Drazin has appealed the Monmouth Park stewards's decision not to reverse the order of finish in Sunday's GIII Philip H. Iselin Breeders' Cup H. Drazin owns Iselin runner-up **Zoffinger** (Unbridled), who appeared to be bothered by winner **West Virginia** (Tomorrows Cat) during the stretch run of the nine-furlong event. A claim of foul was lodged by Zoffinger's rider, Eddie King, but the stewards let the result stand. Zoffinger, a 65-1 shot, was closing on the outside when West Virginia appeared to come out and take away his path. King was forced to steady at that point. "A great number of people have come up to me and told me we were robbed," Drazin said. "I've looked carefully at the race and looked at the back view. That clearly showed that the other horse came into our path and made Eddie King check and lose momentum. Our horse was coming on again at the end. I thought the stewards should have taken the other horse down." Drazin said this is the first time he has appealed a stewards's ruling as an owner. As an attorney, he has represented two owners who have filed appeals and both, Drazin said, were successful. "I think our chances of winning this are 50-50," he said. "It should be overturned, but you can never count on that happening."

### HECKLE TO SEQUEL STALLIONS IN OCALA

Grade III winner **Heckle** (Hennessy--Bid Me Adieu, by Spectacular Bid) has been sold to JMJ Racing and the partnership of Becky Thomas and Lewis Lakin and will begin his stud career at Sequel Stallions in Ocala, Florida. The four-year-old, who competed in the green and yellow colors of Dogwood Stables, had been unraced since running in the GIII Shakertown S. in April. As a two-year-old, Heckle equaled a

track record at Keeneland for 4 1/2 furlongs in his debut, winning by 12 1/2 lengths in :51 flat, and captured the GIII Tremont S. two starts later. "Heckle could run a hole in the wind," said Dogwood President Cot Campbell. "He was a most attractive yearling, looked like speed, and produced it early in his two-year-old year. Any time you equal a Keeneland track record that had stood for 37 years...you scorch the earth." Heckle, a half to GI Sword Dancer H. winner Spectacular Tide (Tsunami Slew), concludes his career with a record of three wins from 10 starts and earnings of \$155,862. A stud fee has not yet been announced.

**Apprentice Jockey Ore Recovering From Surgery:**

Apprentice jockey Zarella Ore underwent surgery Tuesday after suffering multiple injuries in a River Downs paddock accident Sunday and is currently recovering at University Hospital in Cincinnati. "The surgery went good and she is obviously relieved now that it appears successful," said Ore's agent, Mitch Reed. "Zarella had screws put in both sides of her hips and right pelvis. She injured three tips of her spine, but that can be treated with medication. We're looking at six to eight months of recovery time, but she is looking forward to returning to riding. Hopefully, we'll make the April meet at Indiana or River Downs." Ore was injured when her mount flipped in the paddock Sunday prior to the third race. Reed said after the mishap that the 26-year-old Ore had suffered a broken hip and that her pelvis had sustained fractures in three places.
