HIS DAY IN THE SUN?

This hasn't been the best of summers for trainer Nick Zito. Just four-for-54 at the Saratoga meet that ends

today, he also had to settle for second in the two biggest three-year-old races of the season, finishing runner-up in the GI Haskell Invitational H. with **Sun King** (Charismatic) and in the GI Travers S. with Bellamy Road. But Zito has the chance to end the summer on a high note as he saddles

Sun King and **Indy Storm** (A.P. Indy) in the GII Pennsylvania Derby at Philly Park. The stronger of the pair, Sun King was given a break after finishing a distant fourth in the May 21 GI Preakness S., then came back to post an impressive score in the July 17 GIII Leonard Richards S. at Delaware. He tried to take them gate to wire in the Haskell, but couldn't hold off Roman Ruler. Indy Storm, no threat when fourth in the GI Belmont S., has not been out since a fifth-place finish against Delaware allowance foes July 16. The duo will be challenged by the lightly raced but promising **Quadrant** (Boundary), who makes his stakes debut after finishing second in a Saratoga allowance test Aug. 6; and GIII West Virginia Derby hero **Real Dandy** (Yankee Victor).

He had become the forgotten horse of the summer, but the Australian Syndicate's **Starcraft** (NZ) (Soviet Star) burst back onto the scene with a powerful front-running effort to take yesterday's G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. Cumani for a bold European campaign, which began brightly with a third in the June 14 G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot at York. Rumplestiltskin (Ire) (Danehill) was made a prohibitively short 2-7 favorite to improve trainer Aidan O'Brien's excellent record in yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh, which he annexed with Sequoyah (Ire) in 2000, Quarter Moon (Ire) in 2001 and Necklace (GB) in 2003. THREE VALLEYS IS PICTURE PERFECT

It took the photo finish camera to decide it, but at the finish of yesterday's GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H., it was 9-10 **Three Valleys** (Diesis {GB}) outfinishing **We All Love Aleya** (Nines Wild) by a nose in course-record time of 1:32.21. "I thought we had it, but when I watched the rerun, I wasn't sure," trainer Bobby Frankel admitted. A Group 3 winner at two, Three Valleys finished first in the G1 Middle Park S., but was disqualified for drifting during the stretch drive. Successful at the highest level from seven furlongs to a mile and a half on his domestic circuit in 2004, including a win in the G1 Australian Derby in April, Starcraft ended the term with a third in the G1 Cox Plate in October. He was on the heels of Valixir (Tremolino) and Rakti (GB) on his European debut at the Royal meeting, but boiled over in the preliminaries and suffered a pelvic injury when sixth in the Eclipse. "He behaved badly in the paddock before the Eclipse and we still don't know why, but we've done lots of paddock-schooling at Newmarket during July and August," trainer Luca Cumani said. Putting that performance behind him, Starcraft made all to win handily yesterday. "Now he'll go on to the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Newmarket Sept. 24] before running in either the G1 Champion S. After a May 14 debut score and follow-up in the Listed Swordlestown Stud Sprint S. at Naas June 6, Rumplestiltskin shipped to Royal Ascot at York and was third in the G3 Albany S. June 17. She returned to the Emerald Isle with a score in the G2 Debutante S. at this track Aug. 7. Racing in rear after an eventful exit from the boxes, the odds-on choice was pulled to the outside of the field and pushed along at the quarter pole. Taking a narrow lead from Ugo Fire a furlong out, she dug in to repel that rival's rally in the final eighth. "It was very rough early on and she got smashed after 50 yards," jockey Kieren Fallon commented. "It more or less took me out of the race, but luckily I had a good filly who got me out of jail. She's a very good filly and has gone from strength to strength--in the last furlong she idled and did nothing. She'll definitely go a mile and has done nothing wrong."

Baden-Baden is high on the list for the veteran Warrsan, who added a second renewal of this prestigious race to his resume in comfortable fashion. Previously, he had reserved his best for Epsom, winning the G1 Coronation Cup in 2003 and 2004, but he didn't fare as well in that contest when fourth behind Yeats (Ire) June 3. He never landed a blow when fifth in the June 15 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot at York, but shaped as if a revival was on the cards when fourth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Newbury last time July 23. In an almost carbon copy of his success here 12 months ago, he stalked the steady early tempo before challenging at the top of the straight. Hitting the front at the quarter pole, Warrsan was always holding Gonbarda in the closing stages. "We'll tackle the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 2] with him now and he could stay in training next year, when we might return to Baden-Baden," said trainer Clive Brittain.

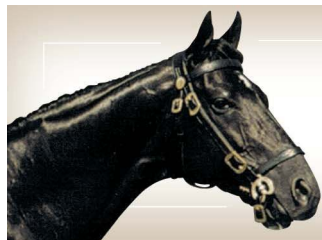

Jambalaya remained unbeaten on the turf here, but just barely. The dark bay tried the grass for the first time in a Woodbine maiden June 12, took an allowance race over that course July 14 and made it three in a row in the third leg of the Canadian Triple Crown, the Aug. 7 Breeders' S. The co-second choice in his first graded-stakes try, he tracked Chestertown Slew (Seattle Slew) through six panels in 1:13.16. He was joined by favorite Silver Whistle as he moved past the pacesetter in the stretch and the two covered the final furlong in tandem, but Jambalaya held on gamely to take the tight photo. "We got lucky, and he's a super horse," trainer Catherine Day Phillips said. "It looked like he had it down the lane, and then he didn't. The see-saw back and forth was something else. As it was, it turned out in our favor." Added jockey Jono Jones, who was winning his first race at the Spa, "We didn't know how good he was because he had only beaten Canadian-breds. Taking on stakes competition once again in quest of her third straight, she broke sharply and set the pace through the opening quarter, then was throttled back to sit off the leaders. The 6-1 chance was fifth after a half and third after six furlongs, but closed from the rail to regain the lead in the stretch and pulled away to a handy score.

Exploded in his second start off a layoff, and at the weights a repeat would give him a big shot. The short rest is a concern, but he did pair up tops at two, so he's definitely a contender.

12 Letterman's Humor Distorted Humor Voss III 20-1

Has done a lot of developing, and is still way too slow.

13 Real Dandy Yankee Victor Asmussen 9-2

Is real solid. He's at least paired his previous top in 10 straight starts, but once the weights are factored in there are a lot of faster horses, and he could get killed by the post and his running style in a big field.

14a Sun King Charismatic Zito 2-1

Qualifies as the best horse with three figures better than anyone here has ever run, but after the weight is factored in he's not as tough, even on his best. And he may not run his best--he has bounced off tops twice before, and now comes off a pair of big ones. And while he does have some speed, the post won't help--contender, but underlay.

Overview – Lots of contenders here, with Quadrant and Smokescreen probably the value.

Jerry Brown formed Thoro-Graph in 1982 to service the needs of horsemen and professional handicappers. Since then, Thoro-Graph has been responsible for the purchase of Belmont winner and champion Victory Gallop, two-time Breeders' Cup Mile winner Da Hoss, multiple track record setter and leading sire Distorted Humor, and 65 other horses that have gone on to win stakes for their clients. Thoro-Graph performance figures take into account weight, ground loss, effect of wind on the time of the race, and track speed. The lower the figure, the better the performance. Among Thoro-Graph's innovations are Thoro-Patterns, and figure-based profiles, which enable horsemen and serious handicappers to accurately assess the tendencies of trainers in different situations, and sire's and dam's runners at different distances, over different surfaces, and at different ages.

'Liam' Gets Bailey, Maybe Rabbit, for Woodward:

Trainer Richard Dutrow, Jr. said yesterday he would enter a 'rabbit' should **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado), the five-year-old he conditions for William Warren, Jr., face a rematch with **Commentator** (Distorted Humor) in Saturday's GI Woodward S. at Belmont. Dutrow blamed himself for Saint Liam's runner-up effort to Commentator in the Aug. 6 GI Whitney H. at the Spa, explaining that he "should have entered a rabbit" to press the front-running Commentator through fast fractions. Commentator led gate-to-wire in the nine-furlong Whitney. In addition to Saint Liam, Dutrow nominated four other horses to the Whitney--**Crafty Player** (Crafty Prospector), **Kazoo** (Tabasco Cat), **Show Boot** (Storm Boot) and **Wamp** (Out of Place)--all horses that prefer to run on the front end. "I'm going to run [one of them] if Commentator runs," Dutrow said. "I don't want [him] getting loose again." Dutrow also revealed that Jerry Bailey would ride Saint Liam in the Woodward, replacing Edgar Prado, who had ridden the bay in his last nine starts. "The owner wanted to make a change for the race," Dutrow explained. Saint Liam worked six panels at Aqueduct yesterday in 1:16 3/5.
