Deauville, the 7-2 co-favorite settled towards the rear early for Thierry Gillet before inhaling her rivals with a sustained stretch run and asserting in the final 50 yards. "She was very good there," Gillet commented. "I waited until two furlongs out and, when I switched her outside, she showed good speed.

The distance was no problem and she has class." Despite finishing third in the G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville last August, Sweet Stream was an outsider when winning the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp the following month. On the road for the remainder of her campaign, she was fourth before being promoted to third in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Italiano at the San Siro in October and fourth in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. She has another foreign assignment to concentrate on this time. "This was a nice test to see if she can get the distance in the G1 Melbourne Cup [at Flemington Nov. 1] and she seemed to need every yard of today's trip," Team Valor's representative Mark Sulkes said. **Click for [Racing Post chart](#) or [brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#).**

**WOODBINE FOR ELECTROCUTIONIST** Earle Mack's G1 International S. winner **Electrocutionist** (Red Ransom) will be aimed at the Oct. 23 GI Canadian International at Woodbine, it was announced yesterday. After the four-year-old's success in the York feature Aug. 16, he was touted as a contender for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 2, but trainer Valfredo Valiani revealed yesterday that the Canadian option was favored. "The decision has been made because there are concerns about the ground and he might have an easier option in Toronto, where he goes with a great chance," he told *PA Sport*. "If the ground is not good in Toronto, we will look at the GI Breeders' Cup Turf [at Belmont] six days later."

### SIMPLY WONDERFUL

**Stevie Wonderboy** (Stephen Got Even), who finished third behind What a Song and **Bashert** (Tiger Ridge) in the July 16 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship while still a maiden, proved he more than belonged with the big boys with an impressive five-length victory in yesterday's GII Del Mar Futurity. Sent off the 5-2 favorite, Stevie Wonderboy was allowed to tarry near the back of the field. He swept into contention with a five-wide move turning for home and mowed down the early leaders with ease to win going away. After his third-place effort in the Hollywood Juvenile, the chestnut colt got a confidence boost with an easy four-length maiden score sprinting 6 1/2 furlongs at Del Mar Aug. 6. Bashert, coming off back-to-back second-place finishes behind the ill-fated What A Song, reared up and flipped over while walking to the paddock, losing a shoe. **Distinction** has his final spin before heading into quarantine for the Nov. 1 G1 Melbourne Cup and enters the starting gate with a point to prove. Having gotten to within a neck of Westerner (GB) in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting at York June 16, he bested lesser foes in the July 28 G2 Goodwood Cup. He was cut down by **Millenary** in the G2 Lonsdale Cup back at that venue on his latest start Aug. 16, but his main asset is stamina, and he goes back up in trip here in his bid to provide Sir Michael Stoute with his second renewal. "He seems in good form," Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's Harry Herbert told *PA Sport*. "He coughed after his last run, so it will be interesting to see what kind of show he puts up against Millenary. Sir Michael has been training him for Melbourne and, hopefully, he can win some more prize money to help pay for his flight." Millenary was rebounding after some below-par efforts this term, having proven himself as one of Britain's top stayers in 2004 when collecting the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York in May, dead-heating with **Kasthari** in this race and bringing up the hat trick in the G3 Jockey Club Cup at Newmarket in October. "He's been frustrating all year and, all of a sudden, he came good in the Lonsdale," jockey Richard Quinn commented. "Two miles and two furlongs is probably just stretching him to the limit, but he did hold on and win it last year and can do it again."

**Iffraaj** gets another chance to prove he is a group performer on his return from a lay-off, having flopped in the July 7 G1 July Cup at Newmarket. He earned a shot at that prize with commanding scores in the seven-furlong Victoria Cup H. at Lingfield May 7 and Wokingham H. back over six at Royal Ascot at York June 18. "We freshened him up after the July Cup and he seems in good form," trainer Michael Jarvis told *PA Sport*. "It remains to be seen if he's a genuine group horse, but we'll find out [today]. The distance will be no problem for him." **Court Masterpiece** is penalised for his battling short-head success over **Jack Sullivan** in the July 26 G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood and that extra burden proved too much when third in the G2 Celebration Mile back at that venue 11 days ago. **Sleeping Indian** is on an upward curve and suffered his sole reversal when fifth behind Proclamation (Ire) in the July 27 G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood. He beat the subsequent G1 Prix du Moulin third Majors Cast (Ire) in the G3 Hungerford S. at Newbury last time Aug. 13, but may need the heavens to open if he is to add to John Gosden's tally of one Park S. winner. Sir Michael Stoute has two renewals to his name since it was made a group contest and relies on **Arakan**, who returned to winning ways in the Listed City of York S. at York last time Aug. 18.

**DARLEY FOR MOTIVATOR** The jockey's merry-go-round continued yesterday as Kevin Darley was named as the replacement for Frankie Dettori on **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. With Dettori booked to ride Susan Magnier's Scorpion (Ire) in the St Leger at Doncaster the same afternoon, the Royal Ascot Racing Club have secured the services of Darley for the G1 Epsom Derby winner, whose prospects of making the race took a turn for the better yesterday. "The latest news is that Kevin Darley rides him and he's a very good big-race jockey," trainer Michael Bell said yesterday after abandoning plans to walk the track. "We're very positive about the weather forecast at the moment, as they rang me this morning to say they can't water as they're expecting up to two inches of rain. That would make life difficult for Azamour, so if it does we're in clover, and if it's not, we'll come back all dressed up and nowhere to go."

### POLLARD'S VISION TO WINTERGREEN

Edgewood Farm's **Pollard's Vision** (Carson City--Etats Unis, by Dixieland Band), who was recently retired, will commence his stud career at John and Beau Greely's Wintergreen Stallion Station in Midway, Kentucky. A winner of six of 23 starts, including the GII Illinois Derby and GIII National Jockey Club H., the dark bay also finished second to Eddington in this year's GI Pimlico Special H. and third in the GI Suburban H. "He has the heart of a champion to overcome everything that has been thrown his way," said Wintergreen's John Greely IV. "He was bred to sprint, even though he broke his maiden as a two-year-old at Saratoga by 12 lengths going seven furlongs, it was his heart and determination that got this son of Carson City to be a Grade II winner at 1 1/8 miles and Grade I placed going 1 1/4 miles." Greely added, "He's a fighter, he always has been since the time he was a young foal and I can't wait to see him pass this on to his offspring." The four-year-old, who is the leading money earner for his deceased sire, retired with earnings of \$1,430,311.

### MAGNA TO SLASH MARYLAND RACING DATES

Maryland Governor Robert Ehrlich told Baltimore radio station WBAL that Magna Entertainment is planning to significantly cut racing dates at Pimlico and Laurel next year. According to Ehrlich, the number of racing dates will be cut from 200 to 112. Magna is proposing two meets at Laurel, for a total of 94 racing days in the winter and fall, and 18 days of racing at Pimlico, from Apr. 21 through Preakness Day, reports [www.wbal.com](http://www.wbal.com). Those dates must be approved by the Maryland Racing Commission. Ehrlich said Magna has given him no assurances that the Preakness would remain in Maryland past 2006.
