### THE BIGGEST SHOW ON EARTH

Nearly one out of every seven foals born in 2004 will make their way through the Keeneland sales pavilion over the next two weeks as the sales company conducts its massive September Yearling Sale beginning this morning at 10 a.m. Billed as the world's largest yearling sale, this year's catalog totals 5,110 yearlings--2,668 colts, 2,440 fillies and two gelding--219 more offerings than the previous record 4,891 booked last year. The 2005 yearling market has thus far been characterized by full catalogs and possible oversupply. Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell suggests that there are external forces at work, adding that this year's catalog, while a record, is only about four percent greater than that of 2004. "The trend more recently has shifted to more commercial breeding and this has really changed the landscape of the business, including the number of horses bred and therefore cataloged for sale," he submitted. "This is especially true of the middle market."

### STELLAR LADY

**Stellar Jayne** (Wild Rush), who looked convincing while dominating easier company in her 2005 debut in the restricted Misty Galore S. going 7 1/2 furlongs July 2, recaptured last year's Grade I-winning form with an impressive victory in yesterday's GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park. Allowed to carve out poky early fractions ahead of **Capeside Lady** (Cape Town), the grey had a five-length cushion turning for home and had enough left in reserve to hold off the ultra-game **Society Selection** (Coronado's Quest). "She broke sharp and went into a nice, relaxed mode," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "[Capeside Lady] never showed up, so I took what came easy. She had plenty left in the tank." According to trainer Saeed bin Suroor, the Godolphin-owned filly may make a start in the nine-furlong GI Beldame S. before her intended engagement in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff Oct. 29. **Ruffian cont. p2**

### MAGIC WANDA

His Highness the Aga Khan's **Shawanda (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) booked her ticket to the Arc in facile fashion yesterday, proving that the course and distance holds no fears with a decisive if cozy victory in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp. The G1 Irish Oaks winner's task was made all the more simple when one of her main rivals **Dash to the Top (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) handed her several lengths at the start, but jockey Christophe Soumillon took no chances, allowing her to stride on in front. Going through the gears in the straight, the 3-10 favorite hardly broke sweat to best **Royal Highness (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) by 3/4 of a length. "She's a classy filly and has improved since the Irish Oaks," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre commented. "That was an easy trial and the fresher she is in the Arc the better. She won't mind any ground, but we don't know about very heavy." **Prix Vermeille cont. p2**

Stellar Jayne showed plenty of class last year while under the tutelage of trainer D. Wayne Lukas. A winner in the June 5 GIII Dogwood Breeders' Cup S. at Churchill Downs, she made it two straight with a 2 1/2-length score over eventual divisional champ Ashado in the GI Mother Goose S. June 26. Second in the mud in the 10-furlong GI Coaching Club American Oaks July 24 and again in a sloppy edition of the Aug. 21 GI Alabama S., won by Society Selection, Stellar Jayne returned to her winning ways in the GI Gazelle S. Sept. 11. Third in her final two starts of the season, including the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Lone Star Oct. 30, the filly was subsequently sold for \$3.6-million at Keeneland in November and is now a perfect two for two in Godolphin blue. "She had a good winter in Dubai," said Saeed bin Suroor. "We really thought she would be a star. We were very patient with her all the time." Shawanda was recording her fourth straight success here, having taken in the May 15 Listed Prix de la Seine at this track, the June 4 G3 Prix de Royaumont at Chantilly and the Classic at The Curragh in her latest appearance July 17. The odds-on favorite to continue her streak yesterday, she made all and was eased down as Royal Highness came to her in the waning yards. "It was clearly just a piece of work," jockey Christophe Soumillon told *PA Sport*. "She did it in a canter." For her owner-breeder, this was a welcome boost after the defeat of Azamour (Ire) in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. "She is a really nice filly who will hopefully improve a little bit more and will definitely take her chance in the [Oct. 2] G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe," the Aga Khan said. "Both her and Azamour could possibly line up, but we have to see what happens with the ground." Pascal Bary said of the runner-up, "She has run a good race and is in the Arc, so we'll see if she takes her chance." This was text-book stuff as Hurricane Run went through the motions in his warm-up for the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe over course and distance. He proved himself over this circuit when winning the May 9 G2 Prix Hocquart before his fast-finishing neck second to Sulamani (Ire) in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 5. Off the track since beating subsequent G1 Grand Prix de Paris and G1 St Leger hero Scorpion (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 26, he raced in second early under Kieren Fallon before muscling his way to the front with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining. Pushed out to assert from there, he was chased all the way to the line by stable companion Runaway, but did enough to keep a comfortable margin. "Its always a delicate situation bringing such a big horse through the summer, but everything has worked out well," commented conditioner Andre Fabre, collecting his sixth winner in this event since 1991. "He proved he is not just one-paced and can quicken today. We've done the most difficult part and it is easy now up to the Arc. I think Kieren Fallon will ride him there and we'll see on the day." Added co-owner Derrick Smith, "I was warned not to expect anything spectacular, but the horse looks the part and Kieren Fallon was pleased. Everything went to plan and I am looking forward to Arc day." Fabre revealed that Runaway may also take his chance in the showpiece if the ground is soft. Alain de Royer-Dupre will have two strings to his bow in the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe after Pride booked her place alongside stable companion Shawanda (Ire) in the fall feature. Last year's G3 Prix Allez France and G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris winner finished off the board in the 2004 Arc. She returned to be disqualified from second after almost upsetting Bago (Fr) in the Apr. 24 G1 Prix Ganay, but failed to figure when sixth in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 3. After a freshener, the bay mare returned with a vengeance at Deauville to win the G2 Prix Jean Romanet last time Aug. 21. Settled in mid-pack early this time, she was produced up the rail in the straight to lead at the quarter pole and was not troubled to hold Alkaased in the run to the line. "She's really started to learn her job and for the first time did not pull in behind," de Royer-Dupre said. "She deserves to win a Group 1 and she is in the Arc and the G1 Prix de l'Opera [on the Arc undercard], but the softer the better." Luca Cumani was pleased with the performance of the runner-up. "He are too much spaghetti in the summer and was a bit overweight," he said. "That was a proper trial and will have brought him on a lot. The plan is to come back for the Arc and only very testing ground would see us change our plans."

Winless at stakes level coming into this race, Silver Train broke into the upper echelon with an authoritative score. Trained earlier in his career by George Mikhalides, the dark bay finished third in his first start for Richard Dutrow Jr. in the restricted Lite the Fuse S. going 6 1/2 furlongs over this track May 18. A runaway winner next out in one-other-than allowance company here July 2, his sole start for trainer Juan Rodriguez, the sophomore again finished third when bumped up to graded-stakes company in the GII Amsterdam S. going six panels at the Spa Aug. 7. Sent off the 2-1 second choice this time, the colt took command early and led the way through early splits of :23.49 and :46.71. Seeming to give the impression that he might allow GI Florida Derby winner High Fly, who was making his first start since a 10th in the May 21 GI Preakness S., to get by after three-quarters in 1:10.04, Silver Train quickly dispelled such notions and drew off to win by daylight. "He should be undefeated on this track for us," explained Dutrow. "The first time I ran him in a stakes here [Lite the Fuse S.], he got into all kinds of trouble. Things just went his way [yesterday]. He was sitting on a race." According to Dutrow, the colt will be aimed at the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 29. [Video, sponsored by Taylor Made.](#)

Heavily favored to remain undefeated, Shakespeare did not disappoint, winning his first graded stakes in the process. A 2 1/4-length winner over Prince Arch in last spring's nine-furlong Caltech S. at Gulfstream Park, the bay would not enter a starting gate again until this season, going postward for a July 27 Saratoga allowance test. A solid 1 3/4-length victor while posting an equally strong 105 Beyer going 8 1/2 furlongs that day, Shakespeare left little doubt with the betting public as to whether he could move that form up to graded company. Content to track the early pace in third through the opening three-quarters in 1:10.53, he mounted his challenge turning for home, took over midstretch and galloped home an easy winner. "He was certainly there for everything he needed through the stretch," commented winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "I think he is adaptable to about anything." According to trainer Bill Mott, an increase in trip might be in the cards for the four-year-old. "He seems to be a horse that would be perfect for a mile and a quarter," said Mott. "I don't think we would want to cut him back to a mile." As to the colt's next start, Mott added, "I've been thinking about the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic [12 furlongs over this track, Oct. 1]. Arravale opened her career with a neck win going seven furlongs on the Woodbine turf and was the second choice moving into the graded ranks at second asking. Rated just off the leaders early, she found herself behind a wall of horses at the quarter pole and lost some ground, but angled outside for the stretch drive. The dark bay filly motored to the front in deep stretch and edged clear. "She's very mature for a two-year-old," said jockey David Clark, who leads Woodbine riders with

12 added-money wins at the 2005 meet. "There were a few quirks down the backside because she wasn't sure where she was. But she's very professional and you would think she's four." Arravale gave trainer MacDonal Benson his fifth win in the Natalma. His first winner in the race, La Lorgnette in 1984, was also ridden by Clark. She went on to win the 1985 Queen's Plate. Shelterfromastorm (Chester House), sent off the 2-1 chalk off a debut win on the grass at Saratoga, set a pressured early pace, but tired in the final furlong to be seventh. **Realism Prevails...**

Last year's September sale was a phenomenal success, as the gross receipts totaled a record \$324.9 million. The average of \$96,411 and the median of \$37,000 also set new standards, while the \$8 million paid by Hideyuki Mori for a colt by Storm Cat--Welcome Surprise was the highest since a \$13.1 million bid for Seattle Dancer in 1985. While officials at Keeneland would love history to repeat itself, they are more inclined to take a realistic approach. "The select books are as strong a group of physicals as we've ever seen, so we are looking forward to a very positive sale," Geoff Russell explained. "Last year's sale was a once-in-a-lifetime sale, the stars aligned. Can we do it again? I'd like to think we can, but now that Hurricane Katrina came along, I think that might dampen it a bit. I think the sale will start off very strong." Russell admits that the economic fallout from the recent events along the Gulf Coast could have a somewhat adverse effect on the middle market at Keeneland. "I'm very pleased the economy has continued on as well as it has. It's very resilient economy, but people are having to pay \$3 for a gallon of gas these days," he said. "I was definitely confident prior to Katrina, but after that I might not be quite so confident [in the middle market]."

**New Sales Pavilion Getting Rave Reviews...**

The September sale is the first to be conducted in the newly renovated sales pavilion. The first stage of the new construction was begun following the conclusion of the 2004 November Breeding Stock sale, which focused on the grounds around the facility. The second phase began upon conclusion of the January sale, concentrating on the upgrade of the interior and the Fayette Room. The third and final phase began after the April Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training, and the results are spectacular. An additional 17,000 square feet of floor space has been added and food service has been enhanced and expedited. Buyers and sellers are now able to take advantage of a new repository, located just off the new dining area. Previously, X-rays were filed and stored in modular facilities located in the parking lot several hundred yards from the pavilion. "When the pavilion was built in 1969, our longest sale spanned four days," Russell explained. "This September, our sale will be conducted over 15 days. Obviously, with this type of growth, it became necessary to expand and upgrade the facility and bring it into the 21<sup>st</sup> century."

**Campy Fun...**

Former Kentucky Governor Brereton C. Jones, headmaster of Airdrie Stud, has had plenty of reasons to smile this year. Nine of them, in fact. That's the number of winners Airdrie's freshman sire **Forest Camp** (Deputy Minister), hero of the GII Del Mar Futurity in 2000, has accrued this season. Remarkably, all nine won in the first trip to post. "Obviously, we're very excited about Forest Camp," said Jones. "I've never know of a sire to have his first nine winners all win their first start. Plus The Pharaoh ran a good second in the GII Del Mar Futurity." With over 50 of his yearlings on offer throughout Keeneland's massive September sale, buyers will have plenty of Forest Camp yearlings to choose from, including two that are catalogued in book one. Today, Airdrie consigns hip [108](#), a bay half brother to MGSW Classic Elegance (Carson City); tomorrow, the nursery consigns hip [279](#), a chesnut colt who counts a pair of stakes-placed geldings as siblings. Jones said hip 108 was an especially sterling representative of the eight-year-old Forest Camp. "He's one of the best physicals in the sale," said Jones. "A number of top horseman had him in their top four or five, so we think he'll sell well. He's extremely athletic and a wonderful mover, which is typical of the Forest Camps. The one who sells [tomorrow] is also very nice." Jones said Forest Camp's 2005 fee of \$15,000 would likely be raised for 2006, but added it probably wouldn't be a sizeable jump. "We haven't decided on a stud fee yet," he said. "But we've always been very reasonable."

**The Heat is On...**

Given little chance at 17-1 and faced with an undesirable inside draw, Xtra Heat, the diminutive but gutsy sophomore filly, sped out to lead the 14-horse field through testing fractions, getting to the half in :44.75 and to the five-eighths mark in :56.30. Despite some of the world's best speedsters behind her, including Kona Gold, Mozart (Ire), Swept Overboard and Left Bank, only eventual champion Squirtle Squirt was able to grind his way past, taking advantage of a ground-saving trip and overhauling the bay in the final sixteenth to win by a half length in a swift 1:08 2/5. In a career that saw her win 26 of 34 starts and earn in excess of \$2.3 million, it was perhaps her runner-up effort in the 2001 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Belmont Park that defined what kind of filly Xtra Heat was--resolute, hard-trying, easy to root for. Modestly bred and hailing from the blue-collar world of Maryland's Laurel Park, Xtra Heat endeared herself to race fans as one of the nation's premier sprinters with a never-say-die attitude. Those attending Keeneland's opening session will have a chance to buy into that attitude this afternoon when Xtra Heat's first foal, a colt by leading sire Gone West, goes under the hammer as hip [132](#). The chestnut is consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent for ClassicStar. Xtra Heat went on to be named champion three-year-old filly in 2001 and continued her winning ways the following season, taking five graded events, placing third in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and beating the boys in the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. Her owners--Ken Taylor, Harry Deitchman and John Salzman--made the pragmatic decision to sell the filly to those who could afford to take seven-figure chances in Thoroughbred's cut-throat breeding industry and entered her in that year's Fasig-Tipton November Sale. Xtra Heat was led out of the ring unsold for \$1.7 million, but was purchased privately shortly thereafter by ClassicStar for a reported \$1.5 million. She raced three times in ClassicStar's red and white silks, winning the What a Summer S. in January of 2003 before annexing her second GII Barbara Fritchie H. in February over the classy Carson Hollow. Retired shortly thereafter, she joined ClassicStar's broodmare band at their farm near Versailles, Ky.

**Murphy Looking for Two-Run Homer...**

It figures to be a busy and nerve-wracking morning for Rob Murphy. As the former MLB player says, "I'll know by lunch Monday how my whole year is going to go." That's because in the span of 28 lots, Murphy will watch a pair of horses that he bred in the name of his M375 Thoroughbreds partnership go under the hammer. And the family has certainly been good to him and his investors. Murphy has been involved in Thoroughbred horses for "most of my adult life." His dad's step-father was a jockey and rode Bimelech during the 1940 Triple Crown. His maternal grandfather was a track announcer and his father had a stable of his own. During the early 1980s, when he was a minor leaguer, Murphy decided to involve himself in the business, purchasing his first horse for \$30,000, who won three of his first seven starts and counted Proud Truth and Creme Fraiche among the horses he defeated. Four of the first six horses he bought (in partnership) went on to win stakes events, but eventually the team needed to adjust their philosophy. "The yearling market began to heat up, making it difficult to buy horses, so we began breeding our own horses and began looking for broodmares in 1995," he explained. Murphy settled on the Wavering Monarch mare Michelle's Monarch, who, he remembered from her racing days at Calder. He learned that the four-year-old was in for \$5,000 at Fair Grounds. They dropped a claim slip and had near immediate success when they sent her to stud. "The first year we bred her and she had a nice foal and then the second year we bred her to Cozzene," he explained. "We ended up with this beautiful gray filly who from day one, you knew was going to be a pretty good racehorse and that turned out to be Platinum Tiara."

That grey filly made a name for herself at two, winning the Brave Raj S. at Calder before finishing runner-up in the 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. She would go on to place in four other graded-stakes events in a career which saw her win five races and \$608,785. The first foal from the now seven-year-old, a filly by A.P. Indy, sells today as [hip 41](#). She is consigned on a foal-share basis by Lane's End. A yearling full brother to Platinum Tiara is consigned by Taylor Made as lucky [hip 13](#). Murphy may have some added optimism, the result of an award-winning science project compiled by his daughter Grace. In analyzing the race records and earnings of each foal by Cozzene from 1987 to 2001, she found that in terms of percentage of runners and winners, those foals which carried Cozzene's gray coloring were more successful at a higher level than non-grays. In fact, at Grade I level, the ratio was about 10 to 1, Grace determined. Both of the yearlings set to sell are gray or roan in color. So, it'd be fair to say that Murphy is looking for gray skies today at Keeneland.

*Oxley Has Interesting Combo...*

It's not too often that a yearling by a Kentucky Derby winner, produced by a Kentucky Oaks heroine, strides into a sales ring, and it's unheard of that the winners were campaigned by the same owner. Such is the case with the Three Chimneys consigned [hip 227](#). A member of the second crop of John Oxley's 1999 Run for the Roses hero Monarchos, the Feb. 20 foal is a daughter of Oxley's Gal In a Ruckus (Bold Ruckus), victorious in the 1995 Oaks at odds of 34-1. The Tulsa, Oklahoma, native will also be represented during tomorrow's second session in the form of [hip 456](#). Consigned by Gainesway as agent, the bay is the first foal of Darling My Darling (Deputy Minister), who raced in the colors of Oxley's wife Debby. The Mar. 21 foal is a grandson of Roamin Rachel, the dam of Japanese champion Zenno Rob Roy (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), recent runner-up in the G1 International S. at York.
