DISCREET CAT HEADED TO THE DESERT

Discreet Cat (Forestry), who earned a division-leading 106 Beyer Speed Figure in his impressive maiden win for owner Joyce Robsham and trainer Stanley Hough at the Spa Aug. 27 ([video](#)), has been purchased privately for an undisclosed amount by Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's Godolphin Racing Inc. and was transferred to Rick Mettee's Belmont barn, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The exciting juvenile may start once more in the United States before heading to Dubai. He will not be pointed to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile S. at Belmont Oct. 29. "Obviously we're excited about having the horse in the barn," Mettee told the *Form*. "He won well up at Saratoga. Looks like a horse that should at least be a middle-distance horse, anyway." Out of GI Alabama S. victress Pretty Discreet, the Robsham homebred is a half brother to Pretty Wild (Wild Again), MSW & MGISP, \$398,280. Hough advised to Robsham to sell. "She just sold him for me, because it's my theory that you have to make a business out of it, it's not something she wanted to do," Hough said. "He's a lot of horse. It was a very fair offer, one that was hard to turn down. In my opinion, he was well worth it."

MR. GREELEY FILLY TOPS KEESEP TUESDAY

Selling as hip 2871, a filly by Mr. Greeley topped Tuesday's session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale with a final bid of \$350,000. Out of Heat Lightning, she is a half sister to this year's GII Del Mar Futurity S. winner Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even). Blandford Bloodstock, agent for Ahmed Zayat, purchased the bay from Glennwood Farm, Inc. as agent. During Tuesday's session, 283 yearlings sold for \$12,917,500 with an average of \$45,645. Through the first eight days of the auction, 2,058 horses have brought a record \$352,576,500 and an average of \$171,320. "The middle market is strong and doing well," said Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "We continue to be encouraged by the fact that we see new people arriving all the time."

It never ceases to amaze us--although by now it probably shouldn't--how often the first major stakes winner or best runner for a sire owns a very clever or intriguing pedigree pattern. It happened once again this weekend when Folklore conclusively defeated her rivals in the GI Matron S., moving to the head of the juvenile filly division in the process.

Folklore is a member of the first crop sired by Tiznow, who now has the distinction of being the first freshman sire of 2005 to be represented by a Grade I winner. That Tiznow should be able to sire such a precocious performer is particularly encouraging in the light of his race record and pedigree. In fact, neither Tiznow nor his sire, Cee's Tizzy, ran at two, and his grandsire, Relaunch, started just once at that age, finishing third.

Tiznow really made his presence know in the second part of his three-year-old season. He gained his first stakes win in July with a score in the GIII Affirmed H., and after seconds in the GI Swaps S. and GI Pacific Classic, ended the season with successive scores in the GI Super Derby, GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. and GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The Classic, which saw Tiznow hold off fellow three-year-old Giant's Causeway in a heart-stopping finish, with Fusaichi Pegasus, Cat Thief, Albert the Great, Captain Steve and Lemon Drop Kid further behind, secured Tiznow honors as not only champion three-year-old, but also Horse of the Year.

The following year, Tiznow kicked off the campaign with a win in the GII San Fernando S. In March, he took the GI Santa Anita H. by five lengths, but his fall campaign started two defeats as he finished third in the GI Woodward S. and GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. However, he was back to his best on the day that mattered, again turning back a formidable European traveler--Sakhee--to claim a second GI Breeders' Cup Classic and another Eclipse Award, this time as champion older male.

It's likely that a considerable portion of the credit for Folklore's precocity can be laid at the door of her maternal grandsire Storm Cat, who came within inches of earning a champion two-year-old title when second to Tasso in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. We don't know what aptitude Folklore's dam Contrive might have possessed, as she never ran, but her pedigree certainly gave her potential in abundance. In addition to being a daughter of Storm Cat, she was out of the Fappiano mare Jeano. This tough mare faced the starter 49 times over five seasons and won 10 races, including the Doubledogdare S. at four; the GIII Thoroughbred Club of America H., GIII Shirley Jones H. and Ellis Park Breeders' Cup H. at five; and another renewal of the Doubledogdare at six.

As a broodmare, Jeano's performance has been less impressive, as her only black-type performer is the French Listed-placed Prinze Oskar (Dayjur). She is, however, the granddam of the Sorority S. winner Queens Plaza, who is by Storm Cat's son Forestry, and therefore is bred on similar lines to Folklore's dam.

Jeano was a product of the famed Fappiano/In Reality combination (which gives inbreeding to Rough'n Tumble through his best son and daughter, Dr. Fager and My Dear Girl) since her dam was the In Reality mare Basie. Winner of the GI Delaware H., Basie was by In Reality out of Stolen Base, which makes her closely related to Smarty Jones' dam I'll Get Along, who is by a son of In Reality out of a daughter of Stolen Base. In direct female line, the family goes back to La Troienne, via one of the families most prolific channels, Stolen Base's granddam, Striking, one of the tribe of important runners and producers to be sired by War Admiral out of a daughter of La Troienne.

In the introduction to this article, we mentioned that Folklore is the product of a clever pedigree pattern: in fact, she is inbred to a horse who himself was highly inbred to another inbred ancestor! The key inbreeding in Folklore's pedigree is a double of In Reality, who appears 4x4 via the direct male line and via a mare in the direct female line. In Reality himself had War Relic 3x3 in the same pattern. When we come to look the pedigree of War Relic, a son of Man o' War, we find that he had Rock Sand and Fairy Gold, two of Man o' War's grandparents, 3x3 in his pedigree. With this in mind, we probably shouldn't be surprised that inbreeding to In Reality has worked rather well. To date it is found in more than 30 restricted stakes winners, with Folklore being preceded as a Grade I winner by Banshee Breeze and Empire Maker (both grandsons of Fappiano, who is also here) and Glitter Woman.

King's Trail hadn't raced since Nov. 13, when he ran second in the G2 Keio Hai Nisai S. in Tokyo. The dark bay had been sidelined with a fracture and proved to be a handful in the paddock prior to this comeback. After travelling kindly in midfield, the three-year-old put his head in front in the stretch and staved off the favorite for his first stakes victory. "He was relaxed in the race and raced smoothly," said winning rider Hiroshi Kitamura. "He started to fight again in the stretch. I am very pleased to win."

Kane Hekili earned his sixth victory in seven outings this season here. After finishing seventh on the turf in the Mainichi Hai S. Mar. 26, the chestnut rattled off three straight, including the G3 Unicorn S. June 4 and the G1 Japan Dirt Derby at Ohi by four lengths July 13. Sent off as the even-money favorite, Kane Hekili was never seriously threatened and won by daylight.

DUBAWI ON TRACK Godolphin's **Dubawi (Ire)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}) pleased connections yesterday as he continued his preparation for Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Newmarket. Partnered by Frankie Dettori over six furlongs of the Racecourse Side gallop, the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois winner was reported in "great form" by Racing Manager Simon Crisford, who revealed that he would be joined by a pacemaker in the mile contest. "We're really excited," said Crisford. "We are looking to run one pacemaker--probably **Blatant (GB)** (Machiavellian), though we haven't decided yet--and we're excited." Trainer Saeed bin Suroor was hoping that the dry forecast proves incorrect yesterday, adding, "He's ready and Frankie was very happy with him this morning. We'll pray for rain, as he moves very well when its good and good to soft. That would be perfect for him."

CAUSEWAY READY Martin Schwartz's **Maids Causeway (Ire)** (Giant's Causeway) came through a racecourse workout at Newmarket yesterday and connections confirmed her as on course for the Oct. 1 G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket. Off the track with a muscle injury sustained when besting Karen's Caper in the June 17 G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot at York, the sophomore galloped over seven furlongs of the Rowley Mile under Michael Hills in company with last year's Listed Chesham S. winner Whazzat (GB). "It was always going to be a piece of work not a trial," her conditioner Barry Hills told *PA Sport*. "But she's back and she's up to speed. I couldn't be more pleased with her. All being well, she'll run in the Sun Chariot and then she'll probably run in the G1 Champion S. [at Newmarket Oct. 15]."

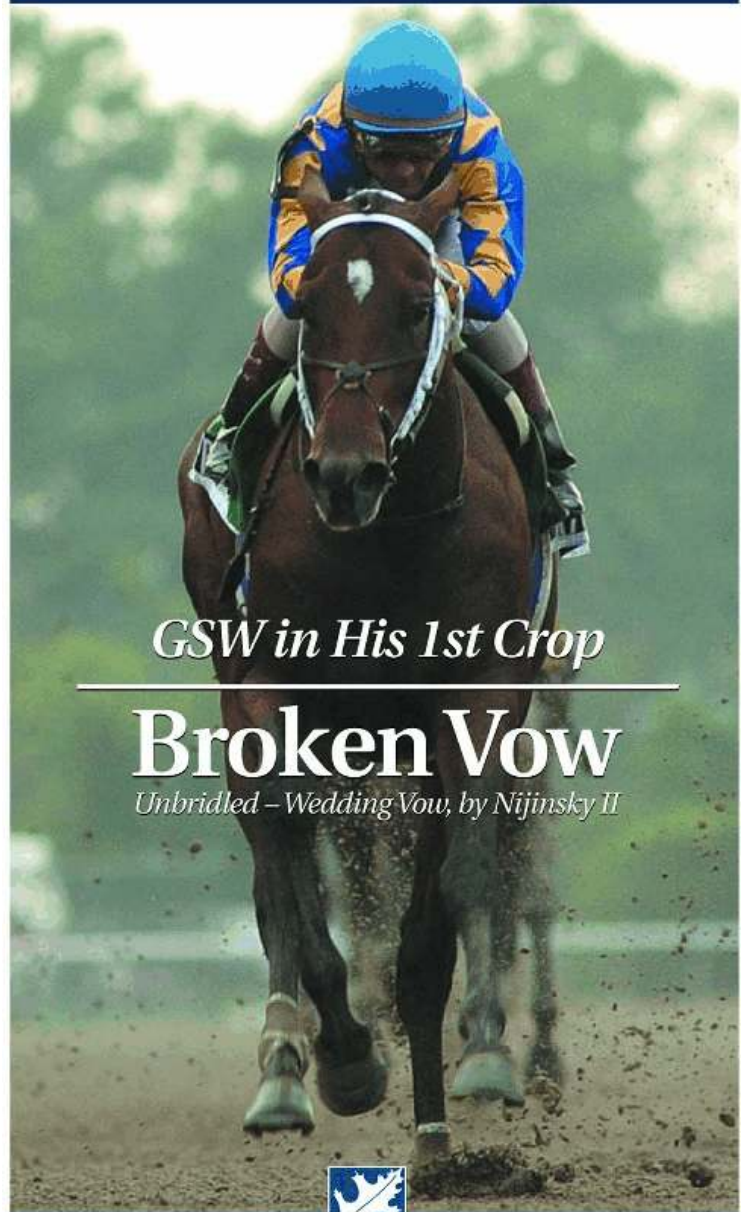




